Ref: *THE GENEALOGY OF THE LEWIS FAMILY IN AMERICA*, by William Terrell LEWIS, The Courier Journal Press, Louisville, KY, 1893. This genealogy is the only known record for the children of David LEWIS Sr. Tradition said **John LEWIS** came from Wales to Virginia about 1660-1670. Just before coming he spent some time with the **MOSTYN** family in Flintshire.

After coming to Virginia, there were several exchanges of letters with the MOSTYNS. These are traditions and the connection that John had with the MOSTYNS is not known.

Abraham later was the patriarch of a wagon train of about one hundred persons, led by his son David, who traveled slowly through the Cumberland Gap to Georgia, Kentucky, and Illinois in 1794. He and others crossed the Mississippi to Spanish Louisiana (later Missouri) in 1795, and some went north to Logan County, Illinois, where they were associated with Abraham Lincoln.

1. Simon DERRICK II was born of sturdy German stock, common, hard working frontiersmen, who were escaping the famines and hopeless conditions they were facing in Germany at that time. We knew nothing of him, not even his name, some thirty years ago. He never made a name for himself, could not read or write. He signed all of his documents and papers with a cursive "S". So far as we know, he had little, if any, education, but this did not keep him from making the best of his opportunities, and there are many lessons we might take from him. He was an experienced "trail blazer," and no matter the adverse circumstances, he was never too old to start again in a new location. I feel that his type are the ones who really shaped the direction this country was to move, though there is no credit given them in the history books.

Born in Shenandoah County, Virginia, 1770, **Simon** was the son of **Jacob** and grandson of **Simon DERK**, the immigrant. He m. **Lydia TIPTON**. Lydia died before 1839, and he began his trek to a new country, The Republic of Texas, to seek his fortune. He had several land grants in Titus, Hopkins and Lamar County, part of which later became Delta County. He has also been

found in Red River and Coryell County in Texas. All of his children followed him to Texas but **Caswell**, who remained in Madison County, Alabama.

In so far as we can deduce from documents and his probate, he probably died in mid 1867. His grave has not been found, but he was living near the Lee Cemetery, and died in Lamar County in 1867. Most of his family who died here are in this cemetery, so a Memorial for the War of 1812, along with a Sons of the Republic of Texas medallion, has been placed near one of his sons. Page 158. Will. I, Henry CHILES of Lunenburg and Parish of Cumberland, being very weak and sick -

First, I want my lawful debts paid, and to do that, if my mother is yet agreeable, the land whereon she now lives, that after her death is left me by my "father will, be sold" by my executors, and if the money arising from that is not sufficient, then some other part of my estate to be sold to satisfy the rest.

To my **mother** - I lend her, during her life, if she will agree to deliver me up the land she now lives on, as much of my land in Lunenburg [as she] has occasion to tend, and the part of the plantation and house.

To my wife - I lend her, during her life, my land in Lunenburg and other part of my plantation not lent to my mother, and houses, as shall be sufficient for her people to work and live in. I also lend her, during her life, for the support of her and my child or children, one half of the estate that shall fall to me by the death of my grandmother, Mary Howl. I also lend my wife, during her life, half of the estate that shall [fall] to me by the will of my father (except the land) after my mother's death. I also lend to my wife, during her life, an equal part as shall be judged by my executor of all my estate Negroes that are now in my possession, viz, Isaral, Samson, Phillis, Lucy, and Tom. I also give my wife all my household goods and furniture, and half of all my stock of horses, cattle, hogs, etc.

To my daughter Elizabeth - when she shall be of age or marry, that part of my land in L not lent to my mother and my wife, together with that part I have lent them, after their death.

To my daughter Elizabeth - the other part not lent my wife, of the estate that will fall to me by my grandmother's death. Also, the other part of the estate not lent my wife, that shall fall to me by will of my father, after my mother's death. Also the other part not lent my wife, of the Negroes I have now in possession, which were before named. Also, the other part of my stock not given to my wife. After my wife's death, what I had lent her, goes to Elizabeth.

As my wife is now big with child or children, if it or they should be born and live, it or they are to have an equal part with my wife and daughter, of all the legacies aforesaid.

Executors - my friends **Phillimon Russell** and **David Russell**. Executrix - my wife.

Signed Mar 6, 1756 - Henry CHILES.

A message for Howard TERRELL,

On your first request, I do not have the answer to your query on **Andrew Jackson TERRELL** (b. 1824).

My database of Southern TERRELLS now includes some 42,800 TERRELLs and related families whose relationships have been identified. I also have census data on TERRELLs in the Southern and Southwestern states (plus Ind. and Ohio) from 1790 to 1900 (almost complete) and a little bit of 1910.

As of 1850 there are three TERRILL families living in Lawrence Co, Ind.: **Robert TERRILL** (b. 1802 Madison Co, Ky.) who arrived there by 1822. His children are known, and he did not have a son **Andrew**.

John TERRILL (b. 1815 Ind.), nephew of Robert above. He himself was born in 1815 to **William TERRILL** (1796 to 1845). This William is not known to have a son named **Andrew Jackson TERRILL**, but William had five wives and the list of his children is somewhat of a muddle (as you will see). His known children are:

Henry TERRILL (b. 1814)

Harrison TERRILL (b. 1815)

John TERRILL (b. 1815 Ind.; d. after May 1900)

Mary TERRILL (b. 1818)

Wilburn TERRILL (b. 1823 Ind.; d. 1897)

Henry Martin TERRILL (b. 1823)

Mahulda TERRILL

Mary TERRILL (b. 1828)

Marinda TERRILL (b. 1829)

Malinda TERRILL (b. 1830)

Living also in Lawrence Co in 1850 is **William TERRILL** of Ky. who is probably related to the other two, but I can't track him. In that census, he is married to **Nancy TYREE Cameron Davis** [as identified by another researcher], and is too young to be **Andrew Jackson TERRELL's** father. I know that his children settled in Jasper and Crawford Counties, Ill.

As to the second question, I have 38 "Elizabeth TERRILL" and 106 "Elizabeth TERRELL," but none match your specifications.

Dear Don,

I have been unable to trace my ancestry back any farther than my ggfather, **William George TERRELL**. His marriage certificate identifies him as coming from Hanover County VA. Sometime previous to his marriage, he relocated to the Huntington WV area and married **Samantha JOHNSON**. However, his marriage cert. may have been from KY. His oldest son, **Robert**, was born in 1889, his second son **Joseph Edgar** (my gfather) born 1891, third **Lester 1893**, and fourth, **Claude**, 1895. Samantha died when Joseph E. was 10 so I suppose the year to be 1901, and **William G**. died when Joseph E. was 12, so I suppose the year was 1903.

My paternal line, beginning with me is:

Joseph Raymond TERRELL (b.2.28.1955, Key West Fl.), **Raymond Lester TERRELL** 9.9or10.1924*

Huntington, WV, **Joseph Edgar TERRELL** 18912.?.1891 presumably Huntington WV, **William George TERRELL**?, presumably Hanover County, VA. The asterisk after my father's birth date concerns the day of his birth. Official records place it on the 10th, but the women present say it was late on the 9th but the doctor did not record it unto after midnight.

If you can be of any help in continuing my genealogy back, I would

appreciate it.

If you are trying to make a complete family tree for TERRELLs, I add the following info regarding my family.

I found your **William George TERRELL** in the 1900 Census of West Virginia at Cabell Co, Guyando Dist., ED 6, S 21, L 35. There, he says he was born in March 1865 in West Virginia. Unfortunately, the 1890 Census was accidentally destroyed in a fire in the 1920s, so the next opportunity to find him is in 1880 (a big gap).

I had previously suspected that this particular **William G. TERRELL** (in the 1900 Census) was **William Gordon TER-RELL**, son of **Richmond Henry TERRELL** (1820-1898) and **Molly Elizabeth PARISH** (1839-1900). Indeed, in 1880 Richmond Henry TERRELL is living in Parkersburg, W.Va. (Wood Co, p. 257b).

However, your statement that William was born in Hanover Co, Va., is a marvelous revelation. Richmond Henry TERRELL was born somewhere in Virginia but married in Fluvanna Co, and is found in census records living only in New Kent Co Va. (1850), Louisa Co Va. (1860), Taylor Co W.Va. (1870), and Wood Co W.Va. (1880). He never lived in Hanover Co.

There is a TERRELL clan which has lived in Hanover Co for about two centuries. They are centered around a little town called Beaverdam (which I intend to visit someday), surrounded by the descendants of their former slaves (also named TERRELL). And, this is the place from which your William came.

There is only one candidate in Hanover: **Richmond Q. TER-RELL** (b. 1838; d. 1880-1900) and Eliza Ann SIMMS (b. 1840; d. 1880-1900). They had a son **William G. TERRELL** b. 1863-65 in Hanover Co. Richmond and William can be found in the 1870 Census Va., Hanover Co, Hewletts, p. 129; and 1880 Census Va., Hanover Co, Beaverdam, pp. 100c-100d. The statement that your William was born in Hanover gives good confidence that this William G. TERRELL is the right person.

There is one additional coincidence which supports this idea: In the 1900 Census, also living in Cabell Co, W.Va. (a few miles away from Wm.), is **Julian TERRELL** (**Julian F. TERRELL**, b. 1833)(ED 4, S 4, L 83). This is the brother of **Richmond Q. TERRELL** (William's uncle). There are no other TERRELLs in Cabell Co. This is not "proof," but it is strong coincidence. Here is what you need to do if you want "proof": See if Hanover Co has a will or probate for **Richmond Q. TERRELL** (I've seen him also listed as **Richmond O. TERRELL**). See if Cabell Co, W.Va., has deeds for your William.

If so, see if **Julian** appears as witness or something else. Any sort of communication between William and Julian would be excellent proof. You can also try the reverse: See if William appears as a witness on any of Julian's deeds. See if William's will mentions any uncles or nieces/nephews. See if Julian's will mentions William.

I have the ancestry of **William G. TERRELL**, son of **Richmond Q. TERRELL**, if you want it. Please provide a postal address, since I send printouts.

Also, if you conclude that the above William G. TERRELL is your ancestor, I would appreciate your informing me. I am anxious to add knowledge to my TERRELL family database. I have presently identified the relationships of 43,689 Southern TERRELLs and allied relatives.

Mr. Terrell, I am contacting you because, in all honesty, I don't know what else to do. We went to Virginia last fall, and found the following documents at the Orange County Courthouse. What are they telling us?

Any document, taken alone, does not prove anything - but if we put them all together, it appears that **Goodrich TERRILL** (1825-1885) might be the first-born son of **John TERRILL** (1791-1872) and grandson of **Oliver TERRILL** (1757-1821) and **Susannah MALLORY** (1770-1857).

The first marriage license to **Susan GRASTY** is dated 1820, the second license to **Elizabeth GIBSON** is 1835.

The real key seems to be in the land transaction. Goodrich is selling his interest in the dower estate of his other grandfather, **Goodrich Lightfoot GRASTY**. We are interpreting the phrase "dower estate" to mean that he held a claim to this land because he inherited from his mother, Susan, deceased first wife of John. However, we are not familiar enough with genealogy research and the old terms to know if this is what it means. We have copies of the original documents, but were not able to transcribe every word. If you can help us understand what these documents are saying, it would be very much appreciated.

I thought the ancestry of **Goodrich TERRILL** was a settled matter. I have found him in the various census records; however, his connection to the proper clan is found in the book *Descendants of Goodrich TERRILL and Sarah Jane Trice*, *Mar-*

ried and Left Virginia in 1848, Came to Louisiana by Jack A. TERRILL, pub. Privately in 1996 by Jack A. TERRILL (now deceased), formerly of 372 Atlantic Ave., Shreveport, LA 71105-2910. This book is not in the Library of Congress, and the only copies I can identify are those in the hands of Dan Brinson (Terrell Society) and myself. If you just want a copy of your ancestry (and, yes, you are listed in that book), just provide me a postal address and I will send you a printout from my database (which includes the information gleaned from the Goodrich TERRILL book).

Yes, Goodrich TERRILL was the son of John Towles TERRILL and his first wife Susan Ann GRASTY. John shows himself as "senior" because his second wife, Elizabeth Eustance GIBSON, gave him a son John Gibson TERRILL (1836-1921). John Towles TERRILL was the son of Oliver TERRILL and Susannah MALLORY.

Have I answered your question?

Meanwhile, your email has provided me with information which I did not previously have: The names of Susan Grasty's parents. Thanks. Don C. TERRILL

I am seeking information on the parents of **George W. TER-RELL**, b. abt. 1817, Licking Co., Ohio, m. **Rachel WIL-LIAMS** 1839 in Perry Co., OH. Also, I am interested in parents of **John TERRELL**, born abt. 1809 in Muskingum Co., OH and married **Nancy WALTON**. George's parents are listed in 1880 Kansas census as being from PA (father) and NJ (mother). John's parents, in the same census, are listed as being born in VA. Both individuals lived in OH, moved to Howard CO., IN around 1840-1850, and then to Putnam CO., MO about 1855-1858. They settled in Cloud Co., Kansas by 1870. I can tell you that the only Terrells occupying Muskingum Co, Ohio, at the right time descendants of **Daniel TERRIL** (ca. 1715 England to 1759 N.J.). My source for Daniel is Ancestry.com, family trees, "Rugh-Nelson-Knox-Ragsdale-Reeves & Related Families" by Phillip A. Knox (pknox@earthlink.net)(dated 6 Dec 2003.

In particular, **Adam TERRIL** (b. 1798 Ohio Co Va.) and his brother **Robert** (b. 1808 Ohio Co Va.) Another posting concerning Timothy's parents is by FranInMa (posting 618, August 20, 2001, TERRILL Family Forum) and this posting says the Terrell Association claims this Timothy is not son to Richmond Terrell. John TERRILL Wayland Jr.'s posting at GenForum (posting #60, August 17, 1998, TERRILL Family Forum) says that Timothy is indeed a son of Richmond.

Who is right? Is there any primary proof one way or another or is it based on speculation/generalization?

Do you have any additional information on **Ann TERRILL**? I have my **Ann TERRILL** marrying a **William REEVES** (son of **George REEVES** and **Nancy Jane BURTON**).

Ann & William's daughter, Hannah, married John M. BURTON (son of John Pleasant BURTON and Susannah STAMPER).

Hannah and John M. BURTON 's son, Hugh, married a Mary Ann ARTHUR.

Mary Ann and Hugh BURTON 's daughter, Sarah, married a Benjamin Franklin STEPHENS.

Sarah and **B. F. STEPHENS**, had a daughter, **Maude Gertrude**, who was my GGrandmother.

Any light you can shed on this Timothy-Richmond-Robert/Timothy-Timothy-Robert area would be greatly appreciated and any additional information you have on Ann's descendants would also be greatly appreciated.

The confusion over early North American ancestor Timothy TERRILL/Terrell existed for the first half of the 20th century. It was settled by Emma Dicken in her 1952 book, and subsequent research by the Tyrrell Family History Society (U.K.) has confirmed her view.

The problem is that Richmond Terrell (b. 1624, m. Elizabeth __) settled in New Kent Co, Va., in 1656. New Kent was larger than it is today, and most new arrivals to the colony settled there, since the western part of (today's) Virginia was still wild and a little dangerous. In that same year (1659) Timothy Terrell

(m. Elizabeth Foster) was born in London. He settled in New Kent about 1697 (perhaps earlier).

Timothy and Richmond were related, but it is unlikely that they knew of each other. They shared common ancestors FOUR GENERATIONS back: Robert Tyrrold (d. ca. 1545) and Agnes __ (d. ca. Jan 1547/48).

Most (but now all) of Timothy's descendants moved on to Orange Co, Va., after the first generation (and then westward after another generation). Richmond's descendants went all over the place, but mostly south and southwest.

You describe yourself as descended from this Timothy. The descendants of **Joseph TERRILL** (b. 1699), son of **Timothy TERRILL** (b. 1656) are extremely difficult to trace. It appears to me that, rather than going to Orange Co, they settled into Hanover and Louisa Counties, Va. Of your Timothy (b. 1739) I know nothing, except that I think he had a son with the unlikely name of **Counterrenchile TERRELL** who grew up in Hanover Co, Va. The link is circumstantial.

Part of the confusion regarding the **Timothy TERRILL** story is that Richmond Terrell's son **William** (b. ca. 1659) had a son named **Timothy TERRELL** (b. ca. 1705) who is sometimes mixed up with your ancestor. The descendants of this Timothy ended up on Georgia and Mississippi.

The ancestry of your Timothy TERRILL (b. 1656) is:

- (1) **Timothie TIRRELL** (b. West Hagbourne, Berks., England; d. ca. Aug 1650
- at Bread Street, All Hallows, London, England died in 1656, knowing that he would never see his unborn child (Timothy).) and his wife **Dorothy COLLARD**.
- (2) **Robert TIRRELL**(d. ca. May 1592 at West Hagbourne, Berks., England) and his wife **Elienor _?_.**
- (3) **Avery TERROLD** (d. ca. May 1584 at West Hagbourne, Berks., England) and his wife **Ayis** _?_ (d. after May 1854 at West Hagbourne, Berks., England)
- (4) **Robert TYRROLD** (b. England; d. ca. Aug 1545 at West Hagbourne, Berks., England) and his wife **Agnes** _?_ (d. ca. Jan 1547/48 at West Hagbourne, Berks., England) and, that is as far as we can trace them.

It is reasonable to assume that your Martha was the daughter of one of the above.

Hiram TERRELL (ca. 1790 to 1840-50) had 10 known children born between 1815 and ca. 1838. He had a daughter **Martha Elizabeth TERRELL** (b. ca. 1836) who is said to have married **Joshua FORD**.

Joseph TERRELL Sr. (1770-75 to 1844) had 11 known children, born between 1798 and 1822. He had a daughter, **Martha Patsy TERRELL** (1812 to before 1870) who married **Joshua SIMPSON** at Amite Co on 22 Apr 1841.

Moses TERRELL (ca. 1750 to 1831) had 6 known children, born between ca. 1790 and ca. 1795. He had a daughter named Martha who was born ca. 1794 at Franklin Co, Ga. Moses' will was written 4 Jan 1828 and proved 21 Feb 1831 (Amite Co Will Book 1 p. 66), and he names his wife Nancy, sons John and Hiram, and daughter Rebecca. Moses was the father of Hiram, above.

Jonathan TERRELL is listed by me as **John TERRELL** (ca. 1795 to 1850-60). He had 7 known children born between 1828 and 1848. His youngest daughter was **Mary S. TERRELL** (b. 1828) and she appears in his household in the 1850 census of 1850 (Miss., Amite Co, p. 64). John was the son of Moses, above.

There appears to be no match, unless you can turn up an undiscovered daughter of one of the above.

Alice Terrell Harden - I also have a Terrell/Hilton line. Richmond **TERRELL** was a Revolutionary soldier in Lancaster, SC. He died Feb 13, 1927. His son **Joseph**, born Oct 27, 1792 married **Tabitha HILTON** Feb 13, 1812. Tabitha was born Nov 21, 1791. In 1822 they moved to Lauderdale County, Ala. There were Hiltons in the census records there, so some of the family probably moved there too. I don't know if these are the same Terrell/Hilton line that you have.

William R. JACKSON, was probably b in abt 1769. He was probably the son of Samuel JACKSON who is found in Union Co. SC from abt 1770 to death soon after 1800. Documentation is found for the following: Wm R. was the brother of Benjamin JACKSON b 1775. Wm R was married twice first to Mary HUMPHREYS. They were the parents of two children, Elijah b abt 1795 and Franklin JACKSON. After death of Mary HUMPHREYS Jackson he married Nancy TERRELL before 1800. Both marriages in Franklin Co. GA. Both Wm R. and his brother Benjamin are found in Franklin Co. GA Tax Records 1802-1808. Both are found in 1810 Warren co. Ky census. Wm R. never moved and Allen Co.
