**TRIBUTE TO MR. BRUCE TODD**

Bruce Todd was born in Neches, TX on March 26, 1914 to Elvis and Myrtie Love TERRELL Todd. He is older brother Bynum Todd was born September 21, 1912. When Bruce was four months old, his mother died of complications of typhoid fever. Bruce went to live with his grandfather in Corpus Christi, TX until his father remar-

ried about 3 years later. His father and step-mother had four more children: Gwynelle, Dona, Mavis, and Malon.

They moved to West Texas and were there for four years; then they moved to Georgia for nearly seven years. The family moved back to the original home in Texas when Bruce was about 11 years old and remained there. When Bruce was 13, he went to visit his uncle in Arkansas. While there, he saw a girl sitting on her back porch shining her shoes and liked what he saw.

His uncle told him she was the daughter of Judge Edgar and to stay away from his girls because he was very protective of them. Bruce decided he was going to marry her anyway—someday.

Bruce had a great desire to see more of the country so at age 16, about 1930, he left home. He wandered all over the USA, working at odd jobs wherever he could. At one point, he rode in rodeos—his specialty was roping steer. He considered staying with that profession, but was discouraged by an "old timer" in the rodeo business who told him it was a hard life and a person had to be constantly on the move.

Bruce eventually went to California and fell in love with the country. He decided to settle in the Westwood area in 1933. He went back to Arkansas in 1940 and asked the girl of his dreams, Hazel Antoinette Edgar, to marry him. She accepted and they were married in Reno, NV on May 3, 1940. Their marriage was solemnized in Salt Lake

Together, they reared six children: Sallye; Galan; Richard; Gina; Gregory; and Chlele. They had 24 grandchildren with one more born in March 1988; three great grandchildren with a fourth born in April.

Bruce was a skilled lumber worker most of his life. He worked for Red River Lumber Company, and from 1956 to 1979 for Collins Pine Lumber Company. His positions included planer man, knife-maker (making knives to cut moldings), molderman, and molding pattern maker.

He worked hard, learned his trade well, and climbed to the top earning bracket in his field.

Bruce enjoyed backpacking, fishing, hunting, and writing poetry. He once related to your editor that, "he felt more at home around a campfire at night than he would in a mansion, but that Hazel would take the mansion."

His love for the outdoors and his knowledge of the wilderness caused him to be in great demand by different groups as a guide and teacher of wilderness skills. He was certified to teach CPR and survival skills. Bruce limited his conversation about his poetry to, "I write poetry for my own pleasure." He never shared any of it with your editor, although he did share a poem written by his mother. (see "PURE WHITE ROSES" page 134) Perhaps his family will share some of Bruce's writing with us for future issues. Bruce was especially fond of his home. He built it himself and took great pride in the lawn, flowers, creek in the back, and all

the natural beauty that surrounded it. Bruce was a religious man who loved the Lord. When he was 26 years old, he joined the church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints. He held many leadership positions including high priest and member of the Stake high council.

Because of the church's emphasis on family ties, he became interested in genealogy. Because of this interest, he traveled all the way across the USA to Georgia where he was instrumental in forming the TERRELL SOCIETY OF AMERICA, INC. and served as charter President. By his demise, this organization had grown to over 150 members all across the USA and in 3 foreign countries. Memorial services were held February 18, 1988 at the Westwood Ward, Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints about 1/4 mile from his beloved home with standing room only.

Pallbearers were sons: Galan, Richard, and Gregory Todd; sons-in-law Fernando Perez and James Lunetta; and grandson Paul Perez. Honorary Pallbearers were son-in-law Steve Boggs; grandsons Mike, Michael, and Trevor Todd; David Dyer, and Kevin Cotroneo. Bishop Bryan Welton conducted the service; Ramona Lyddon was pianist. Glenn Simms gave the invocation which was followed by "In the Garden," a solo by Darcy Goolsby. Jack Seipert brought the eulogy which was followed by talks by his sons Gregory and Galan and his daughter Gina Lunetta. "The Light De vine" was sung by his son Gregory Todd in Spanish. Darrell Foote followed with an inspirational talk. "Abide with me,

tis even Tide" was sung by Darcy Goolsby, and the service closed with a benediction by Les Bingham.

Interment followed in Westwood Cemetery. Graveside services included family prayer given by his daughter, Gina Lunetta.

If there is anything your editor has learned from life, it is the simple truth that places are not special—people are! We tend to muddle through life day by day, fighting the brush fire that is burning the hottest; taking care of our immediate family's needs and giving little thought to the hundreds or thousands of our other relatives who do not happen to live in our little circle of influence.

Our preoccupation with our immediate problems does not diminish the importance of our estranged relatives, but it does rob us of many opportunities for fellowship, caring, and sharing.

Your editor did not have the good fortune of meeting either of his cousins, Bruce Todd or Lowell Terrell, until their twilight era, the last 7 years of life—then he lost them both in the same month. Although I know that my life has been enriched in many ways by having known each of them, I cannot help feeling a bit of remorse that I did not know them many years earlier.

My prayer is that someone who is reading this now will be inspired to seek out his kin today and not repeat my mistakes.

#### ADVISORY MEETING MARCH 26, 1988

This detailed review is provided to keep those of you who could not join us abreast of what is happening.

We missed you, and would have loved for you to join us, but we understand that everyone can't participate in everything.

#### PREPARATIONS

Prior to the arrival date of March 25, Dan Brinson prepared some materials to give out to members as they arrived.

However, no one had checked in and made themselves known by 8:30 pm, so the materials had to be handed out as the meeting began.

#### CALL TO ORDER

President Bill Terrell called the meeting to order with a few brief remarks about the Society, its beginning, and its status.

#### MR. TERRELL REMEMBERED

Mrs. Eleanor Terrell took a few minutes to share the details of the last two days of Mr. Lowell Terrell's life.

#### —CREATIVITY BEGINS WITH QUESTIONS—

For example, Columbus asked 'Is there a sea route to India?' If he had not asked that question and kept seeking an answer, we would not be here today.

In keeping with that thought, Dan Brinson passed out sheets containing the following information:

#### TERRELL SOCIETY OF AMERICA, INC ADVISORY MEETING

SATURDAY, MARCH 26 1988

It has been proven that more is accomplished by persons participating in 'Think Tank' planning sessions when those attending have a written list of questions in hand before the meeting begins.

Therefore, we ask that you sit down and write out at least one page of questions you would like answered pertaining to the TERRELL SOCIETY OF AMERICA, INC. and its future objectives.

To prime your question pump, we offer the following example.

Question: What is the Terrell Society of America, Inc. trying to do?

Possible Answers:

1. Build a surname organization from a single Terrell line origin
2. Look for prospective members.
3. Provide information about the society to prospective members
4. Increase our membership to reduce the load upon each
5. Increase participation by each individual member
6. Locate and tap into computerized genealogical data bases to facilitate collection of information
7. Collect copies of original documents about Terrells and their related families
8. Publish a quarterly newsletter
9. Build a Lending Library of information about Terrells & their descendents
10. Establish a quick retrieval and copy system for our information
11. Promote a spirit of kinship and oneness among all Terrell descendents regardless of individual lineages
12. Establish a computerized data base of Terrell information
13. Establish a museum of Terrell artifacts, photos, etc
14. Locate an organization willing to accept our archive tentatively named TERRELL COLLECTION, USA and to handle the physical management of the materials on a revenue sharing basis
15. Raise the necessary funds to do all of the above

So, you see, there is no such thing as the

right question' or 'the right answer.' Neither is there any such thing as a 'wrong answer.' The sole purpose of this exercise is to stimulate THINKING. The only DUMB question will be the one not asked. Each of the above questions, plus all that you have, can be expanded upon by more questions, including, but not limited to:

What is needed to do it?  
How are we doing it now?  
Why do we do it this way?  
How else could it be done?  
Who does it? Where?  
Who else could do it? Jointly?  
Severally? Where?  
How can we improve the process?  
How can we speed up the process?  
What can I do to help solve this problem or supply this need?  
Ad infinitum. (Without end)

It has been said that the ROOM FOR IMPROVEMENT is the largest room in the world, and the Terrell Society of America, Inc. certainly has plenty of room for improvement. Our goal is not 'socialization.' We don't want to compress you and fit you into a mold so that you will look, act, talk, or think like any other member of the Society. All we ask is that you take a good look at yourself, determine what abilities and resources you possess, then determine how you can (or will) use these for the benefit of the Terrell Society of America, Inc. After giving everyone a few minutes to look over the preceding information, Bill Terrell asked each one there what he or she would like to see the Society do.

Mr. Lee Ponder stated that he gets a lot of genealogical and surname publications, but that he believes *Terrell Trails* is the best. He added that he would like to see all the information we are gathering pulled together, computerized for easy access, and the LENDING LIBRARY grow.

Mrs. Ponder stated that she was just there to support Lee.

Mrs. Eleanor Terrell suggested a short pamphlet, 5 or so pages, describing the Society, the LENDING LIBRARY contents, etc. to be distributed to libraries and genealogical societies around the USA. Mr. Bill Terrell said he would like to see the entire contents of our LENDING LIBRARY placed in 3 to 10 large libraries around the country where the public would have access.

Mr. Guy Clarke suggested that we continue publishing queries and that we encourage members to submit more queries. He pointed out that with most genealogical publications, the query section is a prominent part of the publication.

Mr. Leland Walker stated that he would support Pat (his wife) in whatever she wanted to do for the Society, but that he did not have any specific goal. Mr. William Terrill, father of member Don Terrill, suggested that we put a query form inside the wrapper to *Terrell Trails* as a means of encouraging members to submit more queries.

Mr. Don Terrill echoed his father's suggestion.

Mr. Monroe King, guest speaker and archivist, suggested a systematic system to gather, share, and exchange information. He cited as an example a program being conducted whereby persons visit nursing homes with tape recorders and ask the patients to share their memories. Unless something of this sort is done, the knowledge of these senior citizens will soon be totally lost to us.

Mrs. Pat Walker stated that she was attending for Mr. LeSturgeon who could not be there due to his wife's illness.

She stated that Lawrence would like to see the Society continue to have annual meetings in other parts of the country even if the attendance was minimal. Virginia, Texas, and Salt Lake City were some of the sites recommended. The major problem is locating persons willing to host those reunions. Pat added that she is not deeply engrossed with genealogy per se, but that she is interested in being Mr. LeSturgeon's legs and in tending to the mechanics of handling his correspondence, lending library shipping, and other details of distribution of our information.

Brenda Brinson stated that she was there to support Dan—he needs a lot of it!

Dan Brinson concluded by saying that we need to go ahead with plans to acquire a much larger computer; to recruit volunteers to index our materials, and to set up a system to make our materials readily accessible for both members and the general public. The ultimate goal is to collect a copy of every original document in the country that contains information about a TERRELL, variant, or descendent regardless of whether that person appears as the principal or as a witness. In many cases, being a witness to a document was much more than proof of residence. Usually, there was a family connection in the present, previous, or succeeding generations. No man lives on an island. This was especially true 100 years ago when mobility was more limited than it is today.

#### —ARCHIVE BASICS—

Our guest speaker, Mr. Monroe M. King, of Douglasville, Ga, entertained and enlightened the group with a talk of about one

hour in which the following basic principles were revealed. See last issue for his credentials.

All archives are operated upon certain fundamentals.

FIRST: Archival records are classified by SOURCE not SUBJECT. This is the way the archivist gains mastery over a large body of records. The first responsibility of the archivist is to know what he has, where it is, and how to get it back when needed. This is what is meant by "mastery" and mastery depends upon this basic archival principle. For example, the primary divisions in the national archives are based upon the three branches of government which generate the records: Judicial, Legislative, & Executive with each of those being further sub-divided, ie, Executive/Dept. of Defense/Army/Division/Regiment/Battalion/Company.

SECOND: the archivist respects the original filing order of the materials, ie, the physical relationship of the materials. One example cited was be a group of letters bound by a string. The originator may have had some reason for binding those letters together, a relationship that is lost when separated.

THIRD, the RECORD GROUP CONCEPT: Records have an organic relationship in the same sense that cells make up tissue, tissue makes up organs, organs make up systems, and all systems make up the organism. The single sheet is equivilant to the cell; a group of related sheets [file folder] equal tissue; several related folders equal an organ; the file series (several related folders) equal a system and can be compared to a nervous, cardiac, or other system in a person; and finally the entire record group (example, all of the records of one county) equal a complete organism. To restore and preserve this organic relationship within the records is another of the principal obligations of the archivist. This yields archival integrity.

FOURTH, LIFE CYCLE CONCEPT: High use records are handled separately on a special case basis and not necessarily filed by source. An example of high use records would be the books and microfilm in the research room at the Georgia State Archive which are filed by state, county, and in some cases era rather than by author or publisher.

FIFTH: ARCHIVAL FINDING AIDS make materials easy to retrieve. All archival research involves some kind of human activity in some discreet geographic area, during some time frame. Finding Aids reflect this reality. Taking recruiting during the Civil War as an

example, Mr. King demonstrated how each of the three elements can be expanded or contracted to define the research. For example, recruiting might be limited to Naval recruiting; the geographic area might be limited to England or France; the time period might be reduced from 1861 through 1865 to one year, 1864. Or you might research cavalry recruiting in Clayton County, Georgia in April 1865, where recruiting cavalry is the human activity, the geographic area is Clayton County, and the time period is 30 days before the war's end.

SIXTH: Indexes are based on those three divisions. Some Indices are chronological, some are based upon geography, and some are based on the human activiy, ie, Terrells who were preachers in South Carolina in the colonial period, for example, as to how TERRELL material might be indexed.

SEVENTH: Terrell Archival Collections should be kept in consecutive order as received. This is how to handle randomly received archival materials— to control & index this material, some of it cells, some of it tissue, some of it organs, or other groupings of records. Mr. King cited his PEMBERTON ARCHIVE in which he has been collecting information on the Dr. Pemberton who developed the formula for CocaCola. He stated that he started with a pile of file folders and numbered them consecutively beginning with one. As materials were collected, each separate find was placed in a separete folder according to source. Later he prepared finding aids so that he could locate any record when it is needed. EIGHTH: The responsibility of the archivist first, last, and always is MASTERY OVER THE MATERIALS. He must know WHAT he has; and he must know WHERE it is. He is not responsible for knowing every single detail that is contained on every sheet of paper or every roll of microfilm, but he must know his materials well enough to help the researcher find what he needs.

#### --- LUNCH ---

When Mr. King concluded his talk, the group recessed for lunch. Mrs. Terrell graciously spread a beautiful table with casserole, Waldorf Salad, rolls, and peach cobbler. As everyone enjoyed lunch conversation between individuals continued, both reflecting upon the morning's activities and looking forward to further accomplishments.

#### --- HOUSE TOUR ---

After lunch, Mrs. Terrell took those attending on a brief tour of her home beginning with the mill stone from the mill of Mr. Lowell Terréll's great grandfather Huie thorough the history of several stones in

the huge fireplace that had been collected on trips with special emphasis on the utility of the hand operated elevator that is used to bring firewood from the basement. From the living area, the tour continued down the west hall which is paneled with timber from their homeplace which was taken in by Hartsfield airport. Along the way, Mrs. Terrell pointed out doors, that had been adapted from older residences being demolished, including one her bedroom over 8 feet high. The top shelf in that closet is reserved solely for her wedding dress and shoes. In her bedroom, she gave the history of *lighting fixtures, organ pipes, cowhide chairs, chaise lounges*, and other items that resulted from a lifetime of caring and collecting. It was also pointed out that the TERRELL SOCIETY OF AMERICA, INC. was 'born' in this bedroom in 1984.

The screened porch between the bedroom and the living area provides a beautiful peaceful view of the garden, yard, and private lake. The stairway to the basement along the back of this porch is paneled with a tall door placed horizontally and adorned with various types of insulators collected by Mr. Terrell during his years with Western Union. The wall over the stairway sports a full cowhide with the hair remaining that is estimated to be over 150 years old. That had belonged to Mrs. Terrell's uncle. Back in the kitchen and dining area, Mrs. Terrell showed the ingenuity used in planning her cabinet system complete with a disposal chute to the basement, special hanging pegboards instead of shelves for her pots, pans, and utensils.

Her favorite accomplishment was the inclusion of a section of 3 inch shelves designed specifically for her crystal and glasses. She explained that she and Mr. Terrell had stayed home from church one Sunday just to count and measure the number of pieces she had that would fit on a 3 inch shelf in order to convince Mr. Terrell and the builder that the narrow shelves were needed and would be used.

#### MEETING RESUMES

By this point, Bill Terrell was anxious to resume with the afternoon meeting, so we reconvened in the living area.

#### PROMOTIONAL MATERIALS

First, it was resolved that we would proceed with preparation of a small pamphlet or brochure to promote the TERRELL SOCIETY OF AMERICA, INC. via libraries, genealogical societies, and other logical places as suggested by Mrs. Terrell in the morning meeting.

#### MINIMUM ANNUAL DUES

Second, there was discussion about annual MINIMUM dues. It was pointed out that although printing, postage, and other costs have been escalating, we have held our minimum dues to \$8.00. Motion was made and seconded that we raise MINIMUM due to \$12.00 effective January 1, 1989, ie the next renewal date. Although this might scare off a few members, the general feeling is that those who are serious about the Society will not be affronted or object to it. It was resolved that this proposed increase be published in the this issue of *Terrell Trails*, and that silence would be considered as approval. If you have any objection to this dues increase, write Mr. LeSturgeon immediately. All those present felt that our dues are the lowest of any organization to which any of us belong. Mrs. Terrell stated that she belongs to several organizations and pays as high as \$25.00 for membership in the National Genealogical Society. Although it was not verbalized, your editor pays \$35.00 per year for membership in the Association of Professional Genealogists.

#### FUTURE REUNIONS

Mr. LeSturgeon's suggestion that we continue our tradition of holding one national reunion annually was taken up next. It was pointed out that no one had volunteered to host a reunion for this year. Mr. William Terrill and Mr. Don Terrill stated that we would be welcome at their reunion scheduled for August in Albuquerque NM. After some discussion, it was agreed that we would accept this generous offer and work out a joint promotion of the event. It is hoped that we will find someone in Virginia who will host a reunion in 1989, one possible site being the old Richmond Terrell home-site, PROSPECT HILL, near Charlottesville, VA. Even though this facility could not lodge as many families as we are likely to attract, it is a point of interest to Terrills and there is adequate lodging nearby. The desire was expressed for a 1990 reunion in Dallas, TX which seems to be in commuting distance of most of our TX members, provided someone there would consent to host the gathering and make the necessary arrangements. It was pointed out that one advantage to a NATIONAL reunion is that it will draw free NATIONAL press whereas a local reunion will draw only LOCAL press. This free publicity is literally worth thousands to the Society. At each meeting your editor has had the pleasure of attending, everyone seems to have enjoyed themselves even though the total group has been under 100 in most cases.

#### OPERATIONAL CHANGES

A suggestion was made that the ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION and BY-LAWS be amended to allow the board to handle the business affairs of the Society including changing dues, increasing or decreasing the number of persons serving on the board, changing the term in office from 'indefinite' to a specific term of 1 or 2 years, and replacing those who resign or finish an established term in office.

The opinion was voiced that most of the members don't care how the mechanics of operating the Society are handled as long as they get their newsletter on time, get their queries published, and find an occasional connection. The lack of response by members to surveys and past elections seems to prove this theory. It was also pointed out that one reason for the apathy is that some members may not feel qualified to vote upon issues or persons about whom they have very little personal knowledge.

It was pointed out that changing the By-Laws is a simple and inexpensive process. On the other hand, changing the Articles of Incorporation involves the State of Georgia and each change must be advertised in the newspaper. This expense is in the neighborhood of \$100.00. Therefore, it was resolved that V-P Lee Ponder and Secretary Dan Brinson would study these items and make recommendations for changes needed to simplify operation of the Society. In that manner, all the necessary changes could be made at once and for one fee.

As the articles are now written, we must put any changes to you for approval or rejection before we can proceed with the changes. If you have any questions, comments, or suggestions, please let Lawrence or Pat know as soon as possible. Their address is inside the front page.

#### PRESIDENT NEEDED

Mr. Bill Terrell reminded us that he had agreed to serve as President for only 1 year and that due to business demands, it would be a hardship for him to continue. Therefore, Lawrence will be seeking candidates to replace Bill. If you have any nominations, please let him know. Bill added that it does not matter whether the Articles of Incorporation and By-Laws are changed or not, he will resign as soon as a suitable replacement can be found.

#### MEETING ADJOURNS

The Advisory Meeting adjourned shortly after 4:00 pm. with out-of-town members returning to the motel and others going their separate ways.

The general feeling was one of accomplish-

ment. We had met. We had questioned our status quo; and we hope we have gleaned a few answers that will benefit future generations. If anyone regretted having attended this meeting, he or she kept quiet. ####

#### INDIANA BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCHES

Over a year ago, some of you contributed toward the cost of doing an index search of the TERRELL and some VARIATIONS found in the database of GENEALOGICAL INDEXING ASSOCIATES; P O Box 102; West Bountiful, UT 84087. We received a reply written January 23, 1987 which contained the following explanation of their service.

biographical sketches, despite their problems, often provide important clues to research not obtainable elsewhere.' [These clues consist mainly of leads of locations to research for original documents to prove or disprove the biographical sketch. Editor] 'Genealogical Indexing Associates has undertaken the indexing of the names of those for whom biographical sketches have been published. This search was made on the INDIANA BIOGRAPHICAL INDEX only. Similar projects are underway for other states, but not completed. The Indiana Index contains over 247,000 names from 537 sources estimated to cover over 95% of the existing biographical references for the state.'

Biographical sketches do not always exist for the individual being researched, but may exist for his brother, father, son, etc. These sketches may contain the info sought. Also, bio sketches often contain information on more than one generation and only the subject of the sketch has been indexed.

'No reference was found in this data base for the THERRELL spelling. Those found included: TERRELL, TERRILL, THEORELL, TYRELL, AND TYRRELL.

We were provided with xerox copies of the pages containing our variations. The listing was by last name, first & middle name, title (Dr, Judge, Col, Gen, Mrs. etc., no Mr), source code number consisting of 'IN' for Indiana followed by 4 digits for the source number, volume #—if any, part #—for sources in parts rather than volumes, page number, and in some cases county of residence. Also included was a listing of sources in source code order.

In the information which follows, your editor has rearranged the information back into source code order to facilitate ordering copies of the information. Address of one or more libraries having the source book is also listed.

If you think one of these might be your pilgrim, or related to your pilgrim, you can

order copies of the sketch directly from the listed library. If you do order copies, we would like for you to provide a copy for our archive in Douglasville.

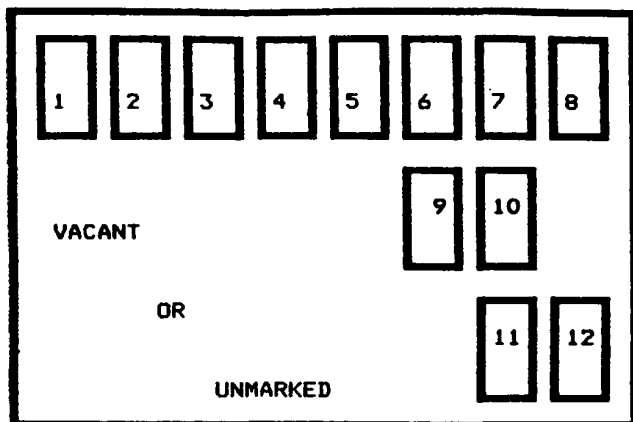

EUBANKS COLLECTION; Western KY Univ.; al-  
though not submitted for review, in the  
interest of genealogical and journalistic  
honesty, I feel compelled to include this  
brief review.

The Terrell Society of America, Inc. paid  
\$64.00 for a complete copy of this collec-  
tion consisting of over 460 pages of private  
papers that had belonged to the late Miss  
Mildred Eubanks, noted genealogist and re-  
puted 'expert' on Terrell lines.

What we received was 4 folders of copies of  
letters written to Miss Eubanks between 1962  
and 1982 by various individuals who had  
obtained her name and address from other  
researchers. The collection does contain one

transcript of a TERRELL will, but not a single original document.

The initial benefit derived from this collection was a list of names and addresses (some of them 26 years old) of persons who are (or were) interested in TERRELL genealogy. Determining how many are still living and still interested is a matter that will require much letter writing and postage expense.

The bulk of this collection consists of letters in which individuals detailed the limited information they had about their ancestors and asked help in furthering their search. It will take weeks full time, or months part time to determine whether there is anything in the collection that we did not already know. Most of it appears to be quotes from genealogy books by Barnhill and Dicken along with other redundant ancient lineage information.

Our one copy came with stringent copyright restrictions, admonitions not to copy or quote from the collection, etc. In my initial scanning, I failed to find anything I would want to copy as presented even if it were freely permitted!

The only honest advice I can give on this collection is SAVE YOUR MONEY. #####

#### JAMES LANDRUM DESCENDENTS

James Landrum was step-son of Ignatious TERRELL of Pike County, GA. He was son of Mary Martha HAMBRICK and John LANDRUM by her first marriage.

You might think that we are straying from the straight and narrow by including step-children and their descendents in a TERRELL surname publication, but if you will read our Application for Membership, you will find that step-children and their descendents are also eligible for membership in the Society.

Also, collateral lines, whether blood or step, often have bits of information needed to continue research. To exclude these lines would be almost equivocal to researching your father's lines and ignoring your mother's.

The James Landrum Bible was published by American Bible Society, NY, 1859. All the births of his children were added after the fact. All records up to 1862 appear to have been entered by the same person in the same sitting. Other records appear to have been entered by various persons as the events occurred.

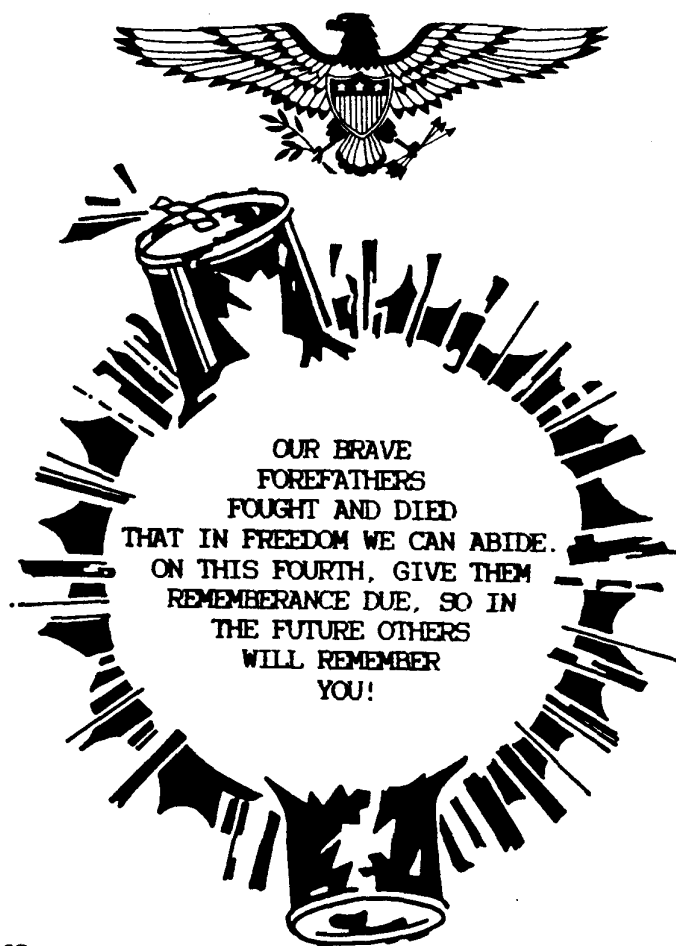

### IN REMEMBRANCE



ORVAL RALPH FINK

Orval Ralph Fink, prominent Manning professional business man with over forty years of service to the Manning community died February 14, 1988 at Manning General Hospital after a prolonged illness. He reached the age of 75 years.

Funeral services were held Thursday, February 18, 1988 at 10:30 a.m. at the Sacred Heart Church in Manning with Reverend Ralph Reinhart, and Orval's nephew Reverend Laurence Burns of Templeton officiating the service. Don Zubrod was lector for the Mass. Orval was converted to the Catholic religion in 1937. Burial was in the Sacred Heart Cemetery in Manning with Frank Willis, Francis Zerwas, Arthur Rix, Eddie Fischer, Claus Bunz and Greg Hanson as casketbearers. Rosaries were held Wednesday at 3:30 p.m. and 8:15 p.m.

Orval Fink was born at Lorimor, Iowa December 19, 1912, the son of William Henry and Beulah Myers Fink. In 1923 at the age of eleven he moved to Manning with his parents. After graduating from the Manning High School he obtained a degree in pharmaceutical chemistry from Drake University in Des Moines. June 6, 1938 Orval married Vera Molloy at Ayrshire, Iowa. He returned to Manning in 1946, and purchased part interest with Art Rix in the Lewis-Reinhold company. He obtained full ownership in 1972, and sold the store to Tom Crabb in 1977. Although Fink retired from the store he continued to work as a relief pharmacist for other drug stores until his health failed. Fink was a member of the Northwest Pharmaceutical

Former NIPCO Director Orval R. Fink passed away February 14, 1988. He served as Western Iowa Municipal Electric Cooperative's (WIMECA's) representative from 1974 to 1985.

He was a great and humble man, and it is safe to say that WIMECA would not have come into being without his influence and dedication.

WIMECA was the "first of its kind" organization in the state of Iowa. Negotiations began in 1968. However, the cooperative did not become a member of NIPCO until 1975. Orval was relentless in his efforts to bring the dream to fruition. After it was realized, he worked above and beyond the call of duty keeping the lines of communication open between the WIMECA members and NIPCO.

As a Director of NIPCO he was respected for his fairness and was always careful to base his decisions on what was good for the total NIPCO family - not just the portion he represented. Orval Fink will long be remembered as a dedicated servant of his fellow man and an example of true cooperative spirit.

Association and served as president for a number of years.

Involvement in the community began in 1947 when Fink was elected as president of the chamber of commerce and remained an active member until selling his business.

Fink was appointed to the Board of Trustees of Manning Municipal light plant in 1959 serving as chairman from 1962 until his retirement in 1985. During his tenure he played a major role in formation of the Western Iowa Municipal Electric Cooperative Association (wimeca) serving as its chairman for 11 years. Fink also served as board member of North Western Power Cooperative.

As a member of the Manning Community Hospital Association for nearly 40 years Fink had been involved in many projects. The Manning Plaza Corporation was formed in 1965 with Fink as its first president. He also served as the hospital pharmacist and president of the hospital board of directors for many years. In August 1987 the hospital dedicated the Orval Fink wing.

He has been involved in numerous other organizations and activities which include; past president of the Rotary Club, Community Chest and Foreign Student exchange coordinator, chairman of the Tri-Valley Health Planning district, cable board of directors, member of the board of the Manning Trust and Savings Bank, Holstein-Friesian Museum board,
