This error was made due to both loss of family ties and failure to communicate.

Paul is my cousin. However, he married, lived his latter years, and died in the Washington, DC area.

I was told that he had married a

woman who had a daughter. I also knew that Valerie TERRELL came to Grady County, GA to visit. No one told me that she was his daughter, not his step-daughter. She does have an older half-sister, but for some unknown reason, I had never heard her name mentioned, only Valerie.

After Paul's death, I never saw or heard from either Valerie or her mother until after that information was published. They remained away from the local TERRELL families for many years.

However, ties have been reestablished with this branch of the family and I am proud to be able to publish this correction.

Revolutionary War to WWI

MRS. ROBERT RAINES TERRELL SUPPORTED THE CONFEDERACY

From the SOUTHERN ENTERPRISE NEWS-PAPER, Thursday, August 15, 1861:
A large number of ladies from Tired Creek, Decatur county [GA] assembled this day, at the Methodist Episcopal Church for the purpose of form-

ing a "Soldier"s Aid Society". . . . Mrs. R. R. TERRELL was chosen Vice-President. (Source: ROOT HUNTERS, DECEMBER 1990 NO. 3. page 192: by Craigmiles & Associates; PO Box 546; Thomasville, GA.)

This was Mrs. Robert Raines TERRELL, the former Miss Henrietta DUTTON whom he had married on 03/09/1848. Their family is listed on page 281

of TERRELL TRAILS.

Robert Raines TERRELL (10/04/1823--03/11/1888), son of Dr. Thomas Waddy TERRELL below, gained the distinction of major in the commissary department CSA during the Civil War. He later became a well know lawyer in Decatur County, GA.

Children included Robert Raines TERRELL, Jr. who was present at the signing of the act creating Grady County Georgia on August 25, 1905.

DR. THOMAS WADDY TERRELL RECEIVED MAIL AT THOMASVILLE, GA POST OFFICE

From the SOUTHERN ENTERPRISE NEWS-PAPER, "List of Letters in the Post Office at Thomasville, GA October 1st. 1861" included Thos. W. TER-RELL. (Source: ROOT HUNTERS, DECEM-BER 1990 NO. 3. page 199) This was Dr. Thomas Waddy TERRELL, born 11/05/1794, who married 09/28/ 1820, Martha Everard Hamilton RAINES; he studied medicine, graduated from the Pennsylvania Medical College of the University of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia. He practiced in the south Georgia area for many years and was considered to be an excellent doctor. About October 1861, the DUNCANVILLE LADIES SOLDIERS RELIEF SOCIETY reported that he had contributed \$10.00 toward supplying needed items to the Confederate Soldiers they were serving. (ibid, page 201) The DUNCANVILLE district was in southwestern Thomas County and included the present day community of BEACHTON in now Grady County GA. In addition to Robert Raines TER-RELL, Sr. above, their children included Cornelia Antoinette TERRELL (08/21/1826--04/15/1876) married in 1845 to Dr. Abner Mitchell Ruther-

ford SESSIONS. He was a graduate of

the Medical School of the University of Georgia and served in the Civil-War as a doctor.

The SESSIONS were ancestors of our Member #134, Mr. John J. STUART.




