Michael, I happened to be working on George W. TERRELL's line tonight and found the following that might interest you. I have reworked it from the GED-HTM format, but all the info is there. In case you want to chase it some more on this site, the URL is:

James TERRILL s/o Margaret WILLIS & Edmund TERRILL was born on 22 Jan 1779 in Virginia. He died in 1834 in Boonville, Missouri. James married on 16 Jun 1798 in Boonville, , Missouri Penelope ADAMS.

"Thanks for your attempt at help. If had gotten the first names right -- it would have helped you. Barbara's sister was married to a **Robert Jones GILCHRIST**. **Barbara** was married to **George Whitfield TERRELL**.

I have gotten undocumented information that George Whitfield TERRELL's - Father and mother was James TERRELL, 1-22-1779, born near Lynchburg, Virginia, d abt 1871; married Penelope ADAMS 6-16-1798 children listed for James TERRELL and Penelope ADAMS as:

1) George Whitfied TERRELL, a lawyer, b 1809, (?); Attorney General in TN, came to TX in 1840; he had a close association with Sam HOUSTON. He was married to Barbara CULP, (date) unk. He died 13 May 1846. I think his wife Barbara CULP may have died???? because I found a marriage record in a book compiled by Edythe Rucker Whitley, Baltimore Genealogical Publishing Co., Inc.

1982 - Marriages of GIBSON County Tennesse 1824-1860. George W. TERRILL to Ann BELL, Sept 5, 1839. (Sept 5, 1839). James M. TERRILL, BM. I do know that he had a wife by the name of Ann who came to TX, what happened to wife Barbara between 1833 and his marriage to Ann Bell in 1839. (I located a marriage of Mrs. Ann TERRELL 7/23/1849 in Cherokee County, TX to a J. C. HARRISON. (George Whitfield TERRELL died in 1846 in Houston County, TX). The reason that I know he was married to Barbara (Culp) is because he and Barbara are listed in a court document in 1833 (I have a copy) where they; and one of Barbara's sister Drucilla CULP Gilchrist was listed along with 6 of their minor brothers and sisters. Their father **Daniel CULP**, died in May 1833, GIBSON County, TX. I believe George Whitfield TERRELL and Barbara may have had one son named James TERRELL. born abt 1831, in TN - This James TERRELL shows up on an 1850 Cherokee County, TX census record living with Barbara CULP's brother Daniel D. CULP. It shows him as 19 years old and born in TN, and a student (his father had died in 1846). Since, I have gotten my material and information straight, do you have any information that would help resolve who his wives were and who his children might be?

- 2) Capt. **Robert Adams TERRELL** (b 2-22-1820 and died 3-8-1881 in Terrell, Texas. He was the founder of Terrell, Texas. Married Emily **LOVE**.
- 3) Dr. Christian TERRELL (born and died no dates). Married (?)
- 4) **Susan/Susannah TERRELL** (no dates of birth or death). Married (?)

**Penelope ADAMS** s/o **Mary Lewis TERRILL** & **Robert ADAMS, III** was born about 1779 in , Campbell Co., Virginia. She married **James** 

**TERRILL** on 16 Jun 1798 in Boonville, , Missouri.

I got this email 3/99 and, as a result, have placed Penelope as a child of this: couple. This is pure conjecture, and needs to be investigated and proven.

Re: Robert ADAMS m. Mary Lewis TERRELL. His death date in 1790. Died while visiting sister Mildred Ward. You are missing two of the children, Penelope ADAMS b. abt 1786, named in Will. Mary Terrell ADAMS b. 1787 supposedly never married. Also named in will.

Re **George ADAMS** (Judge) m. \_\_\_\_\_ **WISSIGER**. He married **Ann WISSIGER** from Louisville KY, d/o of **Daniel** 

RE **Milly ADAMS** m. \_ **WEBB**. She married **George Webb** of Amherst Co.

Mary Lewis TERRELL Adams moved to Amherst Co after the death of Capt. Robert ADAMS in 1790. There she raised the younger of the 12 living children.

Mary Lewis TERRELL Adams (wife of **Robert ADAMS** died 5 Oct 1852 in Campbell Co Va.

I am REALLY curious about the **Penelope ADAMS** you have b. abt 1779 m. **James** Terrell Adams, Penelope (~1779 - ) - female b. Abt 1779 spouse: TERRILL, James (1779 - ~1871) - m. 18 Jun 1798; children:

TERRILL, George Whitfield (~1809 - 1846)

TERRILL, Susannah "Susan" (~1813 - )

TERRILL, Christian (~1815 - )

**TERRILL, Robert Adams** (1820 - 1881)

If I have from granddaughters of Robert Adams and set forth in a manuscript done in early 1900 stated Penelope never married, but I had some doubt about that. Here we have a Penelope Adams m. to a TER-RELL in 1798 and with a child, Robert Adams Terrell. Do you know where you found that info. I think this is the Penelope, one in the same. Do you have a place of marriage?

There is almost no way for one to be named Penelope Adams and with a child

named Robert Adams for her not to be the daughter of Robert Adams and Mary Lewis Terrell. I see you don't have parents for her. I wonder. Just food for thought? Karen

Thanks Dan, I appreciate it. I have seen Mr. Wayland's website, and have tried to email him with updated info, but it bouces. Do you know Mr. Wayland.

These emails are interesting, and in fact I have seen this inference that **Barbara** [Ann] CULP died and **George W. TERRELL** remarried Ann BELL. This is not **George Whitfield TERRELL** who married Ann BELL. The G. W. TERRELL who married Ann Bell was **George Washington TERRELL** of Gibson Co. TN. He was many years younger than my G.W. Terrell, although, at first I thought the same. On many records they both used "G. W. Terrell" making it even harder

to figure out who is who - and frankly - I could have mistaken them in some instances - that is why in my manuscript I stayed away from Gibson County - although my TERRELL did have at least business there and was licensed to practice law there. Do you think I should put reference of that in my book?

After the exhaustive research I have done - I discovered the common mistake and hopefully this myth can be disiminated over time. For yours and the Society's records [or for further inquiries from other researchers] Barbara CULP survived George W. TERRELL and in fact lived until sometime after the 1870 census when she was living with her son **Sam Houston TERRELL**, but before the 1880 census when her and Sam Houston TERRELL were both dead I have narrowed his death year based on one of his sons Bios for congress to 1876. His bio said his dad died when he was 13. On the 1880 this son was 17, [that son being George Butler TERRELL].

Anyway - the absolute proof that it was **Ann CULP** on the 1870 census is found in the *Diary of Adolphus Sterne, Hurrah for Texas*. On several entries he

notes that "Mrs. TERRELL and her sister, Elizabeth CULP" did whatever..... [depends on the entry].

One other thing I noticed - James TERRELL married Penelope LYNCH in Campbell County VA on the date you give - it's recorded there in a marriage book [ not Missouri] in fact they did not move to MO until 1833 and James TERRELL died in 1834 there. Penelope then moved to Iberville Parish Lousianna. It is there that son Robert Adams TERRELL was appointed by the Gov. of La. to a position [I don't recall exactly now] because of strings pulled by his uncle Christopher ADAMS (Penelope's brother).

I never have figured out where she died. One would have to assume Louisiana since that is the last known place she was. I did locate on of the siblings of G. W. TERRELL getting married in Boone Co. that has otherwise been unaccounted for as well! Maria M. TERRELL married a man last name VAUGHN.

**Barbara Ann CULP Terrell** remarried after **George Whitfield TERRELL** 's death in 1849 - I have the exact date in the manuscript - to **Joseph C. HARRI-SON** - a man quite a bit younger than herself. He died in Nov. 1855 and she remained a widow until her death after that.

Anyway - only thought you might like those tidbits. If anyone contacts you about this line of Terrell's, please feel free to send them in my direction. You may also note beside George W. in your records the book I mentioned - as it is a great source for East Texas and TERRELL [the Adolphus Sterne Book]. However it is out of print now and they have to be found used. I got one from Barnes and Noble for 35.00.

I have dilly dallied around now for several years and never gotten my application to you for the society. I will finish that stuff up in the next week or so and drop it in the mail with the specified amount of money. {please forgive me}

I really do thank you for remembering me to forward this info. When I send my info - I will try and send a flat file for you, with the names, dates etc of what I have on all James and Penelope ADAMS Terrell's descendents. From them back - is widely known - I think. There are all sorts of clues in various letter I have either from James TERRELL to Gen. John COFFEE when he mentions his brother in law Robert ADAMS, or from G. W. TERRELL to James POLK when he speaks about his moms 1st cousin,

Gov. Charles LYNCH of Mississippi. As for James and his parents - you know as well as I that the only solid evidence as to who his parents were is the letter from Robert Adams TERRELL to Gen. W. H. H. TERRELL that you sent me a few days back that clearly states that Dr. Christopher J. TERRELL was James' brother and 2 of his sons had come to Texas; Alexander Watkins TERRELL of Austin and Dr. J. C. TERRELL of Ft. Worth. Based on that we then know that the parents of James were Edward TERRELL who 1st married Mary JOHN-**SON**, 2<sup>nd</sup> **Jane JOHNSON**. Strangely enough - I never have figured out why Edward did not list James on his will? Any thoughts on that? Also - I don't know where I found it, but I have a birth date of James TERRELL of 22 Jan. 1779.

Apparently James was not a Quaker - perhaps that is why he is not mentioned!

Well - that's about it for now Dan - again, my humble thanks for you

# JOSEPH TERRELL Lauderdale Co. AL

Joseph and Tabitha HILTON TERRELL arrived in Lauderdale County, AL 22 April 1822 from Lancaster District, SC, via Montgomery Co. TN. Joseph served in the War of 1812 in the Company commanded by Captain DOUGLAS in the Regiment of Col. MONTGOMERY. He was honorable discharged 13 March 1815 at Charleston, SC. Joseph was the son of Richmond TERRELL, a lieutenant in the South Carolina Militia during the Revolutionary War: Tabitha was the daughter of Jeheil and Hester HILTON.

Joseph and Tabitha settled northwest of Rawhide (now known as Cloverdale) to rear their children: Calvin, Eliza, Pinkney, Darthery, Manurva, Sylvanus, Richmond B., Wyatt Monroe, William Carroll, Joseph Calhoun, Doctor Hilton, James Bear and Andrew Jackson. Joseph died 29 April 1837 in Lauderdale County, AL. Tabitha filed for Widows Bounty Land Grant in 1850 in Lauderdale

County, AL. Tabitha moved to Hinds, MS in her later years to be with her sons **Pinkney** and **William Carroll**.

**Sylvanus TERRELL** died in 1863 at Rock Island Prison. Col. **MEIGS** had instructed the Quartermaster to build this Yankee prison on the Mississippi River, as cheaply as possible. Many Confederates died there.

Calvin TERRELL married Matilda THREET, daughter of Sarah SHELBY and John THREET, 20 April 1835. Children: Jack Wesley, Joseph C., Pinkney Ashe, Richmond Bluford, Sara Elizabeth, Thomas and William Perry.

Calvin, a farmer, decides to move his family to Arkansas but returned to the Threet area. Matilda died of Typhoid Fever while crossing the Tennessee River in a covered wagon. Calvin married Catherine BLALOCK, daughter of Jesse BLALOCK. Children: Roseanna, Dennis, Angeline and Steven Calvin.

Calvin died of pneumonia in 1864.

Richmond Bluford TERRELL married Mary (Mollie) MOSS, daughter of Margaret L. PENNEY and Joseph L. MOSS. Children: Thornton Cox, William Powers, John R., Beulah, Andrew Hudson and Roxie. After Mollie died, Richmond married Mary RYAN, widow of John MC DONALD. Richmond moved his family to Olive Hill, TN. Richmond and Mary Ryan's children were: Lizzie Mae, Robert Lee, Nannie Josephine, and Myrtle Estelle.

Thornton Cox TERRELL married Ann E. NICH-OLS of Colbert Co. and they had two children: Mazzie Bell and Emanuel Boyce (Brice). Ann died and Thornton married Lizzie Dee ARNOLD, daughter of Nancy CLARK and Ivy Eli ARNOLD. Their nine children were Lucien Clyde, James Homer, Roxie Bernice, Lillie, Myrtle, Nellie, Edgar, Ethel and Lorene.

TERRELL TERRELL married Myrtle SMITH, daughter of Beulah TAYLOR and Stanley Lewis SMITH. Beulah TAYLOR was the daughter of Millie FRANKS and Abison, a Choctaw Indian who changed his name to Tom TAYLOR. James Homer died 5 April 1936, during the "Tupelo Storm", a tornado that wreaked havoc from Tupelo, MS through west Lauderdale County, AL. James Homer and Myrtle had three children: James Homer, Jr. Wil-

liam Howard (Buddy), and Frank David. James Homer Jr. married Eva Lee COLEMAN, Children: James Howard and Timothy Wayne: William Howard married Doris Elizabeth SHARP, Child: Cheryl Denise; Frank David married Judy Ann KIMBROUGH, Child: Tina Liana TERRELL.

# EDGECOMB CO. NC TERREL BURIALS

#### James Bynum Graveyard

My ancestors owned this farm at one time. A black family owned the farm next to it. For some reason or another, the families decided to switch farms. While doing research on my family tree (Varnell), I decided to record the information in this graveyard, located in a field near the old home my Great Grandfather was born in. The people buried here are of African American descent.

**Alonzo TERRELL**; B 9-17-1921; D 8-12-1977

**John TERRELL**; B 1-1-1896 D 5-31-1949 North Carolina PFC QMC World War I

I do not have any personal information concerning this graveyard and the relationship of the people there. There are at least 5 or 6 unmarked graves at this location. The unmarked ones are cemented over graves with no gravestone or the type where the paper has dissolved. James Bynum (buried here) has a living son named James Bynum who probably still owns this property. Sorry I cannot provide more information.

Here is what I stumbled across on the BRUCE connection. Obviously, I don't have any idea if this line really hangs together. it was pretty easy to find mistakes in the BRUCE line, even though the general

outline after it hits the BRUCES is good (a good example is that **William the lion** was **Isabel**'s uncle, not father, & there are some mistakes because full names were repeated over & over in the BRUCE lineage). spelling is terrible.

I'm very skeptical but interested. Too many people seem to want to find important people in their family tree, so they jump to conclusions that aren't there. I just wanted to find out where my immigrant ancestors came from. When I started, I literally had no clue where & when any of them came from except for a great-grandfather who came here before the civil war. My dad started & I inherited his material & tried to move his research forward.

#### ONE ROYAL CONNECTION

What I've done myself has been slow & tedious, but rewarding. but I've found people who have well researched different branches of my family tree, so I've amassed a lot.

I have to go back 7 generations to tie into the TER-RELL line. I've been aware of **Sarah TERRELL** for several years, but only recently began finding lineages for her. John Chamless - dmncartoons@dallasnews.com

## GENEALOGY? ASK DAN!

Q. I have been working on the TURL tree and have come across an interesting little fact: James TURL born ca1801 in Devonshire, England (his father was James born abt 1775 and his mother was Mary Ann WILSON). They had the following children: Elizabeth, Mary Ann, James, William, Francis (Frank), George, Sarah and Amey. They all came to America...This is known.

Now I have a **James TURL** born about this time -- *same* siblings...who were all born in England and their lines run out in England. No further trace of them. However I have (and it's proven ) different parents for James.

It seems very odd to me that two families would have children born at the same time with the exact same names.

Here is what I think. I think that they are the same and that James TURL married to Mary Ann WILSON who came to America with his family is the same James TURL on my line. I think the confusion comes with the first James TURL who is thought to have married Mary Ann Wilson and the second James TURL who married Mary Ann Cellaos Wilson, (I think those two May Anns are the same person married to James TURL born Mar 06 1803). The names are just too exact and it is just too much of a coincidence that an entire family line would just disappear without a trace! Please tell me what you all think. **A.** Brenda, The odds of two men with the same name marrying wives with almost the same name and having the same number of children with the same names

in the same order are about equal to the odds of winning a national lottery. It is not impossible, but I would have to *see it to believe it*.

As to whether the two Mary Ann WILSONs are one and the same, I dare not reach any conclusion based solely on the information in your e-mail. *Mary Ann* is a very common given name. WILSON is one of the top ten surnames in the USA and probably in England as well. In either country on any given year, there probably were many Mary Ann WILSONs. You can add the fact that *James* is probably the 3rd or 4th most common male given name in the T\*R\*L lineage, soon after the most common, *William & John*.

In the 17-1800s, men usually married "the girl next door," or at least one who lived within a 5 mile radius because he could not do a day's work, go courting, and get back home in time to start the next day's work at dawn from any greater distance. His mode of transportation was limited to foot or horseback.

Neighboring families tended to intermarry for generations if they stayed neighbors that long. "Double" cousins show up in almost every family tree.

It is just as likely that James the son, and James the father, each married a Mary Ann WILSON as it is that the same Mary Ann has been assigned to both the father & the son.

How much faith I could put into the linking of either couple would depend upon the quality of the evidence that you refer to as "proof." For example, if it is based solely upon entries found in the International Genealogical Index, I would hesitate to believe *either*. If I had a parish register verifying one marriage and the IGI for the other, I would believe the register, and still doubt the IGI, etc.

We tend to think that there are more persons of the TURL (or whatever) surname today than there were 200 years ago. We tend to think of "our ancestor" as an "isolated island" in the sea of those who had the surname. In 22 plus years, I have run across many who claimed an ancestor with no more evidence than the mere fact that he had *the right name combination in the right time frame*. The truth is, "It just ain't so!"

A thorough investigation of the census of the USA for any census year will reveal many persons with the same name combination in different states, a much smaller number within any given state, and some-

times several within the same county precinct. The same is probably true for England as well, but I cannot be certain because I do not have either access to, or experience with English records.

The "gem" that I found most interesting in your email is the name of the wife, Mary Ann Cellaos WILSON. Cellaos is probably a surname; one that would Americanize to something like SELLERS or SEE-LAY-US depending upon the pronunciation. In that era, boys were often given only one name. Girls were frequently given the full name (including surname) of the ancestor of whom she was named to honor.

The question raised by the name combination is: "was she the wife of a WILSON who had the maiden name of CELLAOS; or was she WILSON daughter who was named for her ancestor, Mary Ann CELLAOS?" Unless you already have the answer to one or both of these questions, you have a clue worth researching. Solving that riddle may lead to the proof that you need to determine whether the Mary Anns are the same, or if each James married a Mary Ann WILSON.

I didn't mean to write a book. I look forward to serving you. *DFB*

Hello Dan,

I recently started digging around on TERRELL ancestry on behalf of my mother **Pat TERRELL** in New Orleans. She received a family tree from her cousin, **Paul NEWFIELD**, that shows we may be descendants from Richmond I from Kent/New Hanover, VA. (I bet every query believes that's the case). The tree she has is from the BROWN/TERRELL line. Her grandfather was **John Lyle TERRELL** (1862-1908), married to Louise **Marie FORTIN** 

(1865-1918). His father was Joseph Oscar TER-RELL, married to Eugenie RAMOUIN. Joseph's father was John TERRELL married to Eugenie LAMBERMONT in 1823. Supposedly John's father was Richmond TERRELL (1759-1815) married to Sarah LISLES. I think they had 3 children, Rebecca (married Nathanial CROPPER, then James JOHNS), John (my line), and Richmond. I think Rebecca may be connected to the Rebecca plantation in Wallace, LA.

John and Joseph TERRELL, my great and gg grandfathers, resided in Iberville Parish around what is now the St. Gabriel and Plaquimine area of LA. If I go back to the 1770s, the only assumption I come to is that John TERRELL (b:1707) to William and Susanna WATERS, has several bastard children (from Elizabeth HARRISON) One sketchy tree on the web has that he had 2 sons, Richmond and John. I know this is a leap but the trail up turns cold.

I cannot locate any records on a **Richmond TER-RELL** (or **John** or **Joseph**, for that matter) residing in Louisiana. Records from Iberville Parish seem to be scant.

My mother has a raised, but very curious, eyebrow over this and I am hoping to give her a Christmas surprise with some information. She is going to the TERRELL plot in St. Louis cemetery in New Orleans to jot down names and dates.

My name is Karen Manasco from Alabama. I saw your posting on the Ancestry.com site. Hope you don't mind my writing you, but I am trying to find out information about my Grandmother who was **Bettie Viola TERRELL** born between 1867-1870, died 1898, supposedly after giving birth to her last child, **John D. Terrell MELTON**, who was born on Christmas day. She married **William Henry Harrison MELTON** born 1867, died 1916.

They had the following children:

Mollie Viola MELTON, Henry Wiley MELTON, Emma M. MELTON,

**Carl Delmar MELTON** (who was my Dad; he was born in 1893 and died in 1965, when I was only 3 yrs. old), and then

John D. TERRELL MELTON. All I know about her parents is that her fathers name was HENRY and her mother was called BABE TERRELL. I have found where John Dabney TERRELL and his wife, Elizabeth, had a son named Henry born about 1846, but I don't know if this is Bettie's father or not. I thought maybe if you have a lot of TERRELL information, you might could help me. I would appreciate it very much. I have an Aunt Ruth who is 98 yrs. old, told me that all she could remember the boys saying was that their Mother (who is Bettie) was buried outside of Guin, Alabama going toward Hamilton, Alabama, in a little cemetery. I have checked those two at Pikeville, but could not find her grave unless it is unmarked. My grandfather is buried at Siloam Baptist Church Cemetary in Fayette County, just outside of Winfield, Alabama, as is his parents. I

just thought that maybe the names being similar in the two families, it has to be somewhere down the line.

You never said where **Bettie Viola TERRELL** was born, so I have assumed it was Alabama. Have you ever found her in a census? Where was she born? I cannot find a match in my database.

The circumstances you described are suggest that she was a daughter of Judge **John Dabney TERRELL** (1804-1885) of Marion Co, Ala.; however, his children were:

Medora Ann TERRELL (b. 1840, Ala.),

William Tazwell TERRELL (b. ca. 1841, Ala.), Rosabella Antoinette TERRELL (1841-1905); Isabella TERRELL (b. ca. 1843); Sarah Catherine TERRELL (b. ca. 1845, Ala.); Mary Louise TERRELL (b. ca. 1848, Ala.); and Henry Clay TERRELL (1848-1873).

Bettie/Betsy can be a nickname for "Elizabeth." I did find an **Eliza Viola TERRELL** (b. 1874, Coosa Co, Ala.; d. 1958), but she married **Thomas Wesley WILSON** in 1895.

In the 1880 census of Marion Co, Ala. (p. 80D), there is a **Betty TERRELL** (b. 1870, Ala.), daughter of **Soney TERRELL** (b. 1842, N.C.). In 1880 this family is listed as white, and in 1900 this family is listed as black

(Ala., Marion Co, Hamilton, ED 58, S 6, L 42). He is living near the descendants of **George Washington TERRELL Jr.** (1813 to 1850-60), but does not seem to be one of them.

Soney's children are:

Henry (b. 1867, Ala.),

**Betty** (b. 1870, Ala.),

Florence (b. 1872, Ala., Alabama (b. 1877-79, Ala.),

**William W.** (b. 1882, Ala.),

Ella (b. 1882, Ala.), and

Lanny (b. 1884, Ala.).

The U. S. census is full of errors, and the "race" may be one of them. I'm sorry that I cannot find a match in my database. Don C. Terrill

Don, Thanks for answering. I see the Henry Clay TERRELL son of John Dabney TERRELL was only 25 when he died. He is the one I thought might have been my grandma's father. Do you know if he ever married or had any children? And the Soney TERRELL you mentioned, another lady told me she thought he might have been my grandmothers father, but how did they get Henry out of Soney? And I am white! I know there are a lot of black TERRELLs in Marion County. I really don't know where she was born, maybe Marion County, Al. I think my grandpa was born in Georgia, William H. MELTON, but not sure. Would the courthouse in Hamilton let me look through old census records, etc? Keep me in mind if you should come across anything in the future. Thank you, Karen

You asked if I have found **Buck TERRELL** in the Census. Yes, I have in 1920 in Marion Co. and 1930 Marion Co. His Children from his last wife, **Mattie Anglin, Lizzie, Felon, Fannie, Charlie, Leonard, Lois, Cecil** will show up in the 1930 census.

He came to Marion Co. from Marshal Co. He was in Marshal Co. for several years. I haven't been able to locate anything on him from there, but his first set of children by **Fannie**, was **Joseph Emmet**, **Hattie**, **Laura**, **Buck Jr**. They lived in Arab for several years because he ran a boarding school for poor people at least that what we were told.

He came from Cleburne Co. We believe that his father was **Joseph TERRELL** or **Joe TERRELL**. We don't have the dates on Joseph or Joe. **Buck TERRELL** died in 1934 and was buried at New Hope Cemetery in Marion Co. I have found where he died in Tuscaloosa, which this is true. 1934.

Regarding **Buck TERRELL**. I have no CHARTED Terrells who match your description. The closest I have is **William L. "Buck" TERRELL** (b. 1849 Marion Co, Ala.; d. 1891 Marion Co, Ala.) married Eliza **A. CANTRELL** (b. 1851 Ala.; d. 1906). Their children:

William Thomas TERRELL, Permelia M. TERRELL, John TERRELL, Robert Houston TERRELL.

Looking through the 1880 census, I find a **Buck** living in Calhoun Co, Ala., age 50 (b. 1830 Ga.) wife **Fannie**, age 19 (b. 1861, Ala.) with son **Joseph** age 2 (b. 1878 Ala.) Buck's parents were born in S.C.

Looking through the 1900 census, I find a **Buck** living in Marion Co, age 48 (b. 1852 Ga.) no wife, son **Buck**, age 16 (b. 1883 Ga.), daughter **Hathe**, age 15 (b. 1884 Ga.). Also in the household is **Joe TER-RELL** (relationship not stated) age 22 (b. 1877 Ga.) and **Belle** "wife" (probably of Joe) age 16 (b. 1883 Ala.). This is almost certainly the Buck TERRELL who was living in Calhoun Co in 1880.

I found no likely matches in Cleburne or Marshall Co, Ala., for census years 1850, 1860, 1870, 1880, or 1900.

#### THE COLONIAL TERRELLS

Exactly when **Richmond** and Elizabeth settled in Virginia I do not know, but it would, of course, have

been before 1656 when **Richmond Jr**. was born in New Kent County.

William, the head of our line of TERRELLs, was born in 1659. Jamestown, on the James River, had been settled in 1606, Williamsburg in 1632, and Richmond in 1637. New Kent County was chartered in 1654, so the area was not a wilderness at the time. New Kent was established as a ideal port on the York River for the shipping of tobacco, which tells us something of the business of the area. It is beautiful forested country with rolling hills and large rivers and small streams. Richmond died between 1667 and 1683; he and Elizabeth are buried in New Kent County. At some time, the TERRELLs became Quakers and the early family history is documented in the local Meeting annals. Many of them remained Quakers and some returned to the Anglican/Episcopal Church. William married Susanna WATERS before 1690 when their first child, William Jr, was born. Susanna was probably a relative of his mother, Elizabeth. They had nine children, all of whom grew into adulthood!

Our line follows John, their sixth child. All of Susanna's babies except Henry, their fifth, were born in New Kent Co., but none of them died there! Susanna was a Quaker. William died in 1743 and he and Susanna are buried in Hanover County which was their last home. He was 84 years old.

I found you and the fact that there was a TERRELL Soc. of America a minute ago on the Terrill page of Genealogy.com. I find I have two TERRELL lines. I descend from **David TERRELL** and **Agatha CHILES**; David son of **William TERRELL** and **Susannah WATERS**. I've known that for many years. I am now trying to get my other Terrill line straight and hope you can help me.

I understand that my ancestor John "Renta" BAKER married Elizabeth TERRELL ca 1754 in Chowan Co. N.C. Another source states that Elizabeth TERRELL was the daughter of James Nimrod TERRILL is 1720. James Nimrod TERRILL is supposed to be the son of a Joseph TERRILL, son of Timothy TERRILL and Elizabeth FOSTER. Is my information at all accurate? In reading my old TERRELL files I find there is much debate on the parents of Timothy who married Elizabeth Foster as well as his birth date and place. It is very confusing. Can you

Suzy,

Timothy TERRILL (b. 1656 London) and Elizabeth FOSTER had a son Joseph (b. 1699 New Kent Co, Va.), of whom little is known. He seems to have had at least four sons: Joseph (1744 to 1787), Timothy (d. ca. 1809), Obediah (b. 1742), and William (d. bef. 1812). *I am not aware of a son James*. Most of the descendants of Timothy Sr. settled in Orange Co, Va.; and many of them subsequently migrated to Garrard Co, Ky., and to Missouri.

The only James "Nimrod" TERRELL of whom I have record was the son of Timothy TERRELL (1705-10 to 1763 New Kent Co, Va., to 1763 Orange Co, N.C.) and Mary MARTIN (ca. 1713 to aft. Feb 1763). This James was b. 1744 and d. Jan 1826 at Carnesville, Franklin Co, Ga. We know that he was called "Nimrod" because he is called by that name in his father's will (Orange Co, N.C., Will Book A, p. 29). That the **James TERRELL** of Franklin Co was the same James (son of Timothy) is not "proved", but Dicken (1952) felt this was probably the same man (Dicken p. 247). His death notice, which appeared in 1826 did not mention a family, and I have not yet connected any children to him (although it is possible). (Marriages and Deaths 1820 to 1830, Abstracted from Extant Georgia Newspapers, Mary Bondurant Warren & Sarah Fleming White [Heritage Papers, Danielsville, Ga., 1972], Lib. Cong. F285.W3, p. 124.)

Although I was not able to find your James TER-RELL, I have found another person researching this same line: Bonnie Jean (Baker) Miller, 948 Kern Street, Kingsburg, CA 93631, Tel. 559-897-1674 (bmiller@theworks.com) (information current as of Sep 2001). Unfortunately, I don't think she has yet discovered the parents of James.

I am providing a copy of your query to Dan Brinson in Georgia, who runs the day to day affairs of the TERRELL Society, to provide you information on membership.

Nimrod SANDRIDGE (1832 to 1865) married Eliza Jane TERRELL (1826 to 1916) in about 1864 at Marshall Co, Ala. Nimrod was the son of Nathan SANDRIDGE and Catherine MODENA. I have the names of two children said to be Nimrod's; however, one of them - John Peyton SANDRIDGE - was born in 1869. His daughter was Pearl SANDRIDGE (b. 1897). I have good data on Eliza's TERRELL ancestry, but nothing more on Nimrod's ancestry. Don C. Terrill

Don, Have you acquired any info on parentage of **Hezekiah TERRELL**, born 1801 in Virginia? He first appeared on record in Morgan Co., KY in 1826 marrying **Amelia LITTLE**. They lived in (what is now) Wolfe Co. KY. They both died there after 1870 and before 1880. I CANNOT get any further than this. Thank you for any clues. **Madge Tate**, Rome, GA. mtate032403@aol.com

Madge, I have a little bit of data on **Hezekiah TER-RELL** of Morgan Co, Ky., but I don't yet have a clue as to his parents. In various other records, the name is spelled **TERRILL**. This being accurate, Hezekiah is the descendant of **Timothy TERRILL** (b. 1656, London) who settled in New Kent Co, Va. in the 1690s. However, Hezekiah's birth (ca. 1801) is too far removed to make him the son of Timothy. This Timothy had a son named Timothy (b. 1702) who is believed to have been living in Orange Co, Va. in 1742, and of whom nothing else is known. This Timothy could not have been the father of Hezekiah, but could have been his grandfather.

Among the thousands of **Timothy TERRILL's** descendants, the name "Timothy" is used only twice - as I have named above. "**Hezekiah**" is not used at all. Among the descendants of **Richmond TERRELL** (b. 1624, Reading, England) "**Hezekiah**" appears 9 times.

If we can assume that "TERRILL" is the correct spelling, your Hezekiah was very likely born in Orange or Albemarle Co, Va. The naming of his son as "Timothy" hints that Hezekiah was the grandson of Timothy TERRILL (Jr.) b. 1702. Don C. Terrill

(1) **Gladys TERRELL** born 1/1931 died 1/29/1959 in Quitman, Brooks County, Georgia married **Arlie MONK** born 2/14/1919 died 2/19/2000 in Quitman, Brooks County, Georgia. They are buried in Welcome Hill Church of Christ Cemetery in Quitman, Brooks County, Georgia.

They had 5 children. Clarence "Buddy" MONK, Randall "Randy" MONK, (2) James R MONK (1951-1993), Raymond MONK, Donald "Duck" MONK. The other 4 boys are living.

- (2) James R MONK born 7/30/1951 in Georgia died 2/27/1993 in Perry; Taylor County, Florida married **Brenda L HILL** born 3/20/1950 in Georgia (still living). **James R MONK** is buried beside his parents. They married in 1973 in Quitman, Brooks County Georgia. They had 3 children. (3) **Latrelle M. MONK**, **James R MONK Jr**, and **Amanda L MONK**.
- (3) Latrelle M. MONK born 1/4/1977 in Quitman Brooks County Georgia married Timothy L GRIF-FIN born 10/3/1974 in Orlando Orange County Florida. We married 1/14/1995. We have 2 children. Kayla M GRIFFIN, Willow A GRIFFIN, (son). Latrelle MONK-Griffin

Did you check the cemeteries in Green Cove for a tombstone for Susie? I found this on Ancestry.com. You can send off for his social security application but it costs \$27.00. It should have his parents name but not always.

#### Of possible interest to all TERRELLs

I am always receptive to good advice. I don't mean to be facetious or disrespectful in this post -- just informative. I'm NOT an expert on genealogy, but I'm not exactly a novice either. I've been researching genealogy for the past 17 years. I'm into my fourth year as President of the local Marion County Genealogical Society.

I have 63 generations of TERRELL/TYREL ancestors in my database. My TERRELL lineage goes back to 443 BC. Most of my research is either "referenced" or explained, and everyone is warned to "use their own best judgment" as to what they wish to do with it. As is the case with much genealogy research, there're always conflicts. The ancient years of my TYREL lineage include kings, princes, dukes, earls, etc., which "should" be a matter of record or ancient history. However, it's still a personal judgment call.

For 17 years I have been researching my mother's ancestor's surnames of **CALHOUN** and **KINARD**; my father's ancestor's surnames of **PERRY**, **ERGLE**, **TERRELL** and **GRANTHAM**; my wife's mother's ancestor's surnames of **BOWEN** and **BELL**; and my wife's father's surname of **MATHEWS**. I have done fairly well with some and exceptionally well with others.

About my **TERRELL** lineage back to 443 BC. In addition to my own research, much of it was done by hired professionals (hired by someone other than myself). I keep copies of all MY data research on file. I don't throw anything away. My wife says I'm pretty much a perfectionist. However, I surely don't claim to be perfect by any means.

I hope this explains things to anyone interested in my 63 generations of TERRELL research. Most of my immigrant TERRELLs were from Virginia and later Robeson County, North Carolina and then spread out from those areas. Great Grandson of **Melvina Sylvester TERRELL**

Dan perhaps you can help me solve a little problem that, in all likelihood, involves a Terrell person.

I am trying to find information on a woman named, in all likelihood, **Ann(a) TERRELL** (or **TERREL**, **TERRAL**, etc), who lived in Spartanburg District at the end of the 18th centiury, married a **James HEN-RY**, and eventually died in Bibb Co, AL, in 1845.

The official documents I have on **James HENRY** only mention her as "**Ann**" or "**Anna**", but one ancestor wrote of her as "**Anna O'TYRELL**". As he was also writing that James HENRY was "**Shamus MCHENRY**", I very much suspect that he had Gaelicized the name. Another clincher, among the descendants I have a great-grandson named "**David TERREL**," with David being a great-grandfather's name.

Unfortunately I do not know much else about her. An informant gave me - no source - a birth date of 03 August 1774 in SC, and a marriage date with **James HENRY** of 1795 at the latest. I have a family Bible that says that "**James HENRY** and **Ann** were married January 1796" and the 1796 date is also found in a 1963 booklet. One descendant wrote that she was "fresh from Connaught", but he was also the one who had her as "O'TYRRELL". That's about it.

Any help, or indication where I can find help, would be greatly

My connection to **Solomon TERRELL** and **Mary COOK** is through their daughter **Martha A. TER-**

**RELL**, who married **John P. ROBERTSON**, both of Wake County, NC. My reference for this is the inscription on Martha's gravestone (below). Your information has added Mary's maiden name and Solomon's parents names and dates. Can you provide published references for this information? I seem to recall that Solomon TERRELL (Jr.?) was a Baptist minister, but can't find a reference for it at the moment. I hope we can be of further help to each other. - 4. **Rachel Bibb TERRELL**, b. 3 May 1772 in Caroline Co, VA. . .married to **Joseph HARGROVE**. . .father was **Pleasant TERRELL**, **Sr**. (no further info)
- 5. **Rachel TERRELL**, b. 1749 in Caroline Co, VA, d. 1781 in Caroline Co, VA. . .married to **John BURRESS**. . .father was **David TERRELL**, **Sr**.
- 6. **Rachel TERRELL**, b. Abt 1837 in Cherokee Nation East in Georgia, d. Abt 1896 in Western Cherokee Nation in Oklahoma. . .father was **John Jack TERRELL**
- 7. **Rachel TERRELL**, b. 2 Nov 1793 in Caroline Co, VA. . .married to **Arnold PATTERSON**. . .father was **Matthew TERRELL**
- 8. **Rachel Moorman TERRELL**, b. 1 May 1831 in Mt. Pleasant, Jefferson Co, OH, d. Sep 1918 in Jefferson Co, OH. . .married to **Joseph M. COX**. .father was **Clark TERRELL**

Here's what I have for Soloman:

- 1. **Soloman TERRELL, Sr.**, b. 27 Nov 1755 in Johnston Co, NC, d. 28 Dec 1816 in Wake Co, NC. . .married 2 times, (1) **Amelia ROBERTSON** and (2) **Nancy WALL**. . .father was **Jeptha TERRELL, Sr**.
- 2. **Soloman TERRELL, Jr**. (son of above), b. 8 June 1794 in Wake Co, NC. . .married **Mary COOK**
- 3. **Soloman TERRELL**, b. 1732 in Hanover Co, VA, d. 1775 in Chatham Co, VA. . .father was **Timothy TERRELL** (See below), mother was **Mary MARTIN**
- 4. **Soloman TERRELL**, son of **Moses TERRELL** (a twin and this gets complicated...see below)

**Timothy TERRELL**, b. 1705 in Hanover Co, VA, d. 11 Feb 1763 in Orange Co, NC. . .married **Mary MARTIN**. . .they had twin sons, **Moses** and **Aaron**, b. Dec 1755 in Orange Co, NC. . .Moses d. 21 Feb 1831 in Amite Co, MS and Aaron d. 1814 in Anderson Co, SC. . .**Soloman TERRELL** #3 (above) is the brother of these twins

Twin son Aaron (above) also had twin sons that were also named Moses and Aaron, b. 11 Jan 1790 in Anderson Co, SC. . . of these twins, **Moses** married **Mary Ann EDINS**, b. 1806 in Anderson Co, SC. . .AND. . . they are the parents of **Soloman TERRELL** #4 (above)

There is a connection between **Rachel TERRELL** #6 (above) and **Moses**, the twin son of Timothy, as follows:

**Moses** married **Ann Nancy MARTIN**, b. 1756 in Chatham, NC and they had a son, **John Jack TER-RELL**. . .he is the father of **Rachel TERRELL** #6 (above)

Here's another confusing part:

**David TERRELL, Sr.**, the father of **Rachel TER-RELL** #5 (above), is the brother of **Timothy TER-RELL**, the father of the "first" twins, Moses and Aaron (the ones born b. Dec. 1755)

David and Timothy are the sons of Capt. **William TERRELL**, **Sr**, b. 1659 in New Kent Co, VA, and his wife, **Susannah WATERS**, b. Abt 1660 in New Kent Co, VA. . .Capt. William TERRELL is the son of the immigrant, Sir **Richmond TERRELL**, b. 1624 in St. Giles Parish in Reading, England, and his wife, **Elizabeth** 

You'll probably have to put all of this on paper to get it straight. It's very confusing, and if there is any part of it you cannot understand, just let me know. If you have something that fits any of the above, I'd like to share total information with you. Please let me know.

I am a descendant of **Solomon TERRELL** and **Amelia** (maiden name I am 99% sure is **SPAIN**) **Robertson** through **William Pitt TERRELL**.

For several years I have "sort of" looked for other family members that may have moved to Arkansas from Wake County, NC. Your emails concerning Martha Robertson may contain information that relates to this. **Amelia Robertson TERRELL** is, in my opinion, the widow of **Richard ROBERTSON**. He would have been deceased/gone before her marriage to Solomon in 1778.

Another clue to family is your mention of the surname **COOK**, the maiden name of Solomon Jr.'s wife, **Mary**.

My William Pitt TERRELL had a daughter, Fetney G. who married William S. COOK. Fetney was born in 1828, NC and later lived with her husband in Union County, Arkansas. Another of William Pitt TERRELL'S daughters, Ellen G. TERRELL married William H. TERRELL (Wake County Marriages, 1770-1868, pg. 310 and a deed in Union County, Arkansas). I have never tried to discover how Ellen and William were related before marriage. They were married 29 July 1844.

**Solomon TERRELL Jr.** occupation is written as Baptist Minister on the North Carolina census of 1850.

William Pitt TERRELL and family moved to Union County, Arkansas, before 1850, probably about 1848 or so (date because of date on deed in NC and AR). Magnolia Arkansas and El Dorado Arkansas are so close, I wonder if they all moved in the same group, and if there are more family ties here than the TERRELL connection.

The book *Terrell Genealogy* by Emma Dicken is the basis of most of my family information, with many other references found in the library/courthouses to double check what I can.

I would appreciate very much any information that you might have that would show more connections between my TERRELLs and COOKS and ROB-ERTSONS in NC and AR.
