The Club was organized May 15, 1884 for the purpose of "collecting, preserving, and publishing historical material, especially pertaining to Kentucky and adjacent states...to encourage historic inquiry and study...and to maintain a library and museum to further these goals." Incorporated in 1891.

Programs and Departments of the Filson Club

LIBRARY: The Library of the Filson Club, which contains fifty thousand research books, is noted for its genealogical holdings, files on individual families, abstracts of wills, deeds, and marriage and court records from many Kentucky counties. The library is open to the public. (There is a \$3 daily usage fee for nonmembers.)

MANUSCRIPT DEPARTMENT: The Club's rich collection of manuscript material is the best in Kentucky for the poineer, antebellum, and Civil War periods. The collection of over one million items provides an essential primary source of researh material.

LECTURE SERIES: Since the Club's beginning, an annual lecture series of six or more presentations has been open to the public. Qualified experts speak on aspects of Kentucky history, art, heritage, and many other topics.

PUBLICATIONS: Over forty volumes of Kentucky history and biography have been published by the Filson Club. Many of these books are the standard reference on their subjects and have drawn national recognition to the Club's scholarship. Since 1926 the Club has published **The Filson Club History Quarterly**, an outstanding state journal that features articles on aspects of Kentucky's culture and history.

DEPARTMENT OF PHOTOGRAPHS AND PRINTS:

This department is responsible for maintaining and preserving thousands of early photographs and illustrations that help illuminate Kentucky's past.

MUSEUM: The Filson Club's Museum of Kentucky art and artifacts helps preserve the state's material culture through its highly-regarded collections of decorative arts, nineteenth-century paintings, firearms, coin silver objects, ceramics, textiles, ephemera, and other artifacts.

Lee explained that a photo was the only way to prove that it was still there. Since there were only three of them in the hall at the time, the man reluctantly allowed them to photograph the arms.


The arms does not appear to be a battle shield as it is too small, but rather to be a painted plaque style of the arms of Poix. The arms are thought to have been designed by Sir Walter TIREL, III and worn on his battle shield in the First Crusade in 1096. Sir Walter TIREL III, (3rd. Lord of Poix), died December 16, 1135 at Poix and is buried in the family sepulcher at Selincourt. He established the Monestary at Selincourt in 1131.

His son, Sir **Hugh TIREL I**, was his heir and as the fourth Lord of Poix wore the arms on his battle shield in the 2nd crusade in 1146. Sir Hugh TIREL I died in 1159 and is buried in Selincourt.

His son, Walter TIREL IV, was heir and became the fifth Lord of Poix. He died in 1171 without any children and all lands and titles went to his brother, Sir Hugh TIREL II, (the Grecian Knight), if Ireland. He wore the arms on his battle shield in the 3rd Crusades in 1191. He died in battle in 1199 at the age of 69 fighting beside King Richard I of England and is buried at Selincourt. His eldest son, Walter TIREL V, became the 7th Lord of Poix. I have not completed that line, but I am told that if the title were to still exist, it would belong to Jean TIREL who

I have heard too many variations to repeat how Sir Walter TIREL III came to design the arms of Poix. Probably none of them are correct.

Sir Hugh TYRRELL II had English arms and Irish arms well before he became heir to the arms of Poix. Upon his death, his Irish arms went to his son, Richard (Ruadh), and his English arms went to his son, Roger, of Hants.



Chroniclers of thetimes stated that the arms of HughTYR-RELL were seen the early foggy morning that King John was taken out of his warm bed to the meadow of Runnymeade by 30 Nobles of the realm. Since Hugh TYR-RELL was killed several days before John became King, it could not have been Sir Hugh TYRRELL that was seen. Since Hugh TYRRELL's English arms was inherited by his son, Roger, it would indicate that Sir Roger TYRRELL was one of those Nobles that took part in that historical event.

EDITOR'S NOTE: A black & white copy of a color photo never does the item justice. In plain Americanized English, the shield is red; the crosses are gold; and the diagonal stripe appears to be blue. The dark streak originating on the left and extending half way across the shield appears to be a crack in the wood.
