# ROOTS-L GENEALOGY

On page 904, I advised you of the existence of an e-mail database that was in danger of being relocated. I had been too busy fighting other brush fires for the past year to attempt to determine the new address. Portions of their Frequently Asked Questions file is quoted here.

### I. WHAT IS THE RSL AND HOW IS IT USED?

The Roots Surname List (RSL) is a list of surnames (about 100,000 in May 1996, submitted by over 6,500 net.genealogists) with associated dates and locations. Its purpose is to enable genealogical researchers to locate others interested in sharing and comparing data about the same families. Genealogists, preferably with Internet access, are welcome to submit the

surnames that they are researching for inclusion in the RSL if they are willing to share (within reason, of course!) their data with others who may be doing parallel research.

Enough identifying information about dates and locations should be provided so that others can decide whether a link with their own lines is possible or probable. Directions on how to submit data are included in Section IV.

If you see a surname listed that interests you, especially if there is a good match on dates and locations, contact the person who submitted the surname. Unless the submitter happened to be me, I won't be of much help. To find out how to contact the submitter, just look up their name tag (listed at the end of each surname entry) in the list of submitters. There are two ways to do this. The family index, described in Section II, has instructions on how to obtain the entire list of submitters. Alternatively, one may order individual addresses from the mail server at emcee.com, as described in Section III. Or if you're accessing the RSL via one of the interactive search pages on the Web, just click on the name tag. See the discussion in Section IV for the meanings of the various data fields.

The = update = to the RSL, consisting of the new and updated surnames, is posted to rsl-update (an Internet genealogy mailing list -- to subscribe, just send the message "subscribe" (without the quote marks) to

rsl-update-request@rootsweb.com) and to

soc.genealogy.surnames (the USENET genealogy newsgroup devoted to surnames) and alt.genealogy (a general purpose genealogy newsgroup) beginning on the first Sunday of the month. The database used by the interactive search that resides on RootsWeb (http://www.rootsweb.com/rootsweb/searches/) and on the RAND Genealogy Club's WWW page at http://www.rand.org/personal/Genea/ is updated a few days later. Included in the posted update is contact information for the submitters of the new and updated info.

At the same time that the update is posted, the entire RSL (over 3 megabytes of information) is stored on the ROOTS-L listserver and on the emcee.com and PSU FTP servers.

#### II. HOW TO OBTAIN THE ENTIRE RSL

### A. Via e-mail

To obtain a copy of the full RSL, the first step is to send e-mail to LISTSERV@MAIL.EWORLD.COM with any subject line and the message GET family.index

You will receive by e-mail family.index, which lists the names of the various files comprising the current RSL and briefly indicates their contents. The files named in family.index, and their contents, change each month, so be sure to use a current one! Each of the files named in family.index may in turn be requested via e-mail from the LISTSERV using the GET command.

#### B. Via FTP

The full RSL is available via FTP from various sites. Just FTP

to genealogy.emcee.com, login as anonymous, giving your email address for your password, then "cd/pub/genealogy/RSL" and "get index" to retrieve the family.index.

This file lists the names of the various files comprising the current RSL. The files named in family.index change each month, so be sure to use a current one! Each of these files are in the same directory as family.index and may be obtained in the same manner.

An alternate FTP site is at ftp.cac.psu.edu. As with emcee.com, log in anonymously. Then "cd /pub/genealogy/roots-l/family", "get family.index" etc. Many thanks to Stephen A. Wood and Michael Cooley for making these resources available!

C. Via gopher

The full RSL may be found via the gopher at ftp.cac.psu.edu. Select "genealogy", then "roots-l", then "family", then "family.index". The files named in family.index will be available at this same gopher menu.

## III. HOW TO OBTAIN THE PART OF THE RSL YOU WANT

What, you only want to look up Humperdinck and don't want to FTP megs and megs of data to do so? Well, for the faint of heart, or the scarce of disk space, there are some alternatives.

#### A. Via the World Wide Web

If you have access to the World Wide Web via Mosaic, Net-Scape, lynx, or most other web browsers, visit either of these URLs:

and you can query the RSL for individual surnames, click on the submitter's nametag to be shown the submitter's contact information, etc. There are still a few rough edges. For instance, at least for now, if you're looking for a name with an embedded space, only ask for the part before the first space, or the name won't be found even if it is in the database. The RootsWeb site supports some additional bells and whistles, such as a Soundex search and an easy way to look at all the data from a given submitter.

#### B. Via e-mail

There are now two mailservers that provide RSL lookups via e-mail. They employ different syntax, so be sure, whichever you choose, that you use the commands specific to it. One mailserver was created by Michael Cooley of emcee.com.

To use it, send e-mail to server@emcee.com. Commands go in the = subject = line, one per message. To check for the surname Keithley in the RSL, use the subject line:

#### find rsl Keithley

To get the contact information for submitter karen, use the subject line:

find rsl-addr karen

The second mailserver was created by Jeff Trembath. His program will search for multiple names and return the contact info all in a singlepass. Jeff writes, "Send mail to rsl@gen.roc.wayne.edu or if that doesn't work to rsl%gen.roc.wayne.edu@vm1.nodak.edu, with each surname on a = separate = line in the message. For more detailed information, send mail to rsl-info@gen.roc.wayne.edu..." Or check out his RSL Search Homepage at http://gen.roc.wayne.edu/fsl.html.

# IV. HOW TO SUBMIT DATA FOR INCLUSION IN THE RSL

Please read this section = carefully = before submitting data. I receive over a thousand messages per month having to do with the RSL, and I and the other folk who prepare the data for inclusion in the RSL sometimes get cranky about the time wasted by obviously improperly formatted or otherwise inappropriate submissions. (You'll do fine as long as your submission looks a lot like the examples below.)

If you find these directions confusing, please try reading instead family.faq -- to obtain a copy, send the message "GET family.faq" to LISTSERV@MAIL.EWORLD.COM. (Don't include the quotation marks.) There is no charge for submitting data.

#### **BASIC GUIDELINES**

Send new entries and contact information to me at one of the addresses listed at the end of this note. New data received in time will be included in the next release of the RSL, typically on the first Sunday of the month. If it's late, it will be included in the release the following month.

See below for format information. = Please = follow these guidelines:

- Send ordinary text files. Please do not compress, zip, uuencode, or MIME encode your file.
- Be sure to submit "how to reach you" information as well as surnames. At the very least, that means your name and your e-mail address.
- Do not submit more than 100 surnames.
- Do = not = put your surnames in CAPS.
- And no Tiny Tafels. They don't conform to the RSL format, and they don't really contain the right information for the RSL. If you have a Tiny Tafel and want to put it to good use, Brian Mavrogeorge, mavrogeorge@genealogysf.com, will enter it in the Fidonet TMS (Tafel Matching System) database if you mail it directly to him. There is also a Tiny Tafel server at emcee.com -- send e-mail to tt-info@emcee.com for more information. (If you don't know what a Tiny Tafel is, you're in little danger of sending me one accidentally.)

# FORMATTING YOUR "HOW TO REACH YOU" INFORMATION

If you are submitting data for the first time, I need one or two lines of address information indicating how you can be contacted. The format is fairly flexible, but should include a short nametag (less than eight characters, all lower case) and at the very least your name and e-mail address. Most submitters also include their postal addresses, but that's not required. If the selected nametag has already been taken, I'll conjure up a new one. Feel free to suggest alternate nametags when you send in your data.

# FORMATTING YOUR SURNAME INFORMATION

In the same message as the "How to Reach You" information, include one line of data for each surname you are submitting. And what should the surname entries look like? Each entry should be on =one = line of no more than 80 characters in length, and should consist of five parts. Entries that don't contain at least one date and location will not be added to the database.

The five parts are:

1. The name of the family, in mixed case (Smith not SMITH or smith).

The earliest date for which you have information about the family. (For instance, the birth date of the founder of the family, or the year he or she first showed up in the records.)

3. The latest date for which you have information about the family. (When the last person with that surname died or skipped town, for instance. Use "now" if you know people of this surname that are still around -- yourself, for example. It's up to you whether a woman is considered under her maiden surname, married surname, or both.)

4. The migration of the family. For instance, if my ancestors started out in Virginia, moved to Kentucky, then on to Missouri, this would be VAKYMO, USA. If I still have room (remember, all fields should fit on one line -- the long Keithley entry in the example below is pushing the limit), then I add some county information to further distinguish the family:

,VAKYGentryCo,MO,USA.

There is a list of most of the abbreviations that are in use. It is in a file called FAMILY ABBREV and can be obtained in the same manner as FAMILY INDEX, discussed above in Section II. Or just spell out the location, and the person who does the final data entry will put in the proper abbreviation, if any.

5. The nametag of the submitter. This is so you can be found in

The nametag of the submitter. This is so you can be found in the address list. See discussion above for how to select one.

The Roots Surname Index is rather oddly computerized. There aren't any firm restrictions on the presentation of the data, but do try to use something like the format suggested above and illustrated below.

#### WHEN TO SUBMIT

Try to get your additions or modifications in to me by the Thursday before the first Sunday of each month, when the monthly update is published. If you miss a deadline, not to worry: your surnames will have arrived in time for the next deadline and will be included in the next month's list.

# ILLINOIS LAND RECORDS ARCHIVE

I stumbled across the following State of Illinois Public Domain Land Tract Sales Archive during one of my internet searches for genealogical information pertaining to the TERRELL variations. I am reprinting excerpts of the information for those of you who had ancestors in that state regardless of what their surname may have been.

This archive contains transaction data for approximately 545,000 public domain land sales in Illinois, supplied by the Illinois Secretary of State and the State Archive to the University of Illinois at Chicago's University Library and Computer Center. The great majority of transactions date from the year 1815 to about 1880, when most public domain lands had been sold. Only the first sale of public lands is recorded in this database; subsequent sales of the land are not. The DBMS in use is Spires 91.01.

#### SEARCHING THE DATABASE:

The following indexes are available: NAME, DATE, SALE TYPE, ACRES, PRICE, and COUNTY. To use any index, select it from the menu and enter your search value at the prompt. The menu displays the type of value to use.

The NAME index is best used by entering a name in the form it appears in the data, for example: Enter key words: Lincoln Abraham (or: Lincoln A) Note there are no commas between last and first names. (The name search tries to match this string with a prefix in the name field.)

#### OTHER Indexes:

DATE Date of purchase in the form DD Mon YYYY e.g. 22 Feb 1831

TYPE Type of sale - codes are used - see 'About...' e.g. FD ACRES Acres purchased, decimal to two places e.g. 93.4 PRICE Price per acre, dollars and cents e.g. 1.25 COUNTY Code corresponding to the county of the purchaser. See the separate table of county codes.

For the indexes other than NAME the operators AND, OR, , , =, and  $\sim$  = (not equals) are fully supported. Please be aware that searches that yield very many hits, somewhere above 60,000, may exhaust the capacity of the database server, and a message such as 'No files available' will be displayed. In this case, you will need to narrow your search. You will also see that only 1000 records from any search are retrieved. To retrieve the rest, you will have to alter the search values.

Finally, the search term SPISRCH is intended for clients who are familiar with the proper syntax for Spires searches. In general, to compose a customized search, use any Boolean combination of the search names from items 2-7 (name, date, type, acres, price, county). These may be combined in the form "searchname = value and/or searchname = value and/or....." For example, a valid search expression is: date march 1836 and county 46

However note: for the name index, use the syntax 'name prefix value'. A custom search including the name field would look like this: date march 1836 and name prefix lincoln

The following field descriptions were taken directly from the documentation that was supplied with the data to UIC/ADN. In a few places comments have been added with information gathered while mounting the database.

## Field Descriptions (05-06-83)

- Name of purchaser this is a 20 character alphabetic field used to Identify the person buying each parcel of property.
   (Note: the name field is strictly a string of the form 'LAST FIRST MID'. Names weren't parsed into subfields, because of the difficulty of multi-word last names.)
- Record id number this is a 6 digit numeric field assigned by data processing and used as the access key for updating and file sequencing purposes.
- 3. Sale type this is a 2 character alphabetic code used to differentiate between the various transactions used for land sales.

#### CODE - TRANSACTION

CN - CANAL (Lands sold to finance the Illinois and Michigan canal in the early 1800'S).

FD - FEDERAL (sale by District U. S. General Land Offices in Illinois).

MT - MILITARY TRACT (The area of Illinois west of the Illinois river set aside by congress to reward veterans of the war of 1812 for their military service. These veterans were issued land warrants and most of these were purchased by speculators in the east.)

RR - RAILROAD (Land given to and sold by the ILlinois Central Railroad).

SC - SCHOOL (Elementary or secondary, usually Section 16 in each township).

SL - SALINE (Valuable mineral land - mostly salt or lead - in 19th century, sales of which were reserved for a time).

SM - SEMINARY (Higher education, old word for public college or university).

ST - STATE (Internal improvements, mostly early railroads).
SW - SWAMP (Wetlands sold by localities, profits to be used for drainage costs).

- Description this is a 12 character alphanumeric field used to identify a particular part of a section in which the land sold Is located.
- 5. Section this is a 2 digit numeric field used to specify in which of the 36 parts of a township and range the land sold is located. Each section comprises an area one mile by one mile square, thus comprising 640 acres.
- 6. Township this is a 3 character alphanumeric field used to identify the north/south relationship to a base line (two of which have been established within Illinois). Each township is numbered serially north or south and covers a distance of approximately 6 miles.
- 7. Range this is a 3 character alphanumeric field used to identify the east/west relationship t0 a principle meridian line (3 of which have been established in Illinois 2, 3, 4). Each range is numbered serially east to west or west to east of the principle meridian and covers a distance of approximately 6 miles.
- 8. Meridian this is a 1 digit numeric field used to identify a representation of a circle or half circle numbered for longitude on a map or globe. The third meridian is the chief meridian for most Illinois surveys.
- 9. County this is a 3 digit numeric field used to identify a specific county in Illinois. On printed reports this field will be converted to a 12 character alphabetic field. See the document 'Table of County Codes.'
- 10. Acres bought this is a 6 digit numeric field used to indicate the number of acres purchased within a given transaction. It carries divisions to hundredths of an acre (.00).
- 11. Price per acre this is a 5 digit numeric field used to indicate the price paid for each acre purchased. In the case of military land warrant sales in which no cash changed hands (only script) this field may be zero filled. This field carries 2 positions for cents.
- 12. Total purchase price this is a 7 digit alphanumeric field used to indicate the total amount paid for a specific parcel of land. For military land warrant transactions the code word warrant is carried instead of a numeric value. This field may be calculated by multiplying acres bought by price per acre: and rounding the results for 2 cents positions. (note: the code word warrant was not found in this field at all. Also, the price x acres was calculated as a check, and it was found that about 10% of the total prices did not agree with the calculated amount.)
- Social status this is a 1 character alphabetic field used to identify the sex of the purchaser.
- 14. Date purchased this is a 7 digit numeric field used to identify the specific day on which the transaction occurred. A 2 digit month, 2 digit day, and 3 digit year are carried with the

first digit of the year being dropped. Example: May 02, 1843 would be 0502843.

- 15. County/state of purchaser this is a 3 digit numeric field used to indicate where the buyer lived, not where the purchased land is located.
- 16. Archives volume this is a 3 character alphanumeric field used to identify the specific volume where the original transaction was recorded.
- 17. Archives page this is a 3 digit numeric field used to identify the page within the volume where the original transaction was recorded.


I was searching the **TERRILL** variation when I located this archive. The following are presented as an example of the information you will find in this archive. There are other TERRILL combinations in the archive but a malfunction broke the connection before I could get them and I was not able to get the connection again prior to this issue. The only changes are that I looked up the [county name] from the County Codes List and reformatted the information to fit *TRAILS*.

If the lineage Robert & Agnes TYRROLD of Hagbourne, Berkshire County; David & Elizabeth of West Hagbourne; and Robert and Jane BALDWIN TYRRELL of Reading is more correct, who are the ancestors of this Robert TYRROLD? T.M. NJ

A.To the best of my knowledge previous works in England (by TYRRELL & BROWN respectively) have based the ancestry of Robert TYRRELL of Reading entirely upon speculation without adequate supporting documentation.

This new account seems to be based upon solid documentation through wills, probate records, and parish registers where relationships are established from more than one document in most cases. Therefore, I personally find the newer account to appear more credible, assuming that the documents are genuine and accurately reported.

Since I cannot prove my lineage back to that point, I have no personal interest in either theory. The decision to revise any lineage should be made at a very specific point--THE POINT AT WHICH YOU ARE CONVINCED THE LINEAGE IS PROVEN BEYOND REASONABLE DOUBT! What anyone thinks about the matter is moot (of no value) unless he has enough evidence to cast reasonable doubt upon your proof.

As for the ancestors of Robert of Hagbourne--that still baffles the researchers in ENGLAND even though they feel it will ultimately end with Sir Walter TYRRELL, the king slayer. DFB

### A MEXICAN WAR HERO

(Obituary from unidentified newspaper, [Tuesday morning, May [15,?] 1906, Photo at left included)

#### JAMES A. TERREL DIED FRIDAY AFTERNOON AGED 80 YEARS.

Participated in Many Battles of the War and Entered the City of Mexico With the Victorious Army under General Scott.

James A. Terrel, a veteran of the Mexican War, died at his home on Butler street, which had been his residence for the past fifty-three years, on Friday afternoon, at the age of 80 years and three days.

Deceased was a son of William and Esther Terrel, and was born in the residence which is now a part of the St. James hotel May 8, 1826. He is survived by his wife Alinda Crannell, whom he married Feb. 15, 1852, and four children: James of Sidney, Carl of Afton, Edward of Oxford, and Mrs. Charles Cole of Castle Creek.

The trouble with Mexico over the annexation of Texas began early in 1846, and sixty years ago Sunday, the day of the burial of this veteran, the United States declared war and called for 50,000 volunteers.

In 1847, deceased enlisted in a company recruited in this village by James Terrell, who was not a relative and who was commissioned a Captain. Dissensions arose in the company and Gov. Tracy and other prominent citizens of the day were called upon to straighten out matters. The result was that deceased with some other recruits went to Utica and were sworn into service on March 20th of that year, and assigned to Company K, 8th United States Infantry, commanded by Colonel W. J. Worth, afterwards a Major General.

His regiment sailed from New York and joined Major General Scott's army at San Pueblo. He participated in several important battles and with the victorious American army entered the City of Mexico, and saw General Scott when he rode into the city at the head of his staff. The capture of the City of Mexico (Sept. 14, 1847) ended the war, and on July 26, 1848, Terrel was discharged from the service at Jefferson Barracks below New Orleans.

While he remained in the city he, as were many other soldiers, was presented with a stock and a handsome blanket by Mexican ladies. The stock was a leather collar worn around the neck and served to keep the soldier's head up and eyes straight ahead. The soldiers called it a "dog collar." The one presented is of Morocco, and was much easier to wear and more fancy. Mr. Terrel preserved it to the day of his death, as he did a portion of his uniform. The blanket was stolen from him by a fellow soldier who was hung for stealing, as were eighteen others for the same crime. He witnessed the execution.

The portrait of Mr. Terrel was taken several years ago. It represents him in cap with silver eagle, and coat and sash worn while in the service. His musket and other accounterments he had, at the expiration of his term of service, turned over to Capt. Elisha Kent Kane, who afterwards became famous as an Arctic explorer. The medals shown on the coat were presented to him by the government. One is of gold, another of silver, given for special services and bravery; the third, made from a captured Mexican cannon, was given in 1878 to all survivors of the war. So far as is known, Mr. Terrel was the last survivor of that war in this section of the state.

Funeral services were held from St. Paul's chapel Sunday at 1 o'clock, Rev. Mr. Broughton officiating. The casket was draped with the American flag, for which the old hero fought to uphold against a foreign foe. Breed Post, G.A.R., acted as an escort of the remains to Riverview cemetery, where the procession was met by a delegation from Meade Post, from the Soldiers' Home, who after the commitment of the body, fired three volleys over the grave, the last honors paid to a brave soldier.





## TYRRELLS OF DRAYTON BEING RESEARCHED

Submitted by Mr. Don C. Terrill from TFHS Bulletin

Information from a recent TYRRELL FAMILY HISTORY SOCIETY BULLETIN indicates that research on TYRRELLS of Drayton (England), which is the same as research on the TYRRELLS/TYROLDS of Hagbourne, is continuing.

This is a difficult task as the Drayton Registers for Baptism and Burials prior to 1813 and the marriage registers prior to 1754 were destroyed and it has been impossible to construct a family tree due to the Bishop's notes lacking enough detail.

Many Wills and Administrations are still available at the Berkshire Record Office in Shire Hall, Reading, England. A large proportion of these wills are for Drayton and nearby villages. Many of these have been transcribed and are lodged with the Tyrrell Family History Society of England. It is hoped that the genealogical data contained in the wills, combined with the Parish Registers, etc. will enable researchers to work out the relationships of some of the TYRRELLS who lived in Drayton, Milton, and Steventon, etc. with a fair degree of certainty.

Don has renewed his membership in the TYRRELL SOCIETY through the year 2000 and promises to keep us advised as new information is published.

We conclude this issue with TERRELL listings of the International Genealogical Index (IGI) from the Family History Library of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints (Mormon) for Connecticut. We remind you that this type of information is available on all your surnames at your nearest Family History Center.
