We thank the 33 of you who took time to mark and return your ballots. There has been ample time for everyone to return their ballot. We assume that the rest of you do not intend to voice your opinions. Dan Brinson, the only officer not on the ballot, counted the votes on 06/02/96. ## SURVEY TABULATION

Vice-President, **Jeddie Terrell**, has reviewed and tabulated the 45 survey questionnaires that were returned out of 400 plus that were mailed.

No usable trend developed for the following questions:

- 1. What do you want the Society to do for you?
- 2. What do you want to do for the Society?
- 6. What would you like to see published more in TRAILS?
- 7. What would you like to see published less in TRAILS?

  The opinions, although good, were too varied to assist us in charting a course of action.

#### Ouestion:

3A. State chapters? 37.8% yes & 28.9% no with 33.3% not responding;

3B. Large city chapters? 15.6% yes & 35.6% no with 48.8% not responding.

Question 4, Would you contribute family genealogical information toward compiling a Terrell Family Encyclopedia? was the only question to receive a 100% yes response.

Question 5: Trails quarterly 80%; Trails semi-annually 6.6%. It appears that our decision to return to quarterly mailings will meet with the approval of the majority.

Question 8: Would you serve on a project committee? was almost equally divided with 35.6% yes and 40% no with only 24.4% not responding.

Question 9: Do you have a computer? 60% yes, 37.8% no. with only 2.2% not responding.

Now the bad news--with only 45 questionnaires returned, our margin for error on any question is about 888%. In other words, for every questionnaire that we received, there were about 8 who did not respond at all.

There is no indication of any specific cause for a drop in membership. There seems to be full support for the idea of a Terrell Encyclopedia and for encouraging the membership to furnish family information covering the 80 year census blackout period. These projects might bring about an increase in membership if they can be advertised economically & effectively then recorded into a progressive format and distributed economically.

## DATA CD-ROM POSSIBLE?

Vice-President, Jeddie Terrell, has located a firm in his area who says we can produce a master CD-ROM for about \$200.00 depending upon the data source to go on it and copies can be made for \$10.00 to \$12.00 each, depending upon the number of copies made at one time.

We know that 27 of the 45 who returned their surveys have computers. I have no idea how many have CD-ROM readers since we failed to include that question. Also, we do not know how many of you who did not respond have computers. We do know that almost every library in the USA has both computers and CD-ROM readers. Even if you do not have the equipment personally, you can purchase a CD and donate it (tax deductible in most cases) to your local library where it could be used by you and others in your community.

The bottom line question is: WOULD YOU BE WILLING TO PAY \$20.00 FOR A POSTPAID CD-ROM CONTAINING ALL THE ISSUES OF TERRELL TRAILS PUBLISHED THROUGH 1996, PLUS ANY OTHER INFORMATION THAT WE HAVE READY FOR DISTRIBUTION AT THE TIME WHICH CAN BE FITTED ONTO THE DISC?

We'll give you a chance to vote with your pocketbook. If you want a CD-ROM for either yourself or to donate to a library, send a check for \$20.00 for each CD you want to Dan Brinson. Please make the check payable to TERRELL SOCIETY OF AMERICA, INC. and mark it "for CD-ROM."

We will hold these funds in escrow until we have enough to begin production. In the event that we do not have enough ordered by the end of 1996 to cover production costs, we will either return your money or apply it toward other projects as you desire.

We will use any funds above actual cost of production and shipping to stock pile a few CDs for future orders, and/or toward other goals of the Society. We will not profit from the sale of CD- ROMs.

Our main objectives are to make TERRELL information more accessible to all and to make the Society a household word if possible. We don't want any genealogical researcher in the USA to be able to say that he or she has never heard of the TERRELL SOCIETY OF AMERICA, INC.



#### THE TERRELL FAMILY NEWS, SUMMER 1995

I have commented on this computer generated TERRELL version of generic YOUR SURNAME publications previously, lamenting the lack of genealogical information that is TERRELL specific and commenting on the large amount of self-serving advertising.

You may recall my statement that it would take over 100 years for them to make good on their promise to publish their entire TERRELL database. This database is allegedly derived from: U S residence records; Canadian residence records; U S Census records (Colonial to 1870); Birth records [must be from newspapers and/or private sources, vital birth records are sealed]; veterans records; & marriage records.

This issue is the first in which the publishers have attempted to fulfill that promise. They published 4 pages from their database which contained a total of 120 of the millions of records they claim to have.

Twenty-four of the first 30 did not have given names; 18 were from early Franklin Co. GA tax lists and one was from Clairborne Co. TN 1850 census.

Two of the first 30 were obviously partnerships. TERRELL & MC CALL Franklin Co. GA Tax list 1819; and TERRELL & PAINE, same county 1808.

Three more were TERRELL ladies without given names from GA Genealogical Magazine #2 who md. Edward CURRIE, Jr, James WILLIAMS, & William WILLCOX respectively, but no dates were given. [These were daughters, born in 1770s, of Philemon & Elizabeth TERRELL of Liberty Co. GA, TRAILS p. 45] One TERRELL man, possibly with a three letter first

name, md. Elizabeth W. THOMASSON 04/28/1850 in Franklin Co. GA. Another TERRELL man with no first name listed lived in Palm Harbor, FL in 1994.

The following useful information was included:

A. B. TERRELL md. 12/26/1893 R. A. LETEFF in Livingston Parish, LA.

A. C. TERRELL md. 10/15/1873 Laura BOND in Williamson County TN.

A. C. TERRELL md. 12/13/1883 Miss S. F. BROWN in Lauderdale MS.

A. J. TERRELL m. 08/05/1845 Sarah A. HAGGERTY in Montgomery Co. AL.

A. J. TERRELL m. 04/07/1864 Julia Ann CLOWER in Hinds Co. MS.

A. V. TERRELL m. 11/17/1860 Mrs. Caroline E. WOODS in Copiah Co. MS.

The remainder of the 120 entries were taken from 1994 phone books. This might be valuable to researchers in 50-75 years, but has little value today--unless you are compiling a list of contemporary TERRELLS for promotional purposes.

Other general information included in this issue suggests looking in Canadian ship lists for ancestors coming to the USA, especially for ancestors arriving between 1865 & 1919. A list of organizations that help adoptees find biological parents is included. Two pages were devoted to one girl's memories of the roaring 20s.

I still failed to find anything impressive in this issue and truthfully, I am not looking forward to any future issues of this publication. DFB

None of these match your query, but they indicate TER-RELL/BUCK relationships that may be in generations prior to and/or collateral with yours. I hope these will provide leads to assist in your search. DFB

I am writing a Masters thesis and am searching for information on Reverend Williamson TERRELL, (? - 1873) Vevay, IN, moved to church in New Albany, IN 1850 - then back to Madison about two years later and then back to Vevay.

My thesis concerns his second wife, Mary Jane CRAIG Eggleston, widow of Joseph Cary EGGLESTON and lived in Vevay with her four children: Edward EGGLESTON, George EGGLESTON, Jane Lowry EGGLESTON, & Joseph William EGGLESTON. She m. TERRELL in 1850.

The main point I am trying to establish concerns the number of children TERRELL brought into this marriage from his first wife. From information I have, I think he had seven children of his own before he m. Mary Jane. One other point may help. Mary Jane d. in 1850 and TERRELL is thought to have married a third time.

### TERRELL ESTATE RECORD

W. H. TERRELL; Probate Case File #822

Submitted by #443 Mrs. Mannie Louise T. Whitten from Noxubee County MS Quarterly Bulletin, #77 Spring 1996, Abstracts of Estates

1860, January Term of Court - Petition of James F. TERRELL for letters of administration on estate of his father, W. H. TERRELL, dec., who departed this life on or about January 2, 1860.

The widow of the deceased renounced right to administer estate and other children were minor. They were E. H. TER-RELL, about 17; W. H. TERRELL, 14; Margaret TERRELL about 10; Richard TERRELL, 7; and Elizabeth H. TERRELL about 4. The latter's name appears in the next petition and thereafter as Harriett. The widow of W. H. TERRELL was the

former Margaret SWEARINGEN according to a TERRELL researcher.

November 1860 - J. F. TERRELL petitioned for guardianship of the minor heirs and stated that Edmond H. TERRELL & William H. TERRELL, over age 14 requested court to make him their guardian. Their written request from Lebanon TN where they were evidently in school, found attached to petition.

17 December, 1862 - Appraiser's Bill to D. A. J. DANTZLER, Joe B. COLE, Richard COLE, Joshua C. FANT, & Wm. B. WELLBORN to appraise personal estate of W. H. TERRELL: returned 26 December 1862 lists: 42 slaves; 43 head sheep; 130 hogs (stock); 50 pork hogs; 3500 pounds salted pork; 2 yoke oxen; 14 head cattle; wagons; gin; mill; 50 bales cotton; 3100 bushels corn, etc; one brouche; total \$51,859.00.

Petition for dower land made by widow, no date appears, states J. F. TERRELL, administrator, died sometime in 1862 and court appointed W. C. ROSS administrator; that W. H. TERRELL owned estimated 920 acres of land all in T15 R18 and that one of the younger sons, Edmond, had died since his father's death.

16 February 1865- Report of commissioners W. B. WELLBORN, J. STEVENS, Joe B. COLE who set apart for dower to Margaret TERRELL 280 acres in S21 T15 R18. Report of commissioners on 28 January 1856 to divide slaves and other personal property of W. H. TERRELL by lot. Amount of each share in first division \$17,701.13; The final division each over \$21,000.

Among the numerous papers in this file is a note in the sum of \$1752.50 executed 27 December 1859 by W. H. TERRELL for J. F. TERRELL and due the estate of Z. P. HERNDON, Union District, South Carolina, for property bought at sale.

A controversy arose over two slaves taken by J. F. TERRELL, administrator, without authorization when he went into active service with the Confederate army. The first slave, Lewis, valued at \$1700 died; the second, Edward, valued at \$1600 ran away to the Union forces upon the death of J. F. TERRELL in the Battle of Perryville. (Source of Confederate service - TERRELL Researcher)

The following letter written by Dr. N. F. SCALES was addressed to the court:

Crawfordsville, Jan. 14th, 1865

On the 18th of July 1862, I was called to see a Negro man at Mr. John M. LEDBETTER's that I understood had been in the army with Mr. TERRELL ... I considered his symptoms those common in typhoid fever and he might have contracted from exposure in the army, at home, or anywhere else with like exposure. I do not know whether he was sick when he went into the army or not, nor do I know whether Mr. TERRELL had similar cases on his farm that season, if so, it may be possible the boy would have had the disease had he remained at home. So far as I know the boy was well attended to at Mr. LEDBETTER's but I do not know how long he had been sick

before I saw him.

## PIKE COUNTY GA MYSTERY

Mrs. Betty S. Lewis has provided us with a copy of a marriage license from Pike County Georgia that had not been brought to our attention. The Book and page number are not on the copy, but the date is clear.

To any Judge, Justice of the Inferior Court, Justice of the Peace, or Minister of the Gospel, you are hereby authorized to join Washington KELTNER and Mary A. TERRELL in the holy state of matrimony according to the constitution and laws of this state and for so doing, this shall be your sufficient license given under my hand and seal this the 17th day of October, 1852. E. P. WATKINS [Ordinary?]

I do certify that Washington KELTNER and Mary A. TER-RELL were duly joined in matrimony by me this 17th day of Oct 1852. Benj. MORRIS, J.P.

The big question is: Is this Mary A. TERRELL the widow of John TERREL who d. 1829 in Henry County GA?

If you have a chance to view original records in Pike Co. GA and find any wills or other records that will shed any light upon the identity of the Mary A. TERRELL Keltner, please share the findings with Dan Brinson.

## JAMES TERRELL, INDIAN AGENT

Abstracted from excerpts of THE EASTERN BAND OF CHEROKEES, 1819-1900 by John R. FINGER which were submitted by P. J. ACHRAMOWICZ.

In October 1851 the secretary of treasury appointed James W. TERRELL to make the annual interest payments [owed to the Indians who had not removed to the west on the funds due them when they did remove] after a conflict of interest arose in the actions of William THOMAS. TERRELL was offered five percent commission for trekking through the NC mountains to find scattered Indians and make the small interest payments to those he could find. TERRELL continued in the capacity from that time until the Civil War. (page 54)

It cost the government more to disburse the interest in this manner than it would to pay the entire \$53.33 due each Indian for removal and subsistence. In January 1855, Congress passed a law providing for payment of \$53.33 to those on the Mullay Roll or to their legal heirs. There were two conditions that had to be met. First, each Indian had to give his assent to such a lump sum payment. Second, the State of NC had to "by appropriate act agree that the Cherokees may remain permanently in that state ..." Recognition of citizenship was not required. NC passed some favorable resolutions and legislation, but refused to guarantee that they would not be removed at some future date. (page 55)

In 1856, support for the lump sum payment increased in Washington to the point that William THOMAS recommended James TERRELL as agent to enroll those who wished to accept the \$53.33 and move west. (page 58)

When the Civil War broke out, Cherokees were recruited to fight with the South. James TERRELL was the unit's first lieutenant. He assumed command in the absence of THOMAS & MORGAN when they went to Knoxville TN to make preparation for the arrival of the Indians. (page 85)

The Cherokees were described as having "average behavior better than that of the whites," by some. In contrast, James TERRELL claimed that not even THOMAS could prevent them from scalping whenever they had the chance, and that by the end of the war they had a number of these grisly souvenirs. This seems an exaggeration, since the Indians did not engage in many battles, and if they had scalped at will the memoirs of Union veterans would have been more vitriolic in their denunciations. (page 93)

In 1869, the Indians brought legal action against THOMAS over lands allegedly bought for them that were being sold at sheriffs sales to satisfy indebtedness of THOMAS. James TERRELL, as a former agent who handled their money was named as codefendant. JOHNSTON who then owned the lands was also named as codefendant. (page 111)

One suit filed in May 1873 in the U. S. Circuit Court for the Western District of NC brought action against THOMAS, TER-RELL, & JOHNSTON in an effort to force an accounting of the money THOMAS received from the Cherokees' representative from 1836 to 1861--money he used to buy land for the tribe. That land remained in his name, of course, and was sold because of his indebtedness. JOHNSTON was codefendant because he had taken sheriffs' titles to the land well realizing the Indians' equitable interest. TERRELL had served as Cherokee disbursing agent from 1853 to 1861 and allegedly had transferred money to THOMAS. (page 119)

THOMAS was among those testifying, leaving no doubt in the minds of anyone that the Indians were entitled to the lands. He was so pro- Indian, in fact, that TERRELL despaired because he was not protecting himself adequately. Be fair but concede nothing was TERRELL's philosophy. On October 23, 1874, the arbitrators finally found that THOMAS had acquired thousands of acres over the years for the Indians in part with their money and in part with his. Almost all of the Qualla Boundary, amounting to some 73,000 acres had been purchased for them as a tribe or community. The arbitrators concluded that the Cherokees still owed THOMAS \$18,250 for the Boundary. The Cherokees paid JOHNSTON \$6,500 as a pledge of good faith when they agreed to buy lands from him with interest since September 1869, that amounted to \$8,486. JOHNSTON was to credit this amount on his judgment against THOMAS as money paid by the Indians toward what they still owed THOMAS, reducing the balance to \$9,764. As for TERRELL, the arbitrators decided that he was liable to the Cherokees for \$2,697.89 that he had diverted (without criminal intent) to

THOMAS as attorney for the Indians. THOMAS had claimed the Cherokees owed it to him. This sum was therefore deducted from the \$9,764, leaving the Indians still owing THOMAS \$7,066.11. They were to pay this amount, with 6 percent interest from the date of the award, to JOHNSTON as a credit on his judgments against THOMAS. When this was done, JOHNSTON was to convey to the Cherokees--or their trustees--legal title to the Qualla Boundary. Those Indians who still owed THOMAS for their individual tracts would also receive title when they completed payment. In a separate decision the arbitrators held that THOMAS still owed JOHNSTON \$18,335, so they appointed TERRELL and Thomas JOHNSTON commissioners to sell any of THOMAS'S property not encumbered by the Indians' equitable interest. Proceeds from these sales would be used to pay off th elder JOHNSTON. The arbitrators concluded that the Cherokees did not possess an equitable interest in Cheoah Boundary and TERRELL and JOHNSTON could sell these properties to help satisfy the judgment. They could evict the Indians, though TERRELL doubted that anything short of military force could accomplish that task. The individual Indians holding title made this unattractive to whites, so they compromised and sold to the Indian Band. (pages 120,

The Cherokee Council also appointed James TAYLOR and TERRELL to assist in procuring the money necessary for purchasing the Qualla and Cheoah boundaries. The only way to accomplish this was to have the government use both principal and interest from the 1848 fund. On March 3, 1875, Congress enacted legislation allowing the Indian commissioner to use the 1848 money as a common fund for acquiring lands and promoting agriculture and civilization of the area for the Indians. (page 122)

ROSS, a "quasi" chief of the Cherokees was a kindhearted man of sound judgment when sober. When drunk, he was a dangerous man. He had twice attempted the life of Captain TERRELL. (page 132)

When MOONEY did his historical sketch of the Indians, James TERRELL was an important informant. (page 153)



## AMERICAN CONNECTION--NEW EVIDENCE

In chapter nine of his book <u>The Tyrrells of England</u>, the late O. F. BROWN records the various theories and evidence available to him regarding the origin of the early TYRRELL settlers in America. Particularly, Richmond and his brother William, and Timothy, all of whom were in Virginia in the third quarter of the seventeenth century. There have also been a number of articles in the Newsletter over the years, e.g. December 1981, page 68, March 1982, page 20, and June 1982, page 36.

The legatees of Robert TYRROLD of Hagbourne in the county of Berkshire, whose will was proved on the 13th August 1545, included his four sons, William, David, Richard, & Avery. The executor of the will of David TURROLDE, husbandman of West Hagbourne, which was proved on the 15th January 1577/8 was his only son William. In the will of his son, Willyam TYR-ROLD, yeoman of West Hagbourne, which was proved on 9th October 1587 by his wife Elizabeth, he left land and goods jointly to her and his son Davy. His other two sons, Francys & Robart, inherited 40 pounds plus land, etc. when they reached age of 21 years provided they leave and yield the land to brother, Davy, when he reached 21.

One of the overseers of the will of David TORRELL of Reading, clothier, the probate date of which was 30th October 1632, was his brother, Robert TORRELL of Reading, clothier. The will of Francis TYRROLL of Reading, broadweaver, named his brother, Robert TYRRELL as an overseer and had the probate date of the 2nd of October 1838. The legatees of the will of Robert TIRROLL of Reading, clothier, dated 1643 were his wife, Jane, his sons, Robert, Richmond, William, Timothy, & John, and his daughters, Marie & Margaret. He had married Jane BALDWIN in Reading, St. Giles on the 29th June 1617. There appears little doubt that these three brothers, David, Francis, & Robert were the sons of William of West Hagbourne.

Avery, son of Robert TYRROLD of Hagbourne (1545 will), was joint executor with his mother, Agnes, and was therefore presumably the eldest son. The executor of Avery's will, which was proved on the 27th May 1584, was his son, Robert, whose will dated 7th May 1592 leaves his estate to his wife Elienor, his sons, William, Avery, & Robert and daughters Elizabeth & Mary, but does not mention a son Timothy. However the date of Robert's death is unknown. There is no doubt that Timothie TIRRELL, citizen and leatherseller of London, whose will was proved on the 11th August 1656 was a son of Robert as his legatees included his brothers, Robert, William, & Avery, his sister Mary Waller who under this name benefited from the will of her brother William, and the poor of Hagbourne.

Timothie, the leatherseller, left 1,500 pounds "to the child that my wife now goes with if a son" or 1,000 pounds if a daughter. He also left 20/- to the poor of All Hallows, Bread Street, "where I now live."

The parish registers of All Hallows record the baptisms of three sons to Timothy & Dorothy TYRRELL: Avery 28 August 1647; William 25 August 1650 (buried 9 October 1651) and Timothy 5 December 1656. Timothie, the father's will does not mention Avery, so presumably, he died before 1656, although his death is not recorded in the registers. It is highly probable that the Timothy who married Elizabeth FOSTER in Virginia and had sons Robert in 1697 and Joseph in 1699 was the posthumous son of Timothie of All Hallows.

From the above, it can be seen that the three early settlers in Virginia were, most probably, descendants of Robert & Agnes of West Hagbourne in Berkshire, now part of Oxfordshire, and not as has been suggested, of the TYRRELLS of Thornton.

I wish to acknowledge the invaluable help I have received from Joanna (71) and Frances (539) in providing copies of wills, family documents, etc., and for their co-operation in answering queries and patiently following my, sometimes lengthy, arguments regarding details of family relationships while compiling a tree of the Tyrrells of Berkshire from which this article is derived.

## TYRRELL MOTOR CAR WORKS

Mr. John M. TERRELL of MN inquired about Ken TYRRELL and the Irish TYRRELLS. The following is a reply from President, Don C. TERRILL, who lives in England.

TYRRELL Motor Cars (TYRRELL Racing Car Works) builds Formula 1 racing cars. They are located at Long Reach, Ockham, near Ripley, Surrey, U.K. I do not know the genealogy of Ken TYRRELL, their championship driver; however, he is descended from Sir Walter TYRRELL III like all of the other TYRRELLS (etc.) of the English-speaking countries. The

company is an institutional member of the Tyrrell Family History Society in England.

Most Irish TYRRELLS are descended from Hugh TYREL, English, who, according to accounts, settled in Ireland before 1174 AD and obtained from Hugh deLACY the castles of Trim and Kells. Although records are few, it appears that his descendants became the TYRELS of Castleknock about 1214. It is a near certainty that he is descended from Sir Walter TYRRELL III, the kingslayer d. 1135, but there are no surviving records to give us the exact lineage.

## TYRELL OF CALAIS EXECUTED

Mr. Frank E. Scott inquired about a reference to the death of TYRELL at Calais in a book about King Henry which contained no details beyond mention of the surname. The following is a reply from Don C. TERRILL.

The text refers to Sir James TYRELL of Gipping, Suffolk (14??-1502). Sir James was discovered by King Henry VII (of York) to be a sympathizer and agent for the Plantagenet cause against the Yorkist king. He revealed his activities when he unwisely supported Edmund of Suffolk to overthrow King Henry. It was subsequently discovered that he had likewise supported Perkin Warbecque, son of King Edward IV, in his attempt to overthrow King Henry.

Sir James TYRELL was not an easy man to capture. He was commander of the English garrison at Calais. In spring 1502, King Henry sent Bishop Fox, the Lord Privy Seal, to Calais and called on Sir James to come out from the fortress on board his ship under Royal Safeconduct. Once on board, TYRELL was told he would be thrown overboard, presumably in full armor, unless he gave the agreed password for his son to surrender Guisnes (the fort). He did so, presumably to save his son's life, but of course, Henry's word was worth nothing and he was taken back to England and executed at Tower Green in London on May 6, 1502. This beach of Royal Safeconduct was cited for decades as an example of King Henry's dishonorable methods.

By the way, Sir James is the same Sir James TYRRELL who is mentioned in Act IV, Scene III of Shakespeare's Richard III.

We conclude this issue with TERRELL listings of the International Genealogical Index (IGI) from the Family History Library of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints (Mormon) for Connecticut.
