According to CHARLES SMITH & RACHEL AMY BRYANT, by Tenney Smith, 1938, p. 266, Daniel TURRELL was born in Instoc, Devon (6 mi. east of Barnstaple). He was a blacksmith and he came to New England about 1640.

His ancestry has not been found. He married (1) Lydia BLOTT c1645 who d. 06/23/1659 (dau. of Robert BLOTT and Susanna, widow of John BLACK). Daniel married (2) Mary COLBRON (b. Brentwood, Essex England) who d. 01/23/1697 (dau. of William COLBRON and Margaret, widow of John BARRELL). Daniel was one of the most wealthy men in Boston in 1685. (Ref: Savage 4:344)

However, THE MARY AND JOHN CLEARING HOUSE began in 1985 to trace ancestry and descendants of the passengers of the ship MARY& JOHN which sailed to New England in 1630. These people founded the towns of Dorchester, MA and Windsor, CT. In 1990, the project was expanded to include all of the "planters" who came to New England from the counties of Somerset, Dorset, Devon, and Cornwall between 1620 and 1643.

THE MARY & JOHN CLEARING HOUSE is a hobby business. All proceeds are spent on new research of English records. They have published sixteen volumes and identified about half of the 3,000 people for whom they are searching. Their goal is to show that these people were extensively inter-related before they came over.

If you have New England ancestry (TURRELL or otherwise), The CLEARING HOUSE is interested in hearing from you, and may be able to help you fill in some of the black holes in your genealogy.

LAST BUT NOT LEAST—before I am buried by letters from purists advising me that the calendar changed after 1650 and January has not always been the first month of the year; let me assure you I am aware of that fact. DANIEL TURRELL SPECULATIONS

It is interesting to note that Daniel TURRELL and his second wife Lydia conformed to the then popular tradition of naming the first daughter after the deceased wife.

He and his first wife conformed to the tradition of naming the first son after the father.

If they continued the tradition, the second son, John TURRELL was named for the father of Daniel TURRELL; the third son Humphrey may have the maiden surname of Susanna BLOTT's mother; the fourth son Joseph TURRELL could have been named for Daniel TURRELL obviously was not named for either (of record) Anna TURRELL obviously was not named for either her mother Lydia or her grandmother Susanna (unless Anna was a shortened Susanna); she may have been named for Daniel TURRELL's mother. Their last son, Samuel TURRELL could have received his name from either his father or his mother's ancestry, but more likely from his father's greatgrand father.

In the second marriage, Daniel TURRELL, Jr. was still living so the first son was named Colbron TURRELL, the maiden name of his mother. The fact that they also named a son Humphrey is an indication that the Humphrey of the first wife had died prior to September 1667.

The preceding speculation is like 'honorable' in front of a judge's name—it don't mean a thing. It will take a lot of hard research to prove the ancestry of Daniel TURRELL.



Note to descendants of John & Marian TERREL: The fact that two of John's sons each named their first born son William indicates that his father was probably named William. The fact that his grandson, John C. TERRELL named a son Albert Wingfield TERRELL indicates a probable connection to the "INGFIELD line. Although we don't know exactly when John ERREL was born, estimates based upon children's known birth dates indicate that it would have been before 1780, and could well have been as early as the 1760's. Those clues make this family worthy of additional research. Since the source of the information is not listed, Hanover Co. VA records is the logical starting place. The remaining clue to the Ancestry of John TERREL is that John C. TERRELL (above) wrote that he had an uncle named Edmund TERRELL. None of the children in John TERREL's will was named Edmund. Therefore, this Edmund must have been a brother of John TERREL or simply a cousin called 'uncle' out of respect.]



I have 5 in school and I am here to tell you I have a time trying to keep them fixed to go. Oh, I have my hands and heart full.

Yes Margrett my poor old mother [Pamelia TERRELL Rutland, page 37] died Aug. 28 [1929] and was burried 29. All her children was here but Arrie and she was in Detroit. She wasn't confined to her bed at all.

I went to John's [page 37] at Tallassee [AL] the 24. Ma and Era staid here and went down to Mr. Bullard's to spend the day and night. Era was going to tend to the cow Saturday night and Sunday morning and we was coming back Sunday eve.

So they called up John's folks from verbena and said that ma was sick, had a light stroke of pralises. that was about Sundown. So beween 9 and 10 o'clock we were back up here. I come in ask her how she felt and ask her if she knew me and she and she said she did.

So Sunday morning we brought her home. She come in, lay down, and cat dinner and sit up moste all Sunday eve, we had company, slept good sunday night. Monday eve she went to sleep and slept all the eve-raised up about 6 tuesday.

she seemed to be doing all right and we washed tuesday eve. So wednesday she didn't seem to be eny worse. I cooked dinner, the children come in from the field, she told them she felt better so they played the phonograph and they played her piece (Ain't it a shame to work on Sunday) and she said ant that pretty? I said yes mam.

and they went on off to the field, she ask for some water and I ask her did she want a lemonaid and she said yes. I fixed it as quick as I could and gave it to her and I noticed she was thumping. So I told her to lay down so I laid her down and that was the last time she was up.

I sent for the Dr. About 4 o'clock I got seared about her and hollowed for the children. So between 5 and 6 she died. Oh she went so easy but you know she is better off. I have all rights to believe she is in heaven and I hope to meet her some sweet day by and by, we burried her at coopers by Willie [William R.? page 37]. That was her request.

Well Zola [Pearl HAND, page 35] I know you and Margrett has a good time by your selves and a hard time to, every one thinks his time is the hardist, well girl live right and do right and when people is talking about you they are letting some one else rest, some people wants to talk eny how.

Well gir! I enjoyed your letter very much but I have wrote so much this eve-1 am about tired down, this is the fifth letter for me his eve. So I will go and you and Margrett write again and tell me all about the Kinfolks out there. I have got to Iron some and it is after 3 o'clock so by by.

JACKSON TERRELL DESCENDANTS

INTERVIEW WITH MR. Arcie TERRELL, TITUS, AL 11/23/1987

By Dan Brinson

We were successful in locating Mr. Arcic TERRELL and his wife Katle just cast of Titus, AL in a beautiful large farmhouse with a long front porch. He is the first descendent (grandson) of Andrew 'Jackson' TERRELL (02/03/1852—10/01/1925) and Frances 'Fannie' SUTTLE [page 37, 310] that we were successful in locating.

We found him through Mrs. Velma PARSONS Terrell of Titus, widow of Arcie's brother Ermon Ernest TERRELL.

Mr. Terrell permitted us to use our tape recorder and the following is a transcript of his comments during 90 minutes of our visit and conversation about our TERRELL ancestors. For brevity, questions and comments by Dan Brinson have been omitted, except for very rare cases where it is needed for clarity.

Due to several others in the room carrying on conversations at the same time, the tape itself is cluttered, but the following genealogical jewels have been gleaned.

I'm the oldest TERRELL that I know of, I'm 83. I was 83 last June, I have emphysema, I reckon I smoked too many eigarettes for too many years.

My mother's people all went to Texas. They've been out there for years. We've been out there 12-15 times. We go out there about every year. We went out there twice last year. We had a funeral in the family. They were PRESSLEYS.

My grandfather was Jack TERRELL. I always heard him called Uncle Jack. I believe he died about September 1925. Both he and his wife died in the same year. She died in the Spring and he died in the fall.

I don't know when either of them was born. Fannie SUTTLE's father was Sink SUTTLES. He was probate judge of Coosa County at one time. I don't know who her mother was.

There were two boys and two girls in my father's family. There was Mary 'Famile', Willie (my father), George, & Maggie.

Mary 'Fannie' was one of the younger ones. She married Calvin JONES. Her children all live around Montgomery and over there on the other side of the [Coosa] river now.

Willie TERRELL married Lenora PRESSLEY, that's my daddy and mother. My daddy was born on June 1, 1876 and my wife's daddy was born in 1878. His birthday is June first, and mine is June 4th. I can remember that because when he got old enough to get off road tax, I got old enough to get on it.

He died July 12, 1942. He didn't die, he killed himself. When he was 17 years old, he traded for an old gun and he shot his eye out and knocked a hole in the side of his head. They say that was what caused him to lose his mind. You know they didn't have good doctors to fix things up back then.

His name was William Jabez TERRELL. He and mother married about 1897. They had been married 7 years when I was born in 1904. Mother was 2 yars younger than him, but I don't know when her birthday was.

I have a sister in Montgomery that has the family Bible. If you go to her house you could get a copy of the births and deaths from it. She lives in Montgomery, but I don't even know the name of the street she lives on.

Nace TERRELL had a boy that left Coosa County when I was a boy and went to Whigham GA. His name was Starling TER-RELL. Do you have any information on him. [Replied that James 'Starling' Terrell died near Foley, AL.]

Joe Terrell's daughter Evie [TERRELL Woodfin] died, Is Marvin [Elzie TERRELL, p.33] still living? [repy; NO]

My people on my mother's side married into Joe Terrell's family and that made some of them double kin. Evie married a Woodin. She was my first cousin. My aunt married one of Joe Terrell's sister, Luza Jacks. [Luza was Joe Terrell's wife, not sure whether he meant his aunt married one of her brothers, but that seem to be what he intended] Anule was the one that married the Burks, I don't remember just how that came about.

Maggie TERRELLnever died marry. She died single when she was 19 years old. I can't remember when she died. I was so small. We kept her picture for for a long time. It might be in her picture.

Uncle George TERRELL son of Andrew Jackson' TERRELL died in 1914. That's his folks that live in Atlanta. He's got one girl there and he's got one boy that lives at Carrville. If he had a name other than George I don't know what it was, I remember that Nace had a boy George [Phillip TERRELL], but I don't remember much about them. There was an [Stephen] Adie TERRELL too.

George TERRELL, my uncle married a PATTERSON, Emma, I believe. She's got people that live in Richville [community of Coosa Co AL]. She is Grace's mother. They came over here to see us. That's the funniest thing. I have to tell that. One day I came in the house here and there was a girl on the telephone talking to Katie. She wanted to know if we knew anything, she said her mother was a TERRELL. I went to the telphone and she asked about all the names that she said her mother had told her. She said that she had never seen any of them. We talked on. I told her I could remember her Uncle's names. They were

Floyd, Melston, & Grace. She was Grace's girl and she had grown children. They have been over here to see us three or four times and invited us to go to see them, but I've gotten to where I can't see to drive. It had been 65 or 70 years since I had seen them. They live in College Park GA. I have their telephone #. Her name is BROOKS.

Clara, she's married again. Both of these girl's husband's died. Her husband died with cancer. The girl at Jonesboro is Margaret BROOKS daughter. Grace HUDDLESTON is Margaret BROOKS' mother. When you call them, tell-um we're doing all right.

Joe [William Joseph TERRELL, p. 31-33] had arthritis and never did have much health. I don't know much about Joe. To tell you the truth, Joe and my daddy fell out back when they first married. They farmed together one year and something caused a falling out. They still spoke and all, but we didn't visit back and forth. All I knew was just what I heard. Evie that married the Woodfin did visit with us some, but not Joe or the others.

I'll have to tell you a joke that my boys told me. They both work at Alabama Power Company. They went to Birmingham to School. They met this TERRELL boy coming out of the school and said to them, 'You know, we might be kin folks.' My boy is always popping off something smart, so he said, 'Naw, I don't think so. They told me all my kin folks was in the penatentiary for stealing cars and horses.' The boy turned around and said, 'Yes, by God, we are kin.'

Mary Fannie TERRELL married Calvin JONES. Her oldest girl was Flossie JONES. She married Bill NIXON and then she married Vivian WARD. Then they had another girl named Frances Doskey JONES. They had a boy named J B. 1 don't know what J B stood for, J. B JONES is all we ever knew.

Fannic's oldest boy Charlie JONES married Ruby PENTON. Charlie & Ruby had two boys, Kenneth JONES and Donald JONES. Donald died in his 30's. I don't know any more about them. Charlie had Parkinson's disease.

Frances JONES married Paul CULVER. They had a boy and a girl, but I can't think of their names. They live on Deatsville route in Coosa River Community.

J. B. JONES married Reva BLAKE. They had two girls but I don't remember their names either. They live in Montgomery, AL. J B's health is bad. I don't know how many operations he has had.

Bessie Mae JONES married Lexie HELMS. He's dead. They had a son, Leon HELMS. Bessie lives in Montgomery.

Flossie JONES is in the Masonic home in Montgomery. She has about lost her mind. She is a diabetic too.

I enjoy talking about old times and the folks whenever someone comes along to ask me some questions about them or can talk about old times with me. Sometimes I go for months without thinking about the folks.

I can't think who Ruby PENTON'S dad was. I've known him all my life. Maybe I'll think about it before you leave.

The reason! don't know any more about them is that we were raised on the opposite side of this lake. It is not more than 5 or 6 miles across to where they live, but you have to go down to Wetumpka to cross the river, then come back up the other side. That's the reason we never did visit and go to church together much. Velma [PARSONS Terrell, sister-in-law] knows them better than I do. She was raised on that side of the river.

Charlie JONES lives between Millbrook and Robinson Springs. I suppose his address would be Millbrook. His mind is bad, but his wife probably could tell you as much about them as he ever could.

I don't know why I cant't think of Ruby PENTON'S dad's name. No, it wasn't Rich PENTON, he was Ruby's brother. Dewey PENTON was too.

They tell a joke about the LORD starting to name all the people. He got them about half named, and he ran out of names, so he said, 'Aw, Hell, just call them the JONES and DENNISES. Kate, my wife, was a DENNIS. Yes, I know Hattle TERRELL married Oliver DENNIS. He was Will DENNIS'S boy. She was a sister to Evie [TERRELL Woodfin].

J B JONES is in bad health. He had his bladder taken out.

Flossle JONES had a child by the NIXON, but it died young. They said that Bill's sister killed it. Do you remember hearing about that woman that poisoned all them kids here about way years ago in Dennison? That was a long time ago. It has been about 50 or more years. She was a nurse. She poisoned them for money. She had insurance on them. She did not have any by Vivian WARD.

Coosa River Community used to be a pretty good sized place. There used to be stores and things there, but it has all died. There were 2 stores and a school but now all that is left is the church.

Andrew 'Jackson' & Fannie SUTTLE TERRELL are buried at Coosa River Primitive Baptist Church in the old cemetery. He lived at Deatesville. That is in Elmore County [AL], but he died at my daddy's here at Titus, AL. Fannie died across the river at Lightwood. Both are buried in Coosa River Primitive Baptist Churchyard.

I've tried to get folks together to do something about Grandpa's grave, but I couldn't get them together. There are 3 graves with just a little coping around them.

Grace TERRELL Huddleston that lives over in Georgia said that she was going to do something about her dad's grave. Lexie HELMS is dead and his boy, Leon HELMS lives away somewhere. He is on some kind of a job where he don't stay anywhere very long. I don't know where. Bessie is still living.

I think Mom and Dad married in Coosa County. He was born there, and Momma came there from Tallapoosa County when she was 3 and lived there. Mom died about 1960, in late May or June. She lay a corpse here on my birthday.

Her father was Joe PRESSLEV and her mother was Liza CAN-NON. Liza was raised in Tallapoosa County on ? creek. She died about 1932 and she was 95 years old.

Since I sat here and got to talking, a lot of it has come back to me. When you came in, I didn't think that I knew anything to tell you.

My name is Arcle Levi TERRELL. I was named for Levi JOHNSON that married one of grandma's sisters [Rhoda SUT-TLE].

My wife was Katie Corine DENNIS. My sister, Lillie 'Mae' TERRELL married Ernest DENNIS, Katie's brother.

Velma PARSONS Terrell has photo of Arcic and his parents when Arcic was about 6 months old.

William Jabez 'Willie' TERRELL like to raise live stock until the cattle ticks caused him to lose out. After that, he grew cotton. He is buried at Titus Baptist Chruchyard.

I was born in Coosa County AL. All my brothers and sisters were born in Coosa. I married and all my children were born in Elmore County. My wife was born in Elmore. Katie is the daughter of William May DENNIS (1878--1946), and Mary Emma GLASCOCK (1878--1950).

I don't remember why we named our first son Wylie Douglas TERRELL except that Kate thought Wylie was a pretty name. [Dan Brinson had ancestor Wylie WOOD of Coosa Co. AL and thought there might be a family connection between them and WOOD)

I farmed for years messing around with stock and drove a dump truck for the county for 12 years. I worked right here around home. I hope pave 105 miles of road in 12 years. It was all right, I enjoyed it.

I was raised up in that part of the country, on Hatchett Creek. (on road between Weogufka & Kelley Cross Roads off Hwy 22) The roads were so crooked they wound around and around the hills. You had to watch for tracks to tell where to turn at the next time. The land was a lot more thickly settled then than it is now. The land was mostly timber with bottom land patches and some hillside farming. It has just faded out until there is hardly any one left. When I was a boy, people lived on the sides of all those hills. They made a good living. They grew what they lived on. My

daddy got in right good shape one time, but ticks hit that country and they killed all his cows.

No, I don't remember Dow WILSON, but I heard a lot of talk about him. I just remember Jim WILSON, Philip WILSON, Greer WILSON, Ab WILSON, and all of them [children ofDow Wilson]. Philip WILSON's wife was a RUTLAND. She was descended from 'Aunt Mealie' [Parmelia/Permelia TERRELL Rutland]. 'Aunt Mealie' was a sister to my grandpa Jackson TERRELL and! think was grandmother to Philip WILSON's wife.

When we moved here 62 years ago, God, they sold everything down there [in Titus, AL]. They sold horses and mules, were running a gin, a school, 2 stores and sometimes 3 stores, and a church. Now all that is left is one store, post office, and church.

THE TERRELLS EIGHTY-FIVE YEARS TEXAS FROM INDIANS TO ATOMIC BOMB

One of our more recent acquisictions to the TERRELL COL-LECTION, USA is a book by the above title which was donated by Mrs. Inez CHRISTIAN Doshler in memory of her father, James Terrill CHRISTIAN.

The book is 8 x 5 format, copyrighted by the author C. V. TERRELL of Austin, TX in 1948 and was authorized by the TEXAS HERITAGE FOUNDATION. Although it is mainly a book of Mr. Terrell's memories, it is also sprinkled with tidbits of genealogial information about his immediate ancestors.

There is a generous sprinkling of photographs.

Mr. Terrell begins his narrative of the Terrells as follows: 'In the sixteenth century, three Terrell brothers came from England to America and settled in Virginia. . . they received their fa ther's blessings and he gave one a pair of silver shoe buckles, to another a pair of knee buckles, and to the third a pair of silver suspender buckles with the solemn admonition that at each of their deaths, these heirlooms should be handed down through the oldest son.'

Mr. Terrell's father, Samuel Lafayette TERRELL inherited the silver suspender buckles which he passed down to Lafayette Philomen TERRELL who passed them down to John Hale TERRELL who d. at Wichita Falls TX in 1938 with no male heir. As of 1948, his widow still had the buckles.

[EDITOR'S NOTE: Lake Eric TERRELL of Florence, SC has the <u>silver knee buckles</u> of emigrant Richmond TERRELL (see photo on page 102) we wonder who has the <u>shoe buckles</u>.]

Mr. Terrell also alludes to his friend, Judge A. W. TERRELL who had a family tree and said that they were third cousins. And mentions the motto as "Sans puer, sans reproche," french, without fear, without reproach."

He mentions one Joe TERRELL, attorney, who 'wrote a very interesting book on Fort Worth and north Texas.'

Mr. Terrell lists his ancestors as:

Lafayette Phillomen TERRELL md. Margaret RATCLIFF; moved from VA to GA and reared a family there, possibly an ancestor of Robert TERRELL who was governor of GA and US Senator; to Mims Fort Alabama; then moved on to Mississippi where Mr. Terrell's father Samuel Lafayette TERRELL was born.

Other Children: Rebecca Penelope TERRELL who md. Geo. W. Marler; John TERRELL; James TERRELL; Margaret TERRELL; Aseneth TERRELL who md. Theron BROWNFIELD from IL; Elizbeth Ann TERRELL who md. Peter Levelve; Pauline TERRELL b. 1829 who d. young.





Burt Terrill Running for Seat in Texas Legislature


Joel Burton "Burt" Terrill, son of Joel Clarence (1916-1973) & Hargaret Terrill and grandson of Joel Abraham (1895-1953) & Eunice (1895-1972) Terrill, is running for the 66th District of the Texas Legislature. That district includes San Angelo, Burt's home.

Burt was born at San Angelo and grew up in Texas. Be graduated from Texas A&M University with a B.B.A. degree in Finance in 1963. He was commissioned in the Army that year and first stationed at Fort Hood, Texas. Be was Airborne and Ranger qualified and served as an officer in the Army for ten years, including two combat tours in Vietnam. Bis last assignment included two years as a Hajor on the Department of the Army Staff in Washington. He left the Army in 1973 to return to San Angelo and go into private enterprise.

Burt's wife, Dela Jean Gibbs Terrill graduated from Baylor University in 1963 with a B.A. Degree in Education. They were married at San Angelo that same year. She has been the Director of the First Baptist Church Montessori Child Development Center; and both she and Burt are active in the First Baptist Church and in many social and civic organizations. They have three children: Craig (age 22), Michael (age 17), and Tamara Lynn (age 12).

Since 1973 Burt has owned and operated several oil companies in the San Angelo area and was a City Councilman from 1980 to 1985. In 1985 he was elected Mayor of the City and served two years. Burt likes Texas politics and public service and intends to take part at the State level.





Terrill Family History Book Goes To Press

The long-awaited family history and genealogy book has at last been sent to the publisher for printing. The limited edition, titled The Terrill Family - The Descendants of John and Clarissa Terrill, will be printed in only 200 copies and offered at \$25.00 each plus \$2.50 shipping (each) until the supply is gone.

The book, which required thousands of hours of research, traces our family through its early English history to America and to the present time. Nearly all of the descendants of John and Clarissa Terrill, who lived from about 1830 to 1863/65, are traced to the current families. This book is more than 300 pages long and includes more than 1,500 names. It is hard-bound and printed on special acid-free paper which will not yellow or become brittle for several centuries. Copies are expected to be received from the publisher. Anundsen Publishing Co. (Iowa), in mid-September. Those persons who wish to purchase a copy should contact William Y. The book's authors -- Elizabeth (Terrill) Brooks (1904-1979), William V. Terrill, Jr., and Don C. Terrill -- gathered information from hundreds of sources for more than 20 years. For many years they were unable to discover the parents of John E. Terrill, a Confederate soldier who died as a P.O.W. in 1863. The breakthrough came in 1987 when they discovered information in obscure "Orphans Court" records from the 1830s and 1840s in Moulton, Lawrence County, Alabama during a one-week research trip. Further breakthroughs were made during subsequent week-long research trips to South Carolina and to Georgia.

Our Terrill family first settled in Virginia in 1656 and later migrated to Georgia, Alabama, Texas and New Mexico. Through these many generations we have acquired thousands and thousands of other cousins, a few of whom are covered in the new book. Further, Terrill descendants include the Caswell, Sublet, Crowell, Miller, Lucus, Young, Crews, Morrid, Brooks, Salmon, and Cox family branches and more.

This book would make a fine addition to the home library of any family member, and a copies donated to public libraries would remain available to Terrill descendants for hundreds of years. (The donation of a copy to a government-operated public library is tax deductible.) We urge family members to buy copies for themselves, their children, and their public library.
