GENEALOGY? ASK DAN

Q. My dad was a TERRELL and we have tried three relatives to get our lineage, but to no avail. I have information that a great grandfather was adopted. The name went from a FORD to a TERRELL in Marietta, Georgia. I wonder if the family tradition is true. ATB

A. I'm breaking my rule against trying to answer "who was my great grandfather" type questions, primarily to show the value of TERRELL TRAILS back issues.

I did not find anything to confirm either residence in Marietta [Cobb County] Georgia or a surname change from FORD to TERRELL.

TRAILS, pages 398 & 399, contain an abstract from the Will of William TERRELL, Revolutionary Veteran, who made his will in DeKalb County Georgia [now Fulton County GA separates Cobb & DeKalb Counties] during February 1851 (proved in July 1851).

He left portions of his estate to the following persons (no sons or daughters were named in the will): to Sileta HINSON, wife of James HINSON of Alabama; to Mary FORD, wife of my grandson William FORD; to my grandson Coleman FORD, executor; and to my great grandson William TERRELL alias William Terrell FORD, apparently a minor since his share was left in the care of "my friend, William EZZARD." No further information regarding relationships was included.

TRAILS, page 341, indicates that the NORTHEAST COBB GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY; P O Box 1413; Marietta, GA 30051 publishes a newsletter entitled FAMILY TREE 10 times per year. There were no queries in issues reviewed in 1989, however, an inquiry to the SOCIETY might yield a genealogical gem or two.

If that fails, someone is going to have to do some serious digging into Federal census records for that era and area as well as state and county records to confirm or deny your family tradition. Good hunting! DFB

NEW VIRGINIA PUBLICATIONS

Carol McGINNIS has completed an encyclopedic inventory of records and printed materials of the state of Virginia.

Although the book does not include every source in the state it does cover enough to help any serious researcher along the way. The bibliography covers 125 pages and refers to 1,421 books and articles. Cost is \$35.00 plus \$3.00 shipping from Genealogical Publishing Co; 1001 N. Calvert St; Baltimore MD 21202.

Gertrude E. GRAY has released Vol III (1775-1800) and Vol IV (1800-1862) on *Virginia Northern Neck Land Grants*. This covers the territory between the Potomac and Rappahannock rivers. From 1690, shortly after the proprietorship of the area was acquired by Lord CULPEPER. Northern Neck land records were kept separate from Virginia Colony records. Even today, they are still a separate and distinct archive maintained by the Virginia State Library. The two volumes comprise 25,000 Northern Neck residents. The volumes are \$28.00 each and are available from Genealogical Publishing Co. at the above address. Add \$3.00 P & H for first book and \$1.00 for each additional book. Volumes I & II are still available.

OBSCURE LAND GRANTS

By our member #388, Mrs. Patricia J. Achramowicz

An obscure land grant file has been located in the National Archives.

It is referred to in the 1964 Guide to the National Archives as a segregated file of post-revolutionary land bounty claims. This file is not mentioned in the usual section of land bounty claims as it has been tied to the sections involving Indians. This is also misleading as not all of the claims are made by identifiable Indians with tribal names (unless so stated by the claimant); rather, some claims are made by those with military service against the Indians in various federal government vs. tribal nations actions (removing Cherokees from GA, Florida Seminole Wars, etc.)

These files have not been microfilmed and must be searched by hand by archivists. Any research request should be as specific as possible, such as requesting a claimant by the war in which they served (War of 1812, Creek War, etc.).

In my first query, I asked them to research quite generally any files of TERRELL family members, giving them several variations of the surname.

They responded with the following information: of the various spellings (TERRELL, TERRILL, THERRELL, THEARALL, TYRRELL, TIRAL, TURRELL, TUREL, (0) TAREL), in total there are 155 files. At the current rate of \$10.00 per file, this is far beyond my means, and probably that of the SOCIETY.

If others wish to write to query these specific files, they should address it to: Military Reference Branch, Textual Reference Division, National Archives & Records Administration, 8th Street & Pennsylvania Avenue NW, Washington D. C. 20408.

Copying requests from this file are then referred to Dr. Tod J. BUTLER, Chief, General Reference Branch, same address. He arranges for copying of the requested documents and billing for them. At present, he is arranging for copying two of the applications for me, so he is already aware of this particular file.

GEORGIA TERRELL CONFEDERATES Part One

ROSTER OF THE CONFEDERATE SOLDIERS OF GEORGIA, 1861-1865 consists of six volumes and an index compiled for the State of Georgia by **Lillian HENDERSON**, director of the Confederate Pension & Records Department. 28 TERRELLS are listed; one TERRILL, and one TARVELL.

Most of these served in companies recruited from a specific county. Most members of the unit were linked geographically and in some cases by blood and marriage. For this reason, instead of merely listing the TERRELLS who served, I am attempting to include those who served with them.

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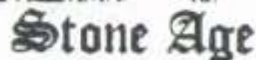
