TYRELLS OF ESSEX

The following is a version of a posting originally made to the Gen-Medieval Internet forum on July 2, 1999 and subsequently reprinted in a slightly edited form in the Summer 2000 issue (Vol. 8, No. 1) of "*The Plantagenet Connection*", published by HT Communications, Arvata, Colorado. It is the result of comparing two secondary sources on the English branch of the **TYRELL** (variously spelled **TIREL**, **TERRELL**) family, one of the most famous (or infamous) members of which was one **WALTER TIREL** (ca 1060 - 1130), allegedly the assassin of **King William Rufus**.

One of the sources used is a book authored by Joseph Henry Tyrrell that a now-deceased relative had cited for much of the information included in a family history. I was provided an extensive extract of this book by Benjamin Hertzel, a fellow poster to Gen-Medieval, and later located a copy of the book at a family residence. The book is entitled "A Genealogical History of the Tyrrells, Sometime of the French Vexin, Poix in Picardy, Guernanville in Normandy, Laingaham in Essex, Kingsworthy and Avon Tyrrell in Hampshire; Castleknock in Co. Dublin, Fertullagh in Co. Westmeath; and now of Grange Castle, Co, Kildare; Clonard, Co. Meath; and elsewhere." It was originally published in 1904, in only 100 copies and was subsequently reprinted by Phillimore & Co. Ltd, Shopwyke Hall, Chichester, Sussex,in 1980 under the sponsorship of the Suffolk), between 1146 and 1148 according to Hatton's Book of Seals, until 1304-5 when records show the presence in Essex County of a **JAMES TYRELL**. As **OFB** puts it (on page 11):

Tyrrell Family History Society. In this analysis, I will refer to this book as "JHT."

The other source that was used for this analysis is "The Tyrells of England" by Dr. O. F. Brown (which I will refer to as "OFB"), which was published by that same Phillimore & Co. in 1982. OFB was called to my attention by both private communications and public references from members of Gen-Medieval as being the most carefully researched book published on the English branches of the TYRELL family. Although presently out of print, I was able to obtain a copy of OFB through a used book store which specializes in genealogical publications. Upon receipt and review of OFB, I certainly concur with its characterization as a scholarly and well-researched work.

I am submitting this analysis to "Terrell Trails" in hopes that some subscribers may have been involved in, or be aware of, research on the early period of the TYRELL family subsequent to the 1982 publication of **OFB**. Specifically, I am seeking information on a what is referred to in **OFB** (pp. 11-18) as "The Missing Period" in the history of the Tyrell family leading to the establishment of its "main historical line" with a family seat at Heron Hall in East Horndon, Essex. The Missing Period extends over the approximately 150 years from when one **HUGH TIREL** sold the manor in Langham (situated in Northeast Essex adjacent to

"The subsequent three or four generations are none too clear, but there is evidence of continuing connection from then on-

wards. For the moment, however, we are concerned with the years in between, when there are no references to Tyrells in Essex, and there is no clear indication of the origins of James and the subsequent family of Heron. This is not to say that there were no Tyrells in England during the period; sparse documentation of the 12th and 13th centuries produces many names scattered throughout at least a dozen shires, but the name James does not appear at any time or place. Thus, with no tradition of this name in any branch, nor a James conveniently available elsewhere at the end of the 13th century, there is a complete absence of any candidate for the founding of the Essex connection."

JHT shows two possible (and contradictory) descents from WALTER, the purported Regicide, to the subsequent TYRELLs of Heron, Essex. According to OFB, these two descents either match or contain elements of the three "traditional" descents for this family, all of which are flawed or unsupported to some significant degree.

The first descent shown by **JHT** is the one derived from the Visitations, which JHT includes as a point of reference in his Chart XIII, pages 115, but characterizes as "... merely a list of names more or less conjectural." **OFB** shares **JHT's** opinion of this descent and also dismisses further consideration of this hypothetical succession of 'knights in every generation.'

JHT goes on to relate the pedigree shown below as his suggested descent from WALTER, the Regicide, to the TYRELLs of Heron (on Chart ID, pp 81-2, Chart IF, pp 83-4, and Chart XIV, p 116). JHT does cite primary sources related to a few, but not most generations of this descent. OFB does credit JHT as giving early recognition to some documentation related to Irish members of the family. However, OFB examines the available Irish material and concludes that it is unlikely that there is any connection between this branch and the later Essex branch of the family. In his review of the "traditional" descents that most closely match JHT's overall interpretation, **OFB** cites much more extensive primary source material and does not reach the same conclusions as JHT. A "power search" of the archives of various Internet discussion forums reveals a limited history of discussion of the TYRELL family during this time period, but the specific language in some of the discussion that did occur sounds like it might have been based on sources which were derived from JHT. Accordingly, this analysis uses the JHT descent along with interleaved comments derived from OFB's book to establish a recognizable frame of reference for readers of this material:

THE DESCENT FROM WALTER III TIREL

Generation 1

[the supposed Regicide] as extracted from **JHT** "Sir **WALTER III Tirel**

Third Lord of Poix, second Lord of Laingaham, Kingsworthy and Avon, A Baron of France, and England, Castellan of Pontoise 1091. At Seige of Jerusalem, 1096. Reputed to have slain **William Rufus** 1100. Founded Priory of St. Denis, 1116,

and Monastery of Selincourt, 1131. Made a pilgrimage to Holy Land in 1136, and there died.

Married **Adelaide**, daughter of **Richard Giffard**, son of **Walter**, 1st Earl of Buckingham. Living in 1136. Died in Nunnery of Conflans 1138."

[OFB points out that Pipe Roll, 31 Hen. 1, 1130 shows Walter's wife, Adelice, answering for Langham in 1130, presumably as Walter's widow. OFB therefore surmises that Walter III was dead by 1130 and that a Walter IV, probable grandson of Walter III and Adelice, was Lord of Poix in 1131. OFB also points out that both J. H. Round and Michael Maclagan concluded that Walter III's spouse, Adelice, was a daughter of Richard de Clare (1024-1090) by his wife Rohese Giffard, daughter of Walter Giffard, the elder, standard bearer of Duke William at the Battle of Hastings. This alliance by marriage with the powerful Clare family likely contributed to Walter III having a position at King William's court, eventually leading to his participation in that fateful hunt in the New Forest during which King William Rufus was killed -- by accident or otherwise. However, both OFB and JHT note that the evidence is far from conclusive that Walter III launched the fatal arrow.]

Generation 2

"Sir **HUGH Tirel** of Avon Tyrell, son of **Walter III and Adelaide**

Fourth Prince of Poix, A Baron of France and England, with the Crusade of 1146. Held lands in the New Forest. Sold Laingaham to Walter de Cornhill, prior to joining the Crusade. Died 1159.

Married **Ada d'Aumale**, daughter of **Etienne de Champagne**, Compte d'Aumale"

[OFB suggests that a probable corollary of the same Pipe Roll citation noted above regarding Adelice answering for Langham is that the Hugh who was son of Walter III and Adelice was also dead in 1131. Based on this and the chronology of other documents, OFB concludes that the **Hugh Tirel** who sold Langham and died on the Crusade was probably a **Hugh II**, son of **Hugh I** and brother of **Walter IV**.]

Generation 3

"Sir **HUGH II Tirel** of Avon Tyrell and Castlenock, second surviving son of **Hugh I and Ada d'Aumale**

Sixth Lord of Poix, First Baron of Castlenock in 1173. With Strongbow in Ireland 1169. Governor of Trim 1183. At Siege of Acre 1191. Named the 'Grecian Knight'. One of DeLacy's Barons. Buried at Selincourt 1199.

Married 1st **Isabel de Vignacourt** in 1161. Married 2nd **Marie de Senarpont** in 1173."

[JHT also refers to his Hugh II of Avon Tyrell and Castlenock (?-1199) as holding property in Hampshire and being father of a Roger who probably inherited this Hampshire property. OFB notes that the Pipe Rolls confirm a Hugh Tyrell holding land in Kingsworthy, Hampshire from 1158 to 1166. However, that Hugh of Kingsworthy was succeeded by a son, Geof-

frey, not a son Roger as shown by JHT. Also, OFB appears to believe that JHT's assumption that the Hugh holding land in Hampshire is the same as the Hugh of Castlenock is not supported by any direct evidence. As to secondary evidence, **OFB** does point out that one of two conflicting references in O'Harts "Irish Pedigrees" states that Hugh of Castlenock received Castlenock from his 'instrinsic friend' Richard "Strongbow" de Clare (1125-1176), which could imply a family relationship between the two. This line of reasoning could support the hypothesis that the **Hugh** of Castlenock was a direct descendant of Walter III and Adelice de Clare, since Adelice's brother Gilbert was grandfather of Richard "Strongbow." Unfortunately, **OFB** points out that in another reference in O'Harts "Irish Pedigrees", the suggestion is made that Hugh of Castlenock may have received Castlenock from Hugh de Lacy.]

Generation 4

"Sir ROGER of Avon Tyrell, son of Hugh II and Marie de Senarpont

probably inherited Hugh's Hampshire property"

[Citing **F. F. Hants**. *1 John No. 10*, **OFB** notes only one reference in the period to a **Roger Tyrell**, who is recorded in 1199 granting a toft in Catherington, Hampshire. There is a subsequent **Thomas Tyrell**, who died in 1240 holding land in Sussex and Catherington, whom **OFB** believes to be the heir and likely son of the **Roger** of the 1199 grant.]

Generation 5

"Sir EDWARD, son of Roger of Avon Tyrell"

[OFB located contemporary or near-contemporary documentation on about 120 Tyrells in England with 38 different given names in the period 1150 to 1450. However, with respect to the name Edward during the 1148-1305 "Missing Period", OFB states ". . . I have been unable to trace anyone of this name throughout the whole period under review." The first documentation of an Edward he could locate occurred in 1426. Also, as noted above, the probable heir of the only identifiable Roger is Thomas, not Edward.]

Generation 6

"Sir GALFIRD, son of Edward"

[As stated above, **OFB** notes that there is a **Geoffrey** (**Galfird**) who succeeded **Hugh** of Kingsworthy, Hampshire. However, this succession occurred sometime around 1170, making that **Geoffrey** chronologically out of place to fall in **JHT's** Generation 6.]

Generation 7

"Sir EDMOND or EDWARD, son of Galfrid Married Jane, daughter and heiress of Sir William Borgate"

[JHT's placement of an Edward at this generation also suffers from OFB's inability to find any primary source material that

mentions an **Edward** anytime during the period. However, **OFB** notes that examination of the costs of arms of several families with whom the early **Terrells** intermarried indicates the probability of a marriage between one of the ancestors of the Essex branch of the **Terrells** and a **Borgate**.]

Generation 8

"Sir **HUGH**, son of **Edmond and Jane** Governor of Carisbrooke. 1377. Married **Jane**, daughter of Sir **James Flambert**"

[OFB notes that . . . "The name Hugh occurs frequently enough to be fitted into any generation." However, he also states the "... records of Sir Hugh (of Carisbrooke) and his family completely disqualify the suggestion. . ." that this Hugh could have been the father of the James Tyrell who was the ancestor of the Tyrells of Heron. There is, however, a Hugh **Tyrell** of Mannington in Norfolk, first documented in 1287 who died in 1313, and who probably had some family connection with a Walter Tyrell whose family owned land in Haningfield in Essex. Later reference to Tyrell holdings in South and West Haningfield give rise to a strong presumption that the early James of Essex may have been descended from this branch of the family, possibly being a son of either Hugh Tyrell of Mannington or Walter Tyrell of Haningfield. This would be an important presumption to confirm by documentation since OFB identifies an ancestry of this branch of the family that is traceable back to a Warin Tirell of Itringham, Norfolk and his spouse Mabel early in the 13th Century. If a connection could be made between this Warin Tirell and the late 12th Century Tirels of Hampshire or possibly the Welsh border counties, "The Missing Period" could be filled in.]

Generation 9

"Sir **JAMES**, son of **Hugh and Jane** Knighted before Ardes, 1380 Married **Margare**t daughter of Sir **William Heron**"

[As previously noted, **OFB** points out that in 1305 there is a **James Tyrell** in Essex holding property in Buttsbury, "one of the places which subsequently recur in later generations", and who, therefore, was apparently related to the later Tyrells of Heron. In 1318, there is a record implying a family relationship between a **James Tyrell** and a John Heron, presumably the initial heir of Heron Hall from Sir **William Heron**. Heron Hall later shows up in 1363 as clearly being held by a **Thomas Tyrell**. This supports the proposition that it was this same **James Tyrell** who married **Margaret**, the daughter **of Sir William Heron** and the heir of her brother **John**, and who was closely related to the **Thomas Tyrell** of 1363.

The marriage of **James Tyrell** and **Margaret Heron** was supposed to have occurred 'in the reign of Edward 2 or Edward 3' which, as **OFB** points out, is a relatively wide window extending from 1307 to 1377. The **James Tyrell** of 1305 is recorded with a wife **Alice** in an initial document of that year, but no wife is mentioned in two subsequent documents later that same year. Although not definitive, this permits the interpretation

that **James** remarried **Margaret Heron** after the death of his first wife, **Alice**, sometime after early 1305 and before 1318. Thus, the limited primary documentation does support the traditional assertion that a **James Tyrell and Margaret Heron** were progenitors, or at least related to the progenitors, of the Heron branch of the family.

However, **OFB** points out that the chronological considerations and inferential evidence indicate that the **James** of 1305 was born around 1265-70 and may have died about 1343 or 1344. Clearly, this could not be the same individual referred to by **JHT** as being Knighted in 1380. **OFB** relates evidence inferring the existence of two **James**, the one who probably died in 1343-44, and his presumed son, **James** 'the younger'. **OFB** indicates that the inferential evidence as to the possible **James** 'the younger' stops in 1345. It can, therefore, shed no light on the possibility that he might have subsequently been knighted.]

Generation 10

"Sir WALTER of Heron, son of James and Margaret Married Anna, daughter of Sir William Swynford"

[OFB does show at least one Walter as being a descendant of the James Tyrell of 1305 and Margaret Heron, but several generations later as either the brother or son of Thomas Tyrell 'the younger.' **OFB** refers to the analysis of **G.A. Moriarty** in NEHGR, Jan 1955 as being a "scholarly and objective assessment" which, among other things, displaces Walter in the 'traditional' pedigree. OFB does not fully agree with all of Moriarty's suggestions, but does concur that there is no primary record of a Walter, son of James of 1305 and Margaret Heron. OFB does not show a Anna Swynford, but does indicate that at about the time of the Walter Tyrell who married Eleanor Flambard (see below), the arms of Swinford were picked up by the Tyrells. Sir John, the probable son of that later Walter married a second time to a Catherine of unknown family. OFB speculates that this Catherine might have been the source of either the Swinford arms or the Borgate arms previously mentioned.]

Generation 11

"Sir **THOMAS** of Heron, son of **Walter and Anna** Married **Elizabeth**, daughter of **John Flambert**"

[OFB points out that there are numerous references to a **Thomas** 'the elder' and a **Thomas** 'the younger', his presumed son between 1332 and 1355. There is an additional isolated reference to a **Thomas** 'the elder' in 1360 and no further distinctions of this nature until the **Thomas Tyrell** who held Heron Hall died sometime between February 1381 and March 1382. **Moriarty** deduced the existence of three Tyrells named **Thomas** from this evidence, but **OFB** interprets the evidence differently and concludes there were only two -- Thomas 'the elder', probably born before 1290 and died about 1354/55, and Thomas 'the younger' (presumably son of 'the elder'), who was knighted in 1362, was the holder of Heron Hall and was born not later than about 1310.

OFB acknowledges that there is no direct evidence that Thomas 'the elder' is the son of James of 1305. Yet, OFB prefers this interpretation to the possibility that Thomas 'the elder' might be brother to James of 1305 despite possible chronological complications. There is a record of **Thomas** 'the elder' owning land in 1332, with the inference that a Thomas 'the younger' must have existed and been of an age to also own land at that point in time, requiring the distinction to be made. This would suggest that Thomas 'the younger' was born not later than about 1310/11 and that his presumed father, **Thomas** 'the elder' was born about 1290 or earlier. This, in turn, would suggest a birth date of 1270 or earlier for Thomas 'the elder's' father. If that father was James, James would have been about 73 at his death in 1343. While this is certainly possible, **OFB** points out that it assumes minimum generations of 20 years each for the birth of both Thomas 'the elder' and Thomas 'the younger.' If either generation is significantly longer, the presumed lifespan of James could get uncomfortably long.

OFB states that assuming **Thomas** 'the elder' to be a brother of **James**, rather than his son, could worsen this problem by moving Thomas 'the elder's' probable birthdate back a generation to be contemporaneous with that of James while still having Thomas 'the elder' die in 1355, 12 years later than James. While I generally find **OFB** to be impressively researched and well reasoned, this particular argument strikes me as curious. Unless I have missed something in this information-rich book (a definite possibility) or unless OFB has additional information that he has uncharacteristically not spelled out, it would appear that **OFB** has overlooked the fact that if **Thomas** 'the elder' were brother of James instead of his son, this relationship would relieve the necessity of assuming that James was born in 1270 or earlier. Based solely on his 1305 land holdings, James could have been born in the early 1280s. If a brother Thomas 'the elder' were born wihin a few years of that time and then died in 1355, the resulting lifespan of said Thomas would still be possible. Furthermore, there is also the possibility that Thomas the 'elder' could have been a considerably younger brother of James if their father was the Hugh of Mannington who died in 1313.

Finally, I wonder if the distinction between **Thomas** 'the elder' and **Thomas** 'the younger' was initially made and subsequently repeated because, for a time, they were both residing on or near the Heron property and some convenient discriminator other than locale was needed. This would allow for the possibility of **James** and **Thomas** 'the elder' being brothers and **Thomas** 'the younger' being a son of **James** who was named for his uncle. I would be interested to know if any subscribers to "*Terrell Trails*" are aware of a documented precedent for such use of the 'elder' and 'younger' notations. At the end of the day, it would appear that all that can be stated with some likelihood is that **James** of 1305, **Thomas** 'the elder' and **Thomas** 'the younger' were closely related.

Editor's Note: Prior to about 100 years ago, "the elder," "the younger," "senior," and "junior" didn't mean anything except *older* and *younger* **as compared to each other**. These terms had absolutely nothing to do with blood relationships. There

are documented cases in the USA where "senior" in the records was literally the "nephew" of "junior." While I'm on a roll, I'll throw in one more major monkey wrench. During that same period, aunt didn't mean anything except an older female relative, uncle didn't mean anything except an older male relative. Cousin meant some kin, but had no specific degree as placed upon the term today. Grandparent, grandchild, nephew, and niece were equally useless for determining relationships. *DFB*

As far as **Elizabeth Flambert** goes, the supposed spouse of **Thomas** according to **JHT**, **OFB** does identify an **Eleanor Flambard**, spouse of a **Walter Tyrell** who succeeded to Sir **Thomas Tyrell's** estates, and states that she had been "wrongly placed' as a second wife of Sir **Thomas Tyrell** in the 'traditional' pedigree.]

Generation 12

"Sir JOHN of Heron, son of Thomas and Elizabeth Sheriff of Essex and Hereford, 1423. Treasurer of Household to Henry VI.

Present at Agincourt. died 1437

Married Margaret or Alice, daughter and co-heiress of Sir William de Coggeshall"

[OFB characterizes Sir **John** of Heron (ca1370/80 - 1437) as ". . . a much-reported figure for the last twenty-five or so years of his life, and from his time succeeding generations are reasona-

bly well documented and authenticated." However, before we get to John, OFB reports one final deviation from the JHT and 'traditional' pedigrees. The will of John's brother, Edward, proves that John is son of a Walter Tyrell and Eleanor Flambard, not the son of Thomas 'the younger.' OFB further notes that "... there is good reason to believe that Sir Thomas was succeeded in his estates by a Walter." There is some confusion, however, as to which one, since there are two Walter's at this time period. OFB refers to one as "Walter of Tweed" (a reference to records regarding the Tweed ferry), who died by 1395, to distinguish him from a different Walter of Essex recorded as late as 1406. According to **OFB**, there are three plausible relationships between **Thomas** 'the younger', Walter of Tweed, Walter of Essex and John which are all consistent with the documentary evidence. **OFB** prefers the one in which Walter of Tweed is son of Thomas 'the younger' and father of the Walter who died in 1406, who in turn is father of Sir **John**. However, **OFB** concedes that alternate interpretations placing Walter of Tweed off the direct line of descent are equally supportable.]

From this point on, the **JHT** and OFB pedigrees generally show agreement. A graphic representation of **OFB's** suggested pedigree bracketing "The Missing Period", as well as speculation within it, is shown below.

I hope that some of this information will prove interesting or useful to subscribers to "*Terrell Trails*" even if it does not elicit new insights on my fundamental query, which is --- is the "Missing Period" still missing or has the ancestry of the Tyrells of Heron been clarified, possibly all the way back to the Regicide **Walter III Tirel**, since the publication of **OFB** in 1982?

Key questions within that query include:

- (1) Is there additional documentation as to the father of **James Tyrell** of 1305 (who was possibly born around 1265-70 and probably died around 1343/44)?
- (2) If that father is the **Hugh Tyrell** of Mannington, has documentation been found to identify the father of the Warin of Itringham who was that Hugh's ancestor?
- (3) Have the **Tyrell/Terrell** marriages with **Swynford** and **Borgate** been definitively located yet?

If the answer to any of these queries is yes, I would greatly appreciate the citations to review the new evidence or interpretations.

This is a most complete article, worthy of further dissemination. Unfortunately, I cannot help with your questions and doubt that anyone can further this discussion, as the available cards seem to all be in play at this time.

Out of curiosity, why is it that **Walter** is alleged to be the assassin--or is it the accidental slayer--of **William Rufus**? His death has always been suspicious, I think primarily because of the haste his brother made to take over the finances and set himself up as the successor. Even if he was murdered, I suppose **Henry** would not have drawn the bowstring himself. Is there any evidence at all of a conspiracy that would place **Walter** and **Henry** together in some diabolic plan to murder **William**? I have always heard that there is no evidence at all of such a conspiracy. Is this legend simply that **Walter** was present and may have been the one to fire the fatal shot? Kenneth Harper Finton

[I responded]

The case against **Walter III de Tirel** is not proven, but is suggestive. **Walter III**, along with **Gilbert** and **Roger de Clare**, his brothers-in-law, were present with the Royal party on the fatal hunting trip, as was **William Rufus'** brother, the future **Henry I**. As to **Henry's** potential involvement in a plot to kill **Rufus**, O.F. Brown (OFB) quotes **Winston Churchill's** "*History of the English-Speaking Peoples*" as stating . . . "There is no proof that he was implicated in the death of his brother, but he certainly wasted no time in mourning. He made straight for the royal treasury at Winchester, and gained possession of it after sharp argument with its custodians."

The **de Clares** and **Giffards** were favorites of **Henry** so a conspiracy speculation is not irrational. However, **OFB** notes that he could find no suggestion of **Henry's** complicity in contemporary documentation. The absence of such contemporary speculation strikes **OFB** as a persuasive indicator that **Rufus'** death was not regarded as suspicious at the time.

OFB therefore concludes that an accidental death is more likely. **Walter Tirel** has been identified as the architect of that accident by several early writers and chroniclers although at least one source, Giraldus Cambrensis, nominates **Ralph of Aix** as the culprit. All versions show variations of the same basic story in which **Walter Tirel** (or **Ralph of Aix**) launches an arrow at a stag which either glances off a tree or passes the stag to strike **Rufus**. **Walter Tirel** probably cemented his claim to being the fatal archer by leaving the country immediately thereafter. One chronicler, Benoit de Sainte More, is quoted by OFB as having the dying king urge **Tirel** to flee for his life.

Whether **Tirel** fled because he launched the fatal arrow or Children of James RAYL and Martha (NEWELL?) are: simply felt that suspicion might be cast his way is unknowable. OFB points out that, late in his life, Walter Tirel was recorded as saying he was in a different part of the wood at the time of the king's death. In any event, the precise circumstances surrounding the death of William Rufus are murky and will probably remain that way.

Where Did Gideon LEWIS Come From?

In 1978, when I started actively researching the LEWIS Family I was pleased to find that other family historians had already tentatively linked to Gideon LEWIS family to William LEWIS of Chester County, PA, and from there on back to the royal Welsh linage, and on back to antiquity. Just about every LEWIS researcher I found had pretty much bought into this theory. Primarily, it was based on a will left by William **LEWIS** where he mentions a young son **Gideon** as one of his children form his second marriage. In 1983, Jeffrey Weaver of Arlington, VA, while going through Quaker records at Chester County Historical Society in West Chester, uncovered the death notice of this 8 year old Gideon who died just 8 days after his father, William LEWIS, and was buried with him. This was a crushing blow to many of the older researchers who had spent so much time with researching this William LEWIS connection. But the fact still remained that this, obviously, was not our Gideon Lewis. So we found ourselves back to square one, where did our Gideon LEWIS originate?

At least three theories have surfaced since that time. All are interesting, but none of them conclusive. The three theories are:

- 2. Nathaniel LEWIS of Wales
- 3. Gideon LEWIS of Charles Town, SC

We will look at each of these theories briefly. Maybe one of them will suit your fancy. There are probably many more theories if we were to examine the records more closely. The fact is we just don't know yet. That is one of the missions of this web site. All of us working together, sharing ideas and data, may just come up with a workable solution.

Abraham LEWIS of New Kent County, VA

According to historians, there are supposed to be 5 distinct branches of LEWIS families in Colonial Virginia, "between whom there is no traceable relation". They are:

- General Robert LEWIS of Wales Gloucester County 1635
- 2. John LEWIS of Wales Henrico County 1660
- 3. **John LEWIS** of Wales Hanover County 1675
- 4. Zachary LEWIS of Wales Middlesex County 1692
- 5. John LEWIS of Donegal, Ireland Augusta County 1732

The third LEWIS in this list is our present focus. This **John LEWIS** was born in Brecon, Wales abt 1640. Some historians say he was the brother to Gen. **Robert LEWIS**, who is the

ancestor of the "Warner Hall Lewis's". They believe that four LEWIS brothers left Wales. Samuel went to Portugal then disappears; William went to Ireland and married a MC CEL-LAND and died there; Gen. Robert came to Gloucester County, Virginia; and John came to Hanover County, VA. Other historians do not think Gen. Robert and John were related at all. Take your pick. My guess is that Gen. Robert LEWIS and John LEWIS have a common ancestor back in Brecon, Wales.

William Terrell LEWIS, and descendant from John LEWIS of Hanover County states in his book, *Genealogies of the LEWIS Family*, that John LEWIS of Hanover County was one of the original brothers who came to America, and was born in 1640 and died in Hanover County in 1726. He was supposed to have lived with the MOSTYN family in *Denbyshire* before coming to America. If this is true that General Robert LEWIS of Gloucester County and John LEWIS of Hanover County were brothers, then their parents were John LEWIS, Sr. and wife, Lydia, who was born in Wales abt 1594 and died in Virginia abt. 1657.

The wife of **John LEWIS** of Hanover County remains unknown. McAllister's "LEWIS an Kindred Families" and Gibben's "The Butcher Book" both say that **John LEWIS** only had two children, **Abraham** in 1679 and **David** in 1685. Both works follow David's line. However, his will filed in Hanover County in 1726 mentions the names of six children: Mrs. **Rebecca Linsay** born in 1677; **Abraham LEWIS** born in 1679; **Sarah LEWIS** born in 1681; Mrs. **Angelica Fullelove** born in 1683; and **David LEWIS** born in 1685. This **David LEWIS** married **Elizabeth Anne TERRELL**, b. 1692 in New Kent County, and their family line can be found in *Genealogies of the LEWIS Family* written by **William Terrell LEWIS**. We know that David's children were "pioneers" in Augusta, Rockingham, and Abemarle Counties in the early 1700's.

Not much is known of our **Abraham LEWIS**. He was baptized in St. Peter's Parish on 27 Nov. 1688. I think some of the confusion is there were four generations of Abraham Lewis's. For the purpose of keeping them straight, we will refer to them as **Abraham LEWIS**, **Sr**. son of **John LEWIS** of Hanover County; **Abraham LEWIS**, **III** probably born abt. 1730 and who is referred to in Gibben's *The Butcher Book* as "**Abraham LEWIS**, Loudoun County pioneer"; and his son **Abraham LEWIS**, **IV** born in Loudoun County, VA.

This **Abraham LEWIS**, **III** who is not our primary focus, moved up to Loudoun County. His will is dated 12 February, 1812 in that county. It mentions his wife **Rebecca**, and his children: **Isaac**, **Jacob**, **James**, **Joseph**, **Abraham** (**IV**), **Nancy**, **Mary**, **Martha**, **Susannah**, & **Rebecca**. **Abraham LEWIS** III had a sister named **Susannah LEWIS** who married **Samuel BUTCHER**. He also had a daughter named **Susannah LEWIS** who married **Samuel** & **Susannah** (**LEWIS**) **Butcher's** son.

County. Gibben's The Butcher Book refers to this younger Susannah LEWIS as the granddaughter of Abraham LEW-IS, (Sr.) the son of John LEWIS of Hanover County.

The theory is that our Gideon LEWIS, Sr. and his brother James LEWIS, along with another brother, Joseph, are the sons of Abraham LEWIS, Jr., whom it seems moved to Lunenberg County, VA near the North Carolina state line sometime before his death. It may be that Abraham Lewis, Jr. had a brother **Enoch LEWIS** who settled in Guilford County, NC. As far as I know, there has not been a will located for Abraham LEWIS, Sr. of Hanover County, or for Abraham **Lewis, Jr.** of Lunenberg County, so who's to say otherwise? If the above statement is true, then the children of Abraham Lewis, Jr. would be; James; Gideon; Joseph; Abraham III, & Susannah.

Nathaniel LEWIS of Wales

This is an interesting theory. Nathaniel LEWIS was born in Wales, or Ireland, and he married Elvira HELTON while still in Europe. He had two sons; James Theopholus LEWIS and our Gideon LEWIS, Sr. James Theopholus LEWIS was born 9 Aug., 1735 in either Wales or England, and died in Perry County, KY in 1825. I guess that **Gideon** was probably born in Wales or England also. At sometime this family was in the Ashe County area of North Carolina. There the two sons married and apparently Gideon LEWIS decided to settle down. James Theopholus LEWIS married Winnie HEN-SON and moved on into Kentucky. He fathered 18 children: John, Thaddeus, Nathan, Absalom, Andrew, Winnie, Sally, Samuel, Isaac, Mary, Patsy, Margaret, Juder, Joseph, Betsy, Elvira, Gideon, & James Theopholus, Jr. At least three of these children are from a second wife whose name is not known. Some of these children were born in North Carolina while the remainder was born in Kentucky.

The problem with this theory is that, other than the descendants of James Theopholus LEWIS, the rest is mostly speculation, having almost no supporting documentation. The problems are:

- 1. There is no documentation that Nathaniel LEWIS ever existed, let alone, was ever in Ashe County, NC. Nathaniel is merely a placeholder for a person who should have existed.
- 2. What colony did they come into from Wales? South Carolina? Virginia? Maryland?
- 3. What record is there that would suggest **James Theopholus** as a brother to **Gideon LEWIS**?

On the other hand there are some good points to this theory.

- The elder Susannah LEWIS died 14 Sept. 1801 in Loudoun 1. The similarity of the names of their children. Both James T. and Gideon had a Nathan, Isaac, Andrew, & a Gideon. You don't see hardly any Abraham's.
 - 2. Some of the spouse's surnames are consistent with surnames found in NW North Carolina.
 - 3. We believe that **Gideon** did have a brother named **James**. (Researcher Ruby Colemon has been shaking this branch for years. I wonder what she has to say about James LEW-

Without supporting records this theory is just a wishful story.

Gideon LEWIS of Charles Town, South Carolina

There was a Gideon LEWIS in Charleston records as early as 1703. He may have had a son Isaac and a daughter Sarah who married Andrew ALLEN. This can be found in several references in Records of The Province of South Carolina 1692-1721 Compiled and Edited by Caroline T. Moore, G. R. S. 1978 R. L. Bryan Co., Columbia, SC. Credit goes to Dr. Hugh PUCK-ETT for this discovery. Several years ago, Jeffrey WEAVER also found numerous references to Lewis's of similar names as the Ashe County LEWIS's in Charleston, SC, as well as, several counties on the Eastern coast of North Carolina. If I remember correctly, there was even a Welshman identified in Charleston. It was determined that many of the Lewis's found in eastern North Carolina could be traced into the Colony of Virginia. It is possible that Lewis's from Charleston or from the eastern counties of NC migrated across the state to Rowan and Wilkes Counties and later turn up into Ashe County. This theory requires much more

As you can see at this point, there is not a theory on the ancestry of our Gideon LEWIS, Sr. that is conclusive enough to "hang your hat on." Either, one of these theories is correct, or they are all wrong and where he came from is still a mystery. One thing is for certain. Gideon LEWIS, Sr. picked the most beautiful spot on earth to live and raise a family.

Lynette,

I have substantial information on this line; however, we have never been able to figure out where this line connects with **Richmond TERRELL** who immigrated to Virginia in 1656. A couple of people have posted some theoretical connections, but they are contrary to known data. We'll make the discovery eventually (I hope). If you will provide a postal address, I will

Lynette,

During lunch I went home and looked up your **Richmond TERRELL** on my database. I'm afraid that I have little to offer regarding Richmond's ancestry (listed as **James TERRELL**). I am, however, sending my listing of the descendants of Richmond TERRELL. From the source list (Endnotes) you can pick up the names and addresses (if known) of a few other researchers of this line.

From census records we know that he and his wife, **Patience**, had 10 children - 4 boys and 6 girls. Until now, I've had record of only two of those children: **John MCTERRELL** and **James TERRELL**. Your **Elizabeth** is new to me, and I would be interested in any information that you would care to share.

You will be interested to know that there was a **Celia Elizabeth DELKE** (1826-1883) who was one of the three wives of **John MCTERRELL**. They had a son **James Richard David Batey Flemming TERRELL**, b. 24 Jul 1852 in Liberty Co, GA.

Hello again Mr. Terrill,

In a separate message I have sent you some information on a **Martin TERRILL/TERRELL** (it was shown both ways) taken from a <u>Liberty County</u>, <u>Georgia history book that I own</u>. As far as I know at this time, he is not in my line, but thought you would like to read about any & all Terrells.

The following is taken from the same book:

DELK, DAVID - The first two persons of this surname to settle in Liberty County were **Samuel** and **Jacob DELK**, brothers, around 1800 in the Taylor's Creek community. They were descended from **Roger DELK**, a member of the Virginia House of Burgesses in 1633. They both migrated from North Carolina to Georgia before the Revolutionary War.

David DELK was the son of Samuel DELK. He bought 100 acres of land near that of his father, married, and had children. His eldest child, Anna DELK, married her first cousin, Samuel DELK, son of Jacob DELK. Their children were Nancy DELK, Jacob DELK, Mary DELK, Eady DELK, & George W. DELK.

David DELK about 1817 received a grant of land in the Gum Branch community for his service in the Continental Army during the Revolutionary War.

After his first wife died he relocated there and married **Elizabeth TERRELL**, whose family also migrated from North Carolina to Georgia. Their children were **John DELK**, **David DELK**

Jr., William Shelton DELK, Elizabeth DELK, Susan daughter Elizabeth DELK who married John Chapman & had **DELK, & Fleming DELK.**

Elizabeth DELK married John CHAPMAN of Liberty County, and they had 15 children.

David DELK Jr. married (1) Mary DELK, daughter of Samuel and Anna DELK, and (2) Mary Leigh CHAPMAN, daughter of Francis John and Mary Leigh CHAPMAN, who migrated from North Carolina to Liberty County about 1800. The children of David and Mary Leigh Chapman DELK Jr. were: David Hamilton DELK, James F. DELK, Mary J. DELK, William Shelton DELK, Nathaniel S. DELK, & Francis DELK.

David H. DELK married Isabel Jane SMART on October 16, 1856. Their children were Zenal L. DELK, James W. DELK, & William A. DELK. He died and she married Robert LONG, and their children were Eliza, Edith Matilda, & Nancy Caroline LONG. After Robert LONG died, Isabel Smart DELK Long remained on the family farm north of the Rye Patch community. In 1900 members of her household included William A. DELK, a son by her first marriage, and Nancy Caroline LONG, a daughter by her second marriage. She died in 1905.

William Shelton DELK (1846-1925) married (1) Sarah Ann SMART, and their children were Sarah, Francis. William H., Mary Beulah, John Andrew, Ruby M., & Jessie V. **DELK**. This family resided in the original home of DAVID DELK, Sr. in the Gum Branch community.

William H. DELK and John Andrew DELK built homes near that of their family, and resided there with their wives and families during the early part of their lives.

The log home of David DELK, Sr. was the residence of Dalton HOWARD and his wife and family until World War II. Its last residents were a **SALTERS** family. It was donated by a descendent of David DELK, Sr., Walter Everitt DAW-SON, to the Chatham County Public Schools in Savannah. Georgia, and became a permanent part of the Oatland Island Educational Exhibit.

Many members of the DELK families of Liberty County relocated in other parts of Georgia, and in Florida, before the Civil War. Some of them returned to live in Liberty County.

John H. and Nancy DELK BAXTER, after residing in Florida, returned to Liberty County. Their daughter, Asenath, married Washington PARKER, son of William Hall PARKER. Their daughter, Cynthia PARKER, married John Hand LONG and they resided in the Gum Branch community

What you see above is about all I know of my line which is through Elizabeth TERRELL & David DELK, by their 5 Elmer Ray TURRILL 1912 -

fifteen children.

Perhaps he has some more information that he would be willing to share, and I will certainly let you know whatever else I learn about Elizabeth TERRELL DELK. There may be some books in the Savannah, Georgia Public Library, which is about 45 minutes away, about the Terrells' in Georgia. I'll keep looking. I have been in the log home that was built by **David DELK** for himself and Elizabeth TERRELL DELK; it is located near Savannah.

I am very grateful to you for sending your TERRELL data to me, Mr. Terrill. You are very nice to go to all the trouble. Thank you too for the TERRELL Society of America application for membership.

I hope we can keep in touch.
