



Adaline LITTLEJOHN (Charles4, Ignatius3, Charles2, Marcellus1) was b. on November 28, 1828 in Spartanburg District, South Carolina. She moved to Union District with her parents and siblings in about 1840. About 1849 she moved to Benton County, Alabama with her parents and siblings. She met Nelson CASTLEBERRY in Benton County. They married on September 13, 1849 in Benton County. Nelson was b. about 1818 in South Carolina d. only eleven months after their marriage August 1850. They had one child:

According to Mae PIKE Carr, S. P.'s granddaughter, he didn't like his initials A.S.S. So he made up his own initials S. P., Mae couldn't recall if they stood for anything. He moved to Benton County, Alabama with his parents in 1847.

He married Adaline LITTLEJOHN on December 20, 1853 in Benton (now Calhoun) County, Alabama. She was b. on November 28, 1828 in Spartanburg District (now County), South Carolina. Adaline is the daughter of Charles and Vianna DRAPER Littlejohn, widow of Nelson CASTLEBERRY.

During the Civil War "S. P." enlisted as a Private in a Company from Calhoun County commanded by Captain **Robert Wilkins DRAPER** (Adaline's uncle). He enlisted on May 27, 1862, at Oxford, Calhoun County, Alabama. Dudley SNOW, a local pioneer, was instrumental in the Companies organization. The Company assembled and camped on Mr. SNOW's land while training. On August 11, 1862 at Oxford, Calhoun County, Alabama "The Dudley Snow Rangers" Company, designated "D" Company, and several other Companies formed the 51st Alabama Cavalry "Partisan Rangers" Regiment commanded by Colonel John T. MORGAN of Dallas County, Alabama.

On May 3, 1865 at Charlotte, North Carolina "S. P." was one of the men paroled in accordance with the terms of a Military Convention entered into on the 26th day of April, 1865, between General **Joseph E. JOHNSTON**, Commanding Confederate Army, and Major General **William T. SHERMAN**, Commanding United States Army in North Carolina.

They continued to live in Calhoun County, Alabama until at least the late 1880s. S. P., Adaline, Willis and Sam, moved to Texas in the late 1880's or early 1890's. Also two daughters, Viney and Nan, and their families moved to Texas. They lived in Hamilton County, Texas until about 1905. In about 1905 they moved to near Iredell, Bosque County, Texas. They lived with their daughter, Nan PIKE. Adaline d. on May 11, 1908 near Iredell, Bosque County, Texas. She is buried at the Riverside

Cemetery in Iredell. **S. P.** d. about 1912 near Iredell, Bosque County, Texas. He is also buried at The Riverside Cemetery. SP and Adaline had six children before the Civil War. The names of these children are:

William LITTLEJOHN (Charles4, Ignatius3, Charles2, Marcellus1) was b. on October 10, 1833 in Spartanburg District, South Carolina. He moved to Union District with his parents and siblings in about 1840. In about 1849 he moved to Benton County, Alabama with his parents and siblings. He met a Georgia girl named Rebecca COCHRAN in Benton County. William and Rebecca were married on December 24, 1857 in Benton County. Rebecca was b. about 1834 in Georgia. They had one child that I know of: Mary Jane LITTLEJOHN.

William enlisted May 27, 1862, at Oxford, Calhoun County, Alabama, in the Confederate Army for 3 years or the War. He was recruited by his uncle, Robert DRAPER, the Captain of a Company know as "The Dudley Snow Rangers".

William was captured on June 27, 1863 during the Battle of Shelbyville at Liberty Gap. He was held prisoner at Nashville until July 3 at which time he was transferred to a Military Prison near Louisville, Kentucky. On July 6 he was transferred to a Prisoner of War Camp in Ohio. He reached Camp Chase in Ohio the next day July 7, 1863. On July 14 they sent him to Fort Delaware. Fort Delaware was a mosquito-infested Prisoner of War Camp on a marshy piece of ground called Pea Patch Island in the middle of the Delaware River. He arrived at Fort Delaware on July 20, 1863. All of the prisoner's clothing was taken from them and given a shirt and drawers of coarse texture. There were 12,500 prisoners on the island in August 1863. Sometime after arriving he contracted small pox and died October 29, 1863. I do not know what became of Rebecca and Mary Jane. I suspect that Rebecca remarried and might very well have moved away.

William married **Rebecca COCHRAN** on 24 Dec 1857 in, Benton, Alabama, USA.

In about 1849 he moved to Benton County, Alabama with his parents and siblings. I do not know if Tom served in the War. I have not come across anything as of yet that would lend to that. Tom married Mary Jane ROBERT-**SON** on January 7, 1866 near Cross Plains, Calhoun County, Alabama. Mary was b. on November 25, 1839 in South Carolina. She is the daughter of Thomas & Drucilla Ann DUNCAN ROBERT-**SON**. According to census records and family stories Tom was a farmer. Some of the land Tom inherited from his father was donated for a cemetery. This land is located near Alsup in Calhoun County. The cemetery is known today as Littlejohn Cemetery. Some kind of epidemic must of occurred in 1874. Tom and Mary lost three of their children within a couple weeks. Elba (3 years and 8 months) d. September 24, 1874, Tommie (5 years and 9 months) followed 9 days later on October 3, 1874 and 4 days after Eddie (1 year and 7 months) d. on October 7, 1874. Tom d. on July 11, 1897 near Piedmont, Calhoun County, Alabama. He is buried at the Littlejohn Cemetery near Alsup. Mary d. on November 22, 1894 also near Piedmont. She is also buried at the Littlejohn Cemetery.

From: Sherry Trebus strebus@austin.rr.com Marciamy Mom remembered quite a bit - many stories about the old people, how they all came to Redden, OK, Aunt Mandy (as my mother and grandmother called her) Amanda SNOW Littlejohn was married to my grandfather's grandfather - Richard Berry LITTLEJOHN. Mom said that the Snow's had moved to Oklahoma - Choctaw County to a place called Goodland, near Hugo. My gggrandfather's brother R. E. (Uncle Ras) LITTLEJOHN had moved his family from Chicota Texas to Goodland. They became good friends with the Snow family. Uncle Ras's son William Pinckney (John) began dating William Elisha's (Snow)'s daughter Pearl. My grandfather and his family came to visit - and he met my grandmother. All moved to Redden during WWI - while my grandfather was in France. He and my grandmother were married in 1918 when he returned. Uncle John married Aunt Pearl - their children are double cousins. Many Snow and LIT-TLEJOHN kin are buried at Redden. So that was how Aunt Mandy and my gggranfather met. My Mom tells the story that they began going fishing together - and love bloomed over a cane pole!Elmira (Taylor/ Snow, the mother of Amanda F Snow LITTLEJOHN) had her own tomb stone. She is buried next to Aunt Mandy and GGGrandpa LIT-TLEJOHN.

SIMPSON BOBO WILKINS

A native and life-long resident of Spartanburg County, the late **Simpson Bobo WILKINS** spent practically his entire life in the town of his birth, Cowpens. Only during the last two years prior to his death was he a resident of Spartanburg, where he had important business, financial, and property interests.

Simpson **Bobo WILKINS** was educated in the public grammar and high schools of his native region. In early life, he engaged in farming and the mercantile business. He acquired large agricultural holdings which he managed with outstanding success and unusual ability for many years.

At Cowpens, Mr. WILKINS had been successfully and extensively engaged for many years in farming, the general merchandise business, operated a flour mill and a sawmill. He dealt on a large scale in lumber. He furnished all the lumber used in the construction of *Converse College*. He organized the *Security Bank* of Cowpens and served as its president for many years. He was director of the *Central National Bank* of Spartanburg and a large stockholder in other financial institutions of Spartanburg. He was known as one of the most successful and largest planters, merchants, and lumbermen in this section of South Carolina and for many years was also an important figure in banking circles. His integrity, his ability, and his public spirit had gained him an enviable reputation and had made for him a large number of friends.

In Cowpens, he was one of the most active members and the most generous supporters of the Baptist Church. In Spartanburg, he attended Central Methodist Church.

A number of years before his death, he disposed of most of his plantation by will to his children except for 1500 acres which he retained until his death. He invested in real estate holdings in Spartanburg to which he moved about 2 years before his death. Mr. WILKINS married twice. By his first wife (not named), he was the father of several children including: 1. William WILKINS of Tryon NC: 2. John WILKINS of Goucher: 3. Mrs.

KINS of Tryon NC; 2. **John WILKINS** of Goucher; 3. Mrs. **William POTTER**, wife of a well known wholesale grocer of Spartanburg & Cowpens; & 4. Mrs. **William MOORE**, a resident of Cowpens.

Mr. WILKINS m. (2) 04/26/1905 at Woodruff SC to Mary Kate SWINK, dau. of Jesse L. SWINK & Margaret, BISH-OP. By the second marriage, he had one daughter, Catherine B. WILKINS who was b. 10/11/1907 and is a graduate of Hollins College in VA.

Simpson Bobo WILKINS died 05/09/1922 at his home at 350 East Main St. in Spartanburg SC. He was in his **68th year** and

had a prolonged illness. Funeral services were held at his residence. The remains were then taken to Cowpens where services were held in the local Baptist Church. Both services were conducted by Dr. W. B. BALL, pastor of the First Baptist Church of Spartanburg. Mr. WILKINS was laid to rest in the Cowpens Cemetery. His memory will long be cherished by all who had the privilege of knowing him and most by those who knew him best

In addition to his widow and children, he was survived by one brother, **Ball WILKINS**, president of *Mary Louise Mills*, and by several sisters.

Mrs. Mary Kate SWINK Wilkins was the daughter of a prominent planter and a veteran of the War Between the States where he served in the Confederate Army. She belongs to an old and prominent southern family dating back to Colonial days. She is eligible to membership in the Colonial Dames and is a member of the Daughters of the American Revolution and of the Spartanburg Woman's Club. After her husband's death, she continued to live in the residence. [Apparently she was still alive in 1934 when this book was printed.]

The WILKINS family is of great antiquity in ENGLAND. It was founded in this country by three brothers--Peter Andrew, Tbomas, and John WILKINS, all sons of Captain Robert WILKINS of the English Navy and his wife, Margaret HUBBARD, of Essex, England. Thomas & John WILKINS settled in upper Norfolk County Virginia in 1637.

The direct ancestor of Simpson Bobo WILKINS, Peter Andrew WILKINS, came to Virginia in the seventeenth century and died there in 1648. The line is traced through: son, William WILKINS; grandson, also William WILKINS; great grandson, Robert WILKINS who d. in VA 1735, m. 1719 Bridger[t?) HAYNIE (a dau. of Richard HAYNIE, Sr. member of the House of Burgesses of VA); gg grandson, John WILKINS b. Converted by her future husband to the Protestant Episcopal Faith, she married in spite of her father's objections. **William TERRELL** was the son of **Capt. John TERRELL** and his wife

Lady **Ann JOHNSTON**, a niece of **Lord ASHLEY**, Lord Proprietor of North Carolina. Capt. **John TERRELL** was a captain in the Royal British Navy and was Lord Proprietor of the holdings of the Earl of Shaftesbury in the Colony of South Carolina. He was killed in 1692 at the battle of Newport in Flanders and never came to America to see his domam. [Either that death date is a misprint or he was nearly 80 years old when he participated in the battle if he sired William in 1635. DFBI

IL--18 Feb 1924 Helena MT) practiced law, Philipsburg, MT; m. 17 Jun 1896 in Petersburg, Menard, IL **Alice Jeanette KNOWLES** b. 1864; RODGERS biographies follow.

William Baker Rodgers came to Montana and began the practice of law more than a quarter of a century ago. During that time, one of the most important honors and remunerative positions in the profession have been accorded him. He is a former United States District Attorney for Montana. For many years he has been counsel for the Anaconda Copper Mining Company. His home is at Anaconda, but as counsel for the corporation he maintains his chief offices in Butte.

Mr. Rodgers was born in Coles County, Illinois. His paternal ancestors were Scotch-Irish and settled in North Carolina in colonial days. One or more of the family were Revolutionary soldiers. Mr. Rodgers' grandfather, John W. Rodgers was a native of Alabama, but early in the nineteenth century moved to Illinois and became a pioneer farmer in Coles County, where he died. His wife was Lovisa BALCH, a native of Kentucky. John White Rodgers, father of William B. was born in Illinois in 1828 and spent his active life in Coles county where he died in 1884. He was a very zealous and devout Presbyterian and elder in the church for many years. Politically, he voted as a Republican. His wife was Margaret Elizabeth Gillenwaters, who was born in Illinois in 1838 and died in Coles County in 1887. They had five children. The oldest, James Farnsworth, was a graduate of Rush Medical College at Chicago and practiced medicine for many years. He died at Bowling Green Kentucky in August 1918. The only daughter, Mary Livonia, is the wife of Dr. L. W. Bunnell, a physician and surgeon at Trenton Missouri. The three younger sons, William B., Hiram W., and Henry G., are all well known Montana lawyers, the first at Butte, the second at Anaconda, and Henry G. at Dillon.

William B. Rodgers was educated in the rural schools of Coles County. He grew up on his father's farm, attended Lincoln University at Lincoln, Illinois, and then entered Cumberland University at Lebanon, Tennessee, graduating in the law department and with the LL. B. Degree in 1891. In University, he was a member of Alpha Tau Omega Fraternity. Soon after graduating, Mr. Rodgers came to Montana, practiced at Phillipsburg one year, and in 1892 was elected county attorney, moving his home and office to Deer Lodge in January, 1893. He was county attorney for 2 years. In 1894, he was chosen joint representative for Deer Lodge and Missoula counties, being elected on the republican ticket. He was a member of the important legislature of the fourth session, and there served as a member of the committees on judiciary, ways and means, state board and offices, code and other committees. Mr. Rodgers continued his practice at Deer Lodge until 1897, when he accompanied the county seat on its removal to Anaconda in that year. In the fall of 1897, he was appointed assistant United States attorney for the Montana District. In 1898, he was appointed United States attorney, and for four years had charge of all the litigation in the Federal

Courts of the state. On retiring from that office, he resumed private practice at Anaconda, and soon after was made local counsel for the Anaconda Copper Mining Company. In 1909, he was promoted to general counsel for the corporation with headquarters in Butte, where his offices are in the Hennessey Building.

During 1901-02, Mr. Rodgers was president of the Montana Bar Association, and for six years he was vice president from Montana of the American Bar Association. He has always been a steadfast republican in politics, and is a member of the Presbyterian Church, and is a member of the Deer Lodge No. 14, Ancient Free and Accepted Masons, Deer Lodge Chapter, Royal Arch Masons, and Deer Lodge Commandery of the Knights Templar, also Helena Consistory No. 3 and Algeria Temple of the Mystic Shrine at Helena. He is a member of Montana Lodge No. 13, Knights of Pythias, at Anaconda, and belongs to the Anaconda Club, the Silver Bow Club at Butte, the Lambs Club at Helena, the Anaconda Country Club, and the Rocky Mountain Club of New York City.

June 17, 1896, at Petersburg, Illinois, Mr. Rodgers married Miss Alice Jeanette KNOWLES, daughter of W. D. and Elizabeth SHEPHARD KNOWLES, both now deceased. Her father was an Illinois farmer. Mr. & Mrs. Rodgers have one daughter, Margaret Elizabeth, now nineteen years of age. (Source: Montana, Its Story & Biography, Vol. II, editor Tom Stout, The American Historical Society, Chicago & New York, 1921, page 523-524.)

A similar biography with the following differences: William B. & Hiram W. called their law firm Rodgers & Rodgers. William B. is the owner of one of the finest and largest private libraries in the state, aside from his professional library, which in view of his fondness and that of his wife and daughter for good literature, is an especial pleasure to him. Mrs. Rodgers is a member of the Presbyterian Church in which she takes an active interest, and shares in all the labors of that organization. She is a woman of wide culture, devoted to her home, and deeply interested in Mr. Rodgers' success to which she has contributed in a large measure. Obituary from *Montana Standard*, Dec 31, 1941: Anaconda, Dec. 30. -- Hiram W. Rodgers, widely known pioneer attorney and counsel here for Anaconda Copper Mining Co. died this morning in his apartment in the Montana hotel. He was 76.

His sudden death came as a shock to a legion of friends in Anaconda, where he practiced law for about 45 years and the news will be received with profound regret by friends and acquaintances in Philipsburg, Deer Lodge, Butte, and other parts of Montana.

The death was discovered about 1 o'clock this afternoon by Wilbur Davis, manager of the hotel, who investigated when it was learned that Mr. Rodgers had not left his room during the morning.

Mr. Rodgers had not been seriously ill, but during the last few days he remarked to friends that he "was not feeling well." He had been ailing for more than a year.

Mr. Rodgers was born in Janesville, Ill. He attended schools there and graduated from Lincoln College in Illinois. He completed his education as an attorney by working in various law offices of Illinois.

He and a brother, W. B. Rodgers, came to Montana about 50 years ago to engage in practice as lawyers in Philipsburg. About 45 years ago, they moved to Anaconda where they continued practice. W. B. Rodgers died in Helena about 15 years ago.

Another brother, Henry G. Rodgers is state district judge at Dillon. Judge Rodgers is visiting in California at present.

Hiram W. Rodgers served as a representative from Deer Lodge county in the Montana legislature about 30 years ago. He was a prominent member of the Montana Bar Association, the Third Judicial District Bar Association; and Mason, Elks, and Odd Fellows lodges.

Mr. Rodgers was also a member of Montana Commandery No. 3., Knights Templar, and Bagdad temple of the Shrine, both of Butte.

Surviving relatives in addition to Judge Rodgers follow. His sister-in-law, Mrs. W. B. Rodgers and a number of nephews and nieces in Dillon and in the east.

The body is at P. J. Finnegan mortuary. Arrangements for the funeral had not been completed this afternoon.

MANY FRIENDS HERE

Hiram W. Rodgers had may friends in Butte and visited regularly with Mr. And Mrs. W. G. Montgomery, O'Rourke apartments. Mr. Montgomery said Mr. Rodgers had been ailing slightly over a year but continued his weekly visits to Butte until about six months ago.

They as well as may other friends and attorneys in the city were deeply grieved by Mr. Rodgers' death.

Henry Gillenwaters Rodgers was born in Coles County, Illinois, July 5, 1871 and had his home there until he was fifteen years of age. During this period, he the attended public schools of his native county. He went to Lincon (IL) to college and remained there for two years. After that, for seven years, he worked extensively in Illinois, Missouri, and Iowa, following various occupations.

He earned his first money as a boy at the age of nine, as a watch boy on a farm, receiving ten cents a day. While attending school in Lincoln, he earned his own way by working at various jobs. At ten years of age, he worked with a team on his father's farm. At twelve years of age, he and another boy put in sixty acres of wheat without outside help. He never was afraid of work.

In November, 1895, Mr. Rodgers came to Montana, settling first at Deer Lodge. He remained there until the spring of 1898, at which time he accepted a position as clerk to the United States attorney in Helena. It was while in this office that he studied law and was admitted to the bar in Helena. He held his clerical position until 1908 and then came to Dillon where he began the practice of law. Two years later, in the fall of 1910, he was elected county attorney of Beaverhead county, and is now filling that office.

Mr. Rodgers is a Republican and is active in politics. He is a member of the Christian Church. He belongs to the Masonic order, to the Modern Woodmen of America and the Eagles. He has been through all chairs in the Woodmen's order and at present is past consul; has passed the chairs of the Eagles and is now past worthy president, as well as a member of the Independent Order of Redmen, and the Beaverhead Social Club. He is fond of baseball and an enthusiastic rooter. He is also a devotee to good books. He has worked his way upward absolutely through his own efforts.

Mr. Rodgers was married August 13, 1909 at Livingston, Montana to Miss L. Brittamna Adams, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Adams of Livingston. There is one child in the household, Henry Rodgers who was born May 20, 1907.

Mr. Rodgers' father was John Rodgers, who was born in Illinois and lived there all his life, where he followed farming. He died in 1883, at the age of fifty-three. His mother was Margaret Elizabeth GILLENWATERS Rodgers, who was born in Illinois and died in 1884, aged fifty. The father and mother are buried side by side. There were six children in the family of the elder Rodgers, five boys and one girl, the subject of this sketch being the youngest child. Mr. Rodgers has two brothers in Montana as follows: William B. Rodgers and Hiram W. Rodgers, both practicing law at Anaconda. The latter is now a member of the Montana legislature for Deer Lodge county. "Rich" WILKINS: Noxubee Co MS Dist 5 1860 slave list, owned 5 slaves. [TT p. 1113, "Rich" is probably short for Richard. I do not have anything to tie him to William & Betsy TER-RELL WILKINS. I am including this here in case you can tie him in. *DFB*]

Peter Hurtle HARRIS was born May 10, 1865 at Cadiz, Trigg County, Kentucky, and he died two weeks after his wife died.

Peter died February 10,1953 in Mt. Vernon, Illinois. He was a Baptist Minister for many years and was also a carpenter. They lived in Cadiz, Kentucky and Martin, Tennessee, and perhaps other locations, but they settled in Mt. Vernon, IL. Peter was baptized in July of 1885 in Blue Spring Creek at Cadiz, Kentucky. He married November 17,1892 to Commie Zell WIL-KINS, born February 15, 1874 and she died January 29,1953. Commie was born in Cadiz, Kentucky and was the daughter of Nathaniel Branch and Harriet (WILES) WILKINS. There were no dry eyes on this sad occasion; even the writer, whose lot it has been to witness many death room scenes, could not repress tears. Deceased leaves not only a bereaved husband, but also three nice pretty well grown up sons, and last, though most lamentable of all, two little twin daughters, aged two years.

Sarah Ellen Terrell was the mother of **Richard Gray TERRELL**, my great grandfather. She was the daughter of **Joshua Perry TATUM** and **Sarah Elizabeth VARDEMAN Tatum**, alll of Arkansas.

Hope you are doing well. We are all hanging in there. We still haven't completely slowed back down into Granny gear yet. I guess it will be awhile yet before we can accept the slower pace. We still miss Aunt

Snookie, & **Huburt** (Pa) badly, but it's getting easier. We've been busy getting Huburt's estate settled and all the hoopla that goes with it.

We haven't had a lot of time for genealogy, but I manage a look every now and again. I have had my head buried in **Francis Oliver TIRRELL**'s Spanish American Military file for over two weeks now.

I'm working on the transcriptions for the file. It covers the years of 1899 - 1950, 3 years after Francis's death.

Francis mother's name was **Louisa** (I suspect Louisa **QUILLEN**). She was the first wife of Charles P TIRRELL, then came **Sarah** (**Unknown**), and then **Eva KISSINGER**.

Then there were all the names of his and Martha LYKINS children and their birth dates and death dates. Francis was actually born in Fletcher Co., Kentucky near Whitesburg. He states that repeatedly in the military file. So, looks like the 1870 Kentucky, Fletcher Co., Census I asked you about a while back was them. But the thing that impressed us the most or I should say blew us away was finding the Odom Funeral Receipt showing he was actually buried at the Pyron Cemetery. We were 99% sure he was there, even had headstones placed last summer, but that was just the icing on the cake. His mother, Louisa, her name is on the request for military burial form. That form was filed by his daughter Mattie Lou TIR-RELL Gooch.

According to his military file he moved to Mineral Wells, Palo Pinto Co., Texas in Feb of 1905 from Rowan Co., Kentucky; although his P. O. address before the move was Paragon, Morgan Co., Kentucky. It doesn't say why, but I suspect for the 'healing powers' of the mineral springs there. Seems like he suffered from several maladies, including catarrh, lung disease, bad kidneys, double hernia, malaria, and the effects of measles. He had a hard time proving it though. He first filed for a pension in 1904, and finally got it in about 1926 after the intervention of a U. S. Senator, or Representive. I'm having the file copied for Mildred Lykins at the moment, so I don't have it right in front of me and it should be ready tomorrow afternoon. There were about 310 different pages in the file and about half of those are copied on the front and back. There were about 50 pages that had two or three records copied onto them. I never in my wildest dreams expected it to be that large or have so much info in it and I'm only about half way through it; closely reading every word, instead of glancing through as I did when I first got it.

Well it's getting late and I have an early morning. You take care and keep in touch. I keep you in my prayers!
