WAS THERE A SAINT TYRRELL?

Yes, there really was a Saint TYRRELL - according to the June and September 1989 newsletters published by the TYRRELL FAMILY HISTORY SOCIETY (England).

He was Rev. William TYRRELL, first Lord Bishop of Newcastle, New South Wales, Australia (b. 31 Jan 1807, London; d. 1879). In March 1985, he was proclaimed a local saint under a rarely used ecclesiastical law.

Bishop TYRRELL arrived in Australia from England in 1847. He was assigned to a huge diocese and soon showed himself to be a financial wizard. Through inspired financial management, he was able to supply the sites for Brisbane, Grafton, and Armidale cathedrals as well as his own at Newcastle; and he was able to keep the diocese in very sound financial condition.

Saint TYRRELL became Newcastle's most famous son, and many streets and properties are named after him. He dedicated most of his life to the well-being of thousands of people in the Diocese of Newcastle. March 24th has been declared his official Saints Day, and in each year since 1985 a suitable service has been celebrated in the old Cathedral.

Bishop TYRRELL was joined in 1858 by his nephew, Edward TYRRELL who founded the famous TYRRELL Vineyards of Hunter Valley which today produce some of Australia's finest wines.

BURNICE FRANCIS TERRELL

Dresden numbers among her representative business men Burnice Francis TERRELL, proprietor of the TERRELL DRUG COMPANY and a veteran of World War I. A native of Weakley county, his birth occurred on the 16th of January, 1894, a son of Benjamin Lewis & Rebecca SUMMERS TERRELL, and a grandson of Francis SUMMERS. His father was born in 1867; his mother in 1871. They are prominent residents of Dresden.

Burnice Francis TERRELL attended the public schools of Weakley county and enrolled in the University of Nashville. Upon completion of his course there, he returned to Dresden and started work as a clerk in a drug store. Being an ambitious lad, he took every opportunity offered him to become thoroughly familiar with the business and in 1921 he bought out the store, which is now known as TERRELL DRUG COMPANY.

His business career was interrupted in 1917 upon the entrance of the United States into the World war. In September of that year, he enlisted in the United States Army and was sent to Camp JACKSON and then to Camp SEVIER for training. He was transferred to Camp MILLS and sailed from Hoboken in August 1918. He disembarked in Liverpool; was sent to Southampton and then to Cherbourg. He saw active service in the Meuse-Argonne and in the Vosges sector with a longer station at St. Nazaire. In June 1919, he sailed for the U. S. and landed in Newport News, VA on the 28th of June. He received his honorable discharge from the army the same month.

On the 10th of October, 1921, at Dresden, he married Miss Leone Lewis NICHOLS, daughter of Clarence G. & Mabel HOLFORD NICHOLS. Mrs. TERRELL is a young woman of culture and refinement and she is prominent socially.

Mr. TERRELL is a staunch supporter of the Republican party, having a firm belief in the principles of that party as factors of good government. His faith is Baptist. He is a Master Mason. He is active in the American Legion and a member of the Business Men's Club. Mr. TERRELL is essentially a public spirited citizen and his aid can always be counted upon in the furtherance of any movement for the upbuilding of town, county, and state.

The success he has achieved in the drug business is the result of his own intelligently directed efforts, business ability, and staunch determination. Dresden is fortunate in having him for a citizen.

A. These are typical of the questions we receive from researchers who find us through various sources. I combined these because the answer to each is similar. I printed the names and addresses for the benefit of our readers who share the same lineages.

TERRELL TRAILS has contained information from every period in TYRRELL/TERRELL history since Ralf, Sir de TERIL who lived near Paris France in the tenth century.

Ann TERRELL & David LEWIS, Sr. have member descendants listed on pages 69, 144, 285, & 363-4. Page 272 indicates that David LEWIS granted land to William TERRELL in 1715 in King William Co. VA upon condition of cultivation, recorded 1722.

Nancy OVERTON appears on pages 72 & 148. Page 72 lists her as daughter of Capt. James OVERTON and lists a line of descendants from Barbara Overton TERRELL, sister of Mary

Overton TERRELL. Page 72 indicates that descendants of Capt. James OVERTON are eligible for membership in Colonial War organizations. He was descendant of Gen. Robert OVERTON (1609-1679).

Additional information on these earlier lines is available from our LENDING LIBRARY in *Terrell Genealogy* by DICKEN and earlier works by others. The LIBRARY contains the most extensive collection of TERRELL information in the world.

I hope these TERRELL descendants will elect to join us. We will be able to continue helping researchers only by pooling our information and resources. DFB

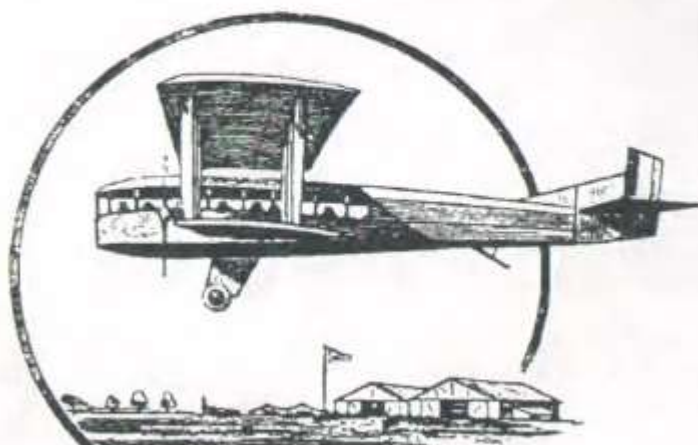

Remembering Steve McQueen: GCC teacher/writer immortalizes hero

There's a little bit of Steve McQueen in author Marshall Terrill.

Terrill, a writer and Glendale Community College instructor who has just seen the publication of his book "Steve McQueen: Portrait of an American Rebel," knows something about succeeding despite the odds. The same can be said of Terrill's subject, a street kid from Indiana who became one of Hollywood's biggest stars.

The 30-year-old Terrill would be the first to admit, however, that his obstacles were nowhere near what McQueen had to face. Unlike McQueen, Terrill says that he had a normal childhood with very supportive parents. That, however, was not the case with Terrill's childhood hero McQueen. While the author attempts to show both sides of McQueen's personality in his 463-page biography, readers will be left with the inescapable impression that the actor was not a pleasant person.

Before finding his purpose in Hollywood, McQueen, who grew up fatherless with an alcoholic mother, spent his early days rolling drunks for cash. Later, with success achieved, McQueen lived a hard life of drugs and drink along with violent confrontations with those who crossed him - enemies and loved ones alike.

While not exactly politically correct, many men consider McQueen to be pretty cool. Women who weren't charmed by

the actor - and McQueen could be very charming, according to Terrill - were often left cold by his behavior.

"Men are a little bit more understanding why McQueen turned out the way he did," said Terrill. "In my book, I tried to show the good side and bad side of him."

The author will be teaching a once-a-week night class on "How to Write a Book and Get It Published" at Glendale Community College starting Feb. 9.

Four years

It became obvious in an interview last week that Terrill would rather discuss his subject of nearly four years research than himself. But that makes Terrill's own story no less interesting.

Terrill, in September of 1989, found his life taking a turn for the worse. He had lived in the Valley since 1982, gotten married and studied business at both Arizona State University and the University of Phoe-

nix.

Things began to sour for Terrill when he was fired from his "runner" job at Lincoln Savings and Loan by Charles Keating (who eventually found himself in prison for his role the savings and loan scandal).

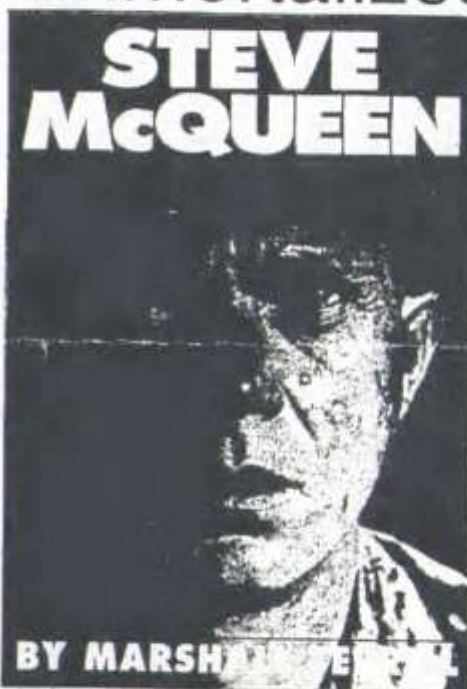
Then, to add insult to injury, Terrill's wife left him.

"My dad called me and said 'You don't have a wife and you've got no job. What do you want to do?'" said Terrill. "I told him that I wanted to write a book about Steve McQueen."

The answer came as no surprise to Terrill's father, who had spent much time with Terrill as a boy in theaters thrilling to McQueen's adventures in movies like "The Sand Pebbles" and "Junior Bonner."

The elder Terrill agreed to put a roof over the aspiring author's head for the three years Terrill believed it would take to complete the project.

"I had no background in writing whatsoever," said Terrill. "It was more deter-



mination than talent."

Terrill's parents lived in Washington D.C. - not a bad town to be in if you need to do research. Terrill spent long days at the Library of Congress getting "every bit of paper" on McQueen that he could. He found a book listing the

agents of actors and actresses who worked with McQueen in order to track down sources.

"I'm told that I did about six months of research in a week," said Terrill. "All my life I never knew what I wanted to do. Once I started the research and writing, I knew this was it."

Terrill found that getting people to talk about McQueen was not difficult, especially considering the people who knew him best were not exactly mainstream Hollywood.

"McQueen's friends were motorcycle riders and stunt people," Terrill said. "Probably his best friend in the world was his karate instructor."

Many times Terrill thought he could get the book out sooner. But he would discover yet another good source, including the nurse that was with McQueen during his final days before his death of

lung cancer in 1980.

During the time he was writing, usually late at night, Terrill knew he was making mistakes. So he would have a friend of his father's, a newspaper editor, correct his errors.

Getting the book published was also going to be a hurdle, but he found that the first company he went to, Donald I. Fine, Inc., expressed interest right away. Being a small publisher (about 80 books a year) the company gave Terrill the freedom to help oversee the project and have input in the packaging.

"I learned from my mistakes as I went along," he said. "The trick is to surround yourself with good people."

More projects

Terrill also has the future to think about. He has spoken to Sam Kinison's brother about a possible project on the comedian's life. He has also spoken with James Coburn on a possible book on his life.

But now Terrill's thoughts are on the class he will be teaching simultaneously at GCC and Mesa Community College.

"This will be my first stab at teaching," he said. "But I figure if I can get a book published - I flunked out of ASU twice - I can probably handle it."

Terrill's class runs from Feb. 9 to March 9, Wednesdays from 7:10 to 9:10 p.m., at GCC.

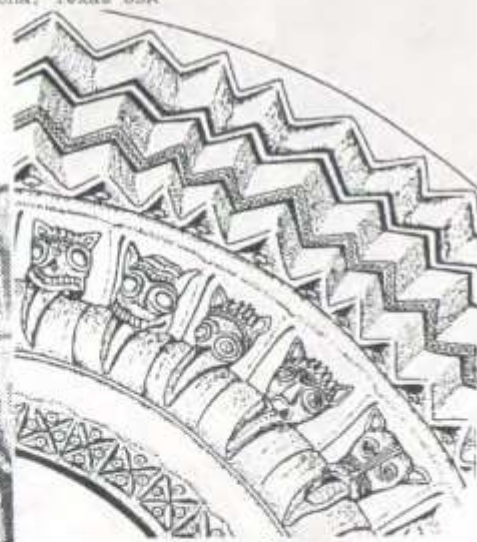

Official Recognition of Your Family Coat of Arms

Many American families choose to display their "family" coat of arms, whether they are entitled to them or not. These arms are sometimes borne based on the knowledge that an ancestor was entitled to display them. More often, they are displayed on the *belief* that an ancestor was entitled to them. In the United States, the laws do not recognize titles of nobility or the hereditary right to the exclusive display of coats of arms. Except for possible copyright or trademark infringement, the assumption and display of heraldic arms is a free-for-all.

In the U.K. and continental Europe, it is a different matter. The granting of letters patent to display arms is a right reserved to the sovereign (monarchy). In some places the trespass of these rights is punishable by law.

If you are going to claim a coat of arms as your own, why not go through the process (and expense) of applying for Letters Patent from the College of Arms in England? It would certainly enhance your own prestige and provide undisputable evidence of your claim to arms.

To find out how this is done, I wrote to the College of Arms in London, and in June 1994 I visited the College.

The College of Arms in London

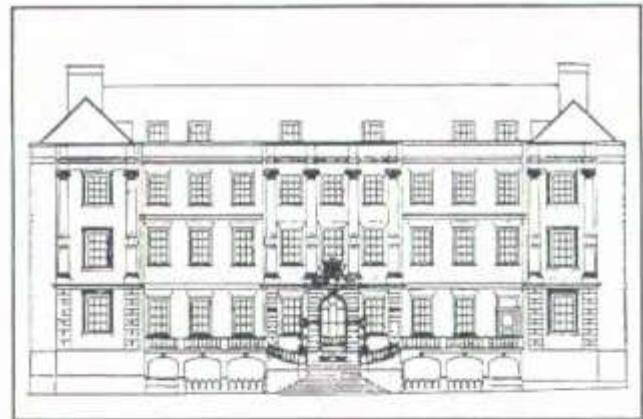
The regulation of coats of arms evolved according to a hereditary system, which required the Heralds of the English royal household to keep records both of arms and family descents. In order to bring his various Heralds and their records together, King Richard III in 1484 granted them a charter of incorporation as the College of Arms, with a house in the City of London. Their second royal charter was granted in 1555.

From the start, the chief among the Heralds, or Officers of Arms, were called Kings of Heralds, or Kings of Arms, those next in rank were known as Heralds, and juniors were known as Pursuivants. All these ranks still exist for the 13 Officers of Arms forming the College today.

Through their work over the centuries, the Heralds have built up a unique registry of armorial and family records. The College itself is one of the few remaining heraldic courts in Western Europe and is now the oldest existing such College in the world.

The Heralds come under the direction of the Duke of Norfolk, and are appointed by The Queen by letters patent under the great seal of the United Kingdom on his recommendation.

They were and still are responsible for the great ceremonies such as coronations, State openings of parliament,

State funerals, and many other events.

The Officers of Arms' daily business covers rights to existing coats of arms and applications for new ones; family history research, whether as part of their involvement in rights to or the granting of new coats of arms or not; identification work; and answering queries from all over the world. They are not paid from public funds and for many centuries have charged professional fees.

The Granting of Arms Today

Anyone who can establish a direct male line of descent from an ancestor whose arms are registered at the College is automatically entitled to those arms. Official recognition of this right necessitates recording of the descent in the registers of the College.

When a person cannot establish a hereditary right to arms, or simply wants to establish new arms, it is still possible to obtain letters patent. Armorial Bearings may be granted to any British subject who is of "good reputation and adequate substance." This is now taken to mean that the petitioner has at least a professional qualification, university degree, or military or civil commission. As arms are granted under authority delegated by The Sovereign to the Kings of Arms, or senior Heralds, they are in the nature of a dignity. The Duke of Norfolk, as Earl Marshal, has absolute discretion to decide whether or not a grant should be made in any particular case.

By special concession, Armorial Bearings may also be granted to citizens of the United States of America, provided that they descend in a direct, unbroken and legitimate male line from any British subject, and first record a pedigree to that effect at the College of Arms. The College would expect to see birth, marriage and death certificates from the recent generations, with extracts of wills, church records, land grants and monumental inscriptions for earlier periods. The petitioner must also fulfil the other conditions of eligibility ("good reputation and adequate substance") mentioned above.

Proof that an ancestor was a British subject does not always require finding a record of his arrival in America from Britain. If you can prove that your ancestor was residing in one of the 13 American colonies on or before July 3rd, 1776 (the day before independence), that should be sufficient to show that he was a British subject. If your ancestor fought against the British during the American Revolution, this is not disqualifying. All is forgiven.

Making Application

The process involves, first, registering your pedigree (with certified proofs) with the College. Once approved, you must submit a "memorial" which is prepared on your behalf by an Officer (this relates to the "reputation and substance" qualifications). When consent for a grant of arms has been given, he will prepare a design based upon your career, achievements, interests and family associations. He will ensure that it has never been used before. You may ask for certain devices to be included, but the final design is at the discretion of the Kings of Arms. They will sign the Letters Patent, the vellum document on which the arms have been painted by artists using colors and gold. These arms can be used exclusively by you and your heirs forever.



Pictured above is the coat of arms of the Tyrells of Thornton Manor, Buckinghamshire (ca. 1517-1905, the last male heir died in 1755). These arms are published as the "Tyrell Achievement" by the Tyrell Family History Society (T.F.H.S.) in the U.K. on greetings cards, banners, sweat shirts, etc. which they sell as souvenirs. These are the same arms as pictured on the 3-ring binders for *Terrell Trails*. They are "claimed" by the majority of American Terrells, since these

persons are believed by many researchers to be descended from George Tyrrell (1549-1571) of Thornton Manor.

Fees

Fees for recording a pedigree depend on its length. The fees payable upon a grant of Arms are laid down by warrant of the Earl Marshal. As of June 1994 they amounted to £1,650 (about \$2,557) for a grant of Arms and Crest. The fees are reviewed from time to time, and are projected to rise by £500 in October 1994.

The College will also do a surname search through their centuries of records and provide a list of pedigrees available. The minimum fee for a surname search is £125 (about \$194).

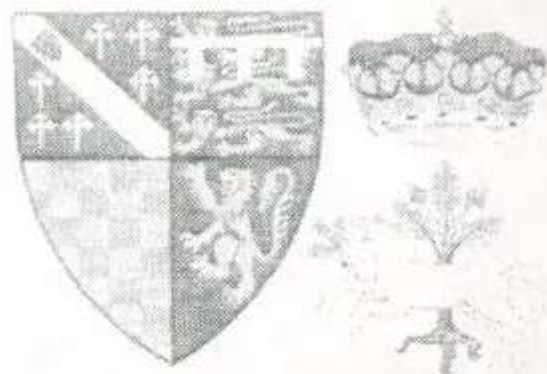
American corporate bodies may also have their arms "devised" for them by the Kings of Arms.

ENGLISH TYRRELLS ANNOUNCE "TYRRELL DAY" PROGRAM

The Tyrrell Family History Society (T.F.H.S.), which is the British equivalent of our Society, has announced their "Tyrrell Day" program for 1995. The event will be of special interest to American **TERRELLS**.

On June 10, 1995, T.F.H.S. members will gather at the villages of Culworth and Sulgrave. Sulgrave Manor was the ancestral home of Gen. **George WASHINGTON**. The manor house was built by **Lawrence WASHINGTON** and completed about 1560. **Robert WASHINGTON**, his son, continued to live there until 1619, and for six years after that date his widow **Anne** occupied it. Then **Lawrence MAKEPEACE**, the son of the builder's daughter **Mary WASHINGTON**, took up residence in 1626 and the house remained in the **MAKEPEACE** family until 1659. Ownership was in the builder's family for almost a century.

The house was purchased by British subscription in 1914, which marked the century of the Treaty of Ghent and thus a century of peace between Britain and the U. S. since the end of the war of 1812. The restoration and refurnishing were by joint British-American effort. The house was opened to the public in 1921. In 1924, the National Society of Colonial Dames of America raised \$112,000 to endow the manor in perpetuity and it has remained open since.

Note: Sir **John TYRELL** (1583-1676) of Springfield and Heron, Essex, md. (2nd) in 1630 **Martha WASHINGTON**, eldest daughter of Sir **Lawrence WASHINGTON** of Stonage, Wiltshire. Lawrence of Stonage was cousin to **Lawrence WASHINGTON** of Wicken, the father of Rev. **Lawrence WASHINGTON** whose two sons (**Lawrence** & **Col. John**) emigrated to America. **Col. John WASHINGTON** was great-grandfather of Gen. **George WASHINGTON**.
