24 through Dec. 21 when she left us to be with her Lord and Savior.

Alex said, "We had a service here in New Jersey on the 23rd. of December. I then took my Scarlett to her beloved southland. We had a service for family and friends on the 27th of December and interred her on the 28th in the Chandler cemetery in Calhoun GA."

"She was very proud of her heritage and took her genealogy seriously. We all lost someone who was a loving, faithful, and willing servant to both her family and friends as well."

In a letter dated simply, December, 1997, Alex shared the following:

Dearest Family & Friends,

Brandon's concern has always been for us!

On her behalf, I would like to express her most fond appreciation for your cherished expression of regards and sympathy. In this somber moment, she sanctions us to share a moment — for time is but the smallest of seed in terms of the eternal.

Sometimes early on in this beleaguered siege, she would engage me in the sharing of certain things which were so very important to her. It seemed as if a message was handed to a messenger.

I recall one evening when she rang the bell (we have a cow bell attached to an outside door; the equivalent of the dinner angle wranglers use on the range to signal 'dinner is ready') and she was so excited. There was something she just had to share which she had just discovered from her readings. It was from **Thomas JEFFERSON** who is both blood relative (through his great grand daughter, P*Sarah RANDOLPH*) and hero to her heart.

She sat me down and read the passage she discovered from an ancient transcript which was written by **JEFFERSON** to his 15 year old nephew, **Peter CARR**. In part, it went something like this, "the possession of science is, what (next to an honest heart) will above all things render you dear to your friends, and give you promotion in your own country — purest integrity — most chaste honor. Above all, give up money, give up fame, give up science, give up the earth itself and all it contains, rather than do an immoral act and never suppose that, in any possible situation or under any circumstances, it is best for you to do a dishonorable thing, however slight it may appear to you ..." 'How far did *this* apple fall from *that* tree?' was my *only* thought.

It wasn't very long afterwards, as we were rocking in our chairs beside our kitchen table when she shared a quote from another of her champions of character, **George WASHINGTON** (to his brother), "Be courteous to all, but intimate

with few, and let those few be well tried before you give your confidence. True friendship is a plant of slow growth and must undergo and withstand the shock of adversity before it is entitled to the appellation."

Thus, family and heart felt friend in kind, I share some of our final conversational themes. Our dearest Margaret Brandon or Peggy (depending on which side of the Potomac we knew her from) leaves us with these thoughts concerning the formation of character for her loved ones while yet engaged in the battle for survival to which she would *not ever* surrender, but nevertheless, eventually succumb.

There are so many passages to which she would often refer concerning character and foundation in light of worldly and social condition. As an historian and biographical devotee, she dwelled on the premise and practice of her champions. Her applications of their principles were paramount in her life. She knew, however, that this was all about canon, courage, & character for the body, a calculable entity of space and time. Her real concern was of the soul — beyond all measurable dimension.

When it seemed darkest to us, she would reach for the *Lamp* and begin to speak of the Power which sustains us all. It remained for her, the Word of God! It's vigilance kept residence within her spirit and drove her onward in vigorous confrontation with her mortal assailant. There is *no* death for the living since we rely upon *hope in the realization* of what the cross at Calvary has afforded to us all. "So, when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory. O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory? (1 Cor. 15:54-55)

Yea, though the *battle* may have been lost, the *war* is won! It is through *His* victory that Brandon as well as you, dear partner in Christ, may live! Thanks be to God in the Name of Jesus Christ through the comfort and power of His Holy Spirit. Amen.

In this trying time, I humbly accept both your concern and condolences with heartfelt gratefulness. Thank you for standing by us. Now that we are asunder, please join my heart in prayer: "Lord God, please grant wisdom, serenity, and strength to carry on for us all."

She was a member of the National Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution, National Society of Magna Carta Dames, United Daughters of the Confederacy, National Society of Colonial Dames XVII Century, Civil War Trust, in addition to serving as our Vice-President. She was a member of Fardale Trinity Church in Mahwah, NJ.

Born in Atlanta, she moved to Rome GA as a child. She began working as secretary to the general commandant of Fort McPherson, then became secretary to the president of the Ladies Garment Workers Union. She moved from there into modeling, television, and screen work under the stage name Brandon Keene, best known for the TV commercial I.E. Salem Girl.

Her modeling and screen careers were featured on page 987 in an article titled *AS WE WERE*. She hoped that others would follow suit and submit information about their achievements, photos, etc. Regrettably, no one has done so.

After retiring from the screen, she opened **Brandon Keene Antiques** in Hackensack, NJ and **Margaret Brandon's Tag Sales** (estates).

Survivors include her husband, **Alexander BIELEN**; a son [Rev.] **Charles L. STARNES, Jr.**; two granddaughters, **Shannon & Shelly STARNES** of Sunnysdale CA; and a brother, **Wesley HUDGINS** of Adairsville GA.

Funeral in Calhoun GA was held in the chapel of Thomas Funeral Home.

TERRELL TRAILS

Hi. I'm researching the **GILES NEWTON** line. There seems to be a fairly close connection between the **NEWTON** line and the **TERRELL** line so I have been researching the Terrell line as a result. Giles and his two sons originated in Virginia and fought in the Rev War, probably in NC and SC. They were given large tracks of land in Robeson County, NC and Marlboro County, SC by the Governors of the area at that time. They owned most of Marlboro County, SC at one time having several large plantations. A lot of the family subsequently migrated to Fayette County, GA and on to AL, AR, MS, and Texas as time passed. Some of the Terrell line seems to have also migrated along the same route. Newtonville, SC was named for the family and some of the family is still there. We haven't been able to find where Giles came from although we have several good clues from the wills and other data passed down from that time. The lost records of the southern counties is a problem for a lot of us. The connection of the **CHILES** family is interesting in light of his name, **GILES**. We do believe he was probably named from the English usage of the name Giles. Giles named one of his daughters **Mary Terrel NEWTON**. I might also note that Giles's son James named one of his sons **PLEASANT**. I was wondering if you had run across any data relating to the **NEWTON** name in your research. We have **James NEWTON**'s wife **Sarah TERRELL** back to 1568 and his wife, **Margaret RICHMOND** back further than that. The name **Giles** and **Pleasant** have survived down through the family. I would appreciate it if you would pass this along to anyone who might be able to help. Thank you for any help you may be able to provide.

Their children included: **Emily ROLB** who m. **GILES**; **Betsy ROLB**; **Thomas ROLB**; & **Charles ROBB**(sic).

Ibid, pages 165 et seq lists **David TERRELL** (1695-1700—4/12/1759 date will proved) s/o **William & Susannah TERRELL** m. ca 1727 **Agatha CHILES** (?—1766) His brother, **Henry TERRELL** m. **Anne CHILES**, sister of **Agatha**. Both were daughters of **Micajah CHILES** whose will was proved in Caroline Co. VA 11/08/1734 by **Martin HACKETT** and **Anne TERRELL**. **DICKEN** did not discover whom **Micajah CHILES** had married.

The listed children of **David & Ann CHILES TERRELL** include: **David TERRELL II** (1728-9—1805) m. 3 times; **Henry TERRELL** (ca 1730—1806) d. unmarried, passed his land to his youngest brother **Johathan TERRELL**; **Micajah TERRELL** (ca 1732—1805) m. (1) **Sarah LYNCH** (2) Mrs. **Deborah COFFIN Gardner**; **Pleasant TERRELL** (?—1803) m. **Caty or Catherine FARISH**; **Mary TERRELL** m. **Robert COBB** of Bedford Co VA in 1758; **Millicent TERRELL** (06/07/1741—?) m. **Christopher CLARK**; **Ann TERRELL**, untraced, living in 1759; **Chiles TERRELL** m. **Margaret DOUGLAS Meriwether**; **Christopher TERRELL** (ca 1747—?) m. **Martha WILSON**; **Rachel TERRELL** (1749—1781) m. **John BURRESS** who d. 1780; **Susannah TERRELL** (05/30/1732—12/08/1828) m. **William BURRESS**, brother of preceding **John BURRESS**; & **Jonathan TERRELL** m. (1) **Margaret HUNNICUTT**.

David TERRELL II had 11 children by his first wife, Sarah JOHNSON, but none were named either Chiles or Pleasant. However, his daughter, Sarah TERRELL m. Benjamin ARTHUR & they named a son Pleasant ARTHUR. His son, David TERRELL III m. Mary "Molly" ANTHONY and named first son Pleasant TERRELL. Son, Samuel TERRELL named sons Samuel Chiles TERRELL, Thomas Pleasant TERRELL & Christopher C. TERRELL.

Micajah TERRELL, s/o David & Agatha CHILESTERRELL did not pass either Chiles or Pleasant to any of their listed children.

Pleasant & Catherine Caty FARISH TERRELL did not name either of their listed children Chiles, but did name one Pleasant TERRELL. He in turn named sons Joseph Pleasant TERRELL & Pleasant Montgomery TERRELL.

Mary TERRELL & Robert COBB named a son Pleasant COBB and had a daughter Judith TERRELL who m. John CHILES.

Mourning CLARK d/o Millicent TERRELL & Christopher CLARK m. William Bibb KEY and named their first son Chiles Terrell KEY apparently after her grandmother Agatha. He did not pass the name to any of his listed children.

Chiles TERRELL m. widow, Margaret DOUGLAS Meriwether, and had only one child, James Hunter TERRELL (1784—1856). He had no children, but is said to have adopted James Hunter MINOR, son of Samuel Overton MINOR & grandson of Garrett MINOR & Mary Overton TERRELL.

Jonathan TERRELL (1755—1823) m. (1) Margaret HUNNICUTT has 8 children listed, one named Chiles TERRELL (03/26/1780—1877) who m. Mary Cordelia UPSHAW. They had 14 children. Six died under age 3. They reared 4 boys & 4 girls but only one is listed, Dr. Thomas F. TERRELL of Paducah KY.

Henry TERRELL and his first wife Anne CHILES did not pass the Chiles name on to their listed children. However, his son Henry TERRELL II and Mary TYLER named children Henry Chiles TERRELL and Anne Chiles TERRELL.

Although I did not find NEWTON, I did find a NORTON connection. Norton is about as close to Newton as Giles is to Chiles.

Ibid, page 237, et seq: Hon. J. F. CLAIRBORNE of Natchez MS, brother of Ferdinand Lee CLAIRBORNE who m. Courtney TERRELL, d/o Archibald TERRELL in mentioning the TERRELLS he had known mentions "a sister of Archibald TERRELL who md. Charles M. NORTON, a native of Frederick Co. VA who was for many years a senator for this district and had a brother John M. NORTON who was a United States Marshall for this state." Marriage bond for Mary TERRELL & Charles M NORTON was issued 02/13/1812.

Page 245, Mary Poiner TERRELL (08/03/1792—04/27/1866), youngest daughter of Micajah and Hannah GOODMAN TERRELL was b. at Fayetteville NC & died at New Orleans LA. She is buried at Pass Christian MS. She m. Charles Mynn NORTON (1888—1824). Children: Sidney Ann Powell NORTON (1812-1895) m. Jilson Payne HARRISON (1806—1874); Louisa Terrell NORTON m. Sheperd BROWN, no children; John Hatley NORTON (1816-1819); Courtney Ann NORTON (1819—1822); Sarah Claiborne NORTON (1822-1906) m. Judge John Marshall CLINTON of New Orleans; & Courtney Mynn NORTON (1824-1910) m. William Hall DAMERON.

The puzzle deepens. Maybe something included here will be the missing piece. Good hunting! DFB

Editor's Note: We have not published a book on TERRELLs yet. We do have a LENDING LIBRARY with about 30 TERRELL specific works written between 1850 and the present.

The only TERRELL/GOODMAN marriages listed in *TERRELL GENEALOGY* by **DICKEN** is the one in the previous Editor's Note and one on page 190 which is obviously a later generation if your dates are correct.

Joel TERRELL [s/o **Christopher TERRELL** (1747—1825-6), gs/o **David & Agatha CHILES TERRELL**] md. **Lucy MARSHALL** in Culpeper Co VA, marriage bond 10/20/1806; children: **Sarah W. TERRELL** m. **Nathan C. GOODMAN**; **Agnes P. TERRELL** m. **Chas. WRIGHT**; **Eliza M. TERRELL** m. **Stapleton SHELTON**; **Mary A. TERRELL** became 3rd. wife of **Fontain D. BROCKMAN**; **Albert C. TERRELL** d. 1849; **Clementina R. TERRELL** m. **Nelson ELSOM**; **Virginia H. TERRELL** m. **Peter V. PHILLIPS**; **Harriet TERRELL**; **Hardenia P. TERRELL** m. **William BECK**.

Only child expanded upon is **Albert C. TERRELL** (?—1849) m. c1835 **Ella BARKSDALE** (1815-?) d/o **Nelson BARKSDALE & Jane LEWIS**; children named in will of **Joel TERRELL**: **Jane Lewis TERRELL** (1836-1859); **John Albert TERRELL** (1838—1863) killed CSA; **George W. TERRELL** (1840—?) soldier in CSA; **James C. TERRELL** (no dates) soldier in CSA; **Sarah E. TERRELL** (1848—?); and **Margaretta "Maggie" TERRELL** (no dates). After the death of **Albert C. TERRELL**, his widow md. **Robert DURRETT**.

I don't see anything in the materials submitted to indicate that the mother of these children was a TERRELL, except in the name of the next to last son, **Joseph Terrell GOODMAN**. If they followed one of the common naming patterns of the era: first son after father, second son after mother's father, third son after father's father; first daughter after mother; second daughter after father's mother, 3rd daughter after mother's mother, etc. it appears likely that an earlier **Joseph GOODMAN** died prior to the birth of **Joseph Terrell GOODMAN**.

Children in the order listed are: **Richard GOODMAN**; **Elizabeth GOODMAN**; **Thomas GOODMAN**; **Noton GOODMAN**; **Ann GOODMAN**; **Zachariah GOODMAN**; **Josiah GOODMAN**; **Mary GOODMAN**; **Joseph Terrell GOODMAN**; & **Edmund GOODMAN** Since I don't know which of these given names were from TERRELL and which were from GOODMAN, I will proceed on the (obviously incorrect) assumption that all were TERRELL, beginning with the unlikely possibility that **Joseph Terrell GOODMAN** was named for a **Joseph TERRELL**. It was common in that era to give girls the full name of their

ancestor including surname, but boys were rarely given more than one name.

TERRELL GENEALOGY by **DICKEN**, page 38 lists one **Timothy TERRELL** of New Kent Co. VA whom descendants say was born 1658 and most agree that he was son of **Richmond TERRELL** who emigrated to the colony of VA in 1656. [Information uncovered in England in recent years indicates that they are probably all incorrect in assuming that **Richmond TERRELL** was his father, but that's beyond the scope of this note.]

Spelling of the name varied in England as well as the colonies. It is sometimes **TERRELL**, **TERRILL**, **TER-RALL**, etc. even when obviously referring to the same person, but descendants of **Timothy TERRILL** who settled in Orange Co. VA seem to have adhered mostly to **TERRILL**.

It is known to descendants that **Timothy TERRILL** md. **Elizabeth FOSTER**. d/o **John FOSTER**. Record is found in St. Peter's Parish Register of the baptism of 3 of their children, but it seems almost certain that there were other children whose records were lost. Timothy was a vestryman in St. Peters Parish as shown in the vestry book. Children recorded in the vestry book: **Mary TERRILL** bapt. 01/03/1689; **Robert TERRILL** bapt. 12/25/1697; & **Joseph TERRILL** bapt. 12/31/1699.

In addition, tradition says that they also had sons **William TERRILL** and **Timothy TERRILL** and some daughters. Some have thought that **Elizabeth TERRILL** who md. **Joseph ANDREWS** in 1705 & **Mary TERRILL** who md. **John MARSTON** in 1711 were their children, but those marriages were recorded in Christ's Church Parish, Middlesex Co. while Timothy TERRILL b. 1658 was in New Kent Co. in 1699 and probably died there.

Robert TERRILL (1697—1786) bapt. above, s/o **Timothy & Elizabeth FOSTER TERRILL**, settled in Orange Co. VA where he was a land and slave owner. He was 21 years old in 1718 and is thought to have married about 1718-1723. Family records give his wife as **Mary FOSTER** who may have been his cousin as his mother was **Elizabeth FOSTER**. Most records give **Mary FOSTER**'s mother as **Ann MOORE**, d/o **Augustine MOORE**. She was still living in 1783 when **Robert and Mary TERRILL** of St. Thomas Parish, Orange Co. VA made a deed to **Marshall DURRETT** for a tract of land in Albemarle Co VA. (D. B. 8, p. 102, Albemarle Co) His will was dated 02/13/1786, probated 03/23/1786 in St. Thomas Parish. He did not mention his wife in the will so she must have died between

1783 & 1786. Children named in the will are:

1. **Robert TERRILL** who m. **Judith TOWLES**
2. **Ann TERRILL** who m. Mr. ? **MOORE** and had children **Robert MOORE**, **Francis**, **Bernard MOORE**, **Alexander**, & **William MOORE** whom it has been said was b. 1756, d. 1835 but we have no proof.
3. **Sarah TERRILL** who m. (1) Mr. ? **MURRAY** and had child, **Lydia MURRAY**, m. (2) **Joseph TOWLES** b/o **Judith** who m. **Robert TERRILL** above. Both **Joseph & Sarah** were mentioned as deceased in **Robert TERRILL**'s will. Their children, not of age were: **Mary TOWLES** m. **Richard SIMMS**; **Ann TOWLES**; **Joseph TOWLES**; **Jane TOWLES** m. **James SIMS**; **Frances "Fanny" TOWLES**; & **Sarah TOWLES**.
4. **John TERRILL** who m. **Elizabeth Ann TOWLES**, niece of **Judith**.
5. **William TERRILL**
6. **Mary TERRILL** m. Mr. ? **HUDSON** and had son **Rush HUDSON** named in his grandfather's will. One **Rush HUDSON** was named among the Revolutionary soldiers who were pensioned in 1818.
7. **Edmund TERRILL** who m. **Margaret WILLIS**
8. **Elizabeth TERRILL** who m. Mr. ? **RUCKER**. **Robert TERRILL** named in his will "children of my deceased daughter **Elizabeth**." He named them as: **Ephraim RUCKER**, **Reuben RUCKER**, **Mrs. Mary Creed**, & **Mrs. Elizabeth Herring**. They probably lived in Amherst Co VA. **Reuben RUCKER** m. his cousin, **Mary Foster TERRILL**, d/o **Edmund & Margaret WILLIS TERRILL**.

The date of birth of all of **Robert TERRILL**'s children is not known. **Edmund**, the seventh child was b. 1740 so the eight children were probably born between 1723 & 1744.

The above **TERRELL** information contains the given names: **Joseph**, **Elizabeth**, **Ann**, **Mary**, & **Edmund** which indicates the possibility that the **TERRELL** who m. **Joseph GOODMAN** was one of the undiscovered daughters of **Timothy TERRILL** or one of his grand daughters by a son other than **Robert** who did not name a **GOODMAN** in his will. **Edmund** is the strongest indication since all the other names are common to most surnames. This theory is further strengthened by the fact that no **Richard**, **Thomas**, **Noton**, **Zachariah**, or **Josiah TERRELL** was found prior to the era of your **GOODMAN** family.

There may still be some marriage bonds and other records in Orange Co. VA that will shed some light upon this mystery, but it will take someone with lots of time and financial independence to uncover it.

TERRELL TRAILS

Of the related families, **BALLOU, HATCHER, McNAMAR, STREET, WADDY, & WALTON** were not found in that era, although one **Malinda WALTON** b. 1825 married a grandson of **Edmund & Margaret WILLIS TERRILL** in KY so the families, if not related, may have followed the same migration pattern.

Page 79 et seq., **Joel TERRELL** (1692-5—1758) s/o **William & Susannah TERRELL** was born in New Kent Co. VA, died in Hanover Co. VA and must have settled in a section of then King William Co. that later became Caroline Co. VA. The date of the marriage of **Joel TERRELL & Sarah OXFORD** is not known, but must have occurred 1716-1718 when he was 21 or older and she probably 16 or older. Their 3rd child, **Hannah TERRELL** b. 1724-25 m. **Israel BURNLEY** s/o **John BURNLEY** from England and his second wife **Phebe DAVIES**. None of theirs sons were named either **James BURNLEY** or **Henry Mills BURNLEY**. **DICKEN** cites a published genealogy *Our Burnley Ancestors* as a good source of **BURNLEY** lineages. *DFB*

I am looking for the wife of a **Thomas C. CRUMLEY** of Virginia, North Carolina, and Georgia. His wife was **Susan**. Thomas was born abt 1799 and Susan born abt 1800 in SC. They were reportedly married in Buncombe County, NC, abt 1825. Records burned.

Their first child was named **Terrell CRUMLEY**, born abt 1827 in NC. I am hoping they used Susan's last name as the first name for their first son. I have no proof of this. Thomas and Susan had children in NC, SC, and Georgia. They lived in Gorden County, Georgia in 1850 then moved to Barry County, Missouri. I know this is a long shot, but think its worth a try. I don't know whether any information you or other Society members might have about my **THERRELLs**. I need help! Following is some of the basic information I have. I don't know when the **THERRELLs** migrated from SC to MS. There was a **Coker THERRELL** in Copiah Co. MS in 1830 census, but I don't know whether it was MY Coker. **Benjamin, J. Elijah & Jonathan D.** (sons of Coker) were in Clarke Co with their families in 1840. All I can say with some certainty is that Coker, Stacia & their five children moved from SC to MS sometime between 1820 and 1840.

Estell ApGAR was born in 1894 in Crawford, IL. Sometime between 1910 and 1914 the family moved to OK. Apparently she married **William CROSBY** and their daughter, **Audrey Elvina CROSBY** was born in OK in 1914. I have not found a marriage record or a birth record. Sometime before 1926 Audrey married **Joel Nicholas DOSS**. My mother, **JoAnn Ruth DOSS** was born in Duncan, Stephens Co., OK in Nov 1926. Joel was listed as an auto mechanic. They also had a son named **Kenneth**. In 1933 Audrey was living in Shawnee, Pottawatomie Co., OK with her mother **Mary Elise "Mollie" Terrell Apgar**. Mollie died in Shawnee in 1939 and is buried in Tecumseh cemetery. I know that Audrey was still living in Shawnee in 1943. Sometime after

that the family moved to Aurora, CO, where JoAnn met my father. I have not been able to find marriage records for any of Audrey's marriages or a birth record for Kenneth Doss. Thank you for the information you sent me about the Terrell Society. I wanted to ask you directly for some advice. I am actually not a Terrell descendant. Back in the 1800's, two Terrell's married into my **GASSAWAY** family. These Gassaway's are actually brother and sister to my gg grandmother (I think). I thought by tracking them I might find some more information on her.

For some time I have wondered why my great grandfather's middle name was Terrell. **Matthew Terrell SCOTT** was b 01/06/1857 in Habersham Co GA. His father, **William SCOTT** m. **Susannah GASSAWAY** 08/01/1833 in Habersham Co GA. [That's 24 years between marriage & birth. Are you sure he wasn't a grandson? Is there a **Matthew TERRELL** in the census records for Habersham Co. GA during that era? DFB]

I have found that GASSAWAYS have married at least twice with the TERRELL family. **James Perry GASSAWAY** who later changed his name to **James Perry ECHOLS** m. 02/11/1847 in Hall Co. GA to **Hannah B. TERRELL** b. 1820. **Catherine GASSAWAY** b. 1825 m. in Rutherford Co. NC sometime before 1852 **Buffon TERRELL** b. 04/03/1808.

If you could give me the names of a few Terrell researchers in Georgia (Habersham and Stephens Counties) maybe I could contact them to help me. Also if I knew which book would help, I would buy it. One Terrell line is **James TERRELL**, revolutionary soldier, from Spottsylvania County, VA b 10 Mar 1762 and died in Green County, GA 18 Oct 1857. Archibald TERRELL (1774—1824) owned a mercantile business in Natchez MS, was a merchant, planter, & cotton buyer. If his death date is correct, he certainly did not live there in the 1830s. His wife, "a **Miss MARTIN** of a wealthy NC family" died between 1821 & 1824 while the children were young. GOLANSVILLE CEMETERY UPDATE

We have received two items about the progress of restoration of the Golansville Quaker cemetery in Caroline Co VA. **Mr. Guy Clarke** sent a copy of an article appearing on page B4 of the *Richmond Times-Dispatch* on February 10, 1998 by **Christine Neuberger**, staff writer. **Mrs. Fay Parrish Wade** sent a card in March briefly updating the project. The following is edited from those two items. *DFB*

Ladysmith VA; Archaeologists working with earth moving machines skimmed the top soil on or about February 9, 1998. The effort is funded by the state's threatened sites program.

"We're starting to get the answers we wanted to let the landowner know where to stay away from," said **David HAZZARD**, a Virginia Dept. of Historic Resources archaeologist.

Authorities have found no criminal wrongdoing in the bulldozing of the cemetery, but public interest in the site has run high with many residents voicing concern about its future. Initially only 2 marked graves were found. That has been expanded to sixteen. Some believe as many as 40 to 100 persons may be buried at the site.

Archaeologists examined three poured concrete slabs positioned atop stone and brick foundation remains. They found no solid evidence that the foundation dated to the 1700s. Artifacts from the early 1900s were excavated. Apparently additional surveys were made or the newspaper in error because the card from Mrs. Wade says both the Golansville Quaker Meeting House and cemetery have truly been located.

"I'm fascinated by the Quakers," said **C. Flippo HICKS**, general counsel to the Virginia Association of Counties and a descendant of the Golansville Quakers. He is helping the restoration committee. "Even if I didn't have ancestors buried there," he said, "the fact that I'm a native of Caroline County ... makes it my civic duty to save that graveyard."

"There are still numerous steps to be taken before the restoration can be completed but we're confident the process will not move at a quicker pace. While no completion date can be targeted at this time, I can affirm that all parties involved are anxious to see the restoration completed." Wade said.

"Your financial support is still needed. Our humble thanks to those who've already made contributions. Whether

Information on his ancestors and descendants is given in *A Genealogical History of the Tyrrells* by J H Tyrrell.

This book was originally published in 1904 as a limited edition of 100 copies. My aunt had one of the few copies available in North America. Unfortunately this copy was lost and I did not get it with the other information. The book has been reprinted more than 70 years later and is available from the TYRRELL FAMILY HISTORY SOCIETY (UK). The author traces the ancestors of Sire de TIREL back 54 generations to 443 BC and his descendants 28 generations

to 1897. The validity of the charts back to BC is very questionable, but the charts for the middle ages and later are more reliable.

Another book that may be of interest is *The Tyrells of England* by O F BROWN, published in 1982 and also available through the above society. This book covers in some detail the period from 1030 to 1146. There is some information between 1146 & 1199. There is a period of about 150 years with little information.
