### 1993 NEW ENGLAND CONFERENCE

In conjunction with the 360th anniversary of the founding of Windsor CT, the first permanent settlement in CT, a conference will be held at Windsor CT on 22-24 September 1993 to study the "West Country" ancestral heritage of the founding families.

In 1630, a ship called the *Mary and John* sailed from Plymouth harbor in England carrying approximately 135 West Country Englishmen to their eventual settlement at Dorchester MA. Five years later, a majority of the so-called "Dorchester Company" trekked 110 miles to settle in the CT river valley at what we now know as Windsor, CT which had been established as a trading post on 26 Sep. 1633.

They lost few of the group to the early years and raised their families in the Puritan tradition. History has properly recog-

nized the *Mayflower* settlers while ignoring those who came aboard the *Mary and John* only 10 years later. Developments in the past 15 years have increased interest in these unsung pioneers and this conference is a culmination of those efforts.

Those presenting include an impressive list of historians, archivists, designers, and genealogical organizers from both England and the USA.

You will recall that Daniel TURRELL, featured in our last winter issue was one of the "West Country" immigrants. Family surname associations include: CLAP, COOKE, DENSLOW, DRAKE, EGGLESTON, FORD, FYLER, GALLOP, GAYLORD, GILLET, GRANT, HILL, HOLCOMBE, HULL, LUDLOW, MAVERICK, NEWBERRY, PHELPS, PINNEY, ROCKWELL, ROSSITER, STOUGHTON, STRONG, TERRY, WARHAM, WAY, AND WOLCOTT.

If you have roots in the "West Country" of England, New England, or in any of the above named families this conference will be of special interest to you. The public is invited to attend the conference, hear the speakers, and meet the representatives of many family associations originating with the "Mary and John Families," to share their own knowledge, and to learn from others.

#### TERRELL/TYLER LINE

**William TYLER**, son of **Richard TYLER**, moved to Caroline Co. VA as is proven by an entry in the records of Essex Co., February 3, 1749, which recites that "William TYLER, of Caroline County," has bargained and sold to **Joseph DUNN** one hundred acres of land lying in South Farnham Parish, Essex County. The land is described as adjoining that of **John TYLER** and "as being the place on which **James BROUGHAN** now lives." The land sold was undoubtedly part of that which William TYLER inherited from his father, Richard TYLER. (See *Letters and Times of the Tylers*, Vol III, 226) William TYLER is the ancestor of all members of this particular family bearing the TYLER name, as his brothers, Richard and John, left no sons. William died in Caroline Co. VA in 1767, and must have been the father of: (1) **William TYLER** of Caroline Co. who was administrator of his estate, and of (2) **Richard TYLER**, of Caroline Co., who with his wife, **Catherine**, made a deed in 1784 for 200 acres in Spotsylvania Co. (Caroline & Spotsylvania County Records, *Letters and Times of the Tylers*, Vol III.) He also had (3) a daughter who m. **Henry TERRELL** (b. 01/29/1735), moved to KY in 1787, and d.

in 1811. (Quarterly, XVI, 287) In Caroline Co. VA records the will of **Catherine TYLER**, wife of **Richard TYLER** above, was probated 08/12/1816, and she mentions legatees, kinsman **Richard Keeling TYLER**, **George TYLER**, **Nancy HEWLETT**, **Kemp GATEWOOD**, **Kemp EVANS**; nieces **Kitty MIKELBOROUGH**, **Dorothy** and **Mary EVANS**; sisters **Jane** and **Lucy COLE**, sister **Frances SMITH**, brother **Philemon GATEWOOD**, kinsmen **George TERRELL** and **Charles TERRELL**. **Richard Keeling TYLER** and **Philip REDD** executors.

**George TYLER** (1755-01/17/1833), son of (1) **William TYLER** above, and his brother, **John TYLER**, were recommended by the court of Caroline Co. to the Governor for commission respectively as second lieutenant and ensign in **Capt. Roger QUARLES'** Company of Militia. He was known as **Capt. TYLER** and resided at "River Bend" in Spotsylvania. In the *Richmond Enquirer* is the following notice: "Another Revolutionary officer, on Friday, 18th January, 1833, Captain **George TYLER**, died at his residence in Spotsylvania County aged seventy-eight years. He married in early life and raised eleven children." In 1884, Hon. **George TYLER**, who represented Caroline in the Legislature in 1861 wrote to the compiler of this account that his great-grandfather (**William TYLER**) lived and died in Caroline. He had three sons, who, during the Revolution organized and equipped a company and were the captains, first, and second lieutenants of it, **Captain George TYLER**, his grandfather, commanded a regiment at Yorktown as colonel, though not commissioned as such. He added: "I am the oldest representative of the name in this section, and trust that a name so identified with the history of the county is not destined to die out or even be diminished in the coming century. I live near Woodford in an old continental brick house about 130 years old, furnished in old English style." *Letters and Times of the Tylers*, Vol I p. 50) In the Spotsylvania County Order Book, 1829-1832, proof is recorded of **George TYLER**, "an active and efficient officer of the Revolution who died January 17, 1833."

**Captain George TYLER m. Judith TERRELL** and had eleven children who are as follows:

(a) **William TYLER m. Jane SCOTT**, moved to MO and died in St. Louis County. He had a son **William Scott TYLER** whose widow married second **Joseph A. WHERRY** and lived at 308 Benton Ave Marshall MO.

(b) **Elizabeth TYLER, m. Jordan PLEASANTS** of Henrico Co.  
(c) **Richard TYLER m. Miss HERNDON**. (d) **Judith TYLER m. Robert GOODWIN**.

(e) **Sarah TYLER m. a HERNDON** and went to KY.

(f) **Kitty TYLER m. Dr. DURRETT** of Richmond Co. VA.

(g) **Nancy TYLER m. — STEVENS**, went to MO and her daughter m. her cousin, **Henry TYLER**, and lived in Saline Co. MO.

(h) **George TYLER m. a DURETT** of Richmond Co. VA

(i) **Henry TYLER**

(j) **John TYLER**, father of the late Major **Joseph TYLER** of Bluefield WV and **George TYLER** of Waco TX.

(k) **Thomas TYLER** who d. unmarried at an advanced age.



## TERRELL/CHILES LINES

From *THE CHILES FAMILY IN VIRGINIA* page 792, 798;

Micajah CHILES, son of John CHILES, first patented 379 acres in Caroline Co. St. Margaret's Parish, VA in 1630 bordering on William TERRELL's land. (L. O. XIII, 489) He married — TERRELL, daughter of Joel TERRELL, Sr. He witnessed a deed in St. George's Parish 05/06/1652. (Spotts. Rec.) Issue: John CHILES; Manoah CHILES; Micajah CHILES Jr.; Thomas CHILES; Sally CHILES; Ann CHILES m. Henry TERRELL; Agatha CHILES m. David TERRELL.

Micajah CHILES, Jr. purchased land on Mechum's River, Albemarle Co. VA 1772. In 1774, he patented land "on side of one of the Ragged Mountains on the head of the East branches of Mechum's River." (L. O. Vol XLII, 712) The old "Joel TERRELL" property was purchased from his executors in 1800. (*Hist. of Albemarle, Woods, p. 276, 324*)

John CHILES, son of Micajah Sr., inherited land from his grandfather Joel TERRELL as seen by record in Land Book XXXVIII, pp 524-25, dated April 6th 1769.

(Copy): Whereas by patent, under seal of our Colony and Dominion of Virginia, bearing date of ninth day of July, one thousand seven hundred and twenty-four, there was granted unto Joel TERRELL one tract or parcel of land containing four hundred acres, lying and being in the county of King William, now Caroline, &c; and whereas John CHILES, in whom right and title of part thereof supposed to contain 250 acres is &c, found to contain, by survey 255 acres, &c Henry TERRELL enters suit on same for accounting of the extra 5 acres in order to settle lines &c. Land said to adjoin that of Manoah CHILES.

In Caroline Co. VA, appointed May 1778, Thomas Carr CHILES, Christopher TERRELL, Charles TERRELL, & Joseph MAGEE to appraise the estate of George CHEADLE, deceased.

From an abstract from Franklin County GA, Superior Court Records...

Armistead STOKES vs. Moses TERRELL - April Term 1804 - Petition of Armistead STOKES for the use of the Estate of Micajah ANTHONY, dec'd, assignee of Bolling ANTHONY. Moses TERRELL on June 17, 1798 entered into an agreement with Bolling ANTHONY whereby Bolling was to lease Moses 440 acres on the water of Grove Fork of the Broad River. Lease was for 6 years for the purpose of building a mill. For the use of the land, TERRELL was to plant 300 peach trees. No date... John GIFFEN, Plaintiff's Attorney.

## TERRELL/SCOTT LINE

Submitted by #269 Mrs. Millie E. WRIGHT; P O Box 427; Merlin OR 97532. Apparently from a *SCOTT Family history*, but title of publication was not on the pages submitted. Note cited references in text.

John SCOTT, son of Johnny & Mary HACKETT SCOTT, b. 07/18/1760 at "Scotland" another house on his father's plantation, was commissioned an ensign 1779 and a lieutenant in 1780 [Scott's *HISTORY of ORANGE COUNTY* p. 261-2]. He also served as a justice of the county court after the Revolution. He married in 1793, according to family records, Sarah TERRELL of Caroline Co. VA, daughter of Charles TERRELL and his wife Anne TYLER of the family from whom Gov. J. Hoge TYLER was descended. Sarah TERRELL is said also from family records to have been born in 1762 (this is an error, probably it was 1772. Her father was not born until 1748 so her birth in 1762 is impossible. See 14T59, 127), to have died April 6, 1836 at "Clifton" and to have been buried there.

The children of John and Sarah TERRELL SCOTT were:

1. John SCOTT, later of Edgefield
2. Charles SCOTT
3. Jane SCOTT
4. Sarah Ann SCOTT
5. Mary SCOTT, &
6. Garrett SCOTT of "Clifton."

If John SCOTT left a will, no record of it can be found nor does a careful and diligent search disclose any division or partition of his estate among his heirs. He d. Sept 1, 1809 and is believed to have been buried in the family graveyard at "Clifton."

1. John SCOTT, of Edgefield, oldest son of John and Sarah TERRELL SCOTT, was born according to W. W. SCOTT's Bible, at "Scotland" on Feb. 8, 1796. He married on April 10, 1822 (*Orange Co. Records, Marriage Register I, p. 107*), Anne COWHERD (01/25/1799-05/18/1870), the daughter of Colby COWHERD and his wife Tabitha TWYMAN. William COWHERD was bondsman and the witnesses for the marriage were Eliza COWHERD, William COWHERD, & P. S. FRY. John SCOTT is said to have been in easy and comfortable circumstances according to the standards of his day. Shortly before the Civil War when the congregation abandoned its old building nearer Orange, he contributed most of the money for the erection of the New Zion church opposite "Todsberth."



The children of **John and Anne COWHERD SCOTT** were: **William Cowherd SCOTT**; **John Wickliffe SCOTT**; **Ann Eliza SCOTT**; **Marcia Pleasants SCOTT**; and **Edward Livingston SCOTT**. It may be noted that this is the first time in the Orange County branch that the name John was not given to the oldest son. John died testate March 1, 1871, and was buried at "Edgefield," but many years later, his remains and those of other members of his family were disinterred and placed in Hollywood Cemetery, Richmond VA. In his will (*Orange Co. Records, Will Book 13 p 282*) provided for his wife **Anne**, his four surviving children, and made his daughter **Marcia P. SCOTT** executrix. It is said that into her hands came most of the family papers which John as eldest son had possessed, and that for some unaccountable reason she destroyed them. John SCOTT is said by those who remember him to have been a cultured and courtly gentleman, typical of that gracious and leisurely period "before the War."

Of the five children children of John and Anne COWHERD SCOTT, **Edward Livingston SCOTT**, the youngest, was born Oct. 15, 1835, died unmarried of typhoid fever Dec. 10, 1855.

**Marcia Pleasants SCOTT**, the second daughter was born at "Edgefield" July 10, 1830, died Oct. 2, 1912. On June 27, 1871, she m. Rev. **Abraham Muir POINDEXTER**. There were no children by this marriage. She is buried in Hollywood Cemetery in Richmond, VA.

**Ann Eliza SCOTT**, the older daughter was born at "Edgefield" Sept 27, 1827, and died in Culpeper Co. March 3, 1905. On Oct. 16, 1855, she m. **Joel GARNETT** of Culpeper. The only child of this union, **Marcia Livingstone GARNETT**, died unmarried Jan 28, 1887.

**John Wickliffe SCOTT**, second son of John and Anne COWHERD SCOTT, m. on Jan 29, 1856, **Sally F. HACKLEY**. In the Register his age is given as 28 and hers as 25 years. Sally HACKLEY was from FL, though her people seem to have been originally from VA. The following children were born of this union: **Percy SCOTT**; **Pembroke SCOTT**; **Mary Strachan SCOTT**; all three of whom died in infancy, and **Imogene SCOTT** who died unmarried in 1876 at the age of 19 years. John Wickliffe SCOTT and his wife lived at "Mountain View" in Orange Co. and together with their children are buried in the garden there. What remains of this property was purchased in 1900 by Dr. **Jesse WRIGHT**.

**William Cowherd SCOTT**, oldest child of John and Anne COWHERD SCOTT, and the only one who had surviving descendants, was born at "Edgefield" Aug 13, 1826, and died Dec. 15, 1909. On Jan. 10, 1850, he m. **Pamelia Augusta GRAVES**, dau. of **Charles Tandy GRAVES** by his first wife **Ann Rogers WEBB**. The witnesses were **L. F. GRAVES**, **P. S. FRY**, and **W. C. GRAVES** who was also bondsman.

At the outbreak of hostilities in 1861, he entered the Confederate Army as captain of the Gordonsville Grays, Company C, 13th VA Infantry. In 1863, his entire family being seriously ill

with scarlet fever, he resigned his commission and returned home. Within a month, he again joined the army with **HENSHAW's** Battery and rose to the rank of captain. He was in a majority of the important battles of the war and at its close held the rank of Major, Chief Quarter Master of Artillery of 3rd Corps Northern Army of VA. Major SCOTT's home was "Waverly" Orange County, about five miles from the town of Orange. He sold this some years before his death and moved to Gordonsville. He is buried there in Maplewood Cemetery beside his wife. They had 10 children.

**I. William Crittenden SCOTT**, oldest child of William Cowherd and Pamelia Augusta GRAVES SCOTT, was born on Oct. 15, 1852 at "Waverly" and died at "Edgefield." On May 23, 1876, he married **Susan Emma COWHERD**, born April 10, 1856, at "Hay Farm," daughter of **Edwin Festus COWHERD** and his wife **Susan LATHAM**. His early life was spent in Orange County but he later moved to Charlotte NC, only returning to his native county a few years before his death. Children:

**II. Anna Pleasants SCOTT** (08/18/1854–05/20/1929) never married; for many years she was a beloved and successful teacher.

**III. John Wickliffe SCOTT** (08/22/1856–08/25/1936) on April 20, 1881, m. **Jane Kirkpatrick HOBSON** of Lynchburg VA and settled in Gordonsville. Through his long life there he practiced his profession of medicine, honored and beloved by all with whom he came in contact. By this marriage, there were the following children:

X. **Robert Edward SCOTT**, youngest child of Major William C. SCOTT was b. in Orange Co. 08/12/1873 & d. 11/08/1935 in Huntington WV. He m. (1) **Justine JONES** of Charlottesville VA by whom he had one child, **William SCOTT**. He m. (2) **Pearl ATCHISON** of OH by whom he had **Judith SCOTT** and **Robert Edward SCOTT, Jr.**

2. **Charles SCOTT**, second son of John and Sarah TERRELL SCOTT, was born May 9, 1799. He m. (1) Oct. 21, 1823, in Orange Co. (*Marriage Register* 1 p. 8) to **Harriet COWHERD** of "Oak Hill," his first cousin, daughter of **Lucy SCOTT** and Maj. **Francis COWHERD**. **John S. COWHERD** was bondsman and **John SCOTT** and **Reynolds CHAPMAN**, witnesses. The children of this union died in infancy.

**Charles** m. (2) in Orange Co. (*Marriage Register* 1, p. 144) on July 23, 1837, **Mary LANDRUM**, daughter of **Daniel LANDRUM**. **William A. LANDRUM** was bondsman, **James A. LANDRUM** and **William A. LANDRUM**, witnesses.

He was too old to take part in the Civil War and is said, like his brother **John SCOTT** to have lived the comfortable life of a country gentleman of that period. He died intestate Feb. 25, 1868, and was buried in the graveyard on his plantation but no marker indicates the spot. His landed estate, consisting of 927 acres, was later partitioned among his heirs. In this division, the house, built originally in 1823 at the time of his first marriage with 189 acres adjacent thereto was assigned as the widower's dower. This dower tract remained in possession of the widow until her death and since has been occupied by several of his daughters. The last occupant, Miss **Mary H. SCOTT**, and the other heirs of **Charles** sold this property in 1927 to Mrs. **Kathleen NEWMAN Taliaferro**. Mrs. Taliaferro is the granddaughter of **James NEWMAN** of "Hilton" who m. **Mary**, sister of **Charles SCOTT**, and is therefore no stranger to the soil but of the direct line of the first John who purchased this land in 1730.

The children of **Charles SCOTT** by his second wife, **Mary LANDRUM** were as follows:

1. **Huldah Jane SCOTT** b. 11/15/1846 at her father's home in Orange Co, died unmarried in the house in which she was born 01/21/1927.

2. **Charles Peyton SCOTT** (12/28/1848--03/21/1934) m. **Sue**



TURNER of Louisa Co. by whom he had Ethel Letitia SCOTT, Inez Hawthorne SCOTT, Ada Lewis SCOTT, & Charles Poin-dexter SCOTT who d. unmarried in early manhood. Charles P. SCOTT entered the Baptist ministry as a young man and over a long life held many charges in VA & KY.

3. Johnson Daniel SCOTT (04/13/1851--10/15/1907) m. (1) 07/05/1881 Rosalie AMOS; by this marriage there were Eva SCOTT, Bernice Lee SCOTT, Johnson D. SCOTT, Walter L. SCOTT, Charles SCOTT, Marion E. SCOTT, & George M. SCOTT. He m. (2) Emma Hamilton LECKY b. 08/14/1872 in Augusta Co. VA. To this union was born in Richmond VA 04/09/1908, one child, Jane Louise SCOTT who m. George V. MONCURE, Jr. of Stafford Co. VA and has two children, viz: Louise Scott MONCURE b. 12/15/1935 & George V. MONCURE b. 08/22/1937. Johnson D. SCOTT is buried in the churchyard of Zion church in Orange Co. in sight of the house in which he was born.

4. Delia SCOTT b. 08/03/1852 d. unmarried 02/18/1913 at the home place and is buried in the family graveyard there.

5. Marion SCOTT b. 07/28/1855 d. 08/16/1856.

6. Lelia SCOTT b. 09/19/1856 d. unmarried 07/07/1879.

7. Sallie Henshaw SCOTT (01/24/1860--08/05/1901) m. 03/08/1893 Charles H. DENNIS. To this union were born two daughters, Agnes DENNIS & Lelia DENNIS who is now [about 1938] the wife of Mr. E. Harold THOMPSON of Richmond VA.

8. Mary Harriett SCOTT, youngest dau. of Charles & Mary LANDRUM SCOTT was born 04/12/1861. She furnished most dates on this line via the family Bible. Richmond *Times-Dispatch*, Thursday, 11/03/1938, Miss Mary Harriett SCOTT, 78, died Wednesday at her home 3406 Grove ave. She is survived by eight nieces: Mrs. Harold THOMPSON, Miss Agnes DENNIS; Mrs. J. C. BLANTON; Mrs. H. D. BOWSER; Mrs. L. C. COGBILL; Mrs. E. N. MOSELEY; Miss Bernice SCOTT; and Mrs. George MONCURE, and five nephews, J. D., Charles, Walter, Marion, & George SCOTT.

3. Jane T. SCOTT, daughter of John and Sarah TERRELL SCOTT m. Oct. 29, 1817, Richard TYLER; the witnesses of this marriage were John SCOTT and Charles SCOTT, Richard M. CHAPMAN, and the bondsman was John SCOTT. Little is known about her and her husband except that they moved to MO where she died in 1862, and that they are said to have had 10 children.

4. Sarah Ann SCOTT, b. Feb 11, 1802, d. Aug. 6, 1862. On July 24, 1824, (*Orange Co. Marriage Register 1, p 113*) she was married by the Rev. J. GOSS to Philip T. HENSHAW also of Orange Co., in the presence of Garrett SCOTT, John SCOTT, and Philip S. FRY, Gerret SCOTT being the bondsman. They soon moved to what is now Oldham Co. KY. On a visit to VA in the summer of 1835, he died suddenly. Sarah Ann accompanied by her brother Garrett SCOTT returned to the home she and her husband had built in KY. There were three children of this marriage:

(a) Sarah Ann Elizabeth HENSHAW, b. Oct 20, 1825, d. unmarried Dec. 31, 1902;

(b) John Scott HENSHAW (Aug 10, 1828--Feb 2, 1883) m. (1) Adeline DAVIS of VA, (2) Anna COLE. Philip T. HENSHAW,

his only child, the son of his first wife was b. 1850, d. 1920. He m. Lillian NEWMAN, daughter of Wilson NEWMAN and granddaughter of James NEWMAN and Mary SCOTT NEWMAN of "Hilton" in Orange Co. John Wilson HENSHAW and Philip T. HENSHAW, Jr., together with their mother still lived in Oldham KY on part of the original tract of their great grandfather, Philip T. HENSHAW [when this family history was written, about 1938];

(c) Lucy Mary Jane HENSHAW (July 7, 1831--Nov. 19, 1899), youngest child of Sarah Ann SCOTT and Philip T. HENSHAW, m. Richard WATERS of KY; issue among others,

(1) John Scott Henshaw WATERS who m. Lillian W. SCOTT;

(2) Richard T. WATERS Jr. who m. her sister Kate G. SCOTT; and

(3) another son who m. Lucy Welch STOVIN of "Tetley" Orange Co., dau. C. J. STOVIN and Betty B. NEWMAN.

5. Mary SCOTT (1804--1884), dau. of John and Sarah TERRELL SCOTT m. on Sept. 24, 1828 James NEWMAN of "Hilton" Orange Co. VA, son of Reuben NEWMAN & Phoebe BUTLER. The ceremony performed by Rev. J. GOSS, was witnessed by John T. DANIEL, Garrett SCOTT, and Philip S. FRY, the bondsman being John T. DANIEL. There were nine children of this marriage. One of the daughters, Fanny NEWMAN m. Philip D. BARBOUR of that branch of the family that moved to Jefferson Co. KY. From this marriage there are, among other descendants, a grandson Philip Barbour STOVIN and granddaughters Fannie BARBOUR Morton, wife of Jackson MORTON and Marguerite Barbour HOBSON Scott, wife of Paul H. SCOTT. The descendants of Fannie NEWMAN and Philip BARBOUR trace their descent through their mother from Jane TODD, wife of the first John SCOTT, and from Sarah TODD, second wife of James BARBOUR through their father. Other descendants of James NEWMAN of "Hilton" and Mary SCOTT his wife now [about 1938] living in Orange are their grandchildren, Herbert S. NEWMAN of "Hilton," Mrs. Barton H. CAMERON, & Mrs. A. Barclay TALIAFERRO, who are children of their son Reuben Manning NEWMAN and his wife Kate Randolph TAYLOR.

6. Garrett SCOTT, youngest son of John and Sarah TERRELL SCOTT, was b. April 9, 1808. He m. Feb 14, 1839, Sarah Elenora NALLE, b. Dec. 1, 1812, daughter of Martin NALLE of Culpeper and his first wife Nelly Madison BARBOUR. Nelly BARBOUR, sister of Gov. James BARBOUR and of Judge Philip Pendleton BARBOUR, was granddaughter of James BARBOUR and Sarah TODD. Sarah Elenora NALLE was therefore great-granddaughter of Sarah TODD, and Garrett SCOTT the great-grandson of Jane TODD. Garrett spent his entire life at his home "Clifton" in Orange Co. and was known as Col. SCOTT by reason of a commission under the old militia system. He appears to have taken a more active part in the public affairs of the county than either of his brothers. For some 75 years he was the presiding justice of the county court; or, from the creation of that office until Feb. 22, 1869, at which time the carpet baggers then in control of the county required all office holders to take "the iron-clad oath." Refusing to do this, he was automatically debarred from continuing as justice. After the state was read-



mitted to the Union in 1870, each county under the new constitution had to be divided into townships; to perform this duty, the governor appointed **Garrett SCOTT, R. L. GORDON, Ferdinand JONES, & Wm. F. BROOKING**. This appears to have been his last public service. He is said to have been a man of great personal magnetism and extremely popular in the county. He d. 02/24/1885 at "Spring Forest" the home of his son **Edmund W. SCOTT** and was buried in the graveyard at "Clifton."

**Garrett & Sarah Elenora NALLE SCOTT** (she d. 1877) had eleven children as follows:

1. **Frances Cornelia SCOTT** b. 12/03/1831 at "Clifton," d. unmarried 01/30/1862.
2. **Geo. Tyler SCOTT** b. 04/30/1833, died of typhoid fever while attending the University of VA 02/28/1852.
3. **Nelly Barbour SCOTT** b. 07/09/1835 d. unmarried 04/19/1921. Grown to womanhood in that golden period "before the war" and steeped in the culture and tradition of her native South, she was the finest example of a type that has all but passed away. She was above the average height, stately, erect, and possessed a rare intellect, personal charm, and exceptional conversational ability. In the art of letter-writing, she was no less accomplished throughout her long life her happy faculty in this mode of self-expression was an unending source of pleasure to her many friends and relatives. It was by reason of her deep interest in her family and its numerous branches, and by her ability and willingness to write letters that she became the link, so to speak, in the ever growing chain that so loosely bound them and which at her passing was to be broken beyond the possibility of repair. She lived a full life, and tho at the last, old and broken in body, her mind and spirit remained undimmed, and she passed to the life beyond with a serene confidence builded on the foundation of a life well spent. She was laid to rest among the departed generations of her ancestors in the old graveyard at "Clifton" at the foot of the little mountains which she loved at all seasons, but best in the springtime when the redbud trimmed its edges with crimson, and the dogwood shone white thru its early mantle of green. She was the last of her name to be buried in the ivy-covered half-acre set aside by her ancestor, John, as "Clifton" was within a few years to pass into alien hands.

4. **James Martin SCOTT**, brother of Nelly, b. 03/11/1837 at "Clifton" d. 10/13/1904 and is buried in Graham Cemetery, Orange VA. On 02/10/1870, he was m. by Rev. **I. W. K. HANDY** to **Catherine GRAVES**, dau. of **Charles Tandy GRAVES** by his second wife **Susan CAMPBELL**. In his childhood a mistake was made in giving him a dose of medicine which resulted in such serious injury to his digestive organs that for many years he was practically an invalid and, in fact, never fully recovered, tho he lived a fairly long life. He spent his entire life in Orange Co. in the neighborhood where he was born and despite the fact that he was unable to perform any manual labor, he successfully supervised the operation of his farm. He was considered a man of the highest integrity and of fine judgement, his advice was sought and valued by many. **George Woodson SCOTT**, his only child, was born at "Milford," the home of his mother in Orange Co. and d. 05/1901. On 07/03/1895, he m. in Richmond VA, **Etta**

**LECKY**, b. in Augusta Co. 09/26/1870. He attended Locust Dale Academy in Madison Co. and the Medical College of VA from which he graduated in 1895. He practiced his profession until the time of his death in his native county. **George W. & Etta LECKY SCOTT** had two children: **Paul Hamilton SCOTT** (07/20/1896-08/30/1938) and **Katherine C. SCOTT** who m. in 1934 **John W. McGAVOCK** of Wytheville. **Paul H. SCOTT**, author of this article, attended McGuire's School in Richmond, and Hampden-Sidney College. On 03/14/1936 he was appointed to fill the unexpired term of the late **J. William BROWNING** as clerk of the Circuit Court County of Orange. He held the office until his death. He was a capable and beloved officer. He married 08/28/1918, **Marguerite Barbour HOBSON** who with two daughters, **Pauline SCOTT** and **Barbour SCOTT** survived him. For this article, the fruit of much time and effort, his kinspeople owe him a debt of thanks.

5. **Philip Henshaw SCOTT** b. 07/06/1839 d. unmarried 08/05/1871. At the outbreak of hostilities in 1861, he enlisted in the Montpelier Guard, Company A, 13th VA Infantry. At the battle of Winchester, 09/20/1864, he was so severely wounded that his leg had to be amputated near the hip. The surgeon performing the operation had to leave him on the operating table to avoid capture himself. (Scott's *HISTORY of ORANGE COUNTY* pp 219-220)

6. **Thomas Allen Bryan SCOTT** b. 12/04/1840, d. unmarried 09/20/1864 of typhoid fever contracted in the Confederate trenches at Petersburg.

7. **Charles Terrell SCOTT** b. 01/04/1843, d. unmarried 07/18/1861 when about to enter the service of the Confederacy.

8. **William Wallace SCOTT** (04/10/1845-01/16/1929) entered the service of the Confederacy at an early age, serving for 15 months in the 13th VA Infantry, and from 11/1863 until the end of the war in the "Black Horse" Troop, Fourth Cavalry. After the war, he entered the field of law and practiced his chosen profession for years. In 1894 he became State Librarian of VA, resigning after 10 years to accept the appointment of State Law Librarian, which he held up until his death. He was an authority on matters touching his native county and state, and in 1907 published a history of Orange County, which for its accuracy, breadth of treatment, and excellence of expression is regarded as one of the standard VA historical works. Some years before his death, by his tireless efforts he succeeded in securing donations of portraits of distinguished citizens of the county and state to be hung on the walls of the courtroom. These included **Alexander SPOTSWOOD, James MADISON, Zachary TAYLOR, James BARBOUR, Philip BARBOUR, Lewis Burwell WILLIAMS, Fitzhugh GORDON, R. E. LEE, & Robert COLLINS**.

**William Wallace SCOTT** m. 09/29/1869, **Claudia Marshall WILLIS** (1846-1912), daughter of Col. **John WILLIS**. They had nine children:

- (a) **Philip Henshaw SCOTT**, b. 1871, d. infancy;
- (b) **Philip Henshaw SCOTT** b. 02/14/1873, m. 04/29/1903 **Mattie Moore LEITCH**. After many years of service in the U S Coast Guard, he retired with the rank of captain and lived on his farm "Beaumont" near Gordonsville. Captain SCOTT's varied experience in many parts of the world are always of great interest



to those who are fortunate enough to hear them. His children:

(d) **Robert Lewis Madison SCOTT** b. 09/29/1876, d. unmarried 10/05/1918.

(e) **Ellen Ritchie SCOTT** b. 03/14/1880 m. 09/26/1901, Rev. **James Jeffries CHAPMAN** of Orange, an Episcopal clergyman. They spent most of their married life in Japan where they were missionaries. There are seven children of this marriage:

They had four children: **Claudia Wycliff SCOTT** b. 06/24/1913; **Willis Shields SCOTT** b. 06/27/1916; **Garrett SCOTT** b. 07/31/1919; & **Harriet Shields SCOTT** b. 07/22/1921.

(g) **Caroline Barbour SCOTT** (05/28/1883–02/15/1918) m. on 11/22/1910 to **J. Haywood STRATTON** of Gordonsville, issue: **Joseph Haywood STRATTON Jr.**; & **Caroline Barbour STRATTON**.

(h) **Wycliff SCOTT** b. 12/27/1885, d. unmarried 02/15/1906.

(i) **John SCOTT**, youngest son of W. W. & **Claudia M. WILLIS SCOTT**, b. 05/01/1888, d. unmarried 03/18/1933.

9. **Mary Susan SCOTT**, ninth child of Co. **Garrett** and **Sarah Elenora NALLE SCOTT**, b. at "Clifton" 10/13/1847, d. 10/23/1848.

10. **Frank Garret SCOTT**, tenth child of above, b. 10/21/1849, d. in Petersburg 12/05/1930. He was educated at Locust Dale

Academy and the Episcopal Theological Seminary at Alexandria, class of 1874. While rector of the church at Smithfield, he was instrumental in having the famous "Old Brick Church," St. Luke's, restored. For twenty-six years Dr. SCOTT was vice-principal and professor of Hebrew and Greek at the Bishop Payne Divinity School, Petersburg VA. For thirty-five years he was examining chaplain for the Diocese of Southern VA. He m. (1) 09/21/1880 to **Eloise GOURDIN** of Eutawville SC and (2) 11/27/1895 to **Rebecca Cary WILLIAMS** of Lynchburg VA. All children were by his first marriage:

(a) **Frank Garrett SCOTT Jr.** b. in Eutawville SC 07/11/1881 m.

(1) **Charlotte WRIGHT**, & (2) in Orange, 08/22/1928 **Alice SHIELDS** Scott, issue: **Frank Garret SCOTT III** b. 08/30/1929. Dr. SCOTT resided near Orange Court House and was a widely loved physician.

(e) **James G. SCOTT** b. in Gordonsville 09/26/1890 m. in Harrisonburg VA 08/03/1916 to **Marie Allebaugh BEARD**, issue: **Milly Beard SCOTT** b. 08/03/1917; **James Gaillard SCOTT Jr.** b. 01/29/1931.

11. **Edmund W. SCOTT**, youngest son of **Garrett** and **Sarah Elenora NALLE SCOTT**, was b. 09/21/1852 and died at "Spring Forest," his home in Orange Co. on 01/18/1931. He was educated at Bethel College, Warrenton, VA and for years taught school in Orange County. From 1905-1909 he was county Superintendent of Schools. On 10/24/1877, he m. **Eudora C. GRAVES** (06/16/1850–03/03/1930), daughter of **James W. & Sarah Jane GRAVES**. By this marriage there were:

## GENEALOGY? ASK DAN!

**Q.** I am hesitant to make my genealogy public because of some illegitimacies and other "skeletons in the closet." How can I handle this? Name withheld

**A.** First, there is no such thing as an illegitimate child. There may have been some illegitimate parents, but there never was and



never will be an illegitimate child. Children have no control over their conception.

Marriage is a commitment between a man and a woman before God. Whether that commitment was made before a congregation of 2,000 and chisled in stone, or whispered in private without witnesses or clergy makes little difference. In the past, court houses and ministers were few and far between. It was not unusual for a couple to set up housekeeping without formal vows and a recorded marriage.

Courthouse fires have destroyed many of the formal marriage records of this country. The fact that you did not find a marriage record does not necessarily prove that none ever existed.

You did not say whether the 'illegitimacies' you are concerned about exist in the present, or whether they existed in past generations.

It would be an invasion of privacy to publish birth and marriage dates of any living person whose parents were not married at the time of the birth. Fortunately, a family history is not compiled in a court of law. You are not bound by oath to tell the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth. It is easy to conveniently omit embarrassing details without resorting to fabrication.

If you have grandchildren, for example, whose parents were not married and you wish to publish the birth dates of those grandchildren, simply omit the marriage date (if any) for the parents and let the readers assume that they married before the first child was born.

If the person is deceased, you are at liberty to tell as much as you feel you need to reveal. I see no reason to be embarrassed by the actions of ancestors. Personally, I would be thankful that he was where he was so that I can be where I am.

Most genealogists are more interested in reporting true facts than in enhancing the lives and reputations of their ancestors. Most talk freely about the bad as well as the good deeds of their ancestors.

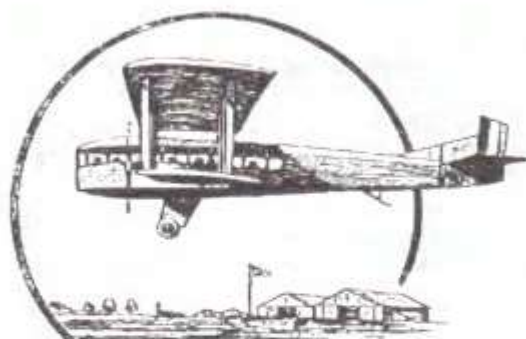
It is possible to 'gloss-over' other incidents that would embarrass you without fabrication. Since you did not say what the other "skeletons in the closet" are, I'll give two general examples.

An ancestor who was hung for stealing horses might be written up as, "died during a public ceremony when the platform on which he was standing collapsed."

Your family history is yours. You are free to write it in any manner that you can be comfortable with as long as you do not reveal embarrassing facts about living persons. Although I hope

you will opt for truth, you need not keep your family in the closet because of a few incidents that would embarrass you if they were current events. ddb

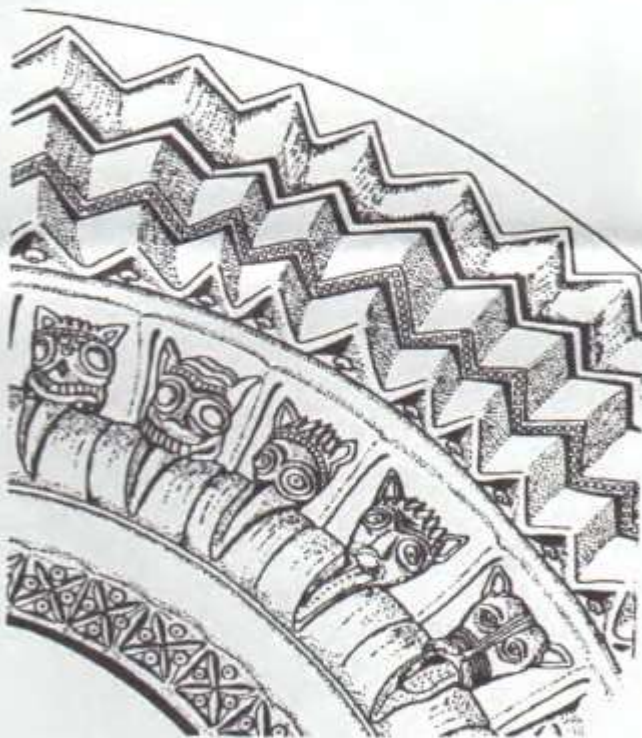
