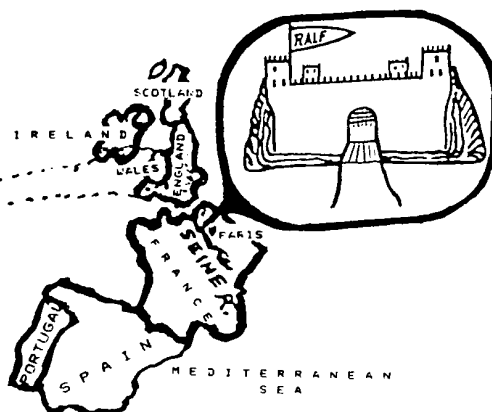

HERALDRY

PART 1: HISTORY

Because of the flurry of questions received from members regarding the choice of crest and motto used on our special binder for *Terrell Trails*, we are devoting this column of this and subsequent issues to the subject of Heraldry.

To properly cover this subject could take years. Here, we will only scratch the surface, apply what we have learned and possibly list some references for further study in the last segment.

Heraldry is properly defined as a study of designs used to distinguish individual families and to authenticate official documents as well as the art of reproducing these designs in full color picture form from written descriptions and/or black & white diagrams.

The oldest form of Heraldry was developed by the Egyptians which has been called a *Cartouche* (*car TOOSH*). This was an oval shaped frame with the name or symbol of the ruler on it. In later years the term came to refer to an oval (Rounded on both top and bottom) shield used by popes and churchmen of noble descent to display their coats of arms. Knights used shields rounded only on the bottom. Therefore the difference in shape kept the churchmen from being mistaken for knights and other combatants. The modern parallel is the white band with the red cross worn by our military medical corpsmen.

In the middle ages, the design came to be known as a *Coat of Arms* because of the custom of embroidering the emblem of a knight onto the surcoat which he wore over his armor.

At first, each individual selected his own design to represent a personal quality or an incident in his life. This led to confusion because of duplication of designs.

In ancient times, each king had messengers called *heralds* that carried his messages to the people, and later to neighboring kings; the forerunner of our modern ambassadors. It was a crime to interfere with their work as they went from one country to another. Medi-

eval heralds became authorities on coats of arms used by different nobles for identification in battle. Eventually, they supervised the selection of new designs to prevent duplication.

The *Order of the Garter* is the highest and perhaps the oldest order of knighthood in Great Britain. It was founded by King Edward III of England in 1349. Only 25 members besides the king were first admitted. It was reorganized in 1831 and the membership was increased to include the Prince of Wales, descendants of George I, and some foreign rulers. The English monarch is always grandmaster.

The emblem of the order is a dark blue garter edged in gold on which is printed the words the king spoke upon establishing the order (too long a story to repeat here) "*Honi soit qui mal y pense*" (French: '*Evil be to him who evil thinks.*')

Saint George was considered its patron Saint, and tho there were many others, it is sometimes called *The Order of St. George*.

Genealogical and Heraldic Dictionary of the Peerage and Baronetage of the United Kingdom, is considered the best source of information about the ancestry of the families of Great Britain. First published by an Irishman, John Burke, in 1826, it has been published every year since and is commonly known as *Burke's Peerage*.

1987 TERRELL SOCIETY REUNION DATE AND SITE: The Fourth annual reunion of the TERRELL SOCIETY OF AMERICA, INC. has been set for the last Friday and Saturday (30/31st.) of October 1987 at Unicoi Lodge in Unicoi State Park near Helen, GA, approximately 35 miles north

of Gainesville, GA.

IMPORTANT: PLEASE NOTE THIS IS OUR FIRST REUNION THAT IS NOT COVERED-DISH. ALSO, YOU DO NOT HAVE TO RESERVE A ROOM TO ATTEND. MEMBERS, PROSPECTIVE MEMBERS, AND GUESTS ARE WELCOME AS DAY GUESTS ON EITHER FRIDAY PM, ALL DAY SATURDAY, OR SUNDAY AM.

We have been advised that we are reserved 25 rooms in the inn under an agreement whereby each family may make its own reservation. The reservation calls for checkin at 4:00 pm on October 30 and checkout at 11:00 am on Nov. 1, 1987.

The lodge is arranged in buildings consisting of 10 rooms upstairs and 10 downstairs. The downstairs rooms sleep 4. The upstairs rooms sleep 6; but two have to be young enough to climb a ladder to a loft---ideal for families with teenagers & children.

Those who have problems which prevent climbing stairs should specifically request ground floor rooms, and those who have no difficulty with stairs should be courteous enough to request loft rooms.

Rooms may be rented either single, or for any number up to 4 or 6. The 1987 RATES (per night) are \$44.00 single, \$50.00 double, and \$6.00 for each additional person over age 12, apparently children 12 & under are free.

The lodge features a buffet three times per day, so you ladies won't have any food to cook, beds to make, or carpets to vacuum, Hoo-rah!!!! **BUFFET RATES: Breakfast \$5.09; Lunch Mon-Sat \$5.92, Sun. \$7.11; Dinner \$8.98.**

Color brochure and reservation application with full rates details can be obtained by sending a long stamped, self-addressed envelope to Mr. L. F. LeSturgeon, Correspondence Secretary, 2314 Hempstead Place, Charlotte, NC 28207.

We only have 30 applications and 39 brochures so **HURRY OR YOU MAY BE LEFT OUT!** You must have an official form.

In addition to the Lodge, Unicoi park has 25 1,2, or 3 bedroom cottages which may be rented for a minimum of 2 nights to a maximum of 2 weeks. If the Lodge reservations are filled, call 404-878-2824 to inquire about cottage availability.

Unicoi has 50 RV sites and 30 tent sites, if camping is your bag. Therefore we are not limited to the 124-130 persons that can be housed in the 25

lodge rooms, but we do need to fill at least 20 rooms in the lodge to get use the living area for our meeting. For camping, Picnic Shelter information and reservations call 404-878-3366.

Access to out of state members in addition to driving all the way is easiest by flying into Atlanta and renting a car to drive approximately 120 miles to Unicoi.

Both regular columns, SETTLING PAINS and WAGONS WEST are being omitted this issue in order that we may bring you the next pages of SOURCE RECORD information on the Terrell variants in the USA between 1600 & 1840.

The first step in researching your ancestor is: BEGIN WITH WHAT YOU KNOW (and what your relatives know).

The second step is to DECIDE WHAT YOU WANT TO KNOW NEXT.

The third step is: USE PREVIOUS RESEARCH. (Don't waste precious time re-inventing the wheel.)

The following pages are an example of what one can locate in less than 3 hours using previous research--if he knows where to look!

This information was copied from microfiche in the LDS Mormon Branch Genealogical Library in Dunwoody, GA by your editor at a cost of about \$11.00

The information published here is from the AIS (Accelerated Indexing Service) file and covers most of the variants.

This is an index of ORIGINAL RECORD information, mostly from census, but some tax record, petition, and miscellaneous information is included.

In most cases, the information is as follows: LAST NAME, FIRST & MIDDLE NAME; COUNTY; STATE; PAGE OR FAMILY NUMBER; TOWN OR TOWNSHIP; YEAR OF ORIGINAL RECORD. Special notes to left of date such as TX indicates tax record; MayTX indicates a Tax Roll for May of that year; some numbers appearing in the township column (example:100010-10100) have meaning only to your LDS Genealogical Librarian who can help you locate information on these if you do not have access to census microfilm.

HOW TO USE THIS INFORMATION: We highly recommend that you check the given name(s) of your ancestor(s) through every variation of the name, not just the ones spelled as you now spell your name. This will give you clues to where your ancestor may have been in this era. If you know where your ancestor was in a given year, then you can eliminate those of the same given name that were elsewhere in that year.

If you find one or more who appear likely to have been your ancestor you will want to follow up and obtain a copy of the original document. If you have access to the microfilm and know how, you can do so yourself. If you are near a LDS Branch Genealogical Library, your librarian and/or volunteer assistants can show you how to look for the original records. If you do not have access to either, then your best route would probably be to seek professional research help.
