Out in cornfield of **Frank R. TERRELL's** Farm residence in Wayne Tp. Clinton Co, O. Oct 12, 1926 2:40 PM

I hired **Albert L. CURL** at Blanchester O. to bring me out here for 10 cts a mile. We stopped at Mr TERRELL's fine home on a corner in New Vienna, O & found the house closed & the lady in the next house said they had moved to their farm home. Going there, we found their fine country house locked up, but gathered a pocketful of good small hickory nuts in the front yard. We then went back to a tenant house near & the lady there said **Mrs. TERRELL** had gone out with some visiting friends to gather hickory nuts, but if we would follow the road down through the woods, we would find **Frank** in the cornfield beyond driving the binder cutting off corn. The cornfield was a 45 A. one about a mile long & I walked half across it before I came to him & was surprised that the binder only cut one row at a time. He is a fine man of 45 yrs with good teeth & a fetching smile. He said his town residence was his permanent address viz: **Frank R. TERRELL**, New Vienna, O.

He says his grandfather, **Robert P. FINLEY** came from Highland Co, O. where he was born at New Market O. He died about 1891 aged 83 yrs. He had a brother **Hiram FINLEY** who lived in Wilmington O. where he ran a harness shop & who was married but had no issue.

His grandfather is buried in Wilmington, in Sugar Grove Cem. & his three wives are buried there also, as you go in the cemetery on a slope to the right in a big lot, but without monument or markers. His son **Wm P.** & his wife & one infant & also an infant of his son **Charles** is buried there. The authorities did not want any markers on this lot. **Wm P's** daughter Miss **Atha FINLEY** aged abt 51 & single is a stenographer in Indianapolis, Ind & he will get her address & send me. He thinks she will have both her father's & her grandfather's bible as her grandfather in his last years lived with his son Wm P. & died there & he got all of his effects. He will also send me the address of his Aunt **Sal-lie Finley** widow of **Charles E.** (see page 420) who died 5 or 6 yrs ago at Joliet, Ills where he lived for many years & died aged 74 yrs. She lives in Chicago, Ills & should have a record of the family which **Charles E.** gathered going to Phila to interview relatives there to do so.

**Frank R.** has a sister living in Maplewood NJ Frank R. said his own mother died when he was 17. She always spoke of Rev **James B. FINLEY** as her great Uncle. See bk 1 1 page 400 [best guess on number] Her brother Wm P. knew this great Uncle & had in his young days visited in his home. Frank R's father **Hugh E. TERRELL** died in Feby 24, 1914 aged 76 yrs. He & his wife had five children:

1. **Arthur Finley TERRELL** living at New Brighton Pa where he is a machinist
2. **Jane L. TERRELL** living at New Vienna, O.
3. **Esther TERRELL**, who married **Howard PIDGEON**, a graduate of Cornell University where he was once a Prof, but is now in the research dept in NY of the Am Tel & Tel Co & both are living at Maplewood, NJ
4. **Russell L. TERRELL** died 21 yrs ago aged 26, would have been 47 now. He died of pneumonia.
5. **Frank Rhoades TERRELL**, my informant born Sept 17, 1881 in the house on this farm & his father was born in same house.

This farm proper has been in the TERRELL family for over 100 yrs. They now have 950 Acres which he is farming owned 300 by his gfs estate 353 by his father's estate 120 by his Aunt & 176 by himself. His gf was **David A. TERRELL** & his wife was **Mary EVANS**.

## GISELA TERRELL

Her Courage, spunk forged a new home in a new country

You find **Gisela Terrell** on the third floor of the Butler University library, working amid rows of books and materials that detail the lives of figures such as **Abraham LINCOLN**, **Herman MELVILLE**, and **Jesse OWENS**.

As the librarian of Butler s Rare Book, Room, Terrell can tell you about the troubles those men faced, the efforts they made and gifts they left behind.

But this day, the 45-year-old Terrell shares the story of a far less prominent person – a woman who was born in war-torn Germany, immigrated to the United States, makes her home in an Indiana, cabin and views life as a quest for quality.

The story Terrell tells is her own. She was born in 1942 in a small town in western Germany, and although she didn't know much about World War II as a child, it

shaped her life. Her father was killed in the war and her mother struggled to provide for three children.

The war also touched Terrell's life when she was a 12-year-old member of the first amateur orchestra to play outside West Germany after the war.

"It was in the 1950s and we toured Denmark for two weeks. Denmark was occupied by Germany during the war and there was a lot of bitterness. But the response to the music was polite and we got invited back. With each tour, we were accepted more. That's when I learned how important the endeavors of amateurs can be in overcoming hatred and differences."

During those years, she also learned how to clear a wooded area, cut firewood, grow a garden and carry water from spring -- lessons that, surprisingly, would help her after she immigrated to America.

As a teacher in West Germany, she met an exchange student from Indiana University during the 1960s, fell in love, married him and moved to Bloomington. Several years later, the marriage ended in divorce, but she decided to stay in Indiana.

A turning point came in 1974. That was the year Terrell became a full-time staff member at IU's Lilly Library, the year she signed a mortgage for a one-room cabin on 5<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> acres of wooded area in Owen County.

It didn't matter to her that the cabin had no indoor plumbing or the only heat sources were a fireplace and a wood-burning stove. By herself, Terrell used an axe, a shovel, a handsaw and a wheelbarrow to clear the land and build a supply of firewood. Then she planted a garden and put in a septic system.

"Sometimes; people would ask me what I was doing, but that's how this area was settled. The thing is when I had all the really hard work done, I fell in love with a neighbor who would have been glad to do the work."

Now married to that former neighbor and working at Butler, Terrell still lives in the expanded cabin, making the 140-mile round-trip every weekday.

"As much as I love books and learning, I love the life of the land. It's beautiful there, and I don't want to put a preference of one life over the other. That's one of the things I love about this country. It still allows you to live in the fashion you wish."

Indeed, one of Terrell's favorite stories about America comes from a trip she made several years ago.

"In Wyoming, there was a mechanic who replaced a starter in our car at 6 o'clock on a Sunday morning. When I returned there two years later, I brought them some homemade blackberry jelly and they gave me two rainbow trout which I had for dinner that night. We're I still in touch.

"In a way, it's a connection to my days in the orchestra when we stayed with a family in those countries. I'm still in touch with some of those people. Those things have always been important I to me. They're part of my life.

Her children were: **Floy; Lena** (she had a twin brother who died @ birth or shortly thereafter); **Selma; Tamie; Taylor; Thomas** (Will); and **Robert Luster/Lester** (who was my great-grandfather). Again, these children's names are from census records and from Crowe family research)

She died 25 April 1967 and is buried at Green Springs Church in Marion Co., AL

L013 *Terrell Genealogy* by Emma Dicken lists him first on p. 52 "**John Dabney TERRELL** 1773-1850, son of Col. **Harry TERRELL**, in his last years wrote from memory a family sketch in which he named **William TERRELL** as the parent of his grandfather, **Joel TERRELL**. "William lived and died in Hanover County on the Pamunkey River .. I cannot remember who he married .. Of his daughters I remember nothing; his sons of whom I have heard were **James, John, Joel** and **Timothy**."

p.109 **John Dabney TERRELL**, son of Col. **Harry TERRELL**, and his first wife, **Ann DABNEY**, was born 14 Oct. 1773 in Bedford County, Virginia, d. 10 May 1850 in Marion County, north of Pikesville,

p.110 **John Dabney TERRELL** and **Lydia Briscoe WARREN** were married 10 march, 1795. We have seen the statement that she was born in North Carolina. She was born about 1774, and died 1853. Their children were:

- (1) **Alpha** b. 29 Mar. 1796 m. **John Thomas NEAL**, a soldier of 1812 and son of **John Thomas NEAL**, a Revolutionary soldier. They moved to Aberdeen, Miss. but later returned to Alabama and died at Neal's Ferry on the Buttahatchie River. Descendents live in Texas.
- (2) **Edward Garland TERRELL** m. **Rachel LAND** in Georgia. He was elected Circuit Clerk of Marion County, Alabama in 1835. He was a Major and later Lieutenant Colonel in the 16th Regiment of the Alabama State Militia, Marion County. (State Mil. Reg. 1820-1822.) He died about 1886. Some of the sons of Edward Garland TERRELL were Confederate Soldiers.
- (3) **William Higgins TERRELL** b. 1800. He and Elizabeth Oxford were twins.
- (4) **Elizabeth Oxford TERRELL** b. 1800 m. **William SMITH** and lived in Chickasaw County, Miss. We know of no living descendants. She had children.
- (5) **James TERRELL** went to Texas. Married a Miss **HUGHES**. He died at Daingerfield, Texas.
- (6) **John Dabney TERRELL, Jr.**
- (7) **Bochim or Bocia TERRELL** m. **Robert CLARK**. Had daughters: **Rebecca** and **Mary**, whose descendants lived at Hamilton, Ala.
- (8) **Ann Dabney TERRELL** m. **Harley TUTTLE**, a lawyer from Vermont; they had one or two children. After his death, she married Judge **HARVEY**, also a lawyer. Their son, **Henry HARVEY**, went to Texas.
- (9) **Sarah Allen TERRELL** m. **James "Red Jim" BANK-HEAD**, of Sulligent, Alabama. Had no children. She died about 1888.

In the spring 2008 Terrell Trails pg 2201 (Vol XXIV/ No I) you mentioned. **Counterenchile TERRELL** He is my G-G-G-Grandfather. He married **Susan STANLEY**. Their daughter, **Susan Elizabeth Francis Fanny TERRELL**, married **Nathaniel MILLS**. Fanny died at my grandfather's house in 1902. All lived in Western Hanover Co., VA.

In a note to you in 2001 may have told you he was called "count" or "counter" by the family. At one time someone had an old photo of the "count", I have been unable to locate it.

Judge Baziles lifelong hobby was Hanover County history. What is left of his notes is in VA Historical Society.

From Judge Bazile notes on the Terrell Family at VA Historical Society: "**Timothy Terrell** was freeholder in St. Martins Parish, Hanover County in 1782. He married [blank] They had the following issue as far as can be established from available records: **Roger Terrell, Ralph H.
