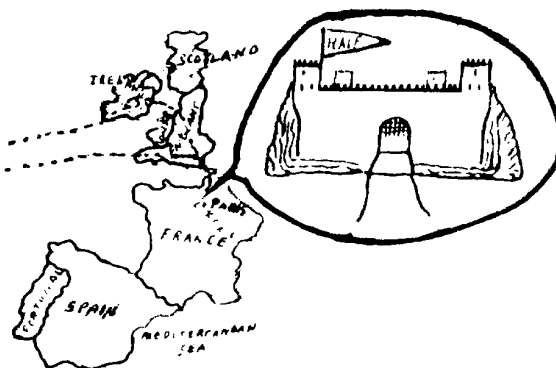

Robert Terrell, a fishmonger, with brothers Richard and William to VA previous to 1647.

The accompanying photograph of THE RUFUS STONE, was taken from one of three postcards donated to the Society by Mr. & Mrs. G. S. Terrell of Aberdeen, WA. The inscription which appeared on page 20 contained some doubt as to the contents of the last line. Upon examination, your editor found that the last line is 'anno 1100.' The anno is from anno Domini (in the year of the Lord) and is forerunner of 1100 A.D. which would be used today to denote time measured in the church age. Each of the three postcards were by a different publisher. One card indicates, 'located just off the main road between Cadnam and Stoney Cross in Canterton Glen, the Rufus Stone marks the spot where King William II, surnamed Rufus, was killed in the year 1100. The stone has three sides and bears an inscription on each face.'

Terrell, George; Mr; (01/01/1799--1799+) born Caroline County VA son of Jesse & Mary Bailey Johnson T.; member of Cedar Creek Monthly Meeting of Friends from birth; 05/10/1823 reported married out of unity and married contrary to discipline disowned 7th month 12th day; 12/10/1845 one George Terrell chosen overseer Caroline Meeting; (*Ency. American Quaker Genealogy Vol VI p 274/277*); Cedar Creek Monthly Meeting Dist, VA.

Terrell, Henry; Mr; (01/29/1735--1740+) son of Henry & Anne ? T.; 08/13/1768 reinstated by Cedar Creek Monthly Meeting; 09/14/1776 dismissed for non-attendance and joining another Society; (*Ency American Quaker Genealogy Vol VI p 273/4/6*); Cedar Creek Monthly Meeting, VA.

Terrell, Henry; Mr; (--1756+) son of David & ? ? T.; 04/10/1756 under care of Monthly Meeting for nonattendance; 06/11/1757 condemned for misconduct; acc; 11/11/1758 dismissed; (*Ency American Quaker Genealogy Vol VI p 275*); Cedar Creek Monthly Meeting, VA.

Ladd received by Henrico Monthly Meeting on certificate from Cedar Creek MM dated 05/07/1831 & returned to care of Wayn Oak PM; 06/04/1831 Caty granted certificate to Short Creek MM, O. (she is step-dau. of Robert Ladd); 04/09/1831 granted certificate from Cedar Creek MM to Wayanoke MM VA; (*Ency. American Quaker Genealogy Vol VI p. 215/277*); VA.

Terrell, Eli; Mr; (c//1859--//1880+) born GA son of William & Mariah T.; md. Martha ? ?; Possibly in Douglas Co. GA; farm labor; possibly for father next door; married in 1880; wife born c1857; (*Census 1880 Douglas County GA Fairplay Dist 439*); (1880) Douglas County, GA.

Terrell, Eliza Ann; Miss; (03/04/1807--//1830+) born Caroline County VA dau of Jesse & Mary Bailey Johnson T.; member of Cedar Creek Monthly Meeting from birth; 06/12/1830 disowned for marrying contrary to discipline; (*Ency. American Quaker Genealogy Vol VI p 274/277*); Cedar Creek Monthly Meeting Dist., VA.

Terrell, Gerrard; Mr; (11/03/1800--//1802+) son of Edward & Jane Johnson T.; 11/14/1801 received on certificate with parents to South River Monthly Meeting of Friends from Goose Creek MM dated 09/05/1801; (*Ency American Quaker Genealogy Vol VI p 341/342/355*); Campbell County, VA.

MARY MC TERRELL  
01/27/1787--10/12/1864

Born SC.; dau Philemon & Elizabeth ? Terrell (see last issue); moved to Liberty Co. GA in the 1790's; md. c1810 Reason F. Swilley (b. SC. 1766--01/13/1854); children: Nancy Swilley b. 01/24/1811 md. ? ? Bone; Calvin E. Swilley (03/19/1812--09/16/ 1841) died single; Franklin Swilley b. 11/21/1813 md Vicy Boyd, dau. Henry; Elizabeth Swilley b. 06/16/1815 md. John Lee, moved to FL; Senie Swilley b. 02/29/1818, evidently died young; Jesse A. Swilley b. 12/19.1819 md. Cane Strickland, moved to FL; Eliza Swilley b. 12/12/1823 md. John Boyd, son of Henry; Reason E. F. Swilley b. 03/20/1826 md. Maria ? ? ; Samuel S. Swilley b. 03/25/1818 md. ? ?, died in Confederate Army; William Madison Swilley b. 05/13/1830 md. Rebecca Daniels, died 1908; husband was son of Samuel Swilley, Revolutionary Soldier; moved to GA soon after the revolution; lived in Bryan and Liberty Counties, GA; most of family moved into Tattnall and Appling Counties GA as they were created; by 1830 Reason and Mary had moved to LL No. 116, 16th Dist. of Lowndes [Now Echols] Co. GA; both were members of Primitive Baptist Church including Sarpeta Baptist Church in Tattnall Co. GA, Union Church in Lowndes Co. GA, and on 02/13/1836 were dismissed to join a new church nearer their home now known as Antioch, later moved their membership into organization of Bethel Church in Hamilton Co. FL where they remained until death; Reason, & sons, Franklin, Calvin, and Jessee were privates in Capt. David R. Bryan's Company, Lowndes Co. Militia in the Indian War; both are buried in the Swilley Cemetery in Echols Co. GA; homeplace passed to youngest son William M. Swilley, then to J. A. Swilley, a grandson of Reason F. Swilley. **MEMORIES OF JAMES HENRY AND JULIA  
OLDHAM COOK**

In compliance with an old tradition--  
ladies first. My grandmother was an  
excellent cook, preparing many Thanks-  
giving, Christmas, birthday, and spe-  
cial dinners for her family. She was  
also very compassionate in offering aid  
to sick friends and neighbors, and  
helping at the time of the birth of a  
new life when they lived in Argyle, TX  
just out of Denton.

As far as personal appearance, she was  
very aristocratic looking, taking a  
great deal of time in seeing that her  
family was dressed and behaved prop-  
erly. She had red hair and blue eyes as  
well as natural wit and a good sense of  
humor. She also had a very volital  
temperament. She was a large woman,  
5'8" tall, but very erect, and I'm told  
that at one time she weighed 200 pounds  
although she didn't weigh that much  
during the time I remember her.

Her mother, (Lodie Oldham) lived with  
them until the time of her death. In  
view of the fact that my grandparents  
lived in Denton during the latter part  
of their lives, numerous neices and  
nephews lived wit them during the time  
they attended T.W.U. of North Texas.

In spite of a 4th. or 5th. grade educa-  
tion, she was one of the most intelli-  
gent women I have ever known. She had  
to quit school to help at home in An-  
derson County.

She died in her sleep of a heart attack  
early in the morning of July 4, 1953.  
At that time, she was living with Aunt  
Mackie and Uncle C. A. Scott at 1401  
Boliver, Denton, TX.

My grandfather, James Henry Cook, was  
every inch of his 5'9" a 'southern  
gentleman.' He had small hands and feet  
even for a small man. After his many  
years in Texas, he still had his Geor-  
gia accent. He had dark hair, blue  
eyes, and a handlebar mustache. He was  
very kind, soft spoken, and had an even  
temperament.

When he lived in Anderson County, TX.,

he carried the mail using a horse and  
buggy. He was a rural mail carrier just  
south of Denton at the small town of  
Argyle when I was a child. Later they  
lived in Denton as he continued carry-  
ing mail until his retirement. At the  
time of his death, he and my grandmo-  
ther were living at 1521 Bolivar, Den-  
ton, TX.

He had numerous heart attacks as well  
as cancer. He was in the hospital three  
times during the last two years of his  
life. He and my grandmother are buried  
at Rose Lawn Cemetary, Denton, TX.

The happy times with my grandfather are  
those I choose to remember. All the  
girls and boys in the neighborhood  
loved him. Each Christmas, he would  
dress as Santa, and pay them a visit.  
In my mind's eye, I can still see him  
after his retirement, sitting in the  
front porch swing.

Both my grandmother and grandfather  
were devout Baptists. He was a deacon,  
and they were always regular in church  
attendance and participation of church  
activities. They nurtured their child-  
ren in a Christian home. ####

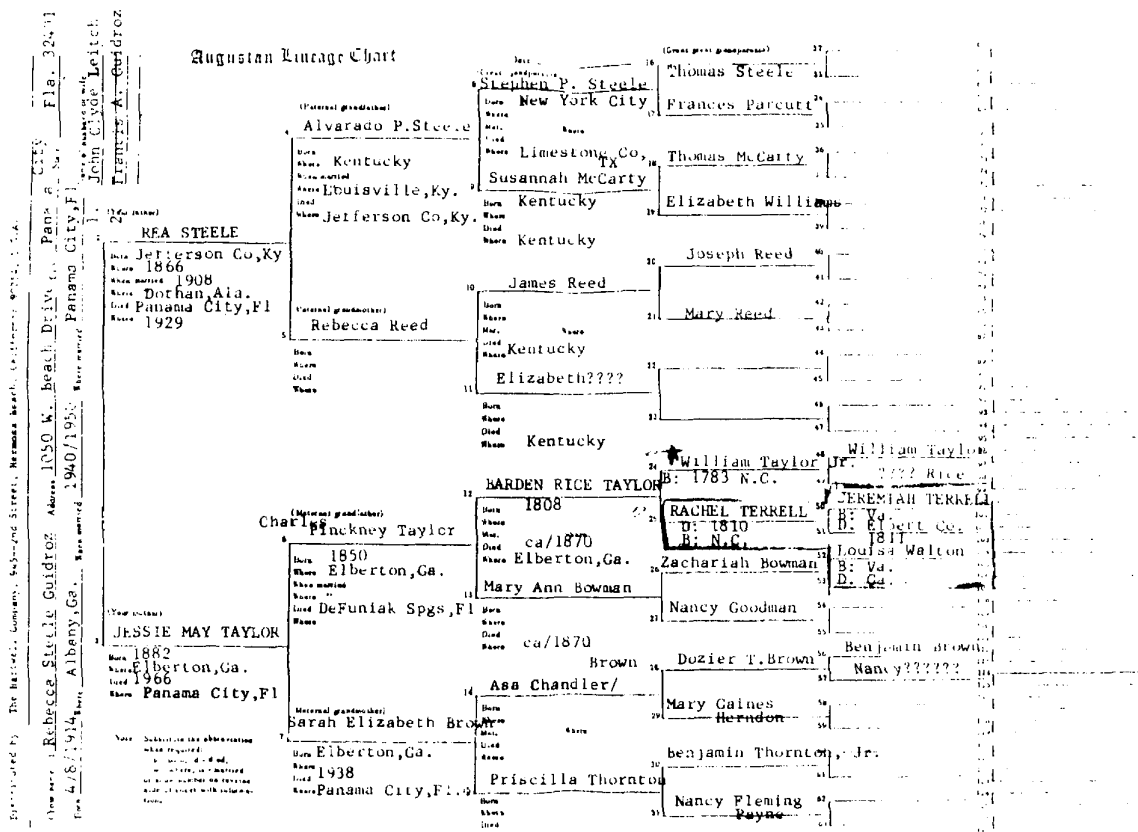
