Every membership expires on December 31 of the current year unless a member has paid for one or more additional years in advance. Each Fall and Winter Issue mailed has a peach and a pink RENEWAL REMINDER respectively complete with the correspondence secretary's address. The expiration date is printed in the top right hand corner of each mailing label for TRAILS. As of Winter 1991, the Expiration date is in BOLDFACE type for those whose membership expired on or before Dec. 31 1991. If members can't or won't read their mailing label with a renewal reminder in their hand, I seriously doubt that they will dig through a wallet or purse in search of a small membership card.

It has also been suggested that having a card to show off to relatives might help increase interest in the Society and likewise increase membership.

The cost of providing a colorful attractive card should run less than twenty-five cents each even in the small number that we would require. However, it might be necessary to have at least 2,000 printed because it is not cost effective to print smaller numbers. Also, the cards would have to be bought in sheet form so the correspondence secretary could get them to feed through her printer to add the individual member information. That would also require that the secretary cut the cards apart for mailing. Die cutting of the card stock to tear out would be too expensive in the small number (at present about 175 per year) that we need.

An equally inexpensive alternative might be a card calendar 5 1/2 X 8 1/2 inches that could be mailed in TRAILS with December 31 prominently highlighted as a renewal reminder. This

could be hung on a wall year around and serve as both a visible reminder and a conversation piece.

If you are not interested in either of these alternatives, do nothing. If you would like to have either a TERRELL SOCIETY membership CARD or CALENDAR, let us know which.

Some members have been confused by the membership numbers appearing on their address labels which do not agree with the number that they were advised when joining the SOCIETY.

As editor, I must accept the blame for this confusion. When I changed computers, I had to change software also because of a different operating system.

The data base that I now use operates slightly differently from the one I had used previously. I had overlooked some fine print instructions regarding sorting.

When I sorted the database into zip code order for mailing labels, the computer changed some of the numbers and I did not catch it.

I hope this error has been corrected and that membership numbers will appear correctly. However, if you should get a label with a number that is not yours, don't panic! It will just mean that I goofed again.

In spite of using membership numbers for convenience, I still have you listed as a flesh and blood member by name and address and can find you in our records even in the absence of your membership number.

I humbly apologize for any discomfort one of these stray numbers may have caused you.

ORGANIZE STATE CHAPTERS?

We have a suggestion to organize state chapters of the TERRELL SOCIETY OF AMERICA, INC. in order to increase interest in the Society.

The officers are considering this suggestion. The legal aspects of such a move must be carefully considered. It must be structured in such a way that activities of any individual chapter could not jeopardize the Society or its status as a non-profit organization.

It would be relatively simple to provide a structure for up to 999 local chapters in each state.

The D.A.R. has already created such a structure and it seems to be working with questionable results. Furthermore, the D.A.R. is not limited to those with TERRELL ancestry.

This suggestion has merit for publicity purposes alone. As each local unit is organized, increases membership, hosts an activity, donates a TERRELL book to the local library, or holds a meeting, it will be an occasion for free 'NEWS' coverage in the local area. As each state chapter holds an annual meeting or sponsors some other event, it will be an occasion for free STATEWIDE NEWS coverage.

Since none of our states have 999 counties, the above structure could allow for members to form chapters consisting of the descendants of certain TERRELL ancestors, for example: **The Roger and Abigail UFFORD TERRELL Chapter; The William and Susanna TERRELL Chapter; The Richmond and Ann 'Nancy' OVERTON TERRELL Chapter; The Philemon and Elizabeth TERRELL Chapter; The Edmund and Margaret 'Peggy' WILLIS TERRELL Chapter; The John and Marian TERRELL Chapter, etc.**

I see no reason why a member could not belong to a local chapter and one or more ancestral chapters if he or she so desired. In the event that such chapters are organized.

GENEALOGY? ASK DAN!

Beginning with this issue, we will have a new regular column for genealogical questions.

We frequently get letters asking for help in locating an ancestor, determining which theory to believe, etc. However, as a totally volunteer organization, we have no formal method to answer these questions.

They usually wind up on your editor's desk anyway. Many have wound up in Trails as QUERIES; others have received a personal reply; but to the best of my knowledge, none have been ignored.

First, let me tell you what NOT to ask. Don't ask me who your gggmother was. Unless it happens to be the same as one of mine, I won't know, and therefore won't be able to answer you.

The same problem will apply to questions such as: "Who was the mother of Susanna WATERS?" To the best of my knowledge, no one has found an answer for that. Unless it has been published in TRAILS, I won't have access to the answers to such questions.

I don't have access to the volumes in the LENDING LIBRARY without purchasing or renting a copy from the LENDING LIBRARY. I did a brief Book Review on each volume for TRAILS. I have a general idea of the content of each and may be able to suggest which volume(s) would be more likely to contain the information you seek.

I do not have time to research the volumes for you unless you are willing to pay my usual fee for genealogy consulting. As a professional genealogist, I would never recommend that you hire me to read a book that you can get and read yourself.

If your problem requires research into microfilm that you do not have the ability to read, or which would require travel and lodging to reach, you might find it cheaper to hire someone else to search for you.

Now, let me tell you how to ask genealogical questions that can be answered constructively.

First, tell me exactly, in as few words as possible, WHAT your genealogical problem is. Second, tell me WHERE you have looked along with WHAT you DID or DID NOT find.

Answers to questions that might benefit others in their research will be printed in this column. No personal replies will be given unless you include a long self addressed stamped envelope. Personal replies will be brief, usually less than one full page.

The following is an example of the type question and answer you are likely to find in this column.

QUESTION: The FINCH family Bible says my great grandmother was Rebecca Rogers TERRELL (03/13/1842--12/03/1882), daughter of William Overton TERRELL and Margaret ROGERS; family tradition held by some of my relatives say that she was daughter of William Pitt TERRELL and Lucy B. JEFFERIES.

They have no proof except family tradition and a few census records that I have found. Which should I believe, Bible or tradition? W.E.F. AR

ANSWER: There are more black holes in history than there are in space. Genealogy prior to 1900 rarely terminates in absolute proof. In most cases, it ends with a preponderance of evidence pointing more toward one conclusion than toward other possibilities.

Credence is given to evidence according to the type of evidence. First, or most credence is given to 'eye witness accounts.' Eye witness accounts occur when someone sees an event and writes it down at the time. It makes no difference where it is written, Bible, diary, certificate, or local newspaper, as long as it is written at the time of the event.

The next level of credibility goes to 'source records.' Source records consist of census, marriage books, wills, probate records, and other public records created at or about the time of an event.

The next degree of credibility goes to published works that are researched through eyewitness and source records. Due to the erroneous nature of humans, typos and erroneous conclusions find their way into print, thus reducing the accuracy of the published work. TRAILS is no exception to this rule.

The least credibility goes to 'family tradition' that cannot be backed up by two or more of the above. I never quote 'family tradition' without clearly identifying it as such.

If the FINCH Family Bible was published before Rebecca Rogers TERRELL was born, and the entries for birth, death, marriage, etc. appear in different handwriting as though entered throughout the years, your Bible is probably an eyewitness account. However, if the Bible was published about the time she married, or later, someone would have had to put in preceding generations from memory which may or may not have been accurate. The cover sheet in the front of the Bible should have the date it was copyrighted or printed and the publisher.

It is unusual to find a Bible that lists the parents of the original owner couple. In order to have an eyewitness Bible for the generations you have listed, you would need the **William Overton TERRELL** Bible, not the **FINCH** Bible. However, if your Bible lists the death dates for **William Overton TERRELL** and **Margaret ROGERS Terrell**, then evidence would point toward these being parents of **Rebecca Rogers TERRELL Finch**.

The census records you cited prove nothing except that there was a **William Pitt TERRELL** in Wake Co. NC in 1840, a **William Pitt TERRELL** in Union Co. AR in 1850, and a **William Simon TERRELL** in Union Co. AR in 1860. Due to the difference in the 1840 age grouping by head of household only and the 1850 exact age plus other members of the household, these cannot be considered positive proof that **William Pitt TERRELL** in each census was the same man.

Even if **William Simon TERRELL** appeared in the household of **William Pitt TERRELL** in 1850, that does not constitute proof that he was a son. Neither the 1850 nor 1860 census listed relationships. Unless there is a will, Bible, or some other document to prove his relationship, **Wm. Simon TERRELL** could have been a brother, nephew, cousin, uncle, or almost anything else to **William Pitt TERRELL**.

I assume the **R. R. TERRELL** was listed as a female in the respective censuses. Even so, this could have stood for **Ramona Ruth** or anything else beginning with **R** as well as for **Rebecca Rogers**. The fact that the female is listed as 8 in 1850 and 18 in 1860 is not proof that it refers to the same person.

The placement of a name in the 1850/1860 census sometimes gave clues to non-children by placing them last. For example, you might have a male head of household 50, a female 48, male 22, male 20, female 12, male 8, female 20. In most cases, checking the local and surrounding counties will reveal that the 20 year old female is the wife of one of the older boys.

In your case, orphan records might reveal that **R. R. TERRELL** in the **Wm. Simon TERRELL** household was **Rebecca Rogers TERRELL**, the daughter of **William Pitt TERRELL**, placed under the guardianship of her brother.

The best conclusion I could draw from what you sent is that **R. R. TERRELL** might have been **Rebecca Rogers TERRELL** since it agrees with your 1842 birth date and her location at marriage assuming that her marriage date was found in a marriage book there and/or the place of marriage spelled out in the Bible record. If AR still used marriage bonds in 1861, the names of those going on the bond might help unravel the mystery.

There was one **Overton TERRILL** in Gerrard Co. KY, household 247, Division 1, 1850 census. [Trails, p. 267] This might be worth investigating.

If you know when and where **William Overton TERRELL**, **William Pitt TERRELL**, and **William Simon TERRELL** died; you may be able to find orphan records in the case of the first

two, and/or wills, estate settlements, or other records in the case of all three that will shed some light on your problem. Any newspaper that existed where they died might have published legal ads or other information that will help.

If there was a newspaper in the area where **Rebecca Rogers TERRELL** married, her marriage may have been published with some brief clue, ie, 'married at the home of the bride's brother, **W. S. Terrell**.' (publication of his full name in that era would be too much to hope for)

Given the mere name **Rebecca Rogers TERRELL**, several questions come to mind. It was not unusual for a man of this era to have (or use) only one given name; likewise, it was not unusual for a girl to be given the full name (including surname) of her namesake. Who was the original **Rebecca ROGERS**? Was it the mother of **Margaret ROGERS Terrell**? Was she simply given her mother's surname for a middle name? What reason would **William Pitt TERRELL** and **Lucy B. JEFFERIES** have had for naming a daughter **Rebecca Rogers TERRELL**?

Based upon the limited information supplied, these are the best suggestions I can give. dfb

QUESTION: I am going to be in D. C. in June [1992] and have one free day. Is there a particular county seat I may find a clue to my **William TERRELL** who d. KY about 1840? **JWB CA**

ANSWER: First, with the exception of the **LIBRARY OF CONGRESS** with its many **COUNTY HISTORY** volumes and the **DAR Library** with similar materials, I don't know where in D.C. you would find county seat type records.

The census records for 1840 and before only list heads of households, number and ages of males and females living with them. Without other confirming documentation such as bibles, deeds, wills, etc. these are practically useless except for clues about which area to search. The mere fact that you find a person with the same name as your ancestor does not prove that he is your ancestor.

Second, I frequently quip that every **TERRELL** man who had two sons between 900 A.D. and 1900 A.D. named one of them **John** and the other **William**. Considering the infant mortality rate of that era and the number who lived to manhood, some of them must have named several replacements.

Third, if your ancestor died in KY about 1840, he may have lived anywhere East [TN, NC, VA, MD, DE] or North [IL, IN, OH, PA, NJ, NY, CT, RI, MA, NH, VT, or ME] of there in addition to the possibility that he was born in KY. Early migration patterns in this country were generally southward and westward. The mountains limited this some due to few gaps that settlers could cross with their wagons and livestock.

1993 NEW ENGLAND CONFERENCE

In conjunction with the 360th anniversary of the founding of Windsor CT, the first permanent settlement in CT, a conference will be held at Windsor CT on 22-24 September 1993 to study the "West Country" ancestral heritage of the founding families.

In 1630, a ship called the *Mary and John* sailed from Plymouth harbor in England carrying approximately 135 West Country Englishmen to their eventual settlement at Dorchester MA. Five years later, a majority of the so-called "Dorchester Company" trekked 110 miles to settle in the CT river valley at what we now know as Windsor, CT which had been established as a trading post on 26 Sept. 1633.

They lost few of the group to the early years and raised their families in the Puritan tradition. History has properly recognized the *Mayflower* settlers while ignoring those who came aboard the *Mary and John* only 10 years later. Developments in the past 15 years have increased interest in these unsung pioneers and this conference is a culmination of those efforts.

Those presenting include an impressive list of historians, archivists, designers, and genealogical organizers from both England and the USA.

You will recall that Daniel TURRELL, featured in our last issue was one of the "West Country" immigrants. 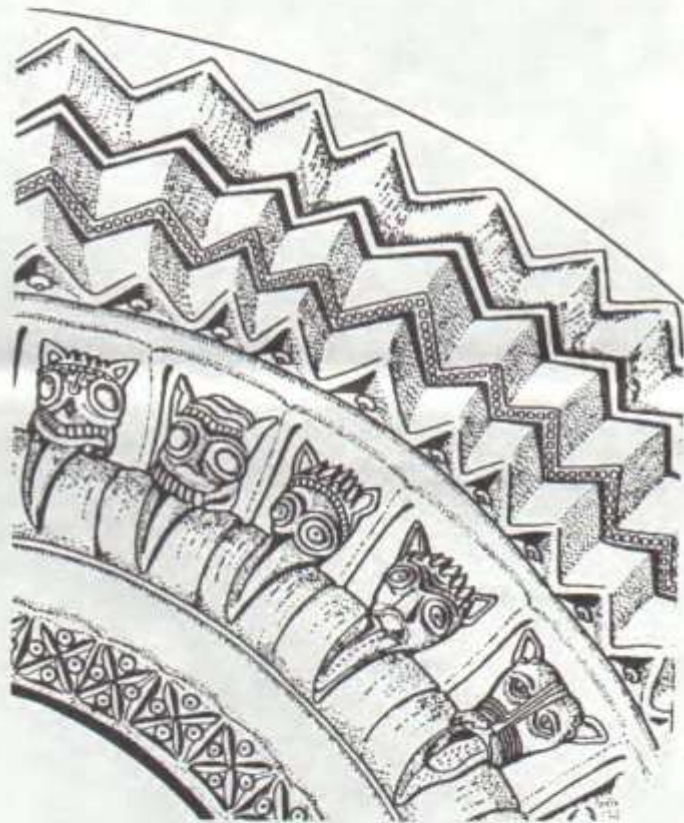

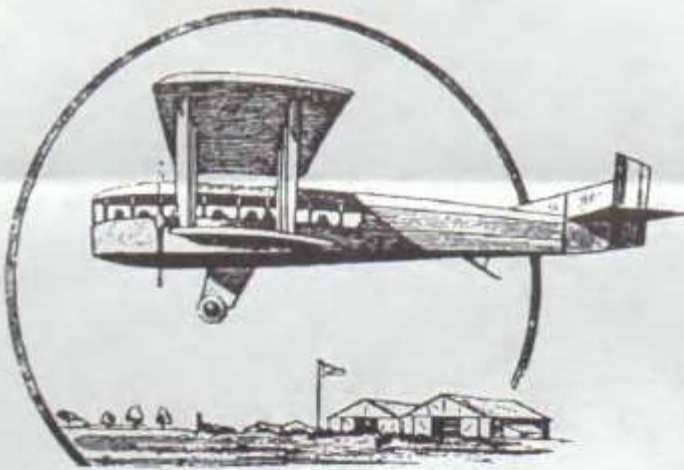

Do they still make them like this?

Just yesterday, when Esther Terrell turned 100, another era frozen in time was taken down off the shelf and remembered. Mrs. Terrell went to work at the age of 76, after her husband, Florida Supreme Court Justice Glenn Terrell, died in 1964. And she didn't stop working until she was 90.

"I want to retire while they're asking me to stay," she told her daughter, Ruth McLeod, who was here from Atlanta for the family tribute to her.

Up until then, friends say, Mrs. Terrell loved nothing more than being partners with the venerated justice, a man ahead of his time who spent 41 years on the court, turning out opinions that made him either hated or glorified — and so widely quoted that a whole book of "Terrellisms" was published by lawyers who were astonished by him.

Terrellisms: "It is better to eat crow than to perpetuate error"; The judiciary "is the poor man's shield against oppression and the rich man's defense against the mob."

It was another time and Tallahassee back then. But, my old-fogey friend, progress sometimes came with change.
