A. The purpose of *TERRILL TRAILS* is to provide communication for TERRELL/TERRILL (and other variations) to both members of the TERRELL SOCIETY of AMERICA, INC. and the general public via selected archives and libraries.

The lineage you have provided begins with Hannah Ann TERRELL, dau. of Joel TERRELL & Elizabeth Sarah OXFORD, b. 1727 VA, d. after 1793 Warren Co. GA; md. 1745 to Israel BURNLEY. You show the TERRELL lineage through two William TERRELLs to Robert TYRRELL & Jane BALDWIN [of England].

Verification of those generations is: difficult; controversial; and, to a purist like me, almost impossible. Several books have been written covering those generations including *TERRELL*

GENEALOGY by Emma DICKEN which is available through our LENDING LIBRARY. At least two other books are available from the TYRRELL FAMILY HISTORY SOCIETY in England which deal with TYRRELL/TERRELL lineages.

The primary help available from *TERRILL TRAILS* per se is to make your plight known to other descendants of those TERRELLS so that they can contact you and exchange whatever information they have compiled. Secondly, back issues are available for you to research what others have written about those generations. There are few source records in existence for those generations and I can't recall a single one that has been reproduced in facsimile in *TERRILL TRAILS*.

As a TERRELL descendant, you are eligible for membership in the TERRELL SOCIETY OF AMERICA, INC. and we will welcome you with open arms. Even though this article may put you in touch with a few distant "cousins," we will be able to help you and others only as long as our membership grows or at least maintains a level that will permit cost effective printing and mailing. At present, dues are only \$12.00 per year and membership is available through our correspondence secretary listed on the second page of this issue. *DFB*

I would like to voice how upset I was at the article about the San Francisco Earthquake. First I see no historical or genealogical reason for including this story. Second, I don't think anyone who receives **TRAILS** is not aware of almost everything that happened. Third, I take great exception to statements that everyone living in the Marina could afford the loss. I know only two. Both are retired with small fixed incomes; renters; lost everything; and except for generosity of friends would have literally been on the street. I feel the statements were totally out of place and if this publication is going to become a sounding board for "social questions," I want no further part of it. Please limit your articles to items of genealogical and historical (further than a few years back) interest.

Although most information printed in **TRAILS** is genealogical and historical in content; **TRAILS** is not a genealogical publication per se. It is the official newsletter of the **TERRELL SOCIETY OF AMERICA, INC.** The text has ranged from current events about persons with the surname (and their descendants) to abstracts of wills written hundreds of years ago.

Second, the article on the earthquake was not included for our current readers. It was included, at the suggestion of the late Mr. **Lawrence LeSTOURGEON**, for the benefit of future generations. **TRAILS** are (or will be) microfilmed and available to generations long after this sheet has decayed. I hope someone

who had ancestors in that area will be as delighted to read that account (regardless of personal bias) in the year 2100 as I would be to read an account of a disaster one of my ancestors survived 100+ years ago.

Third, I have no desire to offend anyone. I personally have absolutely no knowledge of either the quake or the residents of the area. Therefore, I was not qualified to edit or rewrite the account. Not all our members have either the same interests or the same reason for joining the **SOCIETY**. I sincerely hope I can continue to provide enough variety to hold at least a majority's interest. *DFB*

He married one of his followers, **Rachel TERRELL**, and left four sons: **Henry, Thomas, Nelson, & John**.

John J. STUART, who led an effort to restore a 500-year-old English church his ancestors founded, died of the flu Wednesday at Baylor University Medical Center in Dallas. He was 84.

In 1970, Mr. Stuart discovered the church built by one of his ancestors, **John TYRELL**, in East Horndon, Essex County, about 21 miles northeast of London. The All Saints Church, completed in 1480 and used until the 1960s, was scheduled to be torn down or converted into a restaurant.

"It was an unusually well-built church," said his wife, **Frances DEADERICK Stuart** of Dallas. "Some of them are just stone or frame, but this was a very fine, beautifully designed church."

The seven church bells had been stolen, windows broken out, pews used for firewood, and lead removed from the roof trim, she said.

"John was completely horrified that they would take down this historic church of his ancestors," Mrs. Stuart said.

A group in England, the All Saints Society, was formed to save the church. Mr. Stuart raised \$16,000 in the United States from other TYRELL relatives, many of whom are known by the Americanized spelling of TERRELL.

The restored church is now used for religious, cultural, and charitable events.

Mr. Stuart, a Dallas native, built homes in the Preston Hollow neighborhood, Irving, and East Dallas after studying business administration and architecture at the University of Texas.

In the early 1950s, he designed a 22 home development in Irving, Lynne Park. The development was the first in the Dallas area to have a swimming pool and recreational area for children incorporated into the design, Mrs. Stuart said. The development was named after their daughter, **Betty Lynne STUART**, who died as a child.

Mr. Stuart also operated a real estate and insurance business in Irving and the Gay Theater in East Dallas.

Other survivors include a son, **John J. STUART, Jr.** of Newport Beach CA; a sister, **Wilson STUART Blair** of Dallas; and two grandchildren.

A memorial service will be at 4 p.m. Saturday at Highland Park Presbyterian Church.

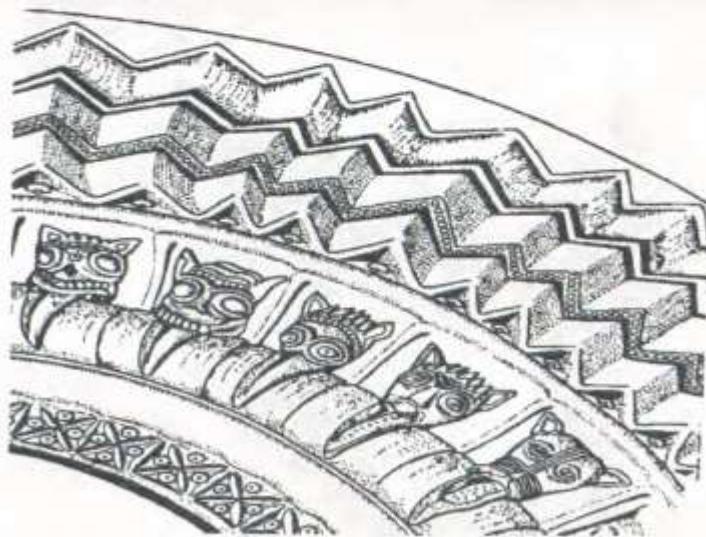

HUGH TIRREL POEM

Submitted by #409 Mrs. Brenna Hobson Budd from microfilms taken at the Armagh Museum on Salt Lake's film #037 4833 0219, roll 9, from the book *Local Rhymes and Jingles* by T. S. F. Paterson

The earliest [local rhyme or jingle] is a far from complimentary verse written about the year 1200 by a certain **Hugh TIRRELL** who had a few years previous been concerned in the capture of the city and the stealing therefrom of a magnificent cauldron, probably a brewing pan, the property of the church authorities, which according to the *Annals* brought many misfortunes upon him.

TIRRELL's satire has often been attributed to an Italian Archbishop of Armagh; "but in reality it had been almost 3 centuries in use then." The original was in Latin and may be (translated) interpreted as follows:

Armagh -- 'tis a pity
Is now a vain city,
deprived of all common morality,
The women go nude,
The meat's taken crude,
And Poverty there has locality.

Editor's Note: Armagh, prior to 1973, was a county in Northern Ireland. It was bounded by Lake Neagh (north), former County Tyrone (northwest), former County Down (east) and by the Republic of Ireland (south and west).

In late prehistoric times and at the dawn of history, Armagh was an important populated area in Ulster. At the beginning of the Christian era, the fortress Emain Mhacha, at the site known as Navan Fort, served as the centre of a kingdom of Ulster extending to the Rivers Shannon and Boyne in the west and south. Also associated with that period is an ancient frontier earthwork, Black Pig's Dyke. Following the decline of Ulster in the 4th century, Emain Mhacha lost its importance; and Ard Mhacha (now Armagh, the county town) became the political centre. It gained added importance after St. Patrick made it his metropolitan site in the 5th century. The area was later ravaged by Anglo-Norman and also Danish (841) invaders, but they made no permanent settlements.

Not until the 17th century did English influence become important in the county. (Source: *Encyclopedia Britannica*)
If the 1200 date of the poem and the invasion in which **Hugh TIRRELL** is correct, that invasion was not considered worthy of note by the *Encyclopedia* publishers.
