INCORPORATION CONTINUES

Efforts to complete incorporation of The Terrell Society of America as a non-profit, and hopefully eventually tax-exempt organization continues. The Secretary of State returned our application for one minor change and to have it all retyped on 8 1/2 x 11 rather than 11 x 14 legal size originally submitted. By the Spring Issue 1986, we hope to be able to print a copy of our ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION and BY-LAWS.

Terrell Descendents Swindled?

The September 30, 1985 issue of *The Spotlight Newspaper*, 300 Independence Ave. SE, Washington, D.C. carried a front page headline 'Income Tax Amendment Null, Void.'

To make a long story short, it seems a 'long hidden document that has been recently discovered in the National Archives' which is a 'February 15, 1913 memorandum from the Office of the Solicitor of the Department of State [that] sets forth in detail the numerous flaws, errors, and deliberate alterations made by the various state legislatures in their consideration of the proposed amendment first ratified by Congress.'

It appears that 'only 27 states actually ratified the amendment, even though the State Department falsely certified 38 states as having ratified the amendment.'

The Rufus Stone
New Forest, England

Gerald 'Steve' Terrell, descendent of Absalom Terrell served in the Merchant Marines during WWII and for many years thereafter.

At one time, he served with a man who had a sister in England. The sister sent her brother a two postcards of what looks like a stone or cement marker titled 'The Rufus Stone.'

The Inscription reads:

HERE STOOD
THE OAK TREE
ON WHICH AN ARROW

SHOT BY
SIR WALTER TYRRELL
AT A STAG
GLANCED AND STRUCK
KING WILLIAM
THE SECOND
SURNAMED RUFUS
ON THE BREAST
OF WHICH HE
INSTANTLY DIED
ON THE SECOND
DAY OF AUGUST
AW [I?] NO 1100

It has crossed arrows beneath the inscription. It was badly weathered at the time the postcard photo was taken and there is some doubt as to the contents of the last line.

Perhaps one of our members has visited the stone personally and can give us a clearer description.

Frances Miers Muller, 99-granddaughter of Robert Terrill Beale of VA, MO, & TX sent us the following notes on our town namesake TERRELL, TX.

It is taken from *Texas Auto Trails - The Northeast* by Myra Hargrave McElvain, Univ. of TX Press, Austin, 1984 to whom full credit for this info is gratefully given.

TERRELL

Terrell is near enough to Dallas to be called a bedroom city, but is is far from that. The old town began with a bang when investors heard that the Texas and Pacific Railroad would come through. They bought the land, donated eighty-seven acres to the railroad, and began laying out town blocks. After making their first big money, the speculators moved on and left the town to serious and stable businessmen, who built stately homes that still line several streets. The business community, although representing a young town, had the foresight to go to Austin in the early 1880's and make a strong bid for building the planned hospital for the mentally ill in Terrell. The Terrell State Hospital is still in town and has continued to pour huge revenues into the city coffers.

The small frame structure on the east side of the campus circle is far older, built in the mid 1800's by Robert A. Terrell, an early settler. Careful examination shows that the main structure is octagonal, one of the few left in the state.

Robert Terrell came to TX from TN before he was 20 years old and settled in San Augustine where president Sam Houston appointed him surveyor of the public domain. In 1840, Terrell joined an ox train headed west to the three forks of the Trinity, present Kaufman County. The deed records for the next forty years are sprinkled with his land purchases and sales. Although he started the octagonal house before the Civil War, his slaves finished it while he was away serving in the confederate army. Terrell paid them in land. His daughter and her husband, W. B. Toone, started a college here in

1897. They sold the facility to the Methodists for Wesley College in 1905. It also served as a military school and a public school before being acquired by the Churches of Christ.

Miami society, which is made up of interesting people from all parts of the world, has received a recent addition on the arrival of Mr. and Mrs. Jack Terrell and baby who were on the water 25 days enroute from South Africa to New Orleans to meet their home here. Mr. Terrell, who left home in 1922, to be in the American regular service in Johannesburg, a being welcomed back by his family friends. Mrs. Terrell was formerly Miss Marjorie Zinn of the Dutch colony in Johannesburg.

Mr. and Mrs. Terrell found the social life of that city of over 400,000 most attractive, although there were not more than 100 Americans, the whole population of 1,200,000 being mostly made up of English and Dutch. Mr. Terrell said that the English in that country started plating their noses of Americans and did everything in their power to be by themselves. The Dutch were friendly.

Revolutionary War to WWI

In the absence of any Queries from the membership, we are expanding this section with photographs of known descendants of John and Marian Terrell.

No known photograph of John or Marian Terrell exists. The following are some of their descendants.

NOTE: Due to fees of \$3.00 each & up for screening photographs for printing and due to our limited budget, your editor is experimenting with various ways to eliminate that cost. These photographs represent the most economical alternative. Other alternatives will be tried in the future to see if the result justifies the expense. Therefore, some of the photos of this issue may be repeated in future issues for comparison purposes.

TERRELL, IGNATIUS (01/11/1808--04/22/1873) Family tradition states he was born Oglethorpe Co., GA; however, records indicate that his parents John and Marian T.; were living in Randolph (later Jasper) Co. GA at that time; probably named for well known Methodist minister of the day Ignatious Few; reared on his father's farm; some time between 1823 and 1826, he married widow Mary Martha HAMBRICK Landrum; however, their marriage record has eluded us thus far. The only confirmation of this marriage is found in the minutes of Providence Baptist Church, Shadydale, Jasper Co., GA, Nov. 1826. 'dismissed sister Mary Terrell, formerly Mary Landrum by letter agreeable to her request.' If their marriage is recorded in Jasper Co., GA between 1823 and 1826, it is no longer legible on microfilm.

She had married first 01/17/1822 to John Landrum by John Hambrick, D.D.

(her uncle?) (Jasper Co. marriages, microfilm, state archives) It is possible that they went wherever John Hambrick was preaching at that time to get married also. Likely possibilities include: Henry, Butts, Newton, & Monroe Counties. She had one son, James Landrum by this marriage then she and Ignatious proceeded to have 11 more. Ignatious and Mary had moved to Pike Co., GA by 1829 when he returned Dist. 1, Land Lot 158, Capt. Buston's Dist., tax 25 cents; 1831, same property, tax 42-1/2 cents; 1834, Capt Leaches Dist., first page, 1 poll, 202-1/2 acres, same land in Capt. Yarbrough's Dist. He does not appear in Pike Co. Tax digests for years 1825-28.

1840 CENSUS, Pike Co., GA p126: Ignatious Terrell; 3 males 5-10; 1 male 15-20; 1 male 30-40; 2 females 5-10; 1 female 10-15; 1 female 30-40; 1 slave. 01/11/1844, Ignatious paid his stepson, James Landrum, \$300.00 for the south half of Land Lot 158, First Dist. original Monroe, now Pike Co. GA, 101-1/4 acres, signed James Landrum; witnesses: John B. Reed, Isaac B. Williamson. (Pike Co., GA. Deed Book G, p. 276-277).

Children: Martha Allen; Francis Marion; William Henry; John Calhoun; Clarisa; Amanda; 'General' Harrison H.; Thomas Jefferson; Andrew David; Mary 'Jane,' & Charles Benson.

He continued to farm in Pike Co. GA where he assisted his brother and sisters by acting as their agent in paying taxes and other matters. He is believed to have been active in the Methodist Church, Williamson, GA. Both he and Mary are buried in the cemetery there.###

Cook, Charles G.: born c1822 in GA of North Carolina parentage; reared on a farm; married 10/17/1845 in Pike County Georgia to Martha Allen Terrell daughter of Ignatious and Mary Martha HAMBRICK Landrum; family continued in Pike County to Cherokee County GA areas and later to Clayton County, GA by 04/19/1869 when Martha passed on; she was buried

where Hartsfield International Airport now stands south of Atlanta, GA.; grave was moved to the John Calhoun Terrell homeplace just south of the airport to make room for airport expansion; children: eleven of 14 lived to maturity; James Jefferson, went to Anderson County TX; William, remained in Georgia; Mary who married Thomas Connelly of GA; Sarah who married a Mr. Moore of AL; Jennie who married John H. Williams of GA; Angeline married in Mississippi; Mattie who married 'Joe' Smith of Mississippi; Emma who married c1889 Young A. TERRELL, ANDREW 'DAVID' (07/20/1845 -- 02/07/1931) born Pike Co. GA. son of Ignatious & Mary Martha HAMBRICK Landrum T.; reared on his father's farm; married Hester Ann Rogers 11/07/1867 either in Pike Co., GA, Butler Co., AL where she was from, or between; moved to Anderson Co. TX before 1906, near Corsicana, where he was a black land farmer with a large family. He served in the Civil War. He died at Karens, TX, he and wife are buried in Camel cemetery, Navarro, Co. TX.

TERRELL, ABSALOM (07/20/1813--09/22/1888) born Jasper Co., GA; son of John & Marian 'Mary Ann' ? T.; name probably of Bible origin but may have been derived from an ancestor--it is interesting to note that one James C. Terrell of Madison Township, Richland Co. IL named a son Absalom c1853, and even more interesting to note that he had named a daughter Lucinda c1846; reared on his father's farm near Providence Baptist Church, Shadydale, Jasper Co., GA, until c1820 when the family moved to Henry County near Phillippi Meeting House where they resumed farming. He lived with his mother after his father's death until 08/29/1833 when he married Margaret Vessells in Henry Co. GA (Book 1822-1837, p 129); in 1832 Cherokee Land Lottery, (pp 285) Absalom Terrell of Hood's Dist. (489th) Henry County, GA drew Land Lot 109, District 23, Third Section, Original Cherokee County, GA granted 08/07/1834. In 1836, he served as a private in Capt. Boggess Co., GA Volunteers, Cherokee War, and as result, drew NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 Section 2, Township 21, Range 17 East (Coosa Co. AL) in District of lands for sale at Montgomery, AL, containing 40.14-1/2 acres on 10/02/1854. Family tradition states that he moved to AL c1836, and 1850 census tends to support this. However, he paid taxes on 67 acres in Carroll Co. GA as late as 1841, first thought to have been part of his Cherokee lottery land. However, 01/02/1877 Thomas Vessells of Henry County GA [his father-in-law] sold to Absalom Terrell of Carroll County GA one-third part of Lot #246 in the 11th Dist. Carroll County GA, 67 acres, for the sum of \$100, Witness James Vessells [brother-in-law]. On 12/15/1838, Ezekiel Arnold of Carroll Co. GA sold to Absalom Terrell of Carroll Co. GA the south half of Lot #67, 11th Dist. Carroll Co. GA, number of acres not stated, for \$68.75, witness James Vessells & Anna Knight. (Carroll Co. GA Deed Book C page 376/377) Whatever became of his Cherokee County GA land grant remains a mystery. 1850 census Coosa Co. AL listed below family: Lucinda age 15 b. GA; the relationship and origin of this person has not been determined. After moving to AL, he attended either Ebenezer Congregational and/or Swamp Creek Primitive Baptist Churches. Family tradition cannot agree in which of these cemeteries

he is buried. It is highly doubtful that any marking on his grave would still be visible. Family tradition states he served in the Home Co. 1 during the Civil War and was wounded after which he walked with crutches. He has been described as a quiet man, less than 5'3" tall, who farmed, possibly preached some, and abstained from association with rowdy elements of the community. He had a tragic life. He lost three daughters during Jan. 1855, had a son killed in the Civil war, led another who went to Texas after the war suffering from war wounds and never returned. ####

THUS ENDS OUR FIRST YEAR

Except for the index which follows this concludes the first volume of *Terrell Trails*.

It has been an interesting year to say the least.

We began by offering you a piece of a dream--a Terrell Family organization with a newsletter that will help to preserve the cultural heritage given to us by our ancestors.

We began the year with many unknowns: how many would be interested enough to join?; how much could we deliver if only a few joined?; what would it cost to provide a newsletter?; how much would our costs increase during the year?; could we put out a newsletter that would be interesting and worthy of our support?; could we count on any help from the readers such as providing information and spreading the word to other potential members?; etc.

Due to using mail services, we had to be extremely conservative in what we promised. We could always provide more than we offered, but to provide less would amount to mail fraud.

We promised a minimum of 16 pages (four issues of at least 4 pages each). Including the following index, we have provided 40 pages--2 1/2 times what we promised!!

We promised to provide an index in issue 4 covering all 4 issues. We have done so. The index that follows took our editor over 8 hours to prepare. It contains over 1100 names that can be found in pages 1-32. This is an intensive index. Extra effort was made to list ladies by their maiden and each of their married names. This was to assist researchers in locating possible ancestors or relatives easily. The index was reduced before printing to cut costs. It would have taken 9 pages to print it full size.

We have watched our membership grow slowly to pass the 60 mark.

A recent review of *Terrell Trails* in the NOV-DEC issue of *Genealogical Helper* has been quite helpful to us. It also created one minor problem. Our Non-resident rate was quoted as member rate. It is the only one published in the Publisher's Statement (second page of each issue). Several have joined at the \$10.00 per year rate when they are not eligible to join at a lower rate. Each has been offered the

option of applying any excess toward next year's membership or leaving it as a general donation.

We hope to have a financial analysis and projections ready by the Spring 1986 issue, and look forward to serving you next year. We hope to get better! How much better will depend largely upon you!##

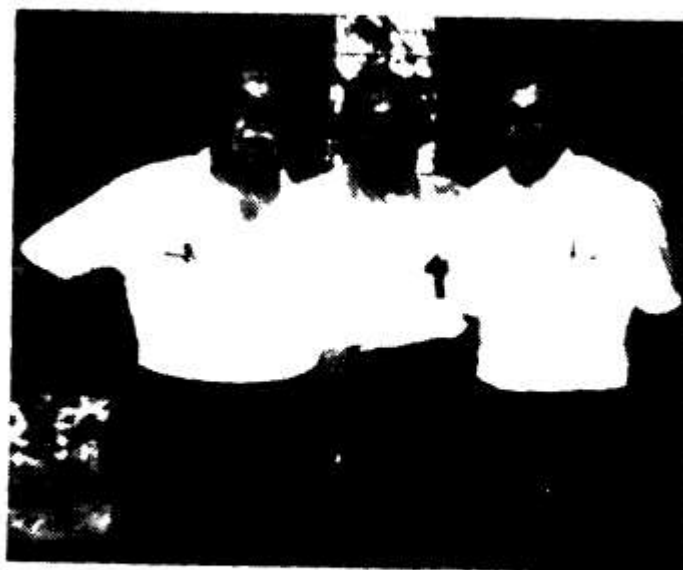
