## The Terrell DNA Surname Project

Have you reached a brick wall in your genealogical research? Or, are you wondering if you're truly a descendant of Robert Terrell who married Jane Baldwin in Reading, Berkshire, England in 1617? Many people are now verifying their paternal lines through yDNA surname projects. And many people are bridging gaps created by apparently complete absences of records in critical areas over critical periods of time, and connecting to lines to which they've long suspected they belong. In some cases a few intermediate generations may still be a mystery, but the connection to a distant ancestor is a virtual certainty. And in some cases connections to England (or elsewhere) are being firmly established.

The Family Tree DNA (FTDNA) Terrell Surname Project is not as far along as some other DNA surname projects, but it's gaining speed. Up to the end of January it had been hosted and administered by World Families Network, a Barton family organization which nurtures many infant FTDNA surname projects, preparing them for adoption by volunteers who are willing to assume responsibility and help them grow. I've only just volunteered to take over administration of the Terrell Surname Project. World Families Network will continue to host and support it. My job now is to bring the project to the attention of as many Terrells as possible, to keep the yDNA results chart and pedigree files up-to-date, and to present the data in an informative way. You should take a moment to check out this site, if you can. The various pages can be reached via the tabs in the menu across the top. You'll probably find the **v-Results** and **Patriarchs** pages to be the most important to you right now. The y-Results page is a chart presenting the yDNA test results of all the project's test participants, in color-coded form. The color-coding makes it relatively easy to group members belonging to a common lineage. Across the top are the DYS (DNA Y-chromosome Segment) marker ID numbers, starting with DYS 393. These markers denote places in the Y chromosome where short sequences of nucleotides (A, C, T and G) repeat some number of times. The marker values for each marker, listed in the column below each marker ID, are basically the number of times the sequence repeats (although it's actually a bit more complex than this). The particular markers chosen by FTDNA are those which are considered useful for genetic genealogical purposes. Their main property is that they tend to mutate once every several hundred generations. You may think this is not often enough, but it's actually just right—and some markers mutate more frequently, and some less frequently. With 67 markers you're bound to see a small number of mutations over ten or so generations. You wouldn't want to see too many, since then you wouldn't be able to distinguish one lineage from another. Mutations occur at the time of conception, when a copy of a father's Y chromosome is made for his son. Once a mutation occurs it is passed on to that son's descendants.

The y-Results page alone would not help very many people. But when used in conjunction with the Patriarchs page, one can make connections and profit from the results. Members are encouraged, but not required, to submit Patriarch information (ped-

igrees), detailing their paternal lines from, say, their grandfathers to their earliest known ancestors.

What have we learned so far? So far we've identified two lineages. (We say we've identified a lineage when we see a match between at least two members who have been tested to 25 markers or more.) Both of these lineages are in the R1b haplogroup. R1b lineage I contains three members right now, one of whom has submitted a pedigree. That one is descended from a Joseph Terrell, born between 1760 and 1770 in North Carolina. The first two members, who both have been tested to 67 markers, differ by three mutations. It's possible that their most recent common ancestor (MRCA) was this Joseph Terrell, but it's also possible that the MRCA was a generation or two or three earlier. The newest member, whose 37-marker results are not completely in at the moment, has indicated that his earliest known ancestor is a Terrell born about 1820 in North Carolina. In time, and with more data, the project can tell us a great deal about this lineage, but it's too early now to say more.

The second lineage we've identified, R1b lineage II, is much further along. This is my own lineage. I'm member N60197. Four of the six members of this lineage can trace their paternal lines back to a Roger Terrill who shows up in the records of New Haven Colony in late 1639, and who lived in Milford (in Connecticut-to-be) to his death in about 1681. We know that the four of us are descended from three different sons of Roger. This knowledge, combined with the close matching of our yDNA test results, establishes that we are all indeed descendants of Roger, including a fifth member who did not know his ancestry very far back, and for whom we've filled in most of it. We five have been working outside of the Terrell Surname Project to analyze this data and to firmly establish Roger's yDNA to 67 markers, which we've done. We've also established the yDNA (to 67 markers) of his sons Thomas and Daniel. Daniel's is identical to Roger's, and Thomas's differs by one in marker CDYb. This mutation gives us a means of identifying Thomas's branch. If a new member's vDNA matches Thomas's closely and has the mutation, and the member has used traditional genealogical research to place his paternal line in New England in the 1700's, then it's virtually certain that he is a descendant of Thomas. Roger had two other sons who had children—Samuel and Roger Jr. A descendant of Samuel is currently being tested, and we hope to find a descendant of Roger Jr. willing to be tested, to round out our data set and make it possible for us to place new lineage members in the proper tree branches, as well as possible.

The one member of this lineage who is not a descendant of Roger Terrill is N10308, who lives in England and has traced his ancestry back in England to the late 1700s. It's seeming unlikely that his ancestors left England in the Colonial period. It's a curiosity, and it appears to be happenstance, that he has the same CDYb mutation that marks our Thomas Terrill line. Some of us other members of this lineage are working with this member, trying to help him trace his paternal line back to the early 1600s or earlier, with the hope of determining Roger's origins in Eng-

land. We think the MRCA of this member and Roger lived perhaps in the mid-to-late 1500s.

Southern U.S. Terrells might not be very interested in these detailed results concerning descendants of a New England Terrill, but the results do show what can be done. A lot has been determined from just six test samples. There's no reason to think it couldn't be done for any other lineage, assuming some of the members have done some good research. And actually, some descendant lines of Roger Terrill and of other New England Terrills have lived in the South since Colonial times. Some Southern Terrells could be surprised to discover they have early New England roots.

The third R1b group consists of R1bs who have not yet been assigned to a lineage. Four of the eight appear to fit in lineages I and II, but have not yet been tested to the necessary number of markers to make the assignment certain. Of the remaining four, who match no others, three have submitted earliest known ancestor information or pedigree information. One is descended from a James Tirrell born before 1810 in Ireland. Another is descended from a William Tirrell/Therrel who married a Rebecca Simpkins in Boston, Massachusetts Colony, 29 Jan. 1654/55 (and there's reason to believe a large number of descendants of this couple now live in the South). And a third, B.H. Terrell, who has been tested to 12 markers, may well be a descendant of Robert and Jane (Baldwin) Terrell, whose sons Richmond and William, and grandson Timothy, (have I got this right?), are the Colonial Virginia immigrant progenitors of very many Southern Terrell lines. We'll discuss this possibility further below.

Of the three non-R1b's, one, of haplogroup E1b1a, is a descendant of an Andrew Jackson Terrell, born about 1824 in Lawrence County, Indiana. Another, of haplogroup I1, is of a relatively new (within the era of surnames) Terrell line. His grandfather, a McPherson, was killed in a hunting accident in Canada in 1919, when his father was seven years old. His father was soon afterwards adopted by a William Rivey Terrell, given the Terrell surname, and brought to Texas. This project member has researched William Rivey Terrell's paternal line and traced it back to Robert and Jane (Baldwin) Terrell. It follows that B.H. Terrell (mentioned above), who is his cousin, would thus be a descendant of Robert and Jane. So we may know Robert Terrell's yDNA to 12 markers, and we may have established that he was of haplogroup R1b. This determination is in need of confirmation and extension, of course.

The Terrell Surname Project is hoping to interest paternal line descendants of Robert and Jane (Baldwin) Terrell, of William and Rebecca (Simpkins) Tirrell, of Roger Terrill, and of all other Terrells, to join the project and get yDNA-tested. We would like to make it possible for more and more people to get past their research stumbling blocks and to discover their ancestries. It would not be hard to do, but we need more data. For those who are interested in joining the effort, you should know that FTDNA offers discount testing prices to members of surname projects. You can join the Terrell Surname Project and order

your cheek swab test kit at the same time. We hope to hear from you, and we look forward to working with all who join.

## **Homemade Quilts & Watermelons**

Tina TIRRELL - TIRRELL, RF website

As young children, Huburt & I were sometimes allowed to go with our grandfather, Francis Oliver TIRRELL, to town. We would help load up the cart with quilts that grandmother had made and with watermelons. Grandfather would watch the dogs as we went along to town. He would pick up sticks that these dogs had wet on and take them with him. We would sell our wares to those who would buy them. Now grandfather had a mean streak when someone would not buy a quilt or watermelon. When a person wouldn't buy anything, grandfather would tap this person on the leg with the stick the dog has wet on. He would continue on until he had sold all he could, then we would head home. When we were headed for home, we would always watch for the persons grandfather had tapped on the leg with that stick. We could always tell who they were. #### Samuel Taylor TIRRELL

The following stories have been told to us repeatedly by **Huburt** Franklin TIRRELL & Nioma Lucinda TIRRELL, children of Sam & Sadie. Randy grew up hearing these stories from them, as well as from the other siblings. Sam came to Texas as a young boy. He did not learn to hitch a team of horses until after he met and married Sarah Katherine ELKINS. The TIRRELL family did not approve of Sarah, and the ELKINS family did not approve of Sam. They eloped to Woodward, Oklahoma. Sam was legally not old enough to get married. He and Sarah paid a black man to stand in as Sam, so that they could get married. (I find this highly unlikely, considering the times.) The TIRRELL family all but disowned Sam after the marriage. The ELKINS Family decided they wished to remain close to their daughter. We know more about the ELKINS side than the TIRRELL side. The TIR-RELL Family was sharecroppers, while they ELKINS Family were ranchers. Apparently Sam & Sarah moved to Dora, NM and had a small farm or ranch, which was lost during the great depression. Before leaving the ranch, Nioma remembers that they cut the fences so that the cattle could get to water and food. This is when they came to Hermaleigh and the Snyder, Texas area. Sam & Sarah lived in Francis Oliver TIRRELL's chicken barn for four months before he finally made enough money to buy an old railroad car and a piece of land. This was their first home in Texas. Sam did many things in his short life, he was a sharecropper, helped build the road between Post & Snyder, Texas; put up fences for area ranchers; and helped to build the brick cobblestone square in Snyder, Texas. We have the following records: Funeral Book, Funeral Notice, Original Social Security Card, several photographs. One photo has Sam standing next to a team of horses, Maude & Ole Bawl. He brought this team with him from Dora, NM. The photo was taken at Dora, NM. Nioma says he rode the horses to Tulia, Texas; Ole Bawl died there and he sold Maude to a rancher and walked the rest of the way to Hermaleigh.

#### Sammie Eugene TIRRELL

Tina TIRRELL - TIRRELL, RF website

Son of Samuel Taylor TIRRELL & Sarah Katherine ELKINS. He began as a farmer, was an Army Paratrooper during WWII, and finally worked in the oilfields of West Texas & Eastern New Mexico. Sam lost the two smallest toes on his right foot due to drill collars mashing his foot while working on a drilling rig at Snyder, Scurry County, Texas. The following has been told to us repeatedly by Huburt & Nioma TIRRELL, Sam's brother and sister: While on duty in Germany, Sam met and married a young lady. They had a daughter. This young lady was reportedly the niece of HITLER. When Sam was sent back to the States, he tried to have her and their daughter brought here as well. The Army and the US Government refused to allow them into the country. His death certificate states that he was never married. Your guess is as good as ours. Uncle Sam is buried in the Denver City Memorial Park at Denver City, Yoakum County, Texas. He has a Military Headstone. We have the following records on him: Death Certificate, 1978 Income Tax Return, Military Records, a letter from then President Jimmie Carter, Original newspaper obit., and his Funeral Book. We also have several pictures.

## FLORIDA CONFEDERATE PENSION APPLICATION FILES

The first Confederate pensions in Florida were authorized in 1885 and granted to veterans the sum of \$5.00 per month. The next three decades saw a new Confederate pension bill introduced at nearly every session of the Legislature. Residency requirements were added and adjusted, militia members and widows were declared eligible, various financial qualifications were added and changed, and the amount and method of distribution were changed many times.

## DON TERRILL'S FIGHT FOR MILITARY RECORDS IN TRAILS

*Editor's Note:* We appreciate the military and pension information that has appeared in previous and will appear in future issues of *Terrell Trails*. This is a mere glimpse into the effort Don used to obtain that information for you. *DFB*

Dear Sir:

I am with the Terrell Society of America (Inc.), a surname genealogy organization which publishes a quarterly magazine ("Terrell Trails"), answers queries, and sells a few genealogy publications regarding persons whose surname is Terrell (all possible spellings).

I am presently working on an article for publication consisting of a detailed listing of data on all persons named Terrell (etc.) who appear in Record Group 94 M233 "Registers of Enlistments in the United States Army 1798-1914." The microfilm photography of these records is marginal throughout; however, the photography on the Mexican War Enlistments (spool 23) is exceptionally dreadful.

On 4 October, when I brought this problem to the attention to the Room 400 staff, they certified on a Form 14001 (Reference Service Slip) that important parts of Roll 23 is illegible.

On 8 October I brought this form to Room 410, and they were helpful in preparing the Form 14001 and submitting it so that the original bound volumes (Stack Area 19E4) would be pulled and made available to me in the 2nd Floor Library.

Unfortunately, the form was returned with an attached note which said: "Due to the poor condition of the volumes we are unable to pull these volumes."

I hope that you might answer two questions for me:

- a. Is it possible that I might examine these pages under certain conditions, or is that possibility foreclosed?
- b. In either case, can you take some sort of action to ensure that these volumes are scheduled for conservation? As you might imagine, military service records are important genealogy resources. It would be an important service to the public to have these volumes repaired and BETTER PHO-TOGRAPHY prepared.

Hi Dan,

Thanks very much for your help. This was so much more than I was expecting.

In spending a few years (on a part time basis, of course) tracing the ancestry of my gt gt grandfather, **Robert TERRELL** (b. 1817, Henry Co, KY) of Crawford Co, IL, I have discovered more questions than answers from many people whose families intersect in some way with his.

His likely grandfather, from circumstantial evidence, is **Robert TERRELL**, b. abt 1751, oldest son of the **Robert TERRELL** who m. **Judith TOWLES** in Orange Co, VA.

You can see from a cursory look at Emma Dicken's book, that she saw the descent of this oldest son as a complete mystery - at least she didn't touch it.

I have been doing some original research, checking tax and deed records in addition to censuses in trying to shed some light on this man and his children.

He was probably the friend of **Warner FORD** of Henry Co, KY and served with him in the Illinois campaign under **George Rogers CLARK**. They entered land together in Lincoln Co, KY at the same time, apparently for service in the war. Two, possibly three, of Warner's sons married Terrell daughters. Those daughters say their father was **Robert TERRELL**.

Just this week I was sent the marriage bond of an **Achilles TERRELL** who married **Susannah FORD** in Henry Co, KY in 1812. Written on the back is a notation showing consent given by **Warner FORD**, her father.

So these Fords and Terrells were indeed thick. According to the tax records of Henry Co, there were only two **Terrell families** with male heads, **Achilles** and **Reuben**, when my **Robert TER-RELL** (b. 1817) was born. So I assume one of these two is his father.

The only **Achilles TERRELL** I see in the records of other people is the one from Tennessee who was supposedly born in KY in 1798, too late to be the Achilles in Henry Co. This latter Achilles, along with several FORDS, moved to Jefferson Co, IN in c.1817/18 and some of them moved on to Crawford Co, IL in the 1830s and 1840s.

Thanks again for your great help. I will continue putting the pieces together.

William, I was reviewing earlier entries on GenForum and found the July correspondence between you, Paul Anderson and **James Monroe TERRELL**.

I am presently building a database of all Terrells/Terrills whose North American origin is known or suspected to be Virginia. My database presently includes 31,000 persons (and is expanding). **Philemon TERRELL** is one of those persons. That he had a brother named **Richmond TERRELL** makes it a nearcertainty that he is descended from **Richmond TERRELL**, b. 1624 in Reading, England.

Paul Anderson says that Philemon was the son of **James TER-RELL** who, in turn, was the son of **William TERRELL** and **Susannah WATERS**. Dicken (*Terrell Genealogy*, 1952) reported the same theory. This theory is impossible. Since the will of James TERRELL was discovered in 1994 and published in 1995. That will lists all of James' children, but does not mention a **Philemon TERRELL**. Further, all of the sons of James (except **Jonathan**) are well documented.

I hope that someday we will figure out where Philemon fits, but it won't be as the son of James. However, James' brother **Timothy** (who settled in Orange Co, N.C.) is a more likely candidate. Unfortunately, Timothy's will also contains no mention of **Philemon**. It is possible that Philemon was a (preferred) middle name, and that Timothy's will uses his first name. I have a speculative theory that the real name was **James Philemon TER-RELL** and that he was the son (**James**, b. 1744) of **Timothy TERRELL** (above).

I hope you might be willing to share additional information on the descendants of **James Reason TERRELL** (died in War Between the States).

By the way, I was the person who discovered the 4 September 1863 letter to his wife in the National Archives. If you would like a copy of the handwritten version of the letter, please advise. Don C. Terrill (with the TERRELL Society of America)

Dear Dan.

I am tracing the line of a **Thomas MORRIS** born in New Jersey in 1903, who married a **Mary TYRRELL**. Your index indicates two Mary's of interest to me, but I am unable to determine what publication(s) may either confirm or deny a family connection.
