Editor's Note: *Question marks were penned in red. If Adeline HOSMER Terrell was not born in MA, this may not be her in spite of one STAPLES & the BAGLEYs in her household, but it appears unlikely. The state was written carefully, and completely with long "ss" which looks like "fs." I have no doubt that someone told the census taker that she was b. in MA. We have no way of determining if she gave the information, or if someone else in the household gave it for her. Without that information, it is impossible to determine the credibility of this entry. I am including the following to shed some light on some of the above census entries as well as to preserve a bit of the customs of the era. DFB

**Mr. J. O. Stamps wrote, "Elijah TERRELL had a brother (John, I believe is his name). Evidently Lucinda A. TERRELL is his daughter, she married Samuel B. STAPLES in 1848. Here is a poem written by Lucinda A. Staples, nee, Lucinda A. TERRELL to Sarah Delphine D. PENN (my grandmother) prior to her marriage to Col. Wm. David LARKIN 12/25/1849. Although having reached her seventy-third year, Mrs. Staples was remarkably strong and hale, and gave promise of many more years of life, but a sudden and fatal illness overtook her three days ago, and deprived a loving family of it's venerable and devoted member.

Mrs. Staples was one of those sweet-tempered, kind, and charitable ladies whose number is now so rare, who kept intact in this prosaic epoch the commendable traits of past generations, -- the beautiful sentiments of altruism, that impelled to deeds of charity and benevolence not only when family and friends were concerned, but also in regard to deserving subjects of sympathy and help, even when outside of the intimate circle.

Mrs. Staples lived the life of the true Christian, and was esteemed by all who had occasion to enjoy her acquaintance.

She was for many years a resident of Ocean Springs and was related to several of the best families in Miss. and La. She leaves several daughters among whom are Mrs. Capt. June Poitevent and Mrs. R.
