E-MAIL ADDRESS

The Terrell Society of America, Inc., now has an INTERNET e-mail address, at least temporarily.

Thanks a grant that placed a public Internet access dial-in service in the Roddenbery Memorial Library in Cairo, GA, you can now reach us from any commercial service that has e-mail with internet access.

The internet provides computer communications between commercial services (AOL, CompuServe, Delphi, & others), university computer users, government agencies, software vendors, and everyone else with internet access.

If you do not have direct internet access, read your service HELP section on line, or check your manual to see how to address something to get to the internet.

Usually your internet address will be "your user ID@your service." For example, in CompuServe, replace the comma with a period and you will have something similar to this: 12345.6789@compuserve.com. For AOL users, it's screen name@aol.com.

Try it out. Enclose your regular (snail mail) address. I will acknowledge all messages. If you do not receive a reply from me within 2 weeks, follow up with a letter and maybe we can figure out what went wrong

E-MAIL GENEALOGY ARCHIVE

There is a massive genealogy database on the internet where files can be gotten by E-mail. (There may be others, but I haven't located them yet)

(Internet) Address a message to:

LISTSERV@VM1.Nodak.EDU

Do not include a subject or message description. Type the following one line message exactly as shown:

get FAQ index

Do not append a signature. Send your message. Disconnect.

Your request will be automatically processed by the computer and the requested file will be e-mailed back to you. Check your e-mail again in a few hours. Your requested file should be there. In some cases, it may take overnight if the computer is loaded down with other requests.

Read the FAO list.

You will get a list of files contained in the FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions) directory. This is maintained to keep hundreds of people from asking the same question individually.

For example, there are two files of general interest to everyone: ADDRESS (address help with ROOTS-L); & LISTSERV (Basic info on the ROOTS-L List and how to make requests to LISTSERV). WHAT2ASK is a file of questions to ask in doing family genealogy. This is a good choice for beginners.

There may be files listed that apply to your situation. If you have a PC and run windows, then PC and WINDOWS should be on your request list.

Send a second message just as you did the first:

LISTSERV@VM1.Nodak.EDU

Request your files in the body of your message and put each request on a separate line. For example:

get FAQ address

get FAQ listserv

get FAQ pc

get FAQ windows

Don't get greedy. Request only 4-5 files at a time. Also limit your request to one per day. (That's not a listed requirement, but it is good etiquette. Give someone else a chance too.) If you do not get all the files requested, try requesting the others one per message.

Next day, try:

get FAMILY index

Digest this index carefully and you should have enough to keep you happy for a long time.

I received information from Marty HOAG, the postmaster at LISTSERV indicating that the owners of this list are looking for a new home for it with the next few months. He did not say so, but I assume that there will be a reasonable period of time when a new address is posted, and or e-mail forwarded to the new location if the list does move.

PLANNED PLANNED

Now that I have the index to Vol VI-X in a data base that can be amended with minimum effort, I intend to incorporate the original index to Vols I-V into one master electronic index covering all the volumes.

Each year I will try to index the volume for that year and make it available both as an index for that year, and incorporated into the master index.

Those of you who do not have computers will be able to request a printed annual index at a nominal cost. Printouts of the master index will also be available for members who desire one.

Those of you who have computers may request either the electronic master index, or the single year edition of interest to you.

We intend to make these indexes available on IBM Compatible 360K or 1.2 meg 5 1/4" diskettes and/or 720K 3 1/2" diskettes.

We will attempt to maintain an E-Mail address at the editor's home so that those of you who have E-Mail can get your index via that method. This will overcome our inability to write Apple or MacIntosh diskettes. Maybe we have at least one member with each of these who will volunteer to accept a copy of the index via either modem or E-Mail and make it available in the proper format to those who need it at a nominal copy cost.

The popularity of multi-media computers with Compact Disc reading capabilities is lowering prices of this new media rapidly.

Minimum requirements are an IBM XT compatible computer with MS DOS or MacIntosh with Universal Soft PC version 2.5; minimum 495K available RAM, minimum 10 MB hard drive; color or monochrome EGA monitor; a CD ROM Drive and GRS Retrieval Software Version 2.77 either on the disk or purchased separately. Some CD's require 286 or better, 5.0 DOS or higher; mouse, VGA, SVGA color, and 2 MB RAM.

TERRELL/MOORE/SPENCER CORRECTION

Some clarification is needed regarding the EDITOR'S NOTE in that article (page 844).

The editor's interpretation of relationship is correct. The original article was incorrect in saying that "Ezra SPENCER, Sr., a native of Saybrook, CT, who with his father, Joseph SPENCER of English Ancestry, came to Wayne County, Penn." Actually, Ezra SPENCER, Jr. came with his father, Ezra SPENCER, Sr. Joseph SPENCER died 18 Feb 1810, as recorded in the Congregational Church Records of Westbrook, CT. He never moved to Pennsylvania. His brother moved there in 1812 and Ezra, Sr. and Ezra, Jr. followed in 1816 (Illustrated Wayne County). The ancestry of Joseph SPENCER is well documented in The American Genealogist beginning in Vo. 27, p. 87. His mother, Lydia GRINNELL, was a great-great granddaughter of Mayflower passengers, John & Priscilla ALDEN.

GENEALOGY? ASK DAN!

Q.One of our major problems is the need for evidence concerning the Mary TERRELL who md. James MOORE of NJ. We are interested in the numerous books listed for your LENDING LIBRARY. None of the references we have found deal with the NJ branch of the family. We are wondering if any of the books on your list cover that branch. CSS, NH

A. First, most of the books deal with the Virginia lines. GENEALOGY OF THE TIRRELL FAMILY OF WEYMOUTH MASS by Benjamin TIRRELL is the only volume in our library that is devoted to the New England Branches. Our President, Mr. Don C. TERRILL has added an excellent index to that work. It should not take long to check it. I do not have a copy. The TERRELL FAMILY by Gen. William Henry Harrison TERRELL contains many letters from persons who responded to his requests for information. I do not know whether the index for it is finished. I do not know whether there was any response from NJ descendants. Migration patterns were generally west and south making the NJ TERRELLS more likely to be of the New England lines.

I assume from the information submitted that the marriage of their daughter, Mary B. MOORE in PA occurred about 1830 with her birth listed as 1811. That would place the marriage of Mary TERRELL & James MOORE about 1810 or earlier. That would place the birth of Mary TERRELL 1890 or earlier.

TRAILS, page 194 lists one Adam TYRRELL in Cumberland Co. NJ #2 on Hopewell Township tax list May 1778; one William TYRRELL in Glouchester Co. #15 Galloway Township 1773; another? William TYRRELL in same county Gr Egg Harbor TWP on September Tax list 1773.

TRAILS, page 161 lists several entries for Abraham TERREL in Essex Co NJ #128 Elizabeth Twp 1780 and in Westfield Twp in 1810-1812; Daniel Enoch, Ephraim, Ephraim Jr., & Isaac were in the same townships during the same period.

TRAILS, page 193 lists Ebenezar TURRELL in Essex Co. #28, Newark Twp. Feb 1782 tax list; one N. N. TERRILL, same county, #437 Rahway Twp 1840 and one Nancy TERRILL same county #22, no Twp listed 1840. These are after your MOORE ancestors went to PA, but are included because of a possible connection. Maybe this has narrowed your search some. Good Hunting! DFB


