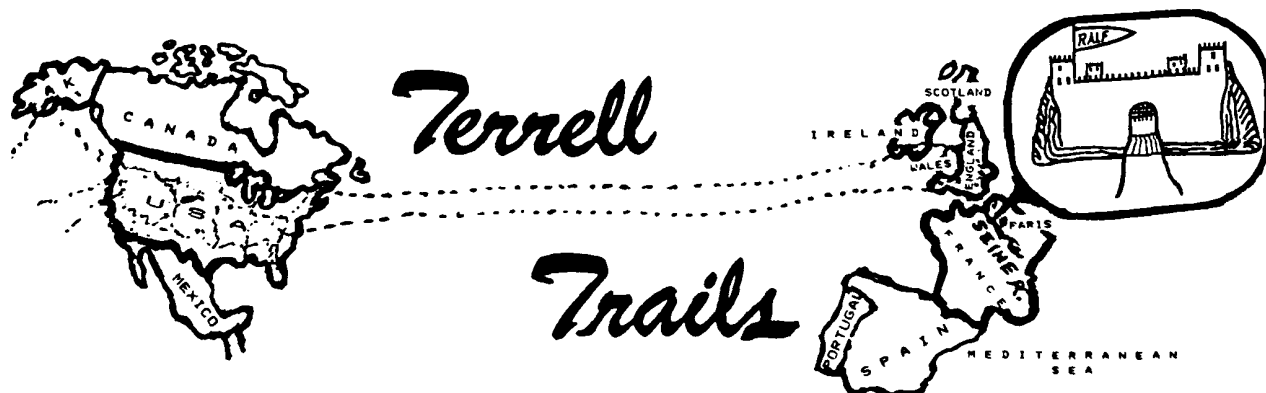

West; Jet Age; Calendar; Changes; Queries; Newsmakers; Operation Hardcopy update; Reviews by Dan; and Welcome New Members.

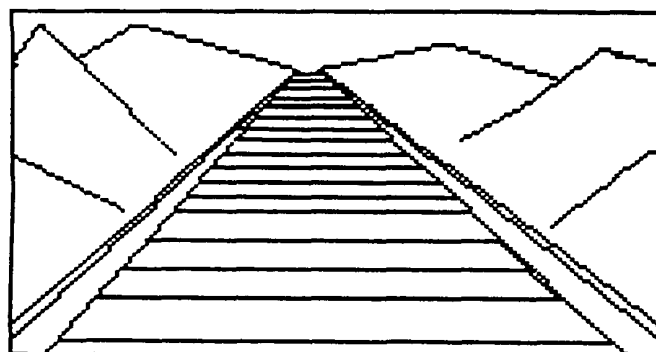
Further enhancement has been provided by choosing carefully selected 'cuts' [illustrations] to accompany these headlines.

ANCESTOR SEARCH PROGRAMS

We have recently received information from ARCHIVE RESEARCH ASSOCIATES; 2586 WEST 4700 SOUTH; SALT LAKE CITY, UT, 84118 offering to check ancestral lines through the: (1) International Genealogical Index; (2) Temple Records Index Bureau; and (3) Family Group Records Archive at the rates of \$15.00 for one ancestral line; \$12.00 each for two ancestral lines; or \$10.00 each for three or more ancestral lines.

Information needed for their request form (in addition to your name and address) includes: surname (maiden if female); given name(s); year of birth or christening; town, county, parish, state of birth or christening; full name of the father; full maiden name of the mother; your relationship to this person; full name of spouse including maiden if wife; year of marriage; town, county, parish, and state of marriage; death date.

Request forms are available upon request, and once received may be xeroxed if more are needed.

They request that you wait six weeks for reply before becoming anxious about your request.

As with all information of this type, it is passed on as received. As the bookie says, 'Yer pays yer money, and yer takes yer chances.'

However, they do offer the following guarantee: 'Although we cannot promise that any connection to your line will be found in the archives, without this search you would

never know if the records of your ancestors were in the Genealogical Department Library. We will refund your money if the sources included in the "Ancestor Search Program" are not searched and photocopies of the data found sent to you."

Competitive services are offered by MICRO GEN; P O BOX 11956; Salt Lake City UT 84147-0956. Their search form is available upon request.

Literature indicates a preliminary search survey of the International Genealogical Index and Family Group Records Archives (main Section) at \$15.00 per surname. England or Scotland are \$25.00 per search. Federal census searches are available at \$20.00 per hour with one hour minimum. A federal index census search is available for certain states and years for \$7.00 per ancestor per statewide index.

WILLIAMS(ON) ANCESTRY?

If you share either Williams or Williamson ancestry, Neil Bancroft; 7149 Sutton Drive; Everson, WA 98247 is currently collecting materials to publish in *WILLIAMS PURSUIT* listing researchers of variant spellings of Williams and allied families. Cross referenced index of names and addresses of interested researchers will be included.

Form asks for: ancestor surname; first name, middle initial; year born; plus up to 55 characters of key data which can include spouse, area of birth, death, residence, etc.

Cost is listed as \$1.00 for the first line and \$0.30 for each additional line. SASE is also requested. #####

INCORRECT ADDRESSES CAUSE DELAYS

The Terrell Society of America, Inc., is a volunteer organization. Our successful operation depends upon locating persons willing to donate their time and talents—and in using them wherever they are found.

At the present time, we are operating from two addresses with which you should be familiar.

Dan Brinson, Society Secretary and newsletter editor is located in Douglasville, GA. He uses his computer to keep membership records including: the date you joined; date your membership expires; all donations made; and all books rented or purchased. After these records are entered, your checks are forwarded to Mrs. Terrell in Jonesboro, GA for deposit until needed for expenses.

As newsletter editor, Dan is responsible for reviewing information submitted, deciding what is suitable for publication, and publishing it as soon as space is available. Therefore, QUERIES should always be sent to the Douglasville address along with all newspaper clippings, and other items of TERRELL interest. QUERIES are always set for the next available issue and carry a higher priority than Newsmakers and membership lineage charts. Our shortage of QUERIES is due to lack of members submitting them.

On the other hand, the LENDING LIBRARY and general questions not for publication are handled by our volunteers in Charlotte, NC, Mr. LeSturgeon and Mrs. Walker.

All lending library selections are prepared in and shipped from Charlotte. When a request for a book is received, Mr. LeSturgeon oversees the necessary preparation and shipping of the book, while Mrs. Walker does that actual physical mailing. Lawrence then prepares a notice to Mrs. Terrell indicating

the name of the book and the member to whom it has been shipped and forwards the member's check for deposit. A copy is sent to Dan for the member's record in Douglasville. When a book is returned, the opposite occurs. A notice is sent to both Dan and Mrs. Terrell from Charlotte. Mrs. Terrell promptly sends a refund check to the member, and Dan enters the refund on the member's record.

Our correspondence secretaries are responsible for screening your general correspondence and for routing your questions on to the officer or committee best suited to answer your question or assist you with your problem. This division of responsibilities has been a tremendous help to your editor and allows more time for research and improves the quality of your newsletter.

We all like to save a little time, trouble, and money. It is always tempting to stuff everything into one envelope and send it to one location.

This does not pose any great problem for us, but IT CAUSES DELAYS IN OUR SERVICE TO YOU.

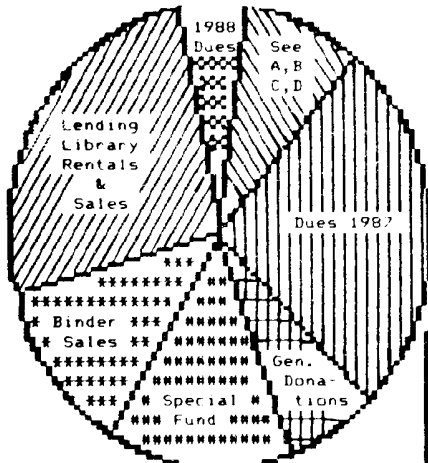
A donation to the SPECIAL FUND can be sent to either address without causing any delay in the check reaching Jonesboro; but an order for a Lending Library selection sent to Douglasville must either be forwarded immediately costing the Society the same 25 cents it would have cost you, or it must lay around in Douglasville until there is something else to go with it to finish filling the envelope.

A Querie or a dues check sent to Charlotte faces the same delay. It must be forwarded to Douglasville. In the case of a delayed Querie, it might be 3 months later being published than it would have been if sent directly to Douglasville. A delayed dues check could cause us to have to pay first class postage of 65 cents to mail you a back issue of TRAILS that could have been mailed in bulk for 17 cents with everyone else's.

We are here to serve you and are willing to serve you in whatever manner you expect. If you don't mind the extra expense and the delay, bundle everything into one envelope and we'll handle when we can; but if you want the best, fastest service possible, please take a moment to consider what you are mailing and to whom it should go. We believe you will find that we are able to serve everyone better. #####

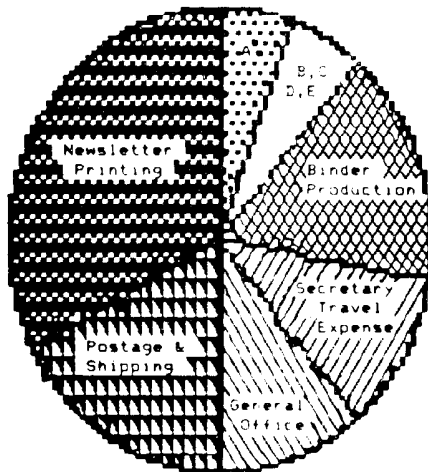

We are reporting 1987 finances on these two pages and the following one.

We hope that the addition of the pie charts, crude though they may be, will help you to understand where our money came from, how it was spent, and what was allocated to what at the end of the year.

There is no pie chart for the Lending Library operations. However, the detailed report on page 279 should answer all your questions about that facet of our operations.

All of the reports reproduced in this issue have been submitted to the Secretary of State, State of Georgia as required.

Some explanation is in order. We are a non-profit organization and try to end each year with

as nearly a zero balance as practical in our regular account that is used for publication of our newsletter and for general operating expenses. The balance of \$49.01 in that account at year end (see chart on lower left) was due

to delays in publishing the winter issue of *Terrell Trails*. It takes slightly over \$200.00 per issue for printing when we can get it done by the high school graphics arts department. You will also note from the REVENUE SOURCES chart (upper left) that \$216.00 had already been received in 1988 renewal dues. We really broke about even again despite the appearance of a surplus.

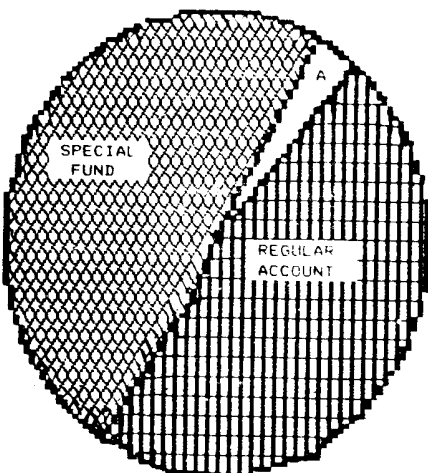
You will be pleased to note that \$620.00 had been given to the Special Fund and that \$400.00 had been given toward the computer/archive expansion fund. This \$400.00 had been in the bank long enough to earn \$1.20 interest by end of year.

At first glance, it appears that a lot of operating revenue was generated from sale of binders, \$512.00 vs \$373.00 production costs. However, the costs do not reflect the cost of shipping the binders which is included in the \$379.92 postage and shipping. The exact cost was not broken down, but it cost about \$125.00 to ship the binders, so again, we provided you with an item very close to actual cost.

Most of those who joined us recently have been interested in back issues of *Terrell Trails*. Since it is impossible to determine exactly how many persons will join us during the year, we have had to print extra copies. Thus far, we have been able to fill back orders with those extra copies except for Volume I which had to be xeroxed most of the

year. Back issues generated \$216.00 which have been used to publish larger editions this year.

You have every right to be proud of what you accomplished in 1987 and to look for a better 1988.

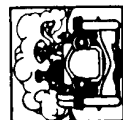

GOVERNOR SIGNING ACT CREATING GRADY COUNTY: Continuing The Messenger's series of historical pictures, the one above, perhaps the most important and most interesting of the series, shows Georgia Governor Joseph Meriwether Terrell signing the act creating Grady County. The scene was in the old, old Mansion in Atlanta and the ceremony was shortly after the Legislature sent the measure to the Governor on August 25, 1905, the county becoming established on January 1, 1906. Witnessing the Governor were the following prominent citizens who had been active in the hard fight to get the new county authorized (left to right): Walter B. Roddenbery, Sr., John B. Crawford, H. W. Hopkins, Thomasville, John F. Stone, J. K. Rodwin, Dr. W. A. Walker, William A. Carr, R. R. Terrell, Whigham, T. Aden Powell, John R. Singhtary, and S. Anderson Roddenbery.

The above Newsmaker, showing Gov. Terrell and his cousins (third cousins, once removed) who were instrumental in forming Grady County, Georgia appeared in THE ATLANTA MESSENGER HISTORICAL SERIES.

As noted in the article, Governor Joseph Meriwether Terrell is seated, and his cousin, Robert Raines Terrell (Jr.) is the man with the mustache and light hair, directly behind him.

Robert Raines Terrell (Sr.) (1823--03/22/1888) son of Thomas Waddy and Sarah Shelton Terrell gained distinction as a Major in the commissary Dept in the Civil War. He was a well known lawyer in Bainbridge, GA. He was brother of Cornelia Antoinette Terrell, ancestor of Mr. John Stuart, our member. (See chart on page 285.) His line extends

backward through Dr. Thomas Waddy Terrell, Thomas IV, William III, Joel Sr II, to William and Susannah.

Robert Raines Sr. md. Henrietta M. Dutton 03/09/1848. Their other children included Thomas Mann Terrell; Sarah Elizabeth 'Bobbie'; Henrietta Mildred who md. Hal Morrison; William Joseph; Jackson Mash; Duke H. H.; Anna Longe md. Dr. N. T. Pike of Thomasville, Ga; Monabelle; and Dutton Terrell.

Robert Raines Jr. b. 06/21/1853 md. Ida Spence. They lived at Whigham, GA. He represented Grady County in the state legislature in 1908.

Hon. Joseph Meriwether Terrell (06/06/1861--11/17/1912) was born at Greenville Ga. He md. Jessie Lee Spivey, no children. His father was Dr. Joel Edgar Green Terrell, son of David Meriwether Terrell, who was son of Joel Higgins and Frances BUTLER Terrell. Joel H. was son of Peter III, who was son of Joel Sr II where the lines split.

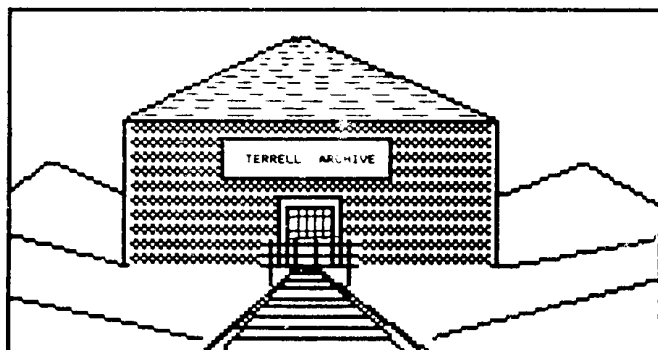

The Raines Family

During the reign of King Henry III appeared Robert, Richard, and William de Raines. They were descendants of Roger de Raines, the first Baron of their time. Robert de Raines died without issue. The family descended to his brother Richard de Raines, who died about the end of King John's reign, and left the Barony to be divided between his three daughters and co-heirs: Alice, the eldest, was the widow of Robert de Marston; Anais, the second, was given in marriage to William de Marston; Joan, the youngest, was given to William de Marston. William de Raines, by his first marriage to Berta, daughter of William Marcherall, perpetuated the line. From his family have descended the various families of the Raines in England and America. In Buckinghamshire were the Raines of Clifton (Raynes), and Yorkshire the illustrious lines of Myton.

Soon after the colonization of America was begun, we find numbers of the Raines family seeking fortune and adventure in the New World. Early in 1615 their names began to appear on the lists of emigrants. In 1700 there were in Virginia more than a score. Among the early arrivals was William Raines, who settled in Charles City, Virginia. He was born prior to 1666. William Raines in 1707 was the father of several children, two of whom, Thomas and Richard, were receiving deeds of gifts to land in Virginia from their father, who evidently had received the grants from the Crown. The Will of William Raines, recorded in Prince George County, Virginia, is dated February 12, 1721, and was probated July 20, 1722. The name of his wife was lost but by her were the following children:

Thomas Raines of Prince George County, Virginia, received a grant of land, 400 acres, in Prince George County in 1733 and 150 acres in 1735. 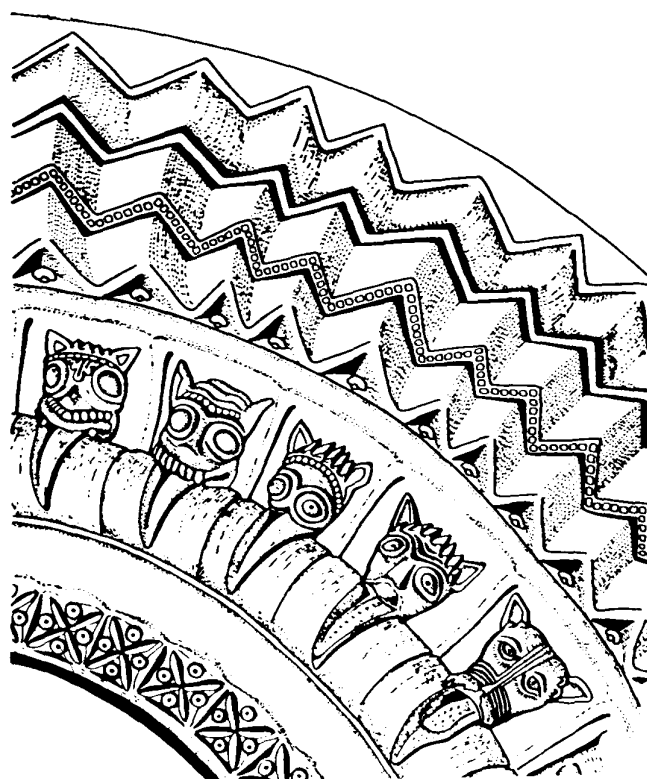

The above stonework is representative of
typical Anglo-Norman motifs found throughout
England.

This particular work is located around a
door of St. Peter's-in-the-east, Oxford. All
these motifs, the chevron or zig-zag, the
'beak-head' and the saltire cross are typi-
cal of 12th century Anglo-Norman architectu-
ral decoration.

Since English clergy had supported Harold,
their replacement by churchmen of Normandy
led to many such buildings. Originally, most
of the sculpture was painted.

Although this design is not Terrell/Tyrrell
specific, it was created shortly after the
first Tyrrell arrived in England following
William the Conqueror. The chevron design,
as you will recall is incorporated in the
Tyrrell/Terrell coat of arms.

The oldest surviving example of the Norman
influence in England can be found in the
Bayeux Tapestry—an embroidered wall-hanging
worked in wool on coarse linen. It illustra-
tes the history of the Norman Conquest in a
series of scenes on a strip 70 meters long
and 50 centimeters wide. It is likely that
the embroidery was commissioned by Bishop
Odo of Bayeux shortly after the Conquest,
for display in his new cathedral, dedicated
in 1077. It was possibly done in Canterbury.

The information appearing on this and the following pages was gleaned from the International Genealogical Index for county Essex in ENGLAND. This type of information is readily available to any researcher who will visit a branch library of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints (Mormon) on any surname. He enlisted again and was in Charleston during the battle of Sullivan's Island but was not in the battle. In 1777, he served under Capt. James PETTIGREW, Col. Samuel JACK, and Col. William TERRELL in a regiment which was called the Minute Troops.
