MEMBERSHIP NUMBERS

There has been some confusion over membership numbers. This has been due to several factors.

First, my computer was set up to automatically assign membership numbers. Unfortunately, this minor convenience turned into a monstrosity. The computer arbitrarily assigned incorrect membership numbers to some members when the list was sorted by zip code for bulk mailing. I changed the data base so that member numbers are assigned manually.

Second, when Mrs. Walker became correspondence secretary and started keeping membership records, she assigned membership numbers and I tried to use her numbers.

Some issues are mailed to libraries, archives, and organizations for exchange and publicity purposes. My data base required that these also have numbers. These numbers change addresses occasionally from one archive or library to another. Since these "members" did not send in dues, Mrs. Walker had no record number for them.

Now that the membership responsibility has been returned to me, I hope these conflicts will be eliminated in the future.

If you have had conflicts in your membership number, please ignore them. They do not affect your status as a member. They do help us credit the proper member when the name or address on a check isn't the same as our records, for example, the check has the husband's name, but the wife is our member and our record is in her name.

We will strive to be consistent in the future. I apologize again for all the confusion I may have caused. DFB

RESEARCH AIDS

THE GOLD BUG; P O BOX 588; ALAMO CA 94507-0588 has several items that may be of interest to you. If you have a computer and modem, they can also be reached via internet at Goldbug@aol.com; through America Online: GOLDBUG; through Prodigy: SGMR50A; or CompuServe: 70303,2363. Phone: 510-838-MAPS.

Their brochure advertises HISTORICAL MAP REPRODUC-TIONS on 8 1/2 x 11 bond paper for 75 cents each. The list is too long to reproduce here. Categories include: Regional (World 1534, Atlantic Colonies 1650, other regions to Lk. MI 1778); Railroads (27); State Maps (1650 Cape Cod to 1922 era); England & Wales; Ireland; Scotland; Europe; France; Germany; Russia & Poland; Jerusalem & Palestine; and others.

The above maps are also offered in sets at prices from \$2.50 to \$12.50. Twenty-six Civil War military map sets are offered in prices of \$2.50 (3) to \$7.00 (13). Seven Railroad sets are offered from \$6.00 to \$14.25. 1885 state maps are offered with a listing of every known place in the state at that time. Each county is listed with population followed by a list of cities and towns giving the county where located and population (if known). Prices vary from \$3.25 for Colorado with 600 places to \$8.25 for Pennsylvania with 4,200 places.

Eighteen colonial and state maps have been enlarged to 11 x 17 as well as 40 city maps with street names and points of interest. These are offered at \$1.25 each.

If you have an IBM PC of fully compatible model with either EGA or VGA display, DOS 2.2 or higher and a hard drive with at least 2.2 MB available (mouse desirable), they offer MILLENIUM version 1.21.

This is advertised as the complete historical atlas of Europe and the Middle East from 1000 to 1993. Maps are full color. Boundaries change year by year as empires rose and fell. Zoom in on 14 levels of enlargement. Use "movie mode" to watch maps change as you go backward or forward in time. Print any map with dot matrix or laser printer. Export as .PCX or .TIFF to incorporate into documents. MILLENIUM has two models: a Working Model covering only 1763-1789 for \$5.00; and the full version \$89.00. They recommend trying the working model before ordering the full version. $3V_2$ " and $5V_4$ "diskettes are available.

For WINDOWS users, they offer AniMap Plus. This is United States historical atlas of county boundaries. Basic program and one region (state group) requires 2MB of hard disk space plus about 1.5 MB for each additional region. Minimum of 2MB RAM; 4MB recommended. Program is \$39.50 for basic package with one region; \$15.00 for each additional region or \$95.00 for the master program and all six regions. (Alaska and Hawaii are not included)

The final offer is SITEFINDER, a database of 190,000 places (cities & towns, plantations, Indian villages, railroad stations, ruins, mining camps, trading posts, country schools, ghost towns, farms & ranches, stagecoach stops, etc). Total of 21MB required for all 6 regions which coincide with AniMap Plus. Latitude/longitude coordinates for 97% of the locations make it possible to plot them with AniMap. Regions are \$9.00 each, \$45.00 for all six.

GENEALOGY? ASK DAN!

Q. Do you have anything in your files that will clear up the apparent conflict between the Solomon TERRELLs listed on PARKER, p. 69 and PARKER p.88 who have different birth/death dates, different children, but the same siblings? We feel that the Solomon on page 88 may be the father of our Joseph TERRELL Sr. (c1755 NC--1843 MS). Copies are enclosed. PIA CA

A. Thank you for including copies of the passages in question. The Lending Library is in Virginia and I do not have copies of either PARKER or DICKEN.

This is the best example I have seen to illustrate the reason for my frequent admonition: PRINTED MATERIALS (including TERRELL TRAILS) SHOULD BE USED ONLY FOR LEADS TO SOURCE MATERIALS. THE FACT THAT SOMETHING IS IN PRINT DOESN'T MAKE IT TRUE!!!

PARKER, page 69, lists Timothy TERRELL & wife Mary MARTIN along with the 14 children named in his will, though they may not be given in the order of age. The first five listed--Jemimah, Ruth, Millie, Solomon, & Micajah b.1746--had already received their allotment of his estate which suggests that they had homes of their own. The remaining children in order named are: James, called Nimrod; Simon b. 1755; Moses; Mary; Elizabeth "Betty"; Keziah; Daniel; Richard; & Aaron. Since the legacies specified that Nimrod (James), Simon, & Moses were not to be turned over until they became of age, we can conclude that these are the younger of the children. References are made to the granting of land to Timothy TERRELL in Deed Book D, page 540 of Orange County; his will dated 9 Feb 1763 naming his wife Mary as executrix; and Deed Book 6, page 305 Rowan County where Mary, widow of Orange County sold John LEWIS 280 acres in Rowan County of Timothy's estate that had been granted to Timothy in 1751 "on north fork of Pole Cat Creek adjoining now William & Jeremiah REYNOLDS ... to John LEWIS line, etc. in a deed dated 16 Sept. 1765, witnesses Nimrod TERRELL, Christopher NATION.

PARKER, page 70, indicates that "Timothy & Mary TERRELL in 1753 deeded 639 acres of land to William REYNOLDS. It has been suggested that Jemimah TERRELL may have married William REYNOLDS but we have made no effort to find out."

[Without access to the original records, it would seem likely that she did and the reference above to **Jeremiah REYNOLDS** is an error either in transcription or typing and probably should have read William & **Jemimah REYNOLDS**.] *DFB*

In 1765, Mary TERRELL appeared in court and exhibited the will, indicating that Timothy was deceased by that time. Three men were appointed to divide the legacy among the heirs named in the will viz. Solomon, Nimrod, Simon, Aaron, & Moses. At that time, all the children were not of age, Moses & Aaron (thought to be twins) chose Isaac BROOKS as their guardian. The report of the division was made in 1768.

[That indicates that the heirs had probably all reached legal age by 1768, making the youngest born by 1747 to be 21 by 1768. The phrase "Moses & Aaron 1775 chose Isaac BROOKS ... may be a typo and possibly should be 1765, but without the court records, it is impossible to be sure. It is odd that Solomon, who had been excluded originally was named in this division. I'd like to see the original will and other documents.] DFB

Also, on 03/20/1768 Nimrod (James) TERRELL sold his brother Solomon the 350 acres of land left to his mother, Mary, during her widowhood.

[This indicates two things: (1) it reaffirms that: **James**, probably the youngest, was of legal age; and (2) his mother had either died or remarried and was no longer entitled to her widowhood estate.] *DFB*

No record of Jemimah, Millie, Keziah, and Richard. Solomon TERRELL lived in Chatham County, was deeded 510 acres of land by his father in 1758, mentioned in the 1763 will as "land that my son Solomon lives on," died by 1775 when a guardian was appointed for is children, Henry age 10, and Abijah. [See next page]

PARKER says Mary TERRELL, dau. Timothy & Mary md. Philemon MARTIN, alleged son of John & Rachel MARTIN. John D. TERRELL referred to her as Molly Phil MARTIN. Daniel TERRELL son of Timothy & Mary md. Hannah THOMPSON, sister of Sarah THOMPSON who md. his brother Simon TERRELL. Daniel died in Chatham County 1786 leaving a will that named his wife Hannah.

[This has no real significance unless some of these names appear in later generations in your line. However it does contain another conflict. See next page.] DFB

PARKER, page 87, begins with William TERRELL & Susannah WATERS of New Kent County VA, not far north of Richmond; ten children, removed to Bladen County included Timothy TERRELL, name of wife unknown [she was Mary MARTIN on page 69] but she may have been a sister of John BROOKS with whom Timothy went south, or a daughter of John BROOKS who arrived in NC before 1735. In that year they [TERRELL & John BROOKS?] removed from Bladen County and took up land in that part of Bladen which was cut off into Cumberland of which the County Seat is Fayetteville (?). In 1749, they were appointed Justice of the Peace in Bladen by a council sitting at Newbern and were renamed in 1750 and 1751.

Timothy TERRELL died in 1763 in that part of Orange County that became Chatham (County site Pittsboro). He left an estate which was administered by his wife (not named) [she was named Mary on page 69] and friend John PILLS (WILLIS?). Six daughters and six sons, not in order.

[There were 14 children on page 69 including Richard and Aaron who are not on this page, although Aaron & Simon appear on page 88 as twin sons of Solomon TERRELL, son of Timothy.] DFB

He lists the second child as Ruth TERRELL who md. her first cousin Isaac BROOKS, son of John BROOKS and his wife Susan (or Susannah) and they had a daughter Sarah BROOKS who md. 05/06/1789 in Chatham Co. NC, Joseph TERRELL, son of Solomon, son of Timothy, as his first wife. Joseph TERRELL md. his second wife in Franklin Co. GA, Ann BLAIR, daughter of Col. James BLAIR, about 1800, and he died about 1812, whereupon she married secondly Oliver Allen ELLSTON and moved to Old Estaboga, AL where both died.

On the next page (88), PARKER lists this same Joseph TER-RELL as the son of Aaron TERRELL (a twin to Simon TER-RELL, sons of Solomon TERRELL) and Hannah THOMPSON. PARKER expanded here on this by calling Col. James BLAIR an aristocrat who ranged over the Carolinas and North Georgia, lived in Franklin Co. and for whom Blairsville in Union Co. [GA] was named. This is the line of Mrs. Charles D. (Elizabeth MORGAN) Wood of Summerville [GA?].

Parker expands on Micajah TERRELL, son of Timothy with the speculation that it was for him that his grand nephew, Micajah MAYO of Jackson & Floyd Counties in GA was named.

Keziah TERRELL, dau of Timothy, is listed as Cizziah on this list. James "Nimrod" TERRELL, son of Timothy, is listed as Himred. Except for a few details on bequests, there is nothing else not included on page 69-70.

On page 88, PARKER says Solomon TERRELL participated in the estate (Timothy's), but to what extent the *Terrell book* does not reveal (Possibly he is citing DICKEN whose work was completed in 1953, or he may have been referring to BARNHILL of 1934, Lynch Moore TERRELL, his cousin Wil-

liam CARROLL, one of the lesser works completed between, and/or Gen. William Henry Harrison TERRELL who did the first work we know of in the 1880s. He doesn't say.) DFB

Solomon was probably one of the eldest children and born about 1725, most likely in Virginia before his parents moved to NC. Very little is known of his early days and the name of his wife is sought. In his declining years, doubtless as a widower who had given his children their part of his estate while he lived, he went to live with his son Aaron TERRELL, in Old Pendleton District (Pickens Co) SC. He died c1812, two years before his son.

[Page 70, says Solomon TERRELL, son of Timothy, died by 1775 when a guardian was appointed for his sons Henry & Abijah. This brings up the possibilities that: (1) the 1812 death date for this Solomon is incorrect; (2) the 1775 death date for him is correct; and (3) the 1775 date for Aaron & Simon choosing Isaac BROOKS as guardian is correct because they were in fact twins (or at least children) of Solomon and not the same ones named in the will of Timothy. The TERRELLS followed the (now frustrating) custom of using the same few names from generation to generation.] DFB

Solomon's children are listed as:

- a. Joseph TERRELL
- b. James TERRELL, RSV & sheriff of Franklin Co. GA, living as late as 1837
- c. Moses TERRELL, probably died in Chatham Co. NC
- d. Micajah TERRELL b. 04/22/1846, md. Hannah GOODMAN who was b. 02/07/1753, believed to be Quaker.

[You are correct, DICKEN, page 236, does list this Micajah TERRELL as the son of Timothy TERRELL & Mary MARTIN. Although either, or both, could be incorrect; I place more credence in DICKEN. Records of that era are few and far between. Family genealogists are human and frequently assign relationships without adequate documentation. DFB]

e. & f. Aaron & Simon TERRELL, twins b.in Orange Co. NC 03/27/1756. Simon TERRELL md. Sarah THOMPSON (b. GA in 1755) and they lived in Franklin Co. GA where he was connected with the court. Aaron TERRELL [page 70 says Daniel TERRELL, obviously one is an error] md. Hannah THOMPSON, who is believed to be a sister of his brother Simon's wife, and died in Old Pendleton Dist. SC in 1814, no will yet found.

All children of Aaron and Hannah THOMPSON TERRELL listed on page 88 are:

William Steele TERRELL, believed to have been named for a prominent man of Old Pendleton District;

Joseph TERRELL, md. Sarah BROOKS, covered in contradiction above;

Moses TERRELL believed to have been born in Chatham Co NC and to have died in Pickens Co. SC;

Aaron TERRELL, no record;

Elizabeth TERRELL md. TAYLOR or MAYLOR;

Nancy TERRELL believed to have married Joseph DAVIS of the Jefferson DAVIS line; &

Sally TERRELL md. Benjamin MAYS. [Line may have continued on page 89, but that page was not provided.]

The William TERRELL (11/1784--1827), son of Simon & Sarah THOMPSON TERRELL, on pages 250-253 of DICKEN is of this same family. It is interesting to note that he also married his first cousin, Sarah KENDRICKS (1797-1862) in Morgan Co. GA 04/06/1817. His wife was daughter of William KENDRICK and his wife Susannah THOMPSON who was also a sister of William's mother Sarah THOMPSON.

His diary (kept between 20 May 1807 & 2 Oct 1809) tells of business with Mr. NAYLOR and Mr. John BOWMAN who married his cousin Elizabeth, daughter of Aaron TERRELL above.

[PARKER says Elizabeth married TAYLOR or MAYLOR above. From DICKEN, it is impossible to tell if William is referring to NAYLOR or BOWMAN as husband of Elizabeth, but from the structure of the sentence, BOWMAN appears more likely since he is listed immediately before Elizabeth. DFB]

He also confirms that Aaron had children: Moses, Aaron, Joe (Joseph) & Sally as cited in PARKER. The diary mentioned Solomon TERRELL, who is thought to have been an older brother of the other cousins [ie, son of Aaron & Hannah. Could this be the Solomon TERRELL who died at Aaron's home in 1812?].

The notebook chronicles the marriage of Joseph TERRELL and Ann BLAIR on Thursday, 20 Oct. 1808 and that of Thomas HOLLINGSWORTH and Amelia TERRELL (William's sister) on Tuesday 1 Nov 1808.

In response to your question about the possibility that John TERRELL, son of William and Susannah, might have been the father of your Solomon but he somehow didn't get listed with the others: it is possible, but highly unlikely. I believe the will of that John TERRELL has been located (or a transcript of it) and it names all his children as listed. Items #7 & #168 in the LENDING LIBRARY deal extensively with this John TERRELL and his descendants. Unfortunately, I do not have a copy of either. John had sons born about 1732, 1733, & 1735 who could have been old enough to father your Joseph by 1755 or so.

I have tried to examine the conflicting information you provided as objectively as possible. I don't have any information to clear up your questions, so I'll ask another far out one. Is it possible that Ann BLAIR md. a HEWITT before she md. Joseph TER-RELL and thus became Anna HEWITT? With the contradictions we have just examined and the lack of information available from that era, it would not have been hard for both PARKER and DICKEN to miss a previous marriage for her. DFB

He worked with transit company.

The said Raymond Lloyd KIRBY, Sr was the child of John Marshall KIRBY born on 05/15/1860 at Heltonville, IN; died at Heltonville, IN on 07/01/1928 and his 2nd spouse: Ora Anna WHALEN born on 09/30/1871 at Carlisle, Sullivan, IN, died at Heltonville, IN on 05/14/1948; married on 12/17/1879 at Lawrence County IN. He was county assessor.
- 4. The said John Marshall KIRBY was the child of William KIRBY born on ca1829 at IN; died at Camp Wecklif, Louisville, KY on 03/04/1862 and his spouse: Rebecca C. ANDERSON born on 02/11/1831 at Heltonville, IN, died at Hamilton, MT on 02/25/1925; married on 09/05/1850 at Lawrence County, IN. He was a farmer.
- 5. The said William KIRBY was the child of John KIRBY born on 11/12/1802 at Bourbon, KY; died at Lawrence County, IN on 09/06/1887 and his spouse: Phoebe TERRILL born on 07/23/1807 at Madison County, KY, died at Lawrence County, IN on 03/01/1879; married on 01/24/1828 at Lawrence County, IN. He was a farmer.
- 6. The said Phoebe TERRILL was the child of Edmund TER-RILL born ca1775-1784 at KY or VA; died at Lawrence County, IN before 12/10/1828 and his spouse: Sarah STEPHENSON born ca1776-1780 at KY or VA, died probably at Lawrence County, IN after 1830 census; married on 03/25/1794 at Madison County, KY. They resided in Madison County KY and Lawrence County, IN.
- The said Edmund TERRILL was the child of Unproven parents.

TERRELL/FORD/ COMPTON/BURNETT

Although this information is a little garbled, it is generally supported by the little data I have been able to collect. Several family letters suggest a connection between the family and Rahway. There is a FORD historical mansion near Warren, but I have been unable to find out more.

"My beloved mother [Harriett Stackhouse COMPTON Burnett] born 1808, died April 1901. Her mother, Ruth TERRELL
Compton, was born in 1775... She was daughter of Judge TERRELL of Plainfield, New Jersey [probably actually Warren
Township, Somerset County], and sister of Thomas TERRELL,
a prominent farmer. Mother's mother, or Ruth TERRELL
Compton, said she had seen her mother many times step on the
darkies' hands as they lifted her into the saddle. She was quite
a rider even into old age. Her name before she married Judge
TERREL was FORD, a prominent name in the history of New
Jersey."

"Mother's father, [Joseph?] COMPTON lived at Perth Amboy. His brother was a sea captain. On the return of Capt. COM-PTON, he brought yellow fever with him. Grandfather COM-PTON, after his brother was taken down with the fever, superintended the unloading of the vessel, and he took the dread disease and died. Grandmother, Ruth TERRELL Compton, being used to aristocratic ways, never having worked much, could not take care of her large family. So her brother Tommy TERREL took her and her children to his home. Mother was the youngest of the little family."

"Mother remembered the return of the New Jersey troops from the war of 1814. As one regiment came by, Tommy TERREL went into his cellar and brought out an abundance of wine for them to drink and fruit to eat..." Journal of Louis Compton Burnett, in press)

"On the other side of Mt. Bethel Road near Rt 78 was the farm of Thomas TERRIL. The land was originally taken in 1730 by Ephraim MARTIN who married Phebe SMALLEY, an aunt of John SMALLEY. At some point in the late 1700s his farm was bought by Thomas TERRIL of Rahway who married Mary DUNN and had eight children. Thomas was a judge and the first town clerk of Warren in 1806. His son, Squire, was a judge, justice of the peace, and Township Committeeman. He married Rebecca KIRKPATRICK and lived on a farm until his death in 1867. George inherited the house and land and his brother lived across the river. Their sister, Margaret, was a devoted member of the Baptist Church. William RALPHS bought the house and lived there from 1909-1923." (Tomblin, Barbara, Villages at the Crossroads: a History of Warren Township, 1806-1976)

Tyrrell's March

By Don C. Terrill (#144)

"Tyrrell's March," is it possible? Yes, there really is such a piece of music.

A 1930 book about Canadian Joseph Burr Tyrrell (1858-1957) carries a short genealogy of his family in the appendix. Part of that history includes the following:

Amongst his descendants one of the most noted was Captain Richard Tyrrell, who defeated Barnwell at a place called Tyrrell's Pass. He was one of the few, if not the only member of the Tyrrell family who fought against English rule in Ireland. In 1595 Hugh O'Neill, Earl of Tyrone, made an offer of Ireland to the King of Spain and began a rebellion, which lasted ten or twelve years and was chiefly directed against the Protestant rule of Queen Elizabeth over the Irish people. O'Neill persuaded numerous gentry to join his cause and one of the most capable was Richard Tyrrell. In the year 1597 the Earl of Tyrone dispatched him with four hundred men to act in Leinster and Munster when he heard that the English were preparing to advance into Ulster.

The Anglo-Irish of Meath, one thousand strong, assembled at Millingar under Barnwell, Baron of Trimlestown, with a view to joining the Lord Deputy. Tyrrell, having encamped in Fertullagh was joined by O'Connor Failly, and Barnwell dispatched his son to take them by surprise; but Richard Tyrrell, making a feint of fleeing, drew him into a defile, and posted half his men in ambush in a hollow at the side of the road; when at a given signal — the playing of Tyrrell's March — Tyrrell attacked in front and Failly in the rear. Only one soldier escaped, and young Barnwell was taken prisoner.

The site of this fight is known as Tyrrell's Pass [now Tyrrellspass] to this day. After the rebellion was over Richard Tyrrell retired to Spain. (W.J. Loudon, A Canadian Geologist [The Macmillan Co. of Canada Ltd., Toronto, 1930], pp. 199-200)

Miss Alma Brooke Tyrrell of County Durham, Ireland, writing in the December 1985 edition (p. 85) of the newsletter of the Tyrrell Family History Society (T.F.H.S)(U.K.) said:

In Fertullagh today, people tell how the battle of Tyrrellspass began with the sound of drums and pipes



playing "Tyrrells March." They remember the rose that the lady of Castle Lost threw her husband as he marshalled his horsemen for the fight, how he wore the rose all that summer day in 1597 until he returned only to find that she was dead, fallen from the battlements. The hero of the battle, one of frightful carnage, was Captain Richard Tyrrell, born in Spain in 1545, a valiant commander for over a decade in the wars against Queen Elizabeth and her Irish plantations. The Battle of Tyrrellspass was fought to prevent a thousand crown forces from joining others gathering to invade the Ulster territory of Hugh O'Neill. The victory contributed to O'Neill's triumph at the Battle of the Yellow Ford near Armagh. Immediately after O'Neill sent Tyrrell with two- thousand cavalry to sweep through the midlands to Munster. The war, successful for the Irish, went on for another four long years until they were defeated at Kinsale. Even then, the Chieftain O'Sullivan Beara held out at Dunboy, with Tyrrell supporting him in the mountain passes above Killarney until the end of 1602. The O'Neill war ended with the Treaty of Nellifont early in 1603.

In December 1981 the T.F.H.S. published some of the sheet music to "Tyrrell's March" in their newsletter. Sometime between March 1981 and March 1985 the founder of that Society, John E. Tyrrell (1908-1992) was able to get the Pipe Major of the Irish Guards to record the march onto tape. I have obtained copies of both, courtesy of the T.F.H.S., and I am printing the sheet music below. The march was written for bagpipe, and so the recording is of a bagpipe. Although no fault of the musician, I must say with candid honesty that the music is dreadful. "Tyrrell's March" is destined to remain a historical curiosity rather than something you will hear on your local FM station.

Kitty Tyrrell or Is It Kathleen? (continued)

In the Summer 1995 edition of *Terrell Trails* (pp. 940-942) appeared my story about competing 19th century Irish folk songs similarly named "Kitty Tyrrell" and "Kathleen Tyrrell." They had different lyrics, and the "Kitty Tyrrell" lyrics were published without sheet music.

The Tyrrell Family History Society (T.F.H.S)(England) has brought to my attention that the song was written for Kitty (Mather) Tyrrell, wife of James Tyrrell of Clonard, (Ireland) (1687-1768). This family was the Tyrrells of Grange Castle. There is mention made of this song at page 43 of J.H. Tyrrell's 1904 book A Genealogical History of the Tyrrells. The question has been: What is the correct version and melody? The T.F.H.S. has turned up another variation of the melody from an 1859 book of Irish melodies, and I have turned up another from an 1804 book with the incredible title of: O'Farrell's Collection of National Irish Music for the Union Pipes, Comprising a Variety of the Most Favorite Slow & Sprightly Tunes, Set In Proper Style & Taste, with Variations and Adapted Likewise for the German Flute, Violin, Flagelet Piano & Harp, with a Selection of Favorite Scotch Tunes, Also a Treatise with the Most Perfect Instructions Ever Yet Published for the Pipes, (London, 1804), p. 17 (Brit. Lib. [music] b.115). The "Union Pipe" is an Irish bagpipe. I am printing the 1804 music below to add to the general mayhem.





A Sketch of the Life of Robert Adam Terrell

by his son W. A. Terrell

Written October 9, 1941

Robert Adam Terrell was born in Murphysboro. Tennessee on February 22, 1820. A few years later his father and family moved to Boonville, Missouri. Just when R. A. Terrell moved to Texas is not known. but it is known that he came with an older brother. George Whitfield Terrell, who was Attorney General of the Republic of Texas during the second administration of Sam Houston, beginning in December 13, 1841 and ending December 9, 1844. During this time, R. A. Terrell was Deputy Surveyor of Nacogdoches County, and led a colony of Pioneers from San Augustine and Nacogdoches to what is now Kaufman County, Texas. These colonists had land certificates issued by proper State Authorities. R. A. Terrell as deputy Surveyor located these Certificates, giving metes and bounds. There was among these the following men: John Moore, Joe Love, Dr. Gant, Jim Alexander, William Ervin, two of the Paschalls, Laroe and others. This was done in 1844, R. A. Terrell locating for himself land on which a part of the town of Terrell is situated. He first built a log cabin with dirt floor; in 1845 he built a log cabin with pucheon floor.

In March 1846, he went to San Augustine and married a Miss Emily Love. To this union were born 6 boys and 3 girls. The first, a boy, died at the age of 16, another boy died in infancy. The other children lived to raise families of their own and today their children are scattered from the Panama Canal in the southeast to Colorado in the Northwest.

In 1848 Kaufman County was organized and the county seat was located where the town of Kaufman now stands. The village was called Bloomfield but

later changed to Kaufman.

I heard my father say that he had killed a bear that had climbed an oak tree about 100 yards in front of the house and that he had killed deer and

turkey without leaving the yard.

Just before the outbreak of the War between the States, the logs for the foundation of the Octagon house that still stands (and is now the dining room for the Terrell Military College) were cut and hewn. but on account of the War the house was not finished for three years. In 1845, Texas having willingly joined forces with the U.S., R. A. Terrell in 1861 thought Texas had its right to withdraw or secede from the Union, so he joined the Confederate Army. He was made Quartermaster of He served 4 years with its Parson's Brigade. hardships and dangers. He had as brave and courageous men under him as ever breathed, and many times they surprised and captured larger forces, together with supplies of food, clothing, and other stuff intended for Northern forces which they needed but not as badly as the Southern forces. The War over, he returned him where the house, started years before, had been finished.

In 1866 his Wife, Emily L. Terrell died on June 26. On April 9, 1868, R. A. Terrell married Nancy Amelia Terrell, widow of Jonathan W. Terrell J. O. Terrell and Ann Amelia Terrell were children of Jonathan

W. and Ann Amelia Terrell.

At that time R. A. Terrell had built a Flour Mill, Grist Mill, Saw Mill and Gin on Camp Creek, a few miles north of Rockwall. After Pa's marriage the older girls and the children lived in Rockwall and attended school. A few years later we moved to Tehuacana. In 1872 the T. & P. Railroad was built and the town of Terrell started. One of the early business houses was moved from Poetry by ox-cart. It belonged to J. V. Durham who operated a grocery Then came Rushing Bros. Dry Goods. Mucklerov & Martin and others.

The Telegraph wires from Shreveport to Dallas joined at Terrell, and R. A. Terrell was asked to send the first wire to Dallas. He sent the following quotation: "United we Stand, Divided We Fall" to the Mayor of Dallas, who signed as Mayor of Dallas and sent to the Mayor of Houston. This order was continued to many cities, finally the Mayor of New York returned it to my Father. The town grew rapidly and in a few years became quite a trade center.

On April 1, 1880 Whit and I moved to the farm just east of what is now Royse City. On March 8, 1881, R. A. Terrell passed away and his body lies in the Cemetery just west of the town of Terrell. One of God's noblemen is gone. While many of the Terrells have sought and secured political honors, he did not run along that line, but he was always ready to express his views and vote his sentiments.

If you wish to trace his ancestors back in the dim past, you will find they hobnobbed with the aristocratic nobility and even sat down with Kings and Queens. But, in their aristocracy he was not interested, but honored them for their courageous

acts and noble deeds.

On October 16, 1894 Nancy Amelia Terrell, second wife of R. A. Terrell and Mother of J. O. and Ann Amelia Terrell passed away -- A good woman who "Did what she could."

The children and step-children of R. A. Terrell carried on. On June 21, 1913 they had a Reunion in Royse at the homes of J. W. and W. A. Terrell. For four days there were many instances of the past recounted. Outstanding among them were: while each one of us had seen the others many times, it was the first time we had all been together at one time at the same place for forty years. All nine of us had married and had families of our own. One had been married 45 years and the youngest 30 years. and the remarkable thing about it was that not one of us had lost our companion. Again, to these nine families had been born 50 children, and only 6 of these had passed away. But, since that time the Grim Reaper has been busy. All but 3 of the 9 Terrells are gone; all their companions but one, Florence Terrell (J. W. Terrell's Companion) still The 3 left are: Mrs. Lela Terrell Toone, lives Brownfield, Texas, J. R. Terrell, Lorenzo, Texas, Crosby County, and W. A. Terrell, Royse City, Texas.

The principal part of this "Sketch" was written on October 9, 1941, by W. A. Terrell on his 81st Birthday.

. . . .

Since writing a Sketch of Pa's Life two months ago, I have received information which should come before what I have already written. I am listing it below:

Grandfather and Grandmother

James A. Terrell and Penelope Lynch Adams were married in the year 1798. To this union were born nine children.

The above information was received from Fannie Huffmaster Newell of 1626 Hemphill St., Ft. Worth, Texas. From an old Book with the back and some of the leaves missing, but published in 1854, I learn that **G. W. Terrell** was Attorney General of Tennessee before coming to Texas, was Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of the Republic of Texas, and appointed Special Envoy to the court of St. James. Through his influence Great Britain, France and Spain recognized the independence of the Republic of Texas.

This old Book also states that **Bob** and **Kit Terrell** lived in San Augustine and roamed the pine clad hills of East Texas while still in their teens.

Ex-Congressman George B. Terrell of Alto, Texas in an article in the Dallas News stated that his Grandfather, G. W. Terrell, had been Associate Justice and Secretary of state before becoming Attorney General of the Republic of Texas.

NOTES

The original typewritten manuscript is on file at the Terrell Public Library, Terrell, Texas. The City of Terrell, Texas was named for Robert A. Terrill.

The following was added by Mr. Jeddie M. Terrell (#221), who was born in Terrell, Texas, and who is descended from the Georgia Terrells (Joel Higgins Terrell Jr. [1823-1859]):

About 1840 Robert Adam [Terrell] was in the Santa Fe territory at the request of General Sam Houston as Surveyor for the Republic of Texas. The family of Robert Adam does not like the term "spy" applied to him and so I won't use it, but General Houston had requested that Robert Adam give him reports on the activities of Santa Anna, who was rather unhappy over his loss of Texas, and was trying to (unsuccessfully) gain political and financial support to raise another army. Robert Adam placed himself inconspicuously in the area as a surveyor while carrying out this commission.

Robert Adam Terrell and Jonathan W. Terrell were cousins and lived next door to each other in Kaufman for several years. Emily Love Terrell and Nancy Amelia (Love) Terrell were sisters and daughters of Judge John Love of San Augustine, Texas.

George Whitfield Terrell was Attorney General for Tennessee when Sam Houston was the Governor of Tennessee and became Attorney General of the Republic of Texas when Sam Houston was its President. George W. was a very strong advocate for the Republic and dearly loved it. Houston sent himto Europe as a Special Envoy to the Court of St. James to gain recognition of the Republic of Texas in the World Court of International Settlements and in that effort, was successful. While George W. was in Europe on his mission, Sam Houston was striking up a deal with his

old friend, Andrew Jackson to admit Texas into Statehood which was done. When George W. returned and found out what Houston had done, he was so angered that he walked away from Houston and never spoke to him again for the rest of his life.
