I descend from Christopher MARTIN whose first wife we do not name, only that TERREL is used in two of the families that came to KS. Christopher had a son George (Terrel?) [MARTIN] and a daughter, Elizabeth [MARTIN]. Christopher owned land in Hardy & Hampshire counties including 4 acres reported to have been given him when he defected from the Hessian Troops and went to the American side. He was injured in the battle of Brandywine. I have been all over the north part of West VA and lower PA looking for proof of the lady he married. We are not sure when his first wife died, but he remarried and had several more children.

In a will from Ohio County [now WV] we found the name Elizabeth MARTIN whose children inherited from their grandfather Daniel TERREL. We have gone through the census records and found dates of birth different in two records. Our George [MARTIN] was reported by our family as having been born in 1810, married in 1835 Rebecca DRAISE and started to MO. WILL OF DANIEL TERREL

In the name of God Amen I Daniel Terrel of the County of Ohio and State of Virginia being in good health and of perfect soundness of mind and memory but impressed with the uncertainty of this man life, do make and ordain this my last will and testament when it Shall please God to call me from the present to an eternal State

My body I resign to the dust and my spirit to God who gave it After my decease it is my will that my body be immediately and decently buried my outstanding dues collected and my just debts immediately and promptly paid; whatever other property I may die possessed of, I will and bequeath in the manner and for follwing Viz **Primus** I will and bequeath unto my beloved wife **Jane Terrell** one third of my real estate, and one third of my moveable porperty at her own disposal the real estate during her life time

Item I will and bequeath to my son Jeremiah Terrel the farm on which I now reside together with the remaining two thirds of my personal estate subject to the payments herein after mentioned

Item I will and bequeath to my daughter Mary Cotes One hundred dollars

Item I will and bequeath unto my son Adam Terrel fifty dollars

Item I will and bequeath to the heirs of Elizabeth Martin eighty dollars to be equally divided among them

ItemI will and bequeath unto my daughter Rebecca Watson
One hundred dollars

Item I will and bequeath unto my daughter Margaret
Thompson One hundred dollars

Item I will and bequeath unto my son Robert Terrel Fifty dollars

4ly to Abner I give and bequeath him the hundred acres that he bought of Georg Terril one hundred acres which he chose himself and fifteen acres lying on the north side of that———

[Either there is no item numbered 5, or it was omitted in the transcript]

6ly, to **Eber** I give and bequeath him one hundred acres of land lying between the place I now live on and the place that George sold to Abner likewise fifteen acrtes lying on the East side of said division——

The remaining part of the said hundred acres that is to be divided between Abner, Eber, and George's son Jerred I give and brequeath to Charisa Terril daughter to Ely Terril

To **Daniel** I give and bequeath him the hundred acres that he chose himself likewise fifty acres ajoining the said hundred acres formerly claimed by **Luke Scarmuhorn** taking in said Scarmuhorn's Cabin and Improvement.

To my son Peter I give and bequeath him the hundred acres that his tanfat is now on, likewise twenty five acres ajoining said division of the land laitly located

Charisa Scarmuhorn I give and bequeath her one dollar and her son Amos seventy five acres of Land ajoining John Millors Survey Southwardly ———

Son **John** I give and bequeath him one hundred and twenty five acres lying on the road called Butors adjoining a five hundred Survey belonging to **E Zanes** on the waters of grave Creek ———

Son; Ely I give and bequeath him one hundred acres of land lying on the left hand fork of glade run.

Sons Egar and Edmon I give and bequeath them a sertain tract or parsel of land Jointly and severally beginning at Ebers line running to the mouth of the run running between my garden and Peter's field running up the run to Peter's line thence with said line to its corner then to continue said cource sixty rod thence Eastardly to Hilliards line on the glade run thence southwardly with said line taking Buters lines Southwardly to a corner of Elys and said boys thence down the creek to the beginning. I give and ascribe this tract of Land to the said boys with all its priviledges and improvements to hold use Cultivate and dispose of as their Econimy and inclination shall lead and direct them ——

I further ascribe order and terminate that in case the land should be disputed that I have lately located Ely shall be Intitled to the hundred acres that is to be divided between his daughter Clarissa, George's son Jerrid Abner and Eber and their claims become voice.

Lastly I have given and bequeathed and conveyed my effects to the true and lawful heirs to use hold and dispose of as they see fit therefor the charge and settlement of said estate.

I commit to my wife Sarah, Son Peter, and Son Daniel as Executors and administrators to settle said estate to give and convey to each their Just and herein ordered given and bequeathed Rights and divisions
