# INDEXING CHANGES

This is the second year that we have had to put out one or more shorter issues to compensate for large updated accumulative indexes to TRAILS. The cost of printing the 62 page index to TRAILS this year will exceed \$600.00, not to mention the additional postage to mail it. We hope we will not be forced to put out any "minimum" 4 page issues, but only time will tell.

I will continue to prepare an index data base each

year. Beginning in 1991, each new data base will be merged with the existing index, still creating an accumulative index.

One copy of the index data base will be made each year, but will not be published in TRAILS.

Instead, the index and/or portions of it will be made available on request to anyone willing to pay the cost of copying and mailing the material to them.

An anouncement will be made in TRAILS when an index is available and the cost of the entire index. If portions are offered, TERRELL surname for example, the cost of that portion will also be stated. If the index is available on a per page basis, cost for first page and successive pages will be stated. One possibility is \$1.00 for the first page and \$0.25 for each additional page of the same order. These details will have to be worked out and will depend upon costs at that time.

At the end of the next 5 years, ie, Vol X, another large index will be prepared covering pages 489 and up.

This will make it possible for us to provide you with more information per publishing dollar.
